Odienné, Cote D'Ivoire -- UPF-Côte D'Ivoire launched on May 21 its annual convocation of Ambassadors for Peace and installation of its Peace Council. This important assembly aims to mobilize many leading actors for the promotion and consolidation of peace as well as for intercommunity dialogue.
