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The Peace Militia's Soft Art

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In the Cheon II Guk Kingdom and also even in Peace Militia training, one of our most important training is our spousal training, our spousal training; it's so important. That's just as important as knowing how to wield the Rod of Iron, and be able to defend yourself etc. It's critical, because that's a different way Satan will attack the Kingdom. Are you with me, folks?

So, there are soft arts, there are hard arts hard. Hard arts are very rough, and they're hard; they're very challenging in that field and they're important. They are important for young people to experience because it unlocks our epigenetics, it breaks them out of delusion; it gives some sense of reality, which is very important.

Spousal training

But it's not the end-all. Another critical aspect about Peace Militia training is creating a very powerful Peace Police men and women, Police Militia men and women, spouses. Very important; very, very, important! That spousal training is so critical. You can see the young people who are taking the training seriously and they're blessed under marriage, but they're not taking it for granted; they're implementing training into their daily routine, weekly routine, etcetera.

One of the things that we highly, highly, highly, recommend all our young people do who are married: you must do your one-day training, at least, with your wife. You have to have your spousal- training day; very, very, important. That is where you just go and have a wonderful date with your wife as the king; you have to take your queen out. You know what I'm saying? Now you may say, "Oh! That's so easy; that's not training!"See, this is why even, with the alpha males, that's why Satan comes and destroys their marriage, because they're not taught this.

They're so focused on the hard arts, which are important! Don't get me wrong, that's important. You've got to be able to fight hard against hard enemies; you got to have that. But the soft art of practicing agape love and unconditional love for your wife is for many men a daily struggle, a battle.

For women, unconditionally respecting their husband, that is obviously a softer art then getting your head beaten by another girl, or again choked out by another girl, right? It's definitely a softer art, but many women find that incredibly difficult: unconditional respect for your husband, just as God commands the husband to give unconditional love.

So, on both side, that training is very hard. It just doesn't look so cool on Instagram and stuff like that but that kind of training is very important, and it is just as important part of Peace Militia, Peace Police training, because we want our Peace Militia men and women, Police men and women of the Kingdom of God decentralized, we want them to be in as strong a marriage as possible! Amen!

Critical! Because the stronger the marriage, the better the safety for the children! Not only that: the stronger the marriage, the greater societal impact; and "loving your neighbor" has power now, because it's now King Kyle and Queen Genn loving up the neighbors. You know what I mean? Kyle is a wonderful man, but you don't want him just loving up on you all the time. You want Genn's sweetness. You know what I mean! He's a gruff man, scratchy beard; you know what I'm saying?

That is a critical element of the Kingdom's safety and the Kingdom's security system; absolutely critical.

So what I'm talking about, especially young people don't take this for granted; your parents did not get this kind of instruction or training. Clearly, you guys have a real gift, okay, but you have to actualize it; you have to train it. Just like for many years we trained you for free; that's a gift. You don't deserve that, you, young people. You're not worthy of that; I don't have to do it for you right! But we did it for you because we want you to improve.

Many of them now are blue belts; that's really the societal standard. Everybody should be Brazilian Jujitsu blue belt, at least. Whether you proceed on from there is another thing but at least blue belt.

But it's the same thing: your spousal training is so critical! Because you know, once you get blessed and you're living together, things get lost in the daily life. You forget; you get lackadaisical! You know what I mean? You forget why you're grateful. I would say, most days, spouses <u>do not</u> count their blessings.

That's a problem, isn't it! Imagine, you live your life and you are a godly man or woman, but you live your life and for days and months and years, you don't stop and reflect on gratitude for your spouse. Now, think about that! I know many of you probably know somebody- it may have been you- who lived that way. Are you with me, folks? That's a problem!

That's a serious problem, because what happens? Satan knows that; he knows he can get in through the soft arts. The hard arts make him scared, but with the soft arts, he knows he can try to sneak in there. So, this is just as much of a battlefront as Antifa or BLM Marxists coming into your neighborhood. This is serious!

Because if you do not water the seed... This is the *Parable of the Sower* which we're on today. Let's go to Matthew chapter 13: 31. Well that was a great sideway! Thank You Lord!

Matthew 13 verse 31-32

* "31 Another parable put he forth unto them, saying The kingdom of heaven is like to a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and sowed in his field: 32 Which indeed is the least of all seeds: but when it is grown, it is the greatest among herbs, and becometh the tree, so that the birds of the air come and lodge in the branches thereof."

Outdoor Arts Training

This is why Father wanted to train us in all these outdoor arts, like horticulture and agriculture and aquaponics, and fishing and hunting. You learn about nature, you learn about natural law. If you have a great appreciation for those nature skills and those nature arts like horticulture, agriculture, plus if you have a little bit of interest in science as well, it even enhances the majesty of the created universe. You know what I mean? It helps you reflect on it at deeper and deeper levels, right. I understand not everybody's into the intellectual sides of science, but if you are, that does increase many times what we can see in the natural world.

For example, if you understand the ratio of the Fibonacci spiral - I did a whole lecture on that - and you have as one of your training to go out and see how many Fibonacci spirals you can count in the natural world. That's a soft art; that's not a hard art, right! That's not like 'bamm, bamm,' right! That's not a hard fighting art, but it's a skill set which gives us tremendous gratitude, appreciation for the architecture of this world that we live in, which of course was created by an Intelligent Mind whom we call God.

There's mathematics behind this veil of green leaves. People who don't know for example natural wild herbs, when they go outside, all they see is green; they can't tell the difference between a maple leaf and an oak leaf. You understand what I'm saying right? You know these kinds of folks, city folk? They come and say, "All I see is trees, green trees everywhere!" They don't know each tree's different species. They don't know that when you look on the ground, all these different types of edible plants, poisonous plants whatever the case may be, but they just look green. If you don't know how to look, if you don't have eyes to see, you can't see it.

Just like if you don't know how to look at an impressionist painting or a Monet, you can't see it. Are you with me, folks? And that's the same thing with God's creation.

That's why hunting is a very interesting art, because you have to sit in the morning early; you see the slumber of the night turn into the opening of the day with songs. As soon as it starts getting a little lighter, "pew, pew, "you start hearing the bird songs and you're sitting; you've got to sit quiet because of the deer walking around. So, for many hunters, it's not about killing the animal; it's about just being outside in nature, just seeing that shift from night to day, and how things come alive.

There's no specific point when it comes alive. It's just somebody decides to praise God; some bird in that neighborhood decides, "Hey! I'm going to go a little early today!" (*Bird sound*) You know what I'm saying? Sometimes they have a competition, so at 2:00 in the morning, they go, (*bird sound*) "prooh, prooh, prooh!"

But, this kind of ability to be able to see! For example one exercise I make my children do when they're growing up is teach them how to see with an artist eye. I'm not the greatest artist, but I'm also quite artsy; you know for a person who likes these kinds of harder arts, I'm quite artsy as well. But for example if we're looking at a particular plant, let's say and I would do this: for example we're picnicking outside and there's a plant there; there's some flower, whatever it is. Then I'll say, "What colors do you see in that plant?"

Now the undiscerning, brain-dead ignoramus is going to say, "Green!" But that's not an artist eye! An artist that will paint that painting of that leaf or that blade of grass, he's going to start putting in yellows, he's going to do oranges; he's going to start putting purples. Are you with me, folks? There are a lot of layers of colors!

There's one guy that I like; he's a bush crafter.... He's a very good brush crafter, very good. He's very capable; he understands bushcrafting wilderness survival. He does solo missions into the wild for seven days; you know what I'm saying? He can do what most people cannot do.

But one of his things is he's a painter. So he goes out in these very remote areas, nobody around, nothing, and he will set up camp. He has this little portable easel that he can just put in his bag; it folds into a little box; some kind of French thing, I don't know. It's a little box; just throw it in your bag. He pulls it up, the easel comes out. He's making a painting about that big. It's impressionist painting; he's got all the different colors on it, and he's painting that campground, he's paying that scene that he's seeing.

And if you see how many layers of color he's putting in that, the normal person just would not even assume that many layers of color go in! Are you with me, folks? But when you see his final picture you can see, because you watched him make it from the base; you can see all the different layers. It's like a hundred different colors in there; it's pretty crazy!

But this kind of thing is important because, if you only can see something and you just say, "Oh! I just see green!" No, no, no, there's so much more richness there! So, one of the exercises I would do with my kids when they were growing up-sometimes I do till this day because I have some younger ones still – to make sure that they have a mind that is able to do that, that they can see in a different way than normal people.

And I'll say, "Okay, what colors do you see in there, in that little leaf floating on the water?" And they'll tell me, they see gold, they see white from the reflection; sometimes you see a little reflection on that leaf and it's got a little bit of a oily glaze like a poison ivy oily glaze, but it's not poison ivy and it's

got a little bit of a reflection. You got a little white in there, you got a little light blue in there; you see what I mean? You've got all sorts of layer of richness in that.

Now, if you have that skill and you are riding with the Rod of Iron Calvary on the iron horses, on the motorcycles, now when you see nature, it's not like, "Oh, I just see green everywhere." "Oh, there's an oak tree. Oh, there's a maple tree. Hey! Look at that! That's a little dandelion over there! That's a plantain I just drove by!" You see so much more richness, "that's a hardwood tree; that's a pine; that's a different type of pine!" You see?

And now just walking, just taking what would normally feel monotonous! Just driving down the road with trees coming forth seems very monotonous; people with very low attention span, low IQ cannot focus, so they just get bored when that kind of thing happens right. But if you're able to see and constantly keep your mind excited about the different variations of color, form, shade, whatever the case may be, now that whole thing has become rich. Are you with me, folks?

Daily Life Training

So, this kind of ability with your eyes and your mind, it's so important, so important! Because it helps add to the richness and gratitude that we can feel in daily life, daily life training. Daily life is monotonous! Can I get an 'amen'? All right! There you go; it's no big surprise! You know people always want entertainment; they want to be entertained all the time. No, daily life is monotonous, but the key is trying to count those blessings!

It's almost like you're on a hunt. You know what I mean? You are exercising your mind; you're trying to find out today, "What are some blessings God has given me right now?" Your baby could be crying, hollering, wailing, and you could get up, caught up in that moment in emotion, and you could start saying, "oh, you crazy baby, stop that!" You could do something like that, right, which would not be good.

Or, I know some Korean grandmas that when the baby's crying say, "Oh, good they're exercising their vocal cords for singing!" That's what they say! So, if the baby's crying, "oh, good! You're going to be a good singer!"You got to change it around, not let the anxiety take over!

The baby is trying to communicate obviously; he's just trying to say he has a need. Maybe he's hungry or he needs to be changed, but he doesn't know how to articulate that. So, he has only one word he can use: this is "waaaah," when he's small. But if we take that in a constant way, "why are you always shouting and crying all the time? Why are you always complaining?"

To an adult Mommy it may sound like complaining, because there's nobody in Mommy's life that just walks up to her and starts, "waaaah!" Nobody does that in her daily life, so she associates that with bad behavior. So, when the baby does it, then what happens? Mommy can start getting upset,

frustrated, anxious about the baby; she can even at times hate the baby. A lot of moms don't want to admit that, do they? Hey, we understand, you know; emotions can get tied up.

Mental Martial Arts' Training

So, it's important to be able to have dominion over your mind as well as your body right; dominion of your mind. So, when the devil is trying to pull you to the negative, you're able to switch it around and counter-attack with the positive. Amen! So, that's a good habit.

For example, one of the habits we did, when we were training with our kids, sometimes you just want to cuss out your kids, "you, little piece of shish-kebab," you don't want to say shish-kebab, right? Sometimes you feel like it, but it doesn't mean you have to do it.

Just because you feel like it, doesn't meaning you have to do it, right!

Look, men feel the urge for violence all the time. We want to kill people all the time; it's just normal. Okay? It's just a normal thing. You're never going to get that out of us! But we don't do it. Sometimes we'll have imaginations; we'll imagine cutting somebody's head," I'm going to get that sucker!" But we're not crazy or anything. That kind of visualization and mental preparation is important for warfare for example, right. When a bad hoard of jihadists or communists is coming your way you want the men to be thinking about that. So, it's not like it's necessarily a bad thing, but even though we have those thoughts, it doesn't mean we act on it, right?

It's the same way having that discipline. Even mommies, sometimes we may really be angry at the baby or at the child, and we want to just unload on the baby or on the child. But if we do that, we're going to regret it later; we're going to regret it.

So, then it takes time, "oh, I'm going to turn this around: the baby's crying, I'm not going to see it as complaining or anxiety. I'm going to say, "Whoo! She's practicing singing!" So, whenever the baby starts singing, I'm going to start singing!" Of course, you tend to the baby; you get the breast milk in, you got to clean the diaper. You got to do what you got to do, but you can sing with the baby.

But this kind of 'mental martial arts,' let's say, it's very important, because the devil attacks you in the mind. The devil attacks you in the mind, always starts in the mind; always starts in the spirit. So, having this ability to have the mental martial arts' training, it's important.

That's why even when you raise your kids, expanding their perception this way actually helps with harder forms and external forms of martial arts, where you actually have to fight enemies, because you're expanding their level of situational awareness, by having a child who has been trained to understand and see more depth and be aware of more of the colors in a particular leaf, or the sounds that they hear around them or they hear in nature.

You know a lot of kids go through nature, they go deaf; they walk through nature deaf. They're so addicted to video games, they want to just, "Aw! It's so boring! I want to have a game; it's so boring! I want to have a game," this kind of thing. They can't focus, so they don't know where to place their mind, and their mind just keeps on wanting to jump on the fact that they're bored, or "this is boring!" Or, "why is daddy making me walk through these woods!" or whatever the case may be, right?

But you have to teach them: "when you have those times where your mind wants to go towards the negative because that's where Satan can dwell, in that realm, you have to take dominion of your mind, you have to take dominion of your thoughts; you have to subdue them!"

The Bible talks about," *Bring all thoughts into captivity; all thoughts into captivity of the power of Christ Jesus!*"(KJV) That word 'captivity' is used-having control of your mind, your thoughts, bringing them into captivity, controlling them; knowing how to control them! Just like you would somebody in jujitsu or something like that!

Soft Arts Training

This kind of internal or soft art is critically important because, look, external arts like fighting and shooting all this is very important. Everybody in the kingdom will have to train in that, because we have to be shepherds, but at the same time that's a skill set you're probably going to use maybe .0001 % of the time. Are you with me, folks? The rest of the time, 99.999% of the time, you are actually going to be relying on your soft arts' training.

Because by having that mind-body unity, that's how you communicate with other people; that's how you make networks and friends and that's how you control your emotions when your kids drive you nuts, or something like that, and you don't make a terrible mistake you will regret. Things like that, it's the 99.9 percent; it's the soft arts. Are you with me, folks? So, this is important; this side of the warrior is very important.

Remember, God is the God of war: He's the God of Israel, and He is the God that vanquished the Ammonites and the Canaanites etc. He is the God of war! But, at the same time, remember He's a painter as well, He's a mathematician; He's a scientist. He displays beautiful art pieces that we see every day, changing, variegated folds and folds of color, manifold layers of richness in a sense. He can do it all!

So the father in the household must be challenging himself as well to be emulating these aspects. Now, some daddies go too much artsy, and they don't do the hard stuff; that's a problem; that will lead the whole family towards usually communism and socialism, because that whole world is dominated by communism and socialism. So, it's critical!

That's why Peace Police, Peace Militia and citizens' Police force are accountable to the people, and all the people are involved. The citizens are the police; the citizens are the militia. In this kind of decentralized kingdom model, those hard arts are important. Nobody can run away from the hard arts because that's our duty to society; that's our duty to God and country; that's our duty to keeping people safe. So, that kind of training is critical!

But, at the same time, we have to have also that other element. In daily life at home, you are dealing mostly with whom as a husband? Your wife; you're dealing most with your wife. So, also cultivating those kinds of soft arts too is important for you to be able to communicate properly.

If you are the type of husband that sees, "that plant is green; it's just green," you're not adding value to her perception of the plant. But if you are the type of husband that says, "Oh, you see that blue there? See the yellow there? See the little purple there?" And, "Look at that! Gorgeous! Look how God painted that! Look at that edge! Look at that serration on that leaf! Ooh! Lord, look at that! Look at how it turns off to the side like that!" You know the mint stalk is square; it's got little hairs on it. You know what I mean? Different from a different stalk which is round, you know!

So, if you have this type of paying attention to minutiae, would a queen like that? Would a queen like that if you have that ability where you can pick up on things which have small minutiae? Why does your wife like that? How does that play into her life? Sisters, if your husband can pick up on small things, is that a good thing? (Yes) Why is it a good thing? Why is that a good thing? Why do women value that? Like beauty? What else? Details- okay- attention to details, attention. This kind of thing, it shows your mindset right.

You can pick up on small things, then when something's going down in your family, there's some weird energy- you know what I'm saying?- when all of a sudden in your relationship there's a cold breeze that comes through, you can feel it, okay! Do the sisters like it if your husband can feel that?

Let's say you're not in a good mood today, something happened, or whatever the case may be, and you're worried about this or you're worried about that; worried about your grandma, worried about your sister-in-law, worried about your sister and your daughter and your granddaughter and nephew and niece and whatever, and you're not even moving, and then the husband is in there and he can't pick up on that. Is that frustrating or not? (*The Queen answers loudly "Frustrating!"*) You heard the Queen, okay! Why is that frustrating?

For men it's not frustrating; in fact that's a sign of respect, "I'm not going to get up in your business, man! You got some problems? That's okay! You hold on to your problems! Work on them; work on them!" Okay? It's an opposite world!

Sibling Realm Training

But you can see; that's why Father always said, "big family, big family!" You need to have a lot of children, because for the boys, sometimes your sisters drive you nuts, but through that, they're actually teaching you something. I'm not saying they're like your teacher or something, but organically they are teaching you a lesson. You can see boys in their families that can get along good with their brothers and sisters, usually are quite balanced; they're quite balanced. They can deal well with both sexes. Now, usually; there are wacky ones of course.

That's why Father said, "Have lots of children!" The sibling realm is also a training realm; it can't just be left to the sibling realm, because then it becomes the *Lord of the Flies*, right. We see where children trying to lead children, leads to murdering, death and chaos. They've got to be led by the parents. But it's a layer of education; it's a layer of training that grows that realm of heart, in the four great realms of heart. It grows that sibling realm. You learn how to interact generally with boys, and girls. You learn how that there are real differences in terms of the girls' world and the boys' world.

That should become a part of education and training place but of course, but it's like in any school; there has to be guiding, there has to be coaching. You can't just put a whole bunch of kids in the dojo and say, "okay start learning MMA," without any guidance. You see what I'm saying? It won't work. They're going to end up coming up with some ridiculous, deluded things, and the first time they actually fight somebody they're going to get destroyed. There has to be coaching, there has to be leadership in the home; there has to be governing.

God's Royal Priesthood Training

When God makes us kings and priests, the part of the king of course has authority over the kingdom, but the part of the priest has spiritual authority and also spiritual responsibility, meaning, the head of the house, the husbands at home, we have to be very, very, serious about training up our children into God's royal priesthood. Are you with me, folks? That element has to be there.

It's not a matter of just doing well in school, as a lot of parents are just focused on. Of course now I think people are waking up; they realize that the schools are brainwashing camps. We have to teach them of course, authority. What is the king dimension of that? It is a political position. Of course, it's connected with God, but also it has a political power.

Political Training

It's also training our children in understanding political reality. It's very important having those discussions of politics, turning on the *King's Report* and discussing with the kids what you heard on

the *King's Report*; if they're old enough having them report to you, "what were some of the stories on the *King's Report* that you want to talk about? - Things like that.

This is where atheists, agnostics, political Satanists and leftists, they understand they've got to get your children, and they've got to turn them with any means possible -any means possible- against the parents, against marriage, against committed relationships. They're going to turn them away from that, and go to shallow relationships, entertainment, pornography, women's porno, which is dramasame business model around pornography for men, drama (the genre of drama) porno for women; same fantasies that are being stimulated in those two genres.

Whatever they can do, they want to pull them away, and they want to make them into political weapons, because their aim is not to raise up people of conscience; their aim is to gain power. So they need to get rid of the layers and the walls to that power.

Marriage Preparation Training

That's why they're so adamant about taking control of education, so adamant about controlling what your kids can see and cannot see, or what they should be taught at a young age like the sex- education courses they are putting in the schools. They are crazy, lunatics!

Because, if they were teaching marriage and how to prepare for marriage, and how to remain pure before marriage, that's a healthy form of sex-ed. You prepare yourself for marriage, you're learning about marriage before you get married so you understand the landscape of it, you have realistic expectations that have been formed and developed; not these crazy Hollywood, unrealistic expectations. You are living with a person, not a movie actor, okay! So that kind of thing is important right, keeping your purity before marriage- which is absolutely a fundamental part of Christian civilization, which of course the West has lost completely!

I mean the Bible says, "Fornicators will not inherit the kingdom of God." That's serious! But you got even major churches everywhere, they're encouraging their kids to date and fornicate! It's ridiculous! It's totally ridiculous; it's a totally anti-Christian culture under the guise of Christianity; it's not real!

Why aren't the church teaching abstinence before marriage, valuing yourself before marriage, keeping yourself before marriage; it's critical! It's a critical, fundamental aspect of all of 2,000 years of Christian history. This is a very critical, critical, aspect!

This whole dimension even of the Rod of Iron Kingdom, where there is liberty, there's freedom and responsibility, critical element! The kings and queens of the Kingdom are deadly warriors, are dangerous warriors, but how delighted would Satan be if he could break those apart, break those marriages apart; tear them down slowly, wear them down. Look your marriage may start good, but if you do not water it just like we see in

Matthew 13: 31-32

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There are a whole bunch of parables here, but we didn't even start this parable, and we went for an hour already, so I don't think we are going to cover them all today.

Gardening Training

You see, critical aspect in planting the seed: you can't just plant it. You have to water it too. How many people are now starting their farming, and they're raising their plants? You guys see, that's a sensitive art, man! Golly! It's sensitive! You overwater, you kill them; you underwater, you kill them. You don't read the signs right, they die; you read the signs all right, bugs show up on them, right!

I planted roses last year; they did great. They came up strong and powerful. I even looked up on YouTube how to trim the rose bushes. You trim them like a vase; you empty out anything in the middle, any crossing branches, so then they flourish up. I never liked roses when I was younger, and I liked more Asian flowers kind of; I felt that was different. But I love roses now; they're beautiful! I pruned them; they're doing wonderful. They're rooted in; they're doing great. The blooms! The whole thing is pink, red; the whole bush is red!

Then we get up close on that guy, the leaves are gone! The leaves are solar panels! The caterpillars ate through all the solar panels; no more electricity going to that flower now! Now I got a problem, big problem! So, we make up the mixture with the vinegar and the soy sauce, and whatever. Don't try that recipe okay! It was not soy sauce. Vinegar, soapy water, garlic inside, pungent herbs, onion; blend it up, and it becomes like a garlic spray. Hit the plants! What happens? You hit them; the caterpillars go away for two days. On the third day they're back eating; they're back eating! They only stay away as long as the garlic hour is playing, okay! Once it rains a little bit; once there's a little bit of due, and moisture, garlic hour is done, all right; now it's salad time! Boy, oh boy, I tell you! Bread stick hour is over! Golly! And they come back like they want the endless pasta at Olive Garden! They want some food; it's crazy, crazy!

Well, it's a constant battle with them! Some of your folks, are starting farming and of course gardening, and you notice the weeds; those weeds they come back with a vengeance, don't they? You clipped them down just a couple of days ago; new ones, six feet tall!

These kinds of things are very important to learn actually, but you can't just learn them without thinking; you have to think about them. You have to actually reflect on them; you have to use your brain about the principles you're learning. So for example, even that simple principle of watering a plant, if young couples understood this, they're helping the health of that plant ten years twenty down the road!

Family Relationships Training

You, young couples you must be committed to at least once a week, train with your spouse. You have a date, you separate from the house, you go out; you have a wonderful night for your queen. Okay? Get her out of the house; get her out of that space! If you got in-laws living in the house she needs to get out more - do you say outlaws or in-laws? - That's incredibly important!

But notice, a lot of the sisters won't ask, and it would be easier if you just asked, of course. The males think, "Hey if you want to go out, just ask! Why is it that hard?" Trust me it's hard, it's just hard; you're not going to change that.

If they ask they're going to get in trouble with the other girlfriends or they're going to get envy or comparison, and if they're trying to be godly and spiritual, they may be getting judged, "oh, you just want to do secular things; you're not going out to pray!" They may get some of that stuff too from some Pharisees that are in the church. Are you with me, folks? They're going to get this. There are different pressures you're not aware of.

To you it may be as easy as, "baby, just ask me when you want to go!" And then she doesn't ask you, but then all of a sudden she's angry, and you're like, "why are you angry?" "Well, we never go out!" "Well, you never asked!" That's the problem! You see what I'm saying? That's the problem!

This kind of realization is important. Men don't know about women; women don't know about men! That's exactly how the devil wants it! We got these small families; we don't have a lot of siblings, small families torn up into the brainwashing education camps. They're taught by the Department of Education about what they should believe, and then the schools are funding transgender bathrooms! Craziness like that, even in Pennsylvania!

So, while we are confused you can kind of understand people saying, "Oh, I don't want to get married till I figure this out," and then they're 40-50 years old, and they haven't figured it out. But you've lost your whole youth; you had that time where you could be investing in your future, in your family, your children, your real assets. Because they're the ones when you get sick, when you get chronically ill, when you go over 40 and now over 50 and you are actually start getting with arthritis and cancer, it's your family that's going to be there for you-depending on the strength of those relationships, right.

But in the Western world and many parts of world, we don't learn this. It should be obvious but it's not obvious; it's not common knowledge now. In fact we're taught to, "oh, just seek a pleasurable life

for yourself, seek entertainment which pleases you! You be you, you be you, you be you! Do you, do you, do you! You, you, you!

If you live like that you're going to be lonely- at least after you get 40 and 50- you're going to be lonely. I mean when you hit 40 and 50, boy, you're going to feel real empty. Do you want to be around somebody who's always, "me, me, me; me, me, me!" How quickly do you get sick of that, right, folks? And when you're 40 and 50 and the other 40 and 50 year olds have more assets, and they have more resources, and you need their help at times, but you're always about "me, me, me; me, me, me! Oh! Me, me, me!" Nobody's going to help you! Nobody's going to help! You got what you deserve! That's the problem! So many people don't even understand this basic thing.

That's why Father talked about the family as a school of learning, but it doesn't mean you just throw your kids in a family, and then everything's going to take care of itself. Even if you are trying to farm that doesn't happen, right! If you're growing plants, that doesn't happen; you can't just throw a plant in a new environment and expect it to grow. It's sensitive to the amount of sun it receives; sensitive to the amount of water it can intake, sensitive to the temperature drops.

There's a lot you got to be aware of; you've got to constantly be aware of these things in that type of training. But that is way closer to living with your spouse, then short highs that young people are trained to pursue: hedonism, short highs, exhilarating highs. That's more like drug addiction. Exhilarating highs, that's the model; that's more like drug addiction. As opposed to living with your spouse and creating a strong king and queen with very powerful love and respect Kingdom, where God can dwell and feel joy and your children can reap the benefits of that!

That is more like horticulture or agriculture, raising plants; it's more like that! You know what I mean? You may think, "Oh, raising kids is like raising a big pig, or something like that!" Some people say, "Oh, my dog's my child!" Honey, you don't know what the heck you're talking about! That's the most racist thing I've ever heard in my life! Your dog is not your child; your dog is a slave, okay. If you raise your child like a dog you, you will have trouble; I guarantee you that. Try dangling some Scooby Snacks in front of your child after 10 years of neglecting, "Come here; listen to mommy! Come here!" It's not working! Raising children takes a long time investment, long time, far-seeing eyes.

Soft Art of Farming Training

That's what Father called 'the farmer's eye'. You remember that? You remember Father used to talk about the farmer's eyes? The farmer's eye has to look through all the seasons. You have to visualize the seasons, like, I just planted this in June which is not the time to plant and July; you can do it but you're going to have to double the water, because they're going to dry it out every day in the sun. And if they can't pass that rooting process they're going to get root shock, and if they get root shock, the roots actually suck in and they don't want to grow any more. You got a problem; you got a big

problem now! Half of your leaves fall off the tree; you got one heroic leaf trying to blow in the wind, "No, no! I'm trying to maintain hope, it's still alive!"

I almost lost my bamboo this year! I planted a bamboo; all the tops got killed because of the frost that we got-five, six different days of frost! It whooped that bamboo up! Oh my gosh, I thought it was dead! Everything's turning hay- brown- you know what I mean- like that yellow; everything is yellow. There's a one little bamboo shoot; everything's dead, but in the bottom, there's one green vein, one green vein, on one side of the bamboo. So I said, "This plant is dead, but I'm just going to leave it, just to see."

Three months later, guess what? There are three shoots coming out of that root right now. It's incredible; that's amazing!

But remember Father taught that when you have to learn the soft art of farming, you have to be able to see through seasons; you have to be able to see through things that you cannot see, but you anticipate. You have some certainties, for example the winter's coming and you better prepare your plants properly, or if you have livestock you have a prepare livestock properly for that winter. You know, it's coming.

But you're not preparing three weeks before winter, you're preparing months in advance, months, and that's why Father talked about the farmer's eye, looking far!

Head Coach Training

This type of mindset and this type of Peace Militia awareness, this is the better mindset for raising children and also being with your spouse. You have to be able to see far. Now you have to intersperse that with moments of exhilaration and excitement and unlocking epigenetics together.

You got to do that especially because the young kids, as they're young, they're very scatterbrain; they're very low IQ etc. They can't focus on thing; they need stimulation exhilaration to keep them excited about learning from their parents. So you have to do adventurous things: you got to go skydiving- you know what I'm saying? Stuff like that. You've got to teach them how to ride a dirt bike, shoot guns; do that kind of stuff.

Those kinds of things are important for a child to learn and to gain trust of the father and the mother as "my central coaches in my life".

I like the analogy of a coach. The husband is the head coach; the wife is the assistant coach, okay. The head coach's responsibility is not only to lead the team, and when we doing the drills, you're going to work out, "Come on one; let's go two, three, four, five!" That's not only the job of the coach. The head coach also has to raise the other coaches. Ah! Are you with me folks? The head coach has to raise other coaches! This is critical!

So, as the husband, as the head coach, you have to be raising up your wife as your assistant coach, to be a better coach for the children, especially for the boys, because she's not going to understand the boys obviously as well as you; she's not a male. She's not going to understand why these boys always want to do violence, and why that's fun! The girls will never get it, okay! They will never get it, never. That's how God made them!

That's why you need to have the daddy and mommy working together. But you understand that, men? Head coach means you're not only doing the exercises with the kids, training the students, you're also training your assistant coach, raising her up, making her level higher. If she feels she can't do that, you're saying, "No, no! Let's do it! We can do it!" And you're skillfully encouraging her to do that, helping her unlock and go beyond that which she thought she could not do. Then, guess what? That woman wants to stay around you more. Why? Because she feels she's growing around you! Are you with me, folks? She feels she's growing from her head coach, even though she's a coach. You see what I mean?

The analogy of a coach is good. I don't like the analogy of master for example; it's not good because that is really a servant and master kind of thing. It's not a good analogy in the home, because if you treat your wife like a servant, or you treat your children like servants, good luck! Or you try to treat your husband like a servant, like these bad women who treat their husband like a servant; you're going to fail, 100%.

So, the coach analogy I like that the best! The coach has a responsibility; he has a sense of duty. He's going to try to raise up those children like his students. He's got to make it exciting enough so that they're willing to do it. He's got to explain and encourage them enough, but at the same time he can't be such a softy that they not growing and they're not being tested. Are you with me folks? He plays that very skillful balance of that good head of the house.

Many times he's kind of put like the general of the house, but that really is a little different, because you know in the military or any fighting force, if your troops don't listen and obey your command, you can kill them. I mean there are procedures to do so, but I mean if they're not listening during wartime, they can die; they can be shot.

That's a little different, okay! There are layers of that, maybe during specific times of conflict in a society, but normally it's more like coaching, trying to keep our students excited about training but yet keep the training hard enough that they're actually being challenged and they're growing through it, but it's not overly hard so they completely want to give up. You understand? There's this balance a good coach knows how to play.

That's why men who have led, who have done coaching, maybe they've coached martial arts... When I was young I coached martial arts; that is how I learned to coach young people, through martial arts, and the young people, when I was training them more, I made them do some coaching too. I took

some of the more responsible ones, and made them coach, because it's a great opportunity for them to have a small level of leadership where they can practice a very important skill. Are you with me, folks?

But it could be for example, training kids in football or something that like. You know what I mean? Something which is relatively vigorous and difficult and has some level of pain involved in it!

You know if it's like golf or something, that's not going to unlock a lot of epigenetics there! Maybe for the specific sport of golf but it's not really translatable to the defense of a nation. Would you want a whole population of golfers, or do you want a whole population of good martial artists? Okay! Yeah, it's simple. Golf is just I guess, something on top of that somewhere; I guess for the society! But in terms of your militia! Antifa shows up, "Well Antifa, I can puck you into the hole!"Not a good idea!

That's why fathers are so critical, because the daddies, we understand the importance of violence and the importance of pain. It's so important in education! Your kids have to face pain; they have to face a healthy amount of trauma and adversity especially for example through sports.

They've got to face that, otherwise they'll become jellyfish. They'll think they're *Puff the Magic Dragon* and think they are dragon species because they got some tattoos on their body, "Yeah! I tattooed my eyes to look like a dragon; that's why I'm a dragon species. I'm no longer human being!"There's literally this kind of lunatic. The guy's on drugs, man; he claims he's an actual dragon and he says he's not a human being. I mean this is la-la land! Change your gender on a whim, become a different species on a whim! I mean, come on, this is ridiculous! They say, "it's *Puff the Magic Dragon* drawing class!" Give me a break! It's totally arrested- development traumatized children; seriously! Very, very, disgusting!

They've taken away the strong potential of humanity and especially the strong potential of males to become very powerful protectors, and they've made them eating into this disgusting jellyfish. That's why it's so important when we're training with our kids to understand that.

Assistant Coach Training

We have to be head coach, but also we have to guide our wife, especially when she starts dealing with the boys, you have to coach your wife folks; she will not know how to deal with boys.

She will not know; she'll do everything wrong. She'll just become the authoritarian mom. Especially if you got a lot of boys in that house, it's almost guaranteed; it's the only way that she knows how, most of the times. But then if you allow that to happen, those boys will get so frustrated; they're going to explode on her one day.

That's why for the queen's it's so critical that you uphold the authority of the king and of your husband in the home, because if you don't do that, if you don't uphold your husband's authority, and you try to become head coach, your kids are going to do that to you, since that's not the proper order.

Male Violence Harnessing Training

You have to train up the next generation of males in the society. Why? Because the males have the tendency to violence; 99% of all violent crimes are from males! If you do not train up that population you will have havoc in your society. If you just always try to be nice to them, give them complimentary awards and participation trophies, you will have havoc in the society because you'll have all these whacked-out males. And these males will not be able to harness violence for good, that is the use of force for good; they'll be harnessing that violence for power. Are you with me, folks?

This is why the father's the key of the house and the family unit; the father is the head! The Bible doesn't say that just because it's just some random social evolutionary tribalism medieval philosophy. It deals with the trouble of the next generation of males becoming violent! Are you with me, folks? You have to harness the power of that force and that violence for good so it does not go evil.

If you eradicate the position and authority of the males, your children will become those kinds of predatory socialists. They'll become like these little flower boys, soy boys that basically hate their father and are worshipping the mother in a goddess cult. So, you see all these little Antifa, "I fight against you, you racist homophobic-whatever- I am so righteous!" And their mom's in the back going, "Oh, honey! You make me cry! Oh!"

Literally that boy is so traumatized, brainwashed; he's living so that the mom can glorify herself. And you can see it: all these little leftist males, they literally walk behind their wife, "Oh, yes honey! Oh, can I hold all your bags? Oh, did you bump your toe? Oh my gosh!"You ladies think that's going to be good to live with? Oh! My Lord, have mercy! That's going to drive you nuts in about ten minutes! Now, a good man, yeah, holds the bag for the wife? For sure; that's fine! But we don't grovel; we don't worship her! Are you with me?

We worship God! Our loyalty and our sense of responsibility in harnessing that violence are not to please our wife; it's to please God! And of course the byproduct of that is that it does create a very safe environment for our wife and our children etc. But if you eradicate the man and the father from the house!

See, that's the feminist movement; they lied to the women. They said, "You can do all that men can do!" Baloney! You cannot raise boys; you cannot! You cannot raise boys alone; not possible! You can do it but they are 32 times more likely to be imprisoned because you're alone. 32 times more! There's a whole line of statistics: lower income, higher crime rates, higher drug addiction; higher divorce percentages! I mean, it's ridiculous! You cannot raise males

A male does not look at a woman as a male role model; he seeks after a male for a male role model. He does not seek after a woman; he can't! You've got all these crazy feminists trying to make their sons worship them to fit as their male role model! You're going to kill that boy, and he's probably going to end up killing you.

Think about it: you may like it if you're a control freak, like bossing your boys around when they're small, and even if they're big, they're still little beta male, little wimpy jellyfish," Okay, Mommy! Okay!" You know they're still living like pathetic boys; they're not men. But then, you're going to see his marriage collapse because he's going to be doing that to his wife, "Oh! Honey! Oh! How may I serve you master?"

Oh my gosh, there's no woman that is sexually attracted to that kind of man! Not one! Your wife has to be sexually attracted to you for her to feel the energy of romance in the marriage. Are you with me, young men and kings? Your wife has to feel sexual attraction. I guarantee you 100%! There are no women who are not totalitarian lunatic control freaks, or just normal good- hearted women that are attracted to that kind of jellyfish boy; it's like she's taking care of a child or something. And obviously she's not sexually attracted to children, unless you're Hillary Clinton, right, and Ghislaine Maxwell. Gully! Are you with me, folks?

Priestly Duty Training

I mean it is very important! The woman is naturally attracted to the leadership in the husband. If the husband is the good representative of the Father in the home; right the Bible says, "Be as Christ is in the home!" The father is supposed to be like the Christ figure in the home; he's supposed to try to resemble Christ as much as possible.

That means for example on the priestly side - kings and priests, priestly side- that means we husbands, are praying for our wife; this is very important. When she feels anxious, she feels anxiety, she feels worried, "I don't know what's going to happen! My son got called in by the principal," blah, blah, blah! "Oh, he got into a fight at school, and he punched somebody! Oh my gosh, what are we going to do?" "You should have sacked him a couple of times! How many times did you punch him, huh?" I'm playing; I'm playing, okay!

But when she's all worried, then the husband can pray, can bring out the priestly nature. Pray for her! "Let's pray! Let's pray! There's something very attractive about a man who is in authority with God, so through the vicissitudes of life and the ups and downs, the crises that happen and things like that, you can rely on your man. I mean there's something very attractive with that.

Is this an interesting topic, folks? (Yes) Yesterday, we were shooting guns and blowing up fireworks and barbecue and hot sauces; today we got to talk about love and respect! It's part of the Kingdom!

I can't only satisfy the masculine element otherwise the sisters may want to flee. No, no; but this is a very important part of our training! Adding prayer into your life for your spouse; that's very important! You're doing your priestly duty.

Imagine if a sister comes up to a minister -if she's in the Catholic Church she goes up to the priest – "Oh, father I want to do confession," or whatever, whatever, whatever, "I have this problem," bla, bla, and the priest or the minister will try to minister to her with God's Word, right – hopefully, in the Catholic Church you know, it's gone the other way. But, anyways, the point is the minister is supposed to be able to basically spiritually try to coach this person how to get through this trouble, and how to keep God at the center through this trouble, and learn from it, and be able through it to become stronger, to have a deeper understanding of why God put you through it; whatever the case may be. He's trying to help that person through that.

So that aspect of ministry is critical, because let me tell you, if your wife can trust you as the head coach, because she knows you've raised her and you've helped her unlock her epigenetics and you've seen more potential in her than she saw in herself, and you've proven that, guess what? Her trust for you grows. And when she's on the side of the husband and she is one with the head coach in the home, think how much more synergy and power you have in the home!

Parental Unity Training

Now the kids that are little sly, that try to divide the parents and use them one against the other and ask mom for permission, but she said ," no," and ask dad for permission, and whatever. Kids do that naturally, but you have to teach them, "That doesn't work here baby! Mommy and Daddy are tight; you can't play us against each other." These kinds of things have to be taught.

But if there's no reflection on the king/queen relationship, then what happens? Your children will start becoming evil. Why? Because they'll start using one against the other; they will start sensing division or lack of closeness, lack of oneness, and they will play you. That's not good for their development, right, because if we let them get away with that constantly, they will actually become evil people. So you have to know that it's not because they're bad that they're trying to do that; just naturally they're trying to test their boundaries. But if you don't coach them properly through that, and you let it go unchecked, you have inadvertently allowed evil to gestate and grow like a cancer. We have to realize that, when those little tests come and they want to test the unity of the parents.

For example when the kids were young they would all be, "Oh Omma, Mommy, whom do you love more: me or daddy?" They're young kids right, two, three, five years old, "whom do you love more, me or daddy?" And a Queen would always say, "Of course I love Daddy more than you!" And when the baby heard that, the baby cried the first time; the baby cried the first time. But you see how she did? She upheld the authority of the King in the house.

So, what happened after that? The kids only cried one time, just once, and some of them didn't cry at all; some of them cried, some of them didn't. But they actually feel stable, because Mommy loves Faddy number one. Are you with me, folks? This is big! Then they can't play; they can't play around now.

Maybe you just acted emotionally; you didn't think about it, you didn't reflect. Maybe you weren't trained; you weren't taught this. And when that moment comes - which comes; it will come - all of you new parents, it will come; your baby will test you, "Mommy, whom do you love most, me or Daddy?" And they'll be smiling and looking at you with these big googly eyes, and if you say, "Oh, honey! Of course I love you, you, you!"

If you do that, you may feel good in the moment, but now you're creating disorder in your home. See, most people do not understand this; you're not taught. And now, your kids they got you! You're now a slave; you're slave to their whims now, in their young immature mind, "Mommy said she loves me most; now she's my slave. Now your life, Mommy, is to prove to me how much you love me, because you said you love me most!" Now they don't actually go through this, and they don't have a nefarious end, but they're children and young children are selfish. So they naturally start going in this direction and of course they're being led to become bad people.

A lot of you parents don't know it's coming; 100%, it's coming! But you have to navigate these waters well; you have to navigate this whitewater through that raft down the river. You've got to navigate this well; you splash here, you're going to be swimming quite a bit. Are you with me, folks Simple small things like that, parents don't know how to deal with them, and they make the mistake of emotional answering, because they're not prepared for that moment. So when that moment hits, they just want to please the child, but if you teach your child that your whole purpose in life is to please them you will fail, and they will destroy you.

How much more clear is it for your kids if when they do, "Do you love me more than Daddy?" and you say, "Of course I love Daddy more than you baby, but I love you too!" How much clearer is that? You see? Now the children know they can't just play Mommy and use her as a servant; if they do that, they're going to have to play with Daddy. They're going to have to deal with two united adults, who have more brain power than them, especially when they're young. Are you with me, folks?

This is important because this may not go through the rational brain processes of the child, but it goes through subconsciously 100 percent -100 percent- the path of least resistance; they're trying to find the path of least resistance.

Just like when you're walking through the woods and there's a dense brush, you're going to try to find the easiest way to get through it. It's not because you're thinking, "Oh, if I go down here then I'll have less percentage to do this, and this; it will take me 3.2 angles, and that would lead me to that faster and that would lead me to shave off 1.3 seconds off." You know what I'm saying? You're not going to do that. You're just trying to find the path of least resistance through that wood.

What happens when you do that in the wilderness? You get dominant- foot syndrome and you start doing circles. That's what happens! That's how people die in the wilderness. Most people die one mile away from their car. Did you know that folks? One mile; one mile away! Because they don't know proper land navigation; they don't know how to travel in a straight line. Because you will have dominant -foot syndrome; you will start pushing towards your dominant leg, and you'll start doing a big circle. And everything looks the same, "Where am I going? I don't know. I'm getting thirsty, but I got to keep going. I got to find my car somewhere around here. Oh I'm really thirsty now man! Crap! Oh boy, oh boy! It's getting dark out here! Wolves! Oh, I see a bear; I see a bear!"

Okay, you get this kind of mounting problems! Whereas if you just had a compass, you know how to leapfrog through the woods, just using your compass, shooting to a target, leapfrogging in a particular line; you get to your car in a minute. But you didn't know how to land navigate; because you didn't know how to land navigate you kept going in circles.

It's the same thing with the spouse; same thing with the children. If you don't know land navigation and the topography, but even how to move straight through the topography, you can run yourself in circles. How many people saw this kind of people? Raise your hand if that's you! No, don't! Don't raise your hand!

This kind of training is important; isn't it important? Are your marriages important? Is your wife's life important? Is your life important to your wife? Are your children important to you and you to your children? Of course it's very important! So it's very important that we are watering that seed; watering that seed.

Husband & Wife Relationship Training

The Kingdom of God is not only studying the harder arts, although that's been taken away by Satan and as the Scriptures say, "The Kingdom of God suffers because the violent take it by force."

In the Kingdom of God, and the Rod of Iron Kingdom, and the Cheon II Constitution, people are the militia and the police, but also we're centered on the Word of God. One of the missions of the Peace Police, Peace Militia is to, of course, 'Love God, Love your Neighbor,' but also creating strong what? Daddy - Mommy houses! Very important! Creating strong household Daddy- Mommy relationships! Powerful love and romance beautiful couples!

Showing a lifestyle that children want when they grow up, "Wow! Man, look at Daddy and Mommy's lifestyle! When I get married, I won't become a nun and have to live in a habit and pretend I'm holy and do Mass five times a day. Marriage is fun! I can go on dates with my husband! We can go explore new restaurants we can go explore this and that, and shopping is not forbidden; it's not illegal. We can have adventures, and we can go on a motorcycle; we can skydive. We can do fighting in a safe way." No, not with each other; I'm talking about martial arts training!

It's exciting! Marriage life in the Kingdom is the most exciting, because that's where you're growing the most, but you have to have knowledgeable kings at home- and queens of course. We have to have knowledge about man, as a wife, and have knowledge about woman as a husband. That knowledge and that understanding and wisdom then give us higher percentage -no guarantee right, everybody knows that, no guarantee- but higher percentages of successfully navigating critical moments. Are you with me folks? That's important! That's really important, isn't it?

So, you young couples, as you are embarking on your Blessing, don't neglect to feed the water. Make it habitual; make it training. Because you may just think, "Man! We're going out every day now; we just got married and we're going out every day!" One year later it's not going to be every day; two years there, it's not going to be every day. That's going to start diminishing, because you get busy with this; you get busy with that. This happens; you got kids in the mix- whatever the case may be.

You're setting yourself up for failure because you're not understanding what is the healthy medium, what is the amount that you can actually realistically do. You can't go out every day, realistically, after working, and all that! Can you do that, realistically, every day? No! How are you going to balance your finances with that kind of bills? So, that's not good, right!

Face Time Training

But a manageable thing is once a week; once a week you make time for spousal training. Make sure you are spending a good one and a half hour, to two to three hours with your wife. She can have that face time with you because that's when she will be fed in that face time. And don't say, "Oh, we get face time when we're making love!" No! That's not considered face time for the woman, you understand? For the man you may consider that face time, but that's not what she's talking about. She wants face time with you, when she can be able to spend time with you, looking at you.

Do you know that the female eyes when they speak to one another- they've done studies on eye movement- the eyes move and ride the whole face of the person they're talking to, twenty-five times more -I believe that's the number- twenty-five times more than men? Did you know that? They have twenty-five times more eye movement; did you know that? That's good to know; that's how much more they're trying to pick up on minutiae. If you look at two girls talking to one another, you can see the eyes, the eyes are looking at the body language posture, whether or not the lip goes up here or goes down there or whatever; you know picking up everything, eyebrow movements, you know everything!

You look at a man like that, you're going to get punched, or if you're a woman looking at a man like that, you're going to get a predator on you; you have a bad problem. But that sister, that queen, needs the king there to get that eye- movement time; she needs that eye- movement time, okay. She needs

that eye- movement training, to make sure we're on the right page, we're still good. She needs that time; it's very important for her. It's not a small thing!

Now if you don't set this up as training and be serious and hardcore about it like, "Every week we're going to do it," because if you're smart in the beginning you set up the habit early, so later on you don't have to think about it; it's just naturally happening. But if, "Oh, this came up and this came up; that came up," and you keep getting a bad habit, what's going to happen? It's going to start degrading. You're not going to be able to have that face time with her, and guess what? When you don't have the face time frustration builds, doubt builds, and anxiety builds. Are you with me, folks? "What are you doing? How come you're not tending to me? Why are you looking at that woman that way?" Huhhuh. Are you with me, folks?

And then at some point she can be so filled with frustration that she's saying, "Yes, you're seeing somebody! And the man may be innocent, and he's saying, "No, I'm not! What's wrong with you crazy woman?" All that's happening, and at some point the man being accused for that for ten years, he's like, "Screw you up!" You see what I'm saying? Then he's going to jump off the cliff into the death- trap hole of a seductress. You understand how that happens, folks?

So you may think that it's a small thing, but it's like one little grain, and you hit that there, and it gets bigger, it hits a little rock and bigger and bigger. You know what I mean? At some point it's big enough to hit a boulder off, and that boulder will smash your car. So you want to get into the habit early; you want to get the training habit in early; you want to get that seriousness in early.

So, regardless, "Oh, I'm too busy; I'm too busy!" "No, no, no! We're not too busy to be investing in one another, honey! You understand what I'm saying? We're not too busy! There's nothing more important than investing in one another!""Oh wow, I don't...I have this or that!""We have to have that face time! I need it," - even though you don't need it- "I need it, baby!" "Okay, well, I'll do it for you!"

These things seem small, don't they? They're big! That's why people are deluded; they're big, they're not small. These things are big; they lead to big problems. Those small frustrations, those little doubts, "Oh, he doesn't pay attention to me anymore! Look at how well he talks to those sisters over there, huh! Oh my gosh, you know, he doesn't see me anymore! He's now riding a motorcycle and now..." I'm talking about some of you folks. You got to always watch out, okay!

But think about it! If she's joyful in the marriage, she's joyful, she has that face time, she has the eye-training time -whatever the case may be- the connection time, and then she sees you: you're gregarious you're treating other brothers and sisters well, "Wow! My husband, he's so caring for other people!" It literally becomes night and day difference in interpretation. Are you with me, folks? Now because your husband and you have a strong, tight, connection, and there's a lot of good romance, a lot of good absolute-sex romance marriage, then she trusts you. Now the interpretation is so different!

And of course, as a man, you should not be stupid; you should not try to show off about how well you can make other women laugh! That's a stupid game, dumb-dumb ego, stupid game; dumb-dumb game. That's going to come back to bite you, because you're putting doubt, unnecessary anxiety and frustration into your wife. Maybe one time or two times, she can cover you, so-to-speak, in the sense that, "Oh, no, no, no, he's fine!" But if you keep doing it, even with the face time, you will be sabotaging the work that you're doing and trying to invest in that marriage. Are you all with me, folks? You got to be careful about those things, you know!

That's why always we've had a policy: any of the younger people that are leading groups, they can never be in a room with the person of the opposite sex alone. If they come to them with counseling, you pass that counseling on to more experienced ministers. So we have the Academy team, we have Regis on the ministerial team, we have Hiromi Stevens on the administer team, and things like that, so that young people being apprenticed, being trained up, they're never in a situation where they're one-on-one with some girl. Holy *shmita*! Big problem! Big, big, problem! These small little things can lead to massive consequences, huge problems! Are you with me, folks?

So, make sure you are doing your training, even if you're older; sometime I talk to young people, but I don't mean to exclude you, older folks! I'm going to be a granddaddy too this year, so I'm grandpa too! (Applause) Ah yes praise God! Actually, I'm already grandpa because he's growing in there; it's not a clump of cells! Lunatics!

And also Kook Jin Nim has become a granddaddy! Shin Ah had a beautiful baby daughter! (Applause) That's right! Beautiful!

I know we focus a lot on the young people, and the old and faithful folks, we're not able to train with you as much, but we're training with you a lot more now, especially as the nation is going into more and more danger, and it's getting closer to real war, and fights are breaking up.

There are so many things, but again folks, even amidst all that, you know what? Our spiritual life, our spousal training, if we have children - and when you young people start having children, you have the incredible blessing of having children and you'll be a great blessing to them, because you will be way higher level parents than 99% of the people in this world because you're listening to stuff like that. You're getting fed this kind of good stuff before you have children, so you understand the landscape way better than somebody who has no idea. Your age doesn't really matter; just you don't know the landscape.

Personal Day Training

But when we have the next generation children and they have that blessing, also doing the dates with the children young people, is absolutely critical! Make it habitual! Make it habitual! Just like you do the date with the queen, you have a date with each child. You make it habitual, especially after that child is about 4 to 5; now they can start remembering what you are doing. Do you know that? Did you

know that children cannot remember what happened until beyond the age of 3, on average? Did you know that? How many people knew that?

That doesn't mean, "Oh, good! I have a three-year window to beat the crap out of that child!" No, tyrant! You don't! But after three especially, they start remembering. So, it's absolutely critical that when you have children you are blessing them with their day. I'm not talking about their birthday come once a year. I'm talking about their day, their face time with you, which is special, which is not you yelling at them telling them how dirty their room is or a filthy their feet are; that's the type of one-on-one time that a lot of parents have with their kids.

No! I'm talking about their day; they get to choose where they're going to go, whether it's McDonald's or Wendy's or Mommy's Organic Greens, whatever. Sometimes they get sick of Mommy's Organic Greens and they want some chicken nuggets with buffalo- wing sauce! "What do you want to eat today? Say, "Organic Greens," child!" That's the kind of the atmosphere with many moms; the child wants to say, "Chicken nuggets, but if I say that Mommy's going to kill me!""Where do you want to go honey?" "Organic Greens? On my day; on my day? Chicken nuggets please!"

So you let them have the GMO food- you know what I mean- for that day! They're not eating it at every meal okay! It's a different time! You're in a different place; it's special. You drive them out; you're talking to them in the car, bonding, sitting down with them, and enjoying something. Let it be okay for them to enjoy some stuff; they're not monks or they're not nuns or something like that. They can enjoy yummy stuff once in a while in moderation blah, blah, blah!

Gratitude Training

And then of course we do the gratitude training there; it's so important. Usually in our family Mommy starts it; so I ask Mommy to start. I'll say, "Mommy, what are three things that you are grateful for about this child?" Obviously with the child's name. Then she says, "I'm grateful for this and this." Usually as the child is young, they just absorb; they just feel good. It's just a great pick-meup; it feels good.

But as they get older, guess what? They may start crying because maybe they really needed to hear that, that month. Are you with me folks? We've had it where our children were crying out of gratitude just to hear that!

But imagine parents who never, ever, have told their children why they're grateful; there are so many parents like that! The Bible says, "Confess your sins one to another; encourage one another!" If you see your child as being in the Body of Christ you have to confess your sins one to another, you have to encourage them. They're not your equal obviously, they're more immature than you, but you want to help them to grow in the Lord. Amen!

Sometimes, not all the time, they are crying; just hearing that, they are so grateful! Something so simple; something that in our home is so natural! My boy I know when he gets his son, he's going to do it naturally because he grew up- 15 years of his life- with that. Ever since he was 5 years old Dad's been doing that.

And I've been the head coach there; I've been making our family do that. It's not the Queen that has been doing that; she's been the assistant coach. It's my job to make it happen. Are you with me, folks? But imagine the kids that grow up not one time hearing why their parents are grateful for them.

All right! So then Mommy will say, "Three things I'm grateful for: you know this child has grown this much, and blah, blah, blah!" That's great, and then I usually always end; for each one I give applause. That's what I do. That's how I lead it. Are you with me, folks?

So she will finish, "Oh, he's great and he's so smart and he's so kind to his Mommy and he's so loving, so nice to his siblings," whatever. Now I'll say, "Oh, okay, that's three! *Bagsu* which means applause and we'll all in the restaurant be clapping for one another, and all the people in the restaurant they are saying, "What the hell is going on in that table? They're clapping for each other over there. We're fighting over here, over the sausage or hamburger!" It's a totally different kingdom!

My child will then say three things he is grateful for about Mommy. I will say, "Now Shin Pal, you can say three things you are grateful for about Mommy!" So he will go on now and say three things he's grateful for about Mommy. You do this habitually, you make this a habit; you make it training. You take your training seriously; you do it! Get it done, no excuses! Make it habitual; hit it!

You will see, as your child is young it's very simple, "Mommy's pretty, Mommy's beautiful, Mommy's the best cook in the world," whatever. Is that right? You can ask the Queen right there!

But as they get older it gets deeper; it gets deeper, like, "I remember that time when Mommy did this for me; when I did that and I needed that guidance, she gave me that wise counsel. I am so grateful for that!"

It gets richer. Do you understand? It only grows in richness, not diminishes, folks, if you make this habitual, if it is a serious part of your family training, and you don't let anybody not do it. The man has to take control of that situation; the king has to take control over the family, and say, "We're going to do it. This is what we're going to do; it's going to be a habit!"

Okay, and then after he's done saying about Mommy, then what do we do? "Okay, *Bagsu!*" We're in some space; I'm not going (clapping loud, and speaking loud) "Ah, wonderful, wonderful!" All the people in McDonald's would say, "What's happening over there?" We just do a nice quiet *Bagsu* "*Bagsu!*"It makes no noise. People can kind of see us; we're different, so it brings enough attention that the child knows that they're special. But it's not crazy, not embarrassing the crap out of them!

So Shin Pal will do it for the Queen, and then I'll say, "Okay, about Daddy now!" and Shin Pal will do about Daddy. When they're young it's, "Daddy's so strong and Daddy's Whatever," but as they got older it got richer and richer. I have been brought to tears at many of my children's days, trust me! You know what I'm saying? But most parents cannot experience that because they didn't make it habitual. It's a long, long, training; years and years of that building and building, you know.

The Queen cries now almost at every single date; that's how rich it gets! You know what I'm saying? You talk about *gamdong*. How do you translate *gamdong* in English? It's like when you're watching a movie that wrenches your heart in a good way, and is so shocking or surprising that oceans just burst into your eyes. I don't know how they call it in English? *gamdong*; they usually translate it as 'inspire', but that's the wrong feeling. I'm completely overwhelmed shocked; gratitude is in there too. You know what I mean? There's all this stuff in it.

The Queen will be welling up in gratitude, just hearing the children say "thank you" about this or whatever; that is inspiring, emotional. Now, more and more as we get older with them, it's getting even more touching. You know what I mean? It's crazy! I'm not supposed to cry this much! Do you understand what I'm saying? Okay?

So, Shin Pal will say that about Daddy and then Daddy will say about Shin Pal, if it's his day, and then on his day I'm not talking about Shin Man, "Did you see how well Shin Man did this and that?" On his day he gets to have his day! No Shin Man, no Goongi, no Jooni or no Dooki "Oh, Daddy wants to talk about the Third King on my birthday!" "No you're not going to hear about The Third King!" Are you with me, folks? I keep it habitual; I keep the training tight. Are you with me, folks? And it's a fun way of having a meal together!

How come Christians are not doing that? That's a great way to have a meal together especially if, with your children, from a young age you've cultivate that culture. Not all of a sudden, your kids are screwed up, they're leftist, they are crazy lunatics, and now you say, "Okay, let's say three things we are grateful for!" Now you got some problems! "Aren't you happy that I'm gay?" Because you didn't make it habitual! You were just trying to jump in with the new Kingdom; not adjusted.

How many people wanted to hear this when they were first blessed? Okay, yeah, yeah, don't be regretful now! But you make the training habitual; make it serious. You got to be serious with it. This is your life, and it has serious implications. If you neglect this, it's going to come back to bite you. I guarantee! (*French accent*) Who was that alligator in Ninja Turtles, the Louisiana alligator? Remember that? "Yes I guarantee!" (*French accent*) He was a Frenchman; he was from Louisiana. Who was that Louisiana bad guy, the Cajun alligator? Oh you all didn't watch Ninja Turtles! Man, you missed out on Ninja Turtles! They missed a whole generation right there!

You know you've got to make it habitual, then that meal becomes a beautiful spiritual practice of prayer in gratitude; you've just done something that gives so much to joy to God watching that happen! Can you imagine Father? We're at a little table in McDonald's or wherever it is-nowadays

they're bigger so I take them out to Vietnamese *Pho* or someplace nice. I take them out to Indian, you know because they're not older; they're married. They get to choose.

But you know think about that! Think about that when we're having that gratitude thing, it's not only us at the table; you imagine Father is sitting right there and True Mother is sitting right there, and they're hearing that! They're crying! Do you see the power? This is critical! This is critical! And you, younger people now you have beautiful marriages! Let's give it up for our young new couples!

They're not perfect, but many of them are doing well! Don't put any added pressure on them. But you've got to do that training; take the training seriously. Especially young kings, you have to take the training seriously; it is part of the Peace Militia training; it is part of your defense of the Kingdom! Your marriage literally matters that much! Do you understand? "Oh, how much does my marriage matter?" It matters a lot in the Kingdom! You understand? Literally!

So you have to be watering that thing; don't expect it to happen naturally. You got to put in that extra work, to put it in that sprinkler system. You can just turn the hose; that's the lazy man's watering system right there! You get the hose with the holes in it, you put that all around your house, turn that baby on- it waters everything, slowly. But to get it set in, you got to put in a lot of extra work. It's easier just 15 minutes a day just water the garden. How many people just do like that? Okay, me too! Don't worry; it's not a sin. It still gets the job done.

But I'm saying with your family this is important; it has bigger repercussions than growing fruits and vegetables; I relate it to growing fruits and vegetables. Obviously your children are more precious than any fruit or vegetable that you can make, right. But the kind of mentality you have to have in doing it is kind of like a farmer; what Father talked about, having that long-range vision, seeing through the seasons, planning for the winter coming. Very, very, important training!

By the way if you do it well it'll bring so much joy! You personally will get so much benefits' it's ridiculous! You will literally be on top of 99.9% of humanity, and you will have pride in doing it. Just remember me in your prayers okay! But it brings you so much joy; it'll bring your marriage so much joy! I don't necessarily benefit greatly personally from it. No! The Kingdom benefits, you understand? The Kingdom benefits from having your marriage tight, powerful, strong, awesome romance, absolute -sex marriage, awesome wonderful romance; both husband and wife fulfilled romantically, sexually, emotionally! It's critical!

I see some of you sisters, whenever I start talking about that, you start crying with tears of regret. You know that's done; what is done! Now you have to move skillfully, to navigate. But you can find hope in seeing the young people who understand and they're now part of the Kingdom culture; you see them bring joy that way, because although they're not your physical children, they're also extended family alright.

So you can always have hope, you can always be celebrating somebody else's victory, because in the end your child may see that and say, "Hey I want to get blessed now! I see that. I didn't think that bozo could create something that tight!" Who knows? You never know how God will work; you just never know how God will turn it around! You don't know. If you celebrate other young kings and queens doing well, tight, strong, giving glory to God, if you celebrate that who knows what God will do on yours! You just don't know right?

That's an important part of the Kingdom too; being happy to see others succeed that's critical! That's a very important part! You're happy for other people succeeding, you're happy for them flourishing in the blessing of marriage; you're happy seeing them raising their children great. Do you understand? You're happy to see tight families, strong Peace Militia SWAT teams against the devil; on many levels, many levels: spiritual, mental, emotional and physical.

Hard Arts Training

Families that train together stay together!

Physical too! We're getting very much into the emotional, intellectual realms, and the heartistic realms today, but that doesn't negate the physical realm of training together too. The physical realm of training will make your family even tighter, as long as it's done well. Kids don't want to work; they don't want to do the hundreds with Daddy because now I like the diamond push-ups. I only do the diamond push us; I don't like the small ones, these are too easy, "Give me some diamonds, baby!"

The kids don't like that, but they know when they do it with Daddy, the workout is so much better; you push a lot harder, learning new skills, new things. The Queen, when she works out, she's quite diligent, because that's a habit now; it's now become habitual. Sometimes she doesn't want to do it too heavy, so she'll do some calisthenics thing from a computer, you know getting a cute little outfit in the bathroom- only I can see. You know what I mean? That's where the bikini comes on; it's only for the King.

But she gets that work done, gets that thing going; that's great, that's a great culture. Daddy's in there, 'bam bam,' doing those diamonds. I love those diamonds! I love them! They blow up your arms; that's great too. And the kids can hear their daddy grunting in the room, "Ha, ha, ha!" "What are they doing there?" They're not saying, "What are they doing?" They know what we're doing in the room, because they have to be training too; it's part of our culture, it's natural!

I remember Shin Pal, when he first got married- I don't want to divulge too much- but he being in the basement, he'd be training alone, because I always told him, "Hey, a man's got to also look good physically for his queen! You've got to be as sexy as you can be, boy! You know what I mean? You got to take that seriously too!"

So, he would take Daddy's advice; he would go down there. He'd be working out, and he'd be calling his queen, "Come on! We've got to go work out! Watch me do this!""Oh Wow!" "Watch this!" "Wow!" She does it in the Japanese style! That's great, wonderful! I hear him grunting down there. "Wow! Get it boy! But that's important too. That's important too!

When it's Shin Pal's day, that's one thing that is wonderful about him, he takes that seriously; he takes the training seriously! He doesn't listen to it, and it goes in one ear, "Well I heard this already. That's my Daddy talking about it; I know he does it but you know." No, he does it seriously; he makes it habitual. It doesn't mean he's perfect or anything, but he is investing. I asked his queen, "Are you happy your husband does that?" and she loves it; she's so grateful that he does that. It's a part of their habit, of the culture that he's implementing as the king of his house, the priest of the home. He's leading. Again, it doesn't mean he's perfect or anything, he's still growing, but he is tremendous.

Okay! Everybody, three things good about Shin Pal! No, no! It's not his day today!

Are you with me, folks! This is applied kingdom mechanics, okay! It's fun and it will enrich your blessings the most, but at the same time, see that's what's great, win-win: you get enriched the most, you develop strong God-centered relationships with your children, and with your spouse it's tight, love, wonderful sexuality, intimacy, romance. All is there; everything that everybody is trying to look for: loyalty, fidelity is here, willing to die for one another. Training also to fight and even die against evil.

Peace Police, Peace Militia Men & Women Heroes

The Peace Police man and the Peace Police woman is a heroic figure. They may be a normal person but in the Kingdom of God they are a heroic figure; they are service men and women. So that's important that you, young couples, you young folks, when you see your queen, you say, "Oh! She's a Peace Police woman!" It's important to remind yourself of that; you may forget sometimes," she's a Peace Police woman!" Now, don't get kinky on me, saying, "Oh, you handcuff me baby!" Come on! Don't tell me about that stuff okay; I don't want to hear it!"

But it's important! You see your queen as a Peace Militia woman, Peace Police woman; you see your king as a Peace Militia man, Peace Police man. So, just like any good police man or woman or military man or woman, to defend your nation you have to be physically fit; you have to be mentally fit, spiritually fit. Those things are important!

And of course there are so many benefits that you personally will get from doing that kind of stuff together: health benefits, relational benefits bonding; so wonderful. But also the society at large gets the benefit of having fit, healthy, strong, spiritually grounded police men and women, militia men and women. Do you understand how much of a tremendous benefit that is for all of the Kingdom of God, for the whole society, and of course, it will cover the world. Do you understand how much of a

powerful benefit? That's why this kind of training in Peace Militia training is just as important as shooting; just as important.

Because this teaches you how to give victory in the home on a daily basis when it's monotonous, to keep energized, excited for training, keep excited for practice, keep excited for your training together You always have something to look forward to; no matter how bad the week is, you got your queen's day coming up next week or in three days, or whatever the case may be. No matter how bad the week was you got your child's day coming up; time to get back to gratitude. Right, you see what I'm saying?

It's so important! Any one of us can die at any moment especially when the citizens are the defense force and the police force to protect other citizens. Anybody could be killed; we could lose one of our Peace Police men or women, service men or women at any day which is the reason why we train hard to be ready, but also live hard too.

Wow! We are blessed to have the Kingdom! I tell you; we're so blessed! Father's not a soy-latte, mashed potato. We're so lucky we have a man's man as a Father; so blessed! (*Applause*)

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, we thank You for this day today that You've given us! Great time for reflection and gratitude after all these great festivities; how You are moving the patriots, and moving, stirring people's hearts and bringing folks that never heard the Gospel to the Gospel, bringing them to the Kingdom of God, bringing them to freedom, liberty, responsibility.

So many things are happening, but at the same time Father we know that we have to take time with our family here in our church family, but the same time in our local nuclear families that we are investing in, especially in our spousal relationship which is the center of the whole nucleus. Let that be strong!

Please put in the heart of all the young new kings and queens that they must take their training seriously, that they must take the spousal providence, blessing providence seriously. That they must not be foolish and ignorant, low IQ and think that things would just be ok by not planning in advance. Let us have the farmer's mindset which pierces and sees through the seasons and can see towards the future, prepares adequately, but also can enjoy the moment.

Father, we are so grateful that You're training us from the past in the Amazon jungle, in horticulture and aquaponics and fishing and hunting and martial arts and self-reliance. We didn't know at the time why You were making us get boat licenses, and hunting out in wild areas. But now we can see how important that is to the fabric of the Kingdom, the fabric of the education system that happens in the Kingdom from the nuclear family where we learn how to be good citizens of the Kingdom of God,

how to be patient with one another, how to love and respect the husband and the wife through that training..

And all those things combined, create citizens- that are not perfect, that need You – but that are exceptional, that stand above the cut, above the rest, not because we seek to boast in ourselves, but because we simply want You to smile and be happy when You see us, Lord.

Please, give us the strength and the wisdom today through your Word as we saw in the *Parable of the Sower*. Let these seeds that are planted in these hearts today become great mustard trees that provide solace and rest for all the birds.

We give You all the praise, glory and honor. Here with all the kingship lines and with your Three Kingship we report, and in your precious name we pray! Amen! Aju! Aju! Hallelujah!
