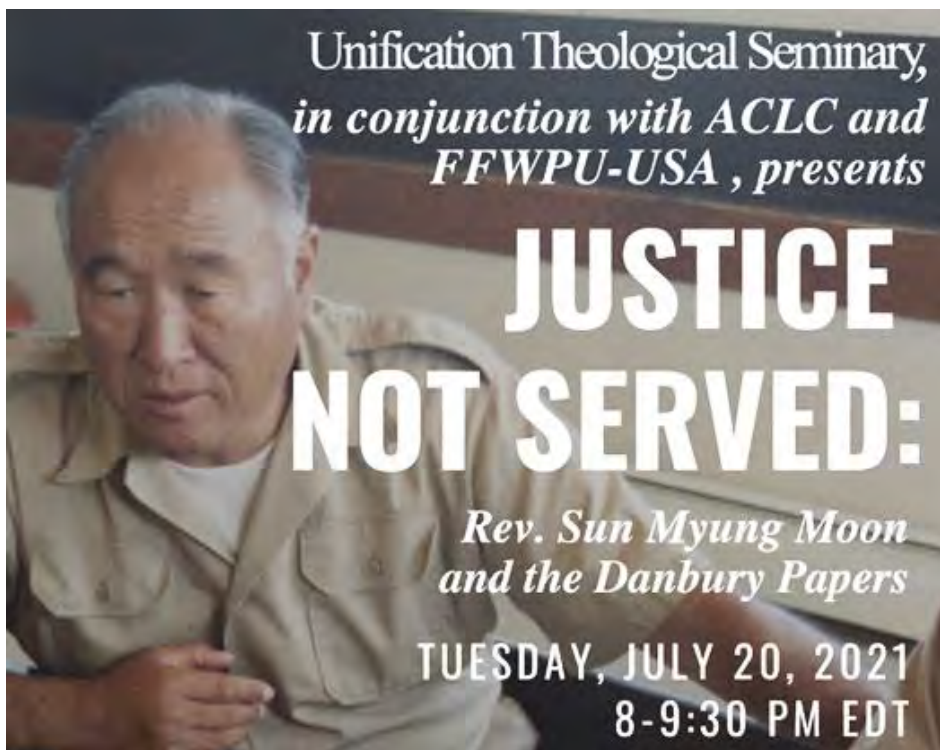


FFWPU and ACLC USA: Justice Not Served - Rev. Sun Myung Moon and the Danbury Papers
