

Ok, the physical Resurrection of Jesus

Yes, this could be deemed as spiritual, but as we read further it says Thomas did not believe the other disciples when they told him they saw Jesus physically, in the flesh, and even said, I will never believe even if I put my finger into print of the nails, and put my hand into His side. But then later Jesus appeared and Thomas was there and exactly that, he became a believer that Jesus was physically alive.

Then we go to Luke 24:36-37...But they were "terrified and frightened" and thought they have seen a ghost / spirit. Then in Luke 24:39-43 we see Jesus said...Handle Me and see for a "spirit" does not have flesh and bones as you see "I have". Then Jesus eats physically some fish and honeycomb. Don't think a spirit / ghost can eat physical food.

So clearly Jesus was saying after he died and physically resurrected that he was no ghost / spirit, which is the reason why the early Christians were motivated to lay their lives down to tell the world that someone had died and then rose from the dead physically, not spiritually. Had that been the case, the whole Jesus thing would not even happened. Nobody would have been interested in some ghost. Nope Jesus himself went out of his way to show he was no ghost, and that after the 3rd day he rose from the dead physically.

That's the whole premise of Christianity, and the reason why we celebrate Easter to this very day. The death and physical resurrection of Jesus, and the promise Jesus said that we also have eternal physical life, not spiritual. That is what a true Christians believe and hope for, all because Jesus rose from the dead physically. If one is a doubting Thomas then be one, but that's the main part of being a Christian.
