We would like to invite you to join us in celebrating the life of Gwyneth Mary Warner 1923-2020, our beloved mother, in the Holy Oak Memorial Woodland Cemetery at South Farm, Trenchard Road, Stanton Fitzwarren, Swindon, SN6 7RZ on Monday 6th July at 12 noon.



Unfortunately due to the exceptional circumstances only close family will be able to sit in the chapel for the first part of the service. There will however be a video relay to a screen for those sitting outside in the Woodland Memorial Park.

Everyone will be able to attend the Graveside Burial Service (while keeping socially distanced) to offer his or her respects and prayers for Gwyneth.



After the burial we are not allowed to offer refreshment but everyone is welcome to bring their own picnic. There are a limited number of tables and benches available for this; otherwise there is plenty of grass.

At 2pm we will be running a looped slide presentation of Gwyneth's life in the chapel, seating in the chapel will be limited to 10 at any one time, but the slides will repeat.

Please observe social distancing at all times and avoid shaking hands or hugs. Please observe good hygiene at all times and avoid touching things others may have touched, there will be hand sanitiser and wet wipes available in the on-site toilet. If you do not feel well please do not attend.
