

Moldova: International Family Day

FFWPU Moldova in cooperation with Ialoveni District Council organized the district level conference entitled “Family and Community involved in Local Development” on May 15.

About 75 people attended, including the vice president of the District Council, a village Mayor, Chief of General Directorate for Education of Ialoveni district, more than 30 social workers and others.

As I mentioned in the previous report, when we met the local administration, they expressed awareness of not having solutions to family issues and showed much openness to work with FFWPU Moldova. So the local administration actively involved in organizing the conference by taking responsibility for mobilizing the audience and the speakers. Since the event had also the purpose of celebrating the International Family Day, our Japanese volunteers prepared two beautiful songs that brought light and joy to the minds of people attending. And the local administration offered flowers of appreciation to a few big and exemplary families living in laloveni.

The event was closed by a nice flash-mob in which participants went out to the street telling people passing by about International Family Day and giving out balloons and other small gifts prepared by the District Council. One more efficient aspect for creating the atmosphere was the welcoming coffee in the morning before the conference began and the tasty warm lunch after the conference ended, both offered by the FFWPU Moldova.

After the event FFWPU Moldova received an invitation to sign Agreement of Cooperation with the District Council of laloveni and with the Department of psycho-pedagogical assistance of laloveni district. We think it was an important and successful event for the providence in Moldova.
