It is good to meet new pastors and really inspiring and hopeful to meet pastors who knew us from before and tell us their good experience with our members. This week Bishop Enoch Ysrael and his family agreed to attend the Pastor Summit in Los Angeles, CA on April 28, 29 and 30. Please include them in your prayers that they will have a safe travel and that they will accept to do the 43 days Blessing course and invite their whole congregation to do the same.
