IQ, EQ, RQ centered on God

The King's Report-July 13, 2021

Good morning folks! Welcome to the King's Report. Today is Tuesday July 13th, twelfth year of Cheon-gi, sixth month and fourth day, by the heavenly calendar. I'm Hyung Jin Sean Moon, the Second King of Cheon II Guk.

Thanks for everybody's prayers as we headed down to the restoration of Cheongpyeong providence project. There's a wonderful potentiality. So please pray for that to come through and to be successful. All right folks, well today we are in:

Galatians Chapter 5:16-26

16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

17 For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

18 But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

19 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,

21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

24 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

26 Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

That's the end of the chapter. There are a lot of notes on this:

Notes on Galatians Chapter 5:16-26

From verse 16: Walk in the Spirit.

Christians are to live with the Spirit's help. How does one live by the Spirit? The Christian must believe that the Spirit is with him, having been sent by God into his heart.

In every spiritual confrontation the believer must yield to the Spirit that is, submit his own desires to those of the Spirit.

One must depend on the Spirit for help, enabling him to live a God-pleasing life.

The believer should anticipate the effects of the Spirit's help in his daily life.

The believer who lives by the Spirit will not carry out the lustful, strong desires of the flesh sinful nature. One's sinful human nature flesh and the Holy Spirit lusteth against one another, that is, they have desires that are contrary to one another.

The Christian then is a battlefield, having desires to do good and evil. The outcome is that ye cannot do the things that ye would; the flesh seeks to thwart the spirit who in turn attempts to frustrate the flesh's evil desires.

<u>Verse 17</u> may leave the impression of a believer being caught in a hopeless tug of war between the flesh and the spirit; this is not the case. The Christian is led by the Spirit when yielding to Him to turn away from the flesh's evil yearnings, thus putting sin out of his daily life. The verb 'led' indicates voluntary submission. The believer decides by whom he will be led, either by his flesh or by the Spirit. The Spirit-led person is not under the Law. The Christian does not need the restraints of the Law because his moral life is governed by the Spirit which will not lead you into immorality. By contrasting the works of the flesh with the fruit of the Spirit the believer can know whether he is walking by the Spirit or being controlled by the flesh.

Uncleanness is sexual impurity, lasciviousness is sexual excess.

Idolatry is not just the worship of a graven image, but putting one's chief affections on any object or person instead of on God.

Witchcraft is sorcery that is tampering with the powers of evil; this would include dabbling in the occult. Variance is strife and discord. Emulation means jealousy. Strife is selfish ambition. Seditions are dissensions. Heresies are permanent organized divisions or cliques.

Revelry means excessive eating or gluttony as well as carousing practice.

Verses 19 through 21

The person whose life is habitually characterized by sins and vices shall not inherit the kingdom of God; that is, he will not be in heaven because he is not Christian.

The word 'fruit' is significant for three reasons: it means the result product outcome or effect produced by the Spirit in the believer's life. Unlike the gift of the Spirit only some of which are given to a Christian, each believer is to have all nine virtues composing the fruit of the Spirit. As fruit on a tree takes time to grow and mature, so the Spirit does not cultivate these virtues in a believer's life overnight.

Love is the willing sacrificial giving of one's self for the benefit of another without thought of return. Joy is gladness of heart. Peace is tranquility of mind, freeing one from worry and fear. Long suffering is patience with others; the opposite of a short temper, a disposition quietly bearing injury. Gentleness is kindness. Goodness is generosity. Faith here is dependability. Meekness is gentleness, that is courtesy and consideration in one's relation with others. Temperance is self-control that is the ability to harness and control one's passions and lust. At conversion every believer crucified the flesh; that is in repentance he turned from and renounced his life of sin and all its wicked passions. This verse then implies that the virtues of <u>verses 22 -23</u> rather than the vices of verses **19-21** should characterize them that are Christ's.

<u>Verse 25:</u> this verse means since we live by Christ and by the Spirit, let us also follow the Spirit; that is, since the Spirit gave us new life at conversion, we then should stay in step with His leading and promptings throughout life.

That's a very interesting section juxtaposing the spirit and the flesh.

Healing-based ministry

I was watching one ministry the other day and it's definitely a healing- based ministry; the healingbased ministry is a very common Pentecostal ministry, as you will see in many Pentecostal churches; laying on hands, slaying of the spirit etc. This young man was a street preacher or street healer, who takes his ministry to different areas in the street. He was in urban area, I think New Jersey, and was healing people in the name of Jesus. People were being delivered and received the Holy Spirit and being slain in the Spirit etc.

It was interesting because while he would be praying over these people, he would be saying for example things like "*Demon, come out of that person!*" Or he would say, "*The demon is over here; the demon is over there.*" One lady had reoccurring back pains or something like that, and he would say, "*Demon come out; demon come out!*" things like that. That's a ministry from the Pentecostal church.

And it got me thinking of Father allowing the Cheongpyeong providence. Now obviously it shows you the danger of that as well, because in the end the power got to the Kim lady. But Father allowed for a healing ministry to happen under his auspices.

When I watched the Pentecostal preacher healing these people, remove the demons -of course he was doing it in a very mainstream style that we see very often in any Pentecostal church - but I just found it interesting because you're saying, "*Oh, the demon is on your back,*" or "*it's on your shoulders,*" or things like this. That reminded me a lot of what Cheongpyeong healing ministers used to say.

They used to do that kind of stuff right, Tim? *-Tim Elder: they used to say we had little tiny, tiny demons all over our bodies.* Oh okay, they would say bad spirits instead of demons *-They would call it aglyeong which means evil spirits* Yes, but basically it means demons.

So, I was puzzled: *"Why did Father allow such a healing ministry?"* Especially because that woman would eventually try to control Han Hakja, who would eventually actually kick her out, so that she could have absolute power. You know the story, she's worshiping herself and she made statues of herself and is now putting Moloch's owl statues all over the place, like a Satanist. Which is very tragic, very, very, tragic, and we pray for her to repent of her sins so that she can become at least a normal member again. But the point is: I would always wonder, *"Why did Father allow that?"* because it's so crazy. You know the spirit realm is a very chaotic place; there are many levels as Father talked about.

As you see, in this chapter, it talks about spirit possession. The good Christian is supposed to be possessed by the Holy Spirit; we're supposed to be filled by the Holy Spirit, not by these demons. Unfortunately there are many people that are filled with demons, or demons are possessing them, or demons are corrupting them; demons are latching onto them and pulling on their soul and demons are telling them of the guilt of slavery that they should have.

But Christ sets us free from that. Christ sets us free because there is no one who is not a sinner before Christ, before God. Christ sets us free from those chains.

Yet because we have the power of the flesh, we can be lured and tempted to go back to those things, because we can become comfortable with what those demons have told us. In other words they almost become a part of our life. They become part of our life, and tell us that "You'll never be able to be a good father, you'll never be able to be a good mother, you'll never be able to be a good husband, you'll never be able to be a good this or that. Look at your feelings! Look at what you did! You remember what happened when you did this? Remember when you did that? Remember when you failed here"?"And these demons keep playing this in your head.

That's what we call the heartistic realm or the subconscious mind. Science calls it the subconscious mind but really I think that's a modern way to understand it; a modern vernacular to understand the subconscious realm, this unseen realm which influences us. It's the dominant influence on our decisions, on our life; it's 95%. That's been shown by studies, and we need to be able to focus in on that. We need to be able to go in there with courage and bravery, and face those ghosts, and to rebuke those demons. We have to rebuke those demons in Jesus' name and True Parents' name.

That guy's ministry was interesting, a young guy; big guy. I think he was some kind of rapper or some kind of gangster or something before God got a hold of him and turned his life around. The casting out of demons for him is a big ministry. It's a special gift for certain people; not everybody is called to do that type of healing. Father himself always warned on the dangers of healing ministries, and of course we saw that warning come to pass with the Kim regime at Cheongpyeong.

Many times the problem with the healing ministries is that people come for very selfish purposes. They don't come to deal with the fundamental roots of sin in their life; they just come because they want a temporary relief from some back pain or some eye pain or this or that. It's almost like they didn't want to go see a doctor. Healing can be evidence of God and God's love for that person and can be a very powerful experience for them at that time, but many times it doesn't have staying power. Many times it's just like, "*Oh, thank You God,*" etc, and that's it. So it's a small part of God's movement in that sense, but it is a part.

Centering on True Father

At the restoration of Cheongpyeong providence we have to be prayerful of these things; that I will move with Father's Spirit on this, and it will not just be a regurgitation of what was happening at Cheongpyeong. That cannot happen; it will not be like what Han Hakja has made, which is this vision of trying to make it into a Vatican. That is a horrific and wretched and destructive image of what Father initially desired, which was a place of retreat, a place where his people can come for spiritual retreat. The foundation of that was what? The foundation of that was the study of the Divine Principle, the study of Scripture, which is of course the unlocking the insights of what? The Bible!

Since we must be totally aligned and centered with the Father God, with Jesus Christ and with the Returning Jesus, True Father, Restored Cheongpyeong will be centered on the biblical culture as we experience it in Sanctuary; centered on the biblical culture, centered on Holy Spirit University type of biblical study. The Principle is unlocking the Bible so the Principle of course is at the center of all the workshops there etc; and the laying on of hands of course is a Christian thing. But we will be centering everything on True Father.

God is preparing a beautiful place. It's going to be a place where it is totally centered on True Father's life course. So, for anybody that goes there, that place is not just for healing; for me just me, "*I want to be healed*?" No, that place is to grow deeper in our love, in our affection, in our relationship with the Returning Jesus, True Father, and his life course which shows Jesus' entire ministry; it includes all these things.

Trail of Tears, Trail of Victory, Trail of Ascension

We will prepare a **Trail of Tears**, which is what? That's Father's Seven Deaths and Resurrection's course; that's his suffering through the death camp, the prisons, the tortures etc. As you walk along the trail, there will be places of meditation and prayer, where you stop and you reflect on that Trail of Tears that True Father had to walk for humanity and for releasing the power of the Blessing upon the earth, which is God's desire for Adam and Eve. It will be a place of deepening our connection to our True Father.

So you have the Trail of Tears, then after a certain section you'll have the **Trail of Victory**, where on that trail you will see what Father did after that Trail of Tears; beginning ministry and going to the

world and the Washington Times and Tiempos del Mundo and this and that. Father's victory and the foundation that he established. That will be a certain section.

After the Trail of Victory, we will be entering the **Trail of Ascension** with: *Father's victorious Seonghwa, *the <u>unity of Cain and Abel</u> which is the foundation for the Kingdom of Heaven, and *the <u>unity with the Father</u>. So the unity of Cain and Abel, and then *the true mother being restored after the fall of the Han mother, but the true mother being restored by the <u>Kang True Mother</u> and then *the continual providence of the <u>Three-Generation Kingship</u>, the heir, the selected appointed anointed kings of True Father's lineage, and then of course *the <u>kings and priests' providence</u> that comes with the Three Generation Kingship, etc. That will be called the Trail of Ascension.

God is preparing something very, very incredible and exciting. Praise God Almighty! That will be exciting!

Pools of healing

There are also some water features; there's a beautiful stream which I plan to build out into pools. Jerusalem had a pool called the Pool of Siloam. It was the only natural spring in Jerusalem and it was a place of healing referred to in the Bible; people would go down there to sit and to be healed in those mineral springs. Well, something like that is may be bestowed upon us by God. So we will have a pool of healing, after everything goes well. So, please pray for that to go well.



We're hoping to put different pools of healing so people can also sit in those springs, and receive living water, receive healing waters upon them as they pray, as they reflect on the Trail of Tears and the Trail of Victory and the Trail of Ascension.

True healing

It will be a place where we will learn to once again pray for one another, and where of course our new folks can go. We will be doing workshops there for our new friends and our new folks, so that they can also experience a beautiful place and also study centered on True Father's life course, not just, "*oh*, *I'm just trying to remove this evil spirit from me.*"

Because when the Holy Spirit dwells within you, no evil spirit can dominate it; if the evil spirit is dominating it, it means that the Holy Spirit is not within you, and it means that you are falling away from God and being tempted by this evil spirit or demon; which shows that your relationship with God is collapsing. So we pray for people who are in that state because unfortunately these demons can

possess people and make their life with God collapse; which of course harms everything- very sad, very sad, very tragic.

Just removing evil spirits is not the purpose; the purpose is not like western medicine kind of like, "*Oh, you have this illness; let's just give you medication for that illness.*" No, that is not the true healing. The true healing comes with the Holy Spirit; the true healing comes with a deep relationship with God. Then all the demons that try to put guilt, all the demons that try to use shame, all the demons that try to say that you can't do this do that, they have no power; because we're filled with the Holy Spirit, we're filled with grace, we know to the depth of our core that while we were sinners He still loved us.

The culture of the Restored Cheongpyeong

And we've repented of our sin, we've repented; we've come to that position of humility and humbleness which the Bible talks about as meekness, humbleness before God - not humbleness to evil people but humbleness to God. We've come to that point. We've asked for forgiveness because we recognize the severity, the weight, the evilness of our sin, the wickedness of our sin, and that we do need a Savior, and that savior who is Christ becomes the bridge for us to come into God's presence.

So, when we are filled with that understanding of grace, when our subconscious mind and heartistic realm is totally filled with that truth of grace, You realize that this is undeserved and this is unearned, and it's not because of your good works or how many times you did Hook Dok Hae that you are saved. You see this is the problem with many people who have the tendency to become pharisaic, pretending they're perfect all the time; this is bad. Learning how to say,"*No, I'm not perfect,"* and being vulnerable to the fact that you are not perfect is so important; that shows the meekness.

Think about it! While I'm preaching, if I never shared my inner subconscious realm with all of you, folks; if I never shared with you how when I was younger, I was totally deluded and I was filled with rage and all this kind of stuff! Imagine if I didn't share that kind of stuff! Or if I didn't even recognize that it was there and just tried to pretend I'm perfect all the time!

That is the sign of a terrible unreflective person; it's the sign of a person that has not done the <u>work</u> of repentance, and has not done the <u>work</u> of going into the subconscious mind, into the subconscious realm, the heartistic realm. And faced those demons, faced those fears, and know that you are strengthened with the power of the Holy Spirit; that those ghosts can't do anything to you. Those ghosts can't do anything; they can't harass you anymore. They have no power over you once you have God; no power!

So, we want people to be filled with the Holy Spirit; we want them to be filled with the Holy Spirit of God. Because once you are filled with the Holy Spirit of God, and you are deep in that relationship, then these other demonic spirits are a joke; they're a pathetic joke. Because even the demon recognize who Jesus is; they know who the Christ is and they cower and they tremble before him.

That's why the demons:

*they don't want you to say Jesus' name,

*they don't want you to say True Father is Returning Jesus,

*they don't want you to love Jesus Christ because the God that was in Jesus is the same God in True Father in the flesh;

*they don't want us to love Jesus, because then they can try to have control over us.

Those are demonic spirits, and that's what unfortunately that Cheongpyeong lady became; she became part of that heresy that includes Han Hakja; that heresy that began to hate Jesus, to see him as a patriarch, and all this ridiculousness. Which then extended to of course, hating the Returning Jesus, and separating and trying to build their own little fieldom - which they did. But of course it collapsed, because once God's power is no longer there and once it's not centered on Christ, it's done; it's useless, it's just an empty vessel, a piece of trash no longer necessary.

So the whole culture at the restoration of Cheongpyeong providence will be biblically centered; will be centered on loving Jesus Christ and loving Jesus Christ #II, True Father, and his life course. And there is no evil demonic spirit that will make us separate our love for Jesus I or Jesus II; it doesn't matter for us. It's the same God; we love both. Jesus and True Father are one, completely one, and any demonic spirit that tries to separate them will be rebuked, and will be cast to the pit of hell. Amen!

The Restored Cheongpyeong will be centered not on the mother; it'll be centered on the Father. When we do workshops there, when we do healing workshops, it will not be centered on healing; it will be centered on restoration of our relationship with the Holy Spirit. We will not be focusing on these demons that are plaguing you, or this and that. No! That's like western medicine; like saying, "*Oh, you have some pain in your shoulder, so let's just deal with that.*" Or you have pain in your foot; but that's coming from the lack of blood circulation, which then leads to a stroke.

You see I'm saying? There's a larger root issue and that root issue is departure from God's Word, no longer studying the Bible. See, a lot of people have studied the Principle, but they don't study the Bible. What are you doing?

PART II: IQ, EQ, RQ centered on God

I was talking about this with the Queen, and she said it helped her tremendously. And I just tried to explain it simply. The question was: why did you have so many people in our church in the past -I think it's much less in Sanctuary - you had so many DP lecturers etc. They may know the Principle but their lives are a wreck; they're so low- level in terms of their marriage relationship or with their children. I mean they're negative, they're not even level one; they're a negative white belt.

So there's this humongous contradiction. You have these people that are claiming that they have the truth and they know everything about God and His heart -I mean this is what the lecturers were doing, right - but their lives are a total mess, a total mess. And of course they want to blame it on, "*oh I'm just sacrificing so much for the providence, that's why my family is falling apart.*" But in reality that wasn't the case at all, because there were people that could do both. The reality was when you actually saw these people how they behaved with their wife or with their husband, it was terrible; they were so low- level. When they dealt with their children it was terrible.

What is IQ, EQ & RQ?

So how did I talk about this to the Queen? I said: Yes, Divine Principle or seeking truth helps us with our **IQ** of God, our understanding of God, His providence; our IQ of God. But think about it: Christian - based material focuses not on IQ of God like knowing God's characteristics. These are more important in apologetics, I would say. But the dominant form of Christian literature that comes to try to help the believer become more mature in God, is not IQ based.

The dominant form of Christian material is **EQ**, learning how to relate your EQ with God. The Queen was saying, *"I read Christian material and it's so enriching; it fills my heart. It helps me try to develop a prayer life with God, helps me try to really have a personal relationship with God,"* which the Divine Principle does not focus on. It doesn't focus on building that personal relationship with God; it doesn't focus on it. It goes through the breakdown of Providence and the preparation for the messiah. So the Divine Principle would be IQ- based whereas Christian material would be EQ- based, and developing a personal relationship with God.

You have IQ and EQ, and then you have **RQ**. RQ is what? The utilization of both IQ and EQ to develop good relationships; that's your RQ.

Know & practice

If you just reflect back, in the Unification Church you had people who may have had good IQ about God, they may have known the Principle like some of my crazy siblings, unfortunately; crazy, psychopaths, really very tragic. Some of them knew the Principle so well; I mean literally, they could recite the Principle, but they were a mess; unfortunately a very sad mess, a very pathetic mess. Nobody in their right mind would follow that person because they were such a disaster when it came to what? EQ and RQ; they were so low- level, it was unbelievable.

Unfortunately I see this tendency: if you only study Principle you get high on truth and you just become like this intellectual, you become like this IQ person. Then you try to dominate your relationships with this IQ and it starts hurting those relationships, because you study Principle the most; but that doesn't mean you're applying it. You see, this is the problem: Just because you know something doesn't mean that you are a master. Just because you know Jiu-Jitsu is effective doesn't mean you're a master. Just because you know and you watched MMA and you know that Jujitsu is effective and that's why all the fighters do it, it doesn't mean you know how to fight with Jiu-Jitsu; that's a totally different thing, totally different thing. You have to know about Jiu-Jitsu, and then you have to practice it. You see the difference?

When I think about these crazy lunatics in our church, not only in our family, but even these lecturers; they all betrayed Father. They all "knew the truth." It boggles my mind when people say, "*How can they betray Father when they know the truth?*" You idiot! Because they had only IQ .They didn't really have a relationship with Father, they didn't have any EQ with Father; they had no RQ with Father. To them it was just IQ, so that they could boast about the truth that they had. It became arrogance, and all those fools betrayed Father.

EQ & the fruit of the Spirit

You see what I'm saying? One big problem I see: when you deal with relationships, what's more important? Is IQ more important or EQ more important? Actually in relationships, guess what? EQ is more important; it's more important. It doesn't mean that IQ is unimportant, but it is less important than EQ because EQ is kind of like your stat on wisdom and it influences greatly how you deal with people in the relationship. Which would be than your RQ: how high level your relationship quotient is. How much control you have over your emotional realm is a <u>massive factor</u> on how you treat people and thus your relationships.

So even though you may know the Principle well, and you may be able to recite it, if your EQ is pathetic - which many of these fools were - if your EQ is pathetic your relationships will crumble. I don't care how much you know about Principle, I don't care how many Scriptures you can recite, if you have no EQ your relationships will crumble.

Dominion over emotion, this is the whole thing about the fruit of the Spirit. I mean temperance, humbleness before God or meekness; all this is dealing with the emotion. You have to be able to deal with your emotions well; you can't just have crazy outbursts with people. You have to be able to be wise in relationship, and you must have sensitivity in relationships as well, as you relate with critical relationships like your spouse or your children. You have to be aware and sensitive to what type of person they are.

IQ & EQ-based children

Broadly speaking you will have either IQ- based children or EQ -based children. IQ -based children are children who believe that through intellect they can solve all their problems, or they can move through the world solving problems with their IQ. Those are IQ -based kids and every parent who has multiple children you know that there's that type of kid that's more IQ- based. I would say that they rely more on IQ or the intellect, and they believe that through the intellect they can solve their life problems. That's IQ -based. Then there's the EQ- based child who is definitely more emotional; now males and females, it doesn't matter. There are males that are more IQ -based, there are males that are more EQ-based; there are females more IQ-based, and there are females that are EQ -based.

And of course there are different levels of this. There are different numbers to these numerical stats to how much they rely on IQ versus EQ, and of course there's always a variety. It's not going to be like you have a ten in IQ and a zero in EQ. Maybe there are some people like that, but that's more rare. There's going to be some variety and balance of the stats.

But the point is: the dominant way that a child is dealing with the beliefs that they can deal with and solve life's problems is either emotionally- based or intellectually- based. Broadly speaking you can see a child as more IQ or EQ, and then how you relate with that child is different; it's very, very different.

For the IQ child feelings are not really important; they can understand more rational thinking separate from feelings. But for the EQ -based child, feelings are a big part of them, at least when they're immature; how they feel is very big.

Now this is a great thing; this is the very hopeful thing. The great thing is that you can raise either the IQ stat or the EQ stat; you can change this. God gives the power to change these things. This is the hopeful thing; this is the amazing thing about it.

Pluses & minuses

So if your kid is high in the emotional realm or **EQ** that gives them some benefits. They can empathize with people quickly. They're usually social butterflies or they can do well socially. People like that will probably go into sales and do pretty well. Those who are EQ -based they have very fast *Nunchi*; *Nunchi* means they can pick up people's energy quickly, and read societal encounters very quickly. There are pluses.

But there are minuses. Minuses that they can fall into great depression, they can get really emotional; that's their humongous weakness. They don't have the ability to rationally think things through; their emotions take over when bad things happen. This is a humongous weakness of the EQ people! They don't have a self-reflective rational set to help them work through problems; they want to just cry through it, etc, and it can lead to tremendous immaturity on that weakness side of the EQ stat.

The **IQ** stat has benefits. You'll be leaning towards more rationality; you will be more open to rational processes. You will be doing the hard work of thinking as an important tool; whereas the EQ person will see that as less important. They just want to feel right; they want to feel good. For the IQ person that doesn't matter to them as much. What matters to them is using their rationality to manipulate reality, or to work through reality.

The downside of that is that the IQ person can become so flagrantly arrogant, that they push everybody away. So, many times the IQ person feels isolated, and many times that's how Satan tempts

them to say, "Look, you're isolated because you're so smart, you see; everybody's dumb and you're smart." They get filled with this hubris.

And they believe that actually through manipulation and using intellect to manipulate people, then they can get their way in society. That's like Bill Gates. So it can really become bad for the IQ people; it can become really evil. They can become <u>super evil</u> if they rely on their intellect to manipulate their environments and reality. They start worshiping the intellect or the IQ realm.

So each one, IQ versus EQ- based, has strength and weakness; each one has potential for good, each one has potential for evil.

I hope this is helping. So broadly speaking your children will have either IQ or an EQ- based dominant personality. Of course there will be a variety, so each child won't be exactly the same.

You'll have children that are more dominantly towards IQ. Unfortunately you have to help them stay away from the bad side of IQ which is that they try to use their intellect to dominate people and they try to use their intellect to manipulate reality. They can become very manipulative and very evil if they go down that path, like Bill Gates and Bezos and these bastards; they can become real evil.

So you have to guard them from that while allowing them to use intellect to do good things for God. But at the same time you have to help them develop their EQ too, so that they can do well in their relationship with their wife or husband and with their children. Because if you're too IQ -based you're going to be weaker in how you deal with relationships. And you're going to try to use intellect to manipulate those relationships, instead of being empathetic, instead of trying to understand and feel people's struggle and their pain so -to- speak, and to work with that to be compassionate. An IQ person is not going to have that as much.

An EQ person on the good side of EQ, will have that a lot more naturally to them; they can be much more empathetic, they can be much more compassionate etc.

These are broad categories; I'm speaking very broadly.

Raising your EQ with God

But the point is: even in our spiritual life we can't just know truth, *"I know the Principle; I read it that many times!"* No, no! That's just knowing truth! That's just raising your IQ; that is not raising your EQ with God at all. And it's not increasing your RQ with God's people at all; at all!

The only way you can start raising your EQ with God is by your spiritual life of prayer and meditation, of studying the Word; and studying the Bible, not only the Divine Principle. I'm talking about the Bible because that's the story of God, and you see His heart and His warnings all through the Bible.

That's how: *you build an EQ and *a prayer life and *a meditation life where
*you are entering into your subconscious realm, and
*you are repenting and
*you are facing your ghosts and
*not letting them have power over you and
*you're not emotionally bursting out;
*you have control over your emotions.
This is not something you're just going to get by memorizing the Divine Principle, like so many of these fake lecturers did. And they betrayed Father, so it's not impressive! It's never impressive when somebody says, "Oh, I've read the Divine Principle this and that many times." So what? So what? Even if you've read the Bible, it doesn't matter; it doesn't mean anything. The Devil can read the Bible and

Divine Principle billions of times. So what? That doesn't mean Jack squat.

You can't come up to me, a black belt in Jiu-jitsu, and tell me, "*Oh*, *I know how real Jiu-jitsu is.*" No you don't! Because you don't know how to apply it and you don't know how to use it in real life. You see what I'm saying? This was a massive weakness. That's why so many of our first- generation families collapsed in their relationships, because they were not trained at all in the EQ realm or the RQ realm; very weak, humongous weakness. They were not trained at all in the EQ or RQ realm; or very little. So, all the training, all the workshops became IQ- based.

But with IQ -based you can't solve life's problems very well, especially in relationships. That's the problem with just IQ -based. You may be able to solve some of life problems with IQ-based but relationships will foil your plans a lot, because there is a lot of emotional realm in the relationships. You see, you actually have to have quite a high EQ to do well in relationships. Ah! See! IQ may be able to help you study hard and make money, or be a lawyer, an accountant, but it's not going to help you be a good husband and know how to romance your wife!

Raise your RQ

Oh my gosh! I don't even know why I have to teach this; it's so basic. It drives me nuts sometimes. Lord, have mercy! Thank You Lord! Praise God! What can I do? I can only praise God, I can only praise God.

Everybody's got to start a white belt anyway, so it's a process; it's frustrating but it's a process, okay. Everybody's got to start a white belt. You may be a black belt in IQ but you're not a black belt in EQ; there, you're a white belt. You may be a black belt in EQ but you're not a black belt in IQ. You see? You need both.

But I would say actually for relationships **EQ** is more important; it's more important. That would be your wisdom stat; it's better to be wise than just to be intelligent. There are plenty of intelligent people who are <u>wicked, evil</u>. Look at them! You can see them, just the elites. They're all intelligence-based, IQ- based mad scientists that are trying to manipulate and engineer the world. These people are IQ - based; they're not EQ- based.

Again I would say EQ is more important for relationships, but IQ is very important too. IQ is not unnecessary. I see all the EQ people celebrating, "*Yeah, yeah, the King said EQ's better!*" No, no, no, you're not listening. IQ is very, very, important to solve your problems, and to get better at controlling your emotions. The problem with the EQ people is that they can be very good socially sometimes, but then they fall into deep depression; that's a tremendous weakness, a tremendous weakness! I would say, even though I'm also intelligent, I mean I've excelled at the highest academies in the world like Harvard etc, so, obviously I'm "intelligent," but I would definitely say my EQ was higher; even though I have an IQ, I would say my EQ would be higher.

So again EQ is important but it's not the end of it all, because you may be good socially, but then when you're down it's a tremendous down; whereas IQ people are a little more stable. So we got to learn that from the IQ realm. We got to learn how to have more stability, and not have these huge emotional fluctuations. This is very bad, very, very bad; that's definitely white- belt level.

EQ people have to work on the terrible fluctuations that they have, the highs and the downers, and you can only do that by increasing your IQ. You see, this is the key. You can only get rid of that down that huge emotional low, by increasing your IQ and working through that low rationally, using your IQ, helping remind you to stay calm. Don't freak out, don't focus on that. You have to let your IQ help you in those downs. That's the problem with the EQ people. The EQ people, they may be good socially, they may good in relationships, but then they have massive downs.

Now I'm speaking generally; this is not always the case, but it's probably a dominant feature of these categories.

The **IQ** people may be more stable but they don't know how to re relate with people who are going through ups and downs; they don't know how to guide the people who are EQ. Maybe your wife would be more EQ- based and you are IQ- based, you're thinking, *"I can't understand this crazy woman; I can't explain anything to her. She is so emotional all the time."* See, there's a problem because you don't have any EQ.

The point is: we want everybody to raise their **RQ**. How do we do that? We have to raise the **IQ and the EQ together**. Everybody will be a little different in their levels of each because we have a God-given base, but we have to put in work to increase them, and the more we do so the better we will be in our relationships. We'll be able to apply what we learn in Principle, we'll be able to apply what we learn through Scripture, to be better in our life and in our relationships which is <u>fundamental</u> to God's Kingdom; <u>fundamental</u> absolutely critical in being a good king and a priest, and a good queen and evangelist. Absolutely critical! So let's do that!

The Restored Cheongpyeong, a retreat

Then the Restored Cheongpyeong place will be focusing on those things, understanding and strengthening our IQ realm but also our EQ realm; growing in maturity and learning of this

empathetic realm, so that we become better at applying what we know about God's truth to our relationships or the RQ realm. Amen!

So, we want people to come not just for, "*oh*, *I got a pain in my back*." No, no, no! We want you to become better. When you leave there, you now know Father's life course better, you have a more personal relationship with God. You work on that there; you work on it in a focused manner. And that's what a retreat is like: a focused intensive course, a focused intensive time period. You get away from everything and you focus in on work. What kind of work? Increasing IQ, EQ, and RQ in relation and centered on God. So that the other parts of your anointing that God has given you, whether it be ministry or ministering your children or ministering your wife, or being a good king and a just shepherd can be improved.

All these things are related and connected to your level of IQ, RQ, and EQ. So we want everybody to get to a higher level in all these things; the higher level you are, the better you will become at these things. Amen!
