

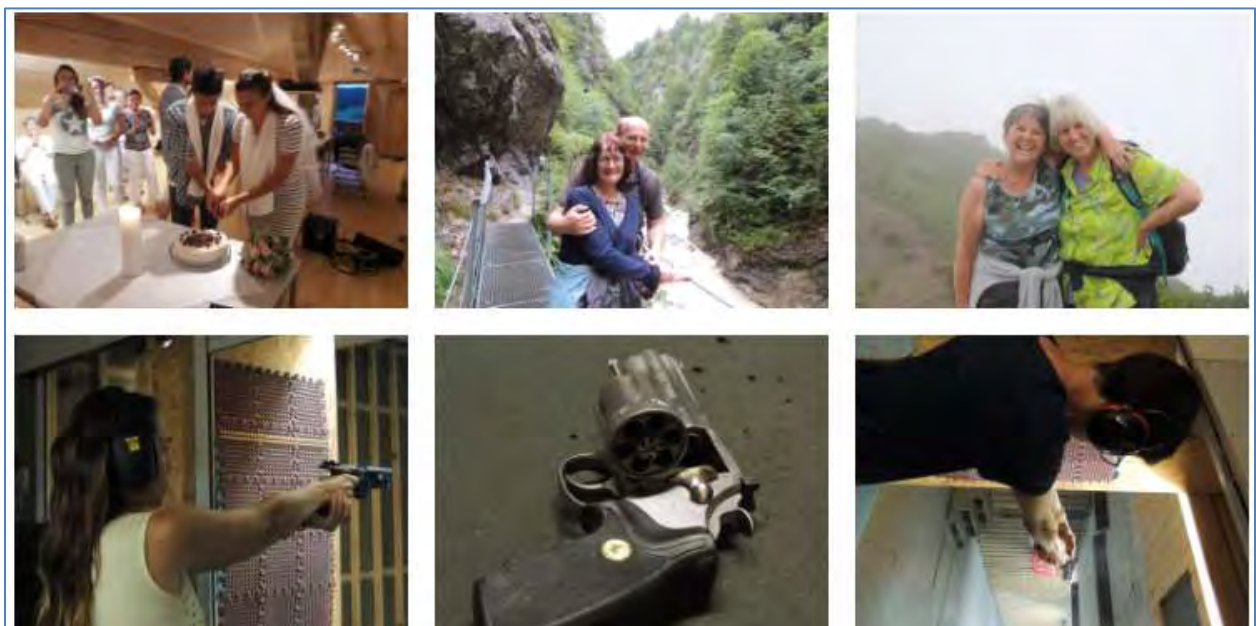
Sanctuary Summer Workshop was held in the beautiful Austrian Tyrol Mountains

The Summer Workshop for Sanctuary members over 30 and families was held for the first time in the beautiful Tyrol mountains of Austria between 27th July and 3rd August. There were Aprox. 30 people who attended adults, children and one baby!

We stayed in the wonderful accommodation Ferien Haus Kohlerhof, which is located in Kramsach. Kramsach is a municipality in the Kufstein district in the Austrian state of Tyrol located about an hour and a half drive east of Innsbruck.



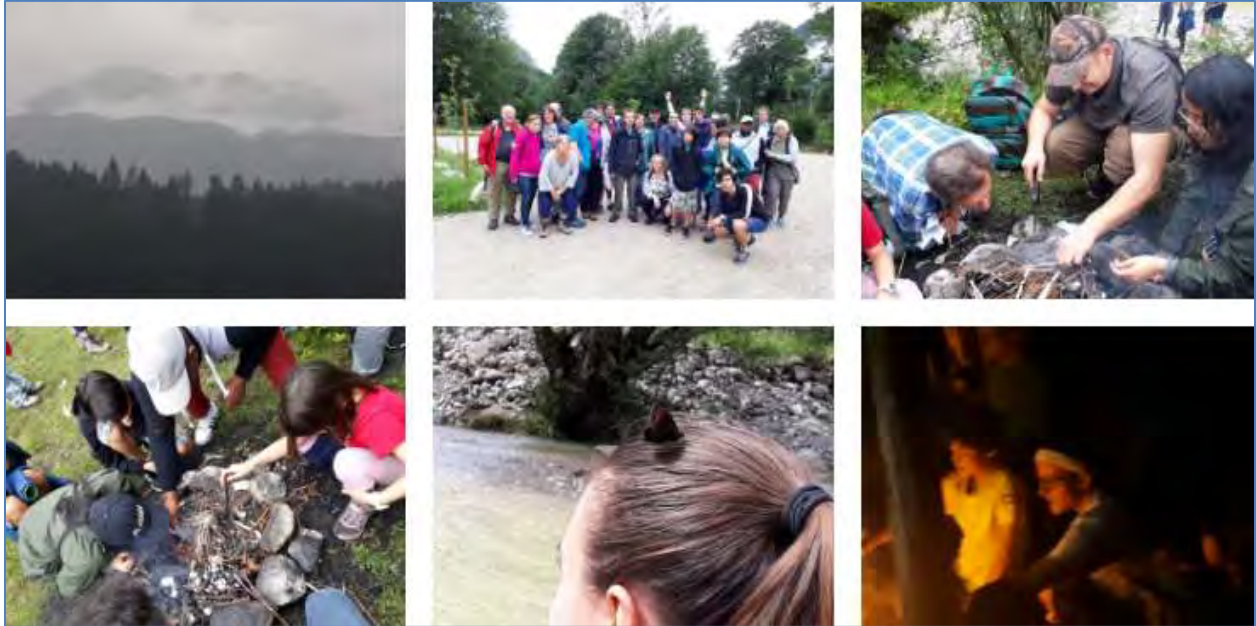
The accommodation is part of a dairy farm and we were greeted every day by the cows as we walked between our housing and the lecture hall.

Our schedule was about 70% activity and 30% presentations, not including Heon Deok Hae which was held at 6.30 every day.

There were a mix of newer members from Eastern Europe and members going back to the nineteen

seventies from Western Europe; some of whom had been part of mobilisations to the UK and the USA.

Our activities included a river walk along the mountain creek, a walk to the mountain peak, fishing, shooting, archery, bbq under the night time skies with good old fashioned fireside sing-alongs in various languages and singing abilities. Walk in the nearby town with an explanations by Christian on Reformation history in the region.



An early morning study session might not sound like a holiday to some but in fact it was a great time to spend with Christian who has a depth of heart and connection with True Family which really is a blessing to us.

The most important aspect of this workshop was not the lectures, activities or even the morning studies but that members from across Europe got to meet each other for the first time and share our hearts and good times together.

My experience in meeting some of these veterans of God's Providence is that they are full of spirit and great heart and it was a pleasure and blessing to make friends. The members from Eastern Europe are a great blessing to us and they have a spirit of goodness and humble heart that is touching and inspiring. It is what I would call a 'New European Union'.
