We then watched a video of Hyung Jin Nim speaking behind a 120 year old house in the Korean countryside. He started by reading Psalm 30 in which the psalmist talks of being in the pit of hell, but finding that "joy came in the morning."

After Father's passing Hyung Jin Nim had so many dark nights of the soul after learning that his mother had a different agenda. Never before in history was there so much victory in a religious founder's lifetime, but she turned her back on her husband and used his foundation for a shockingly different purpose.

He then showed a 5 minute video about the past 10 years in which there were so many challenges and painful realities, but also God's guidance in the midst of those.

In the last week when they went out to a small restaurant, Hyung Jin Nim would often ask the waitress to take off her mask. Invariably if she did so, it would uncover a beautiful, smiling face.

Hyung Jin Nim felt an enormous weight preparing for the speaking tour, starting in Yeosu.

The idea of a book being the center of a civilization is a modern idea. The Bible is viewed as the Word of the Creator. Our civilization comes into being from the unseen word of God. The idea of seeking truth becomes the core ethic of the culture. The idea that we need to obey the laws in the Constitution is linked to the idea we must obey the word of God. In most other cultures family and clan ties are uppermost, not following written words.

When the Han mother changed Father's words after his passing, she was uprooting the word of God, the core ethic. He begged her not to change those.

It is significant that two days before the True Parents Day holy day in April, a federal judge threw out the Family Fed lawsuit.

The Kwak group and the Family Fed stole everything except for the most precious thing, the Word of God. We had nothing, and were cursed by many members as being unfilial. But from the biblical standpoint he knew he must not support treachery.



Starting in 2015, when Hyung Jin Nim prophesied worldwide judgment, people mocked him, but now we have seen the worldwide deaths and economic devastation in the past two years due to the Covid virus and tyrannical government mandates. Hak Ja Han claimed there would be world peace, not suffering on a worldwide scale.

Despite the opposition and mockery, a tremendous foundation has developed, with thousands coming to the Freedom Festival each year and many coming to the Sanctuary Church to renew their faith.

He could not sleep the night before the first rally. Finally, he just had to surrender to, and trust in, God's will.

He woke up and saw a new blooming peony flower. He took it as a sign from God and felt peace. He decided he would look forward to seeing what the Holy Spirit would do.



A man who was outspoken about the reality of election fraud in Korea had his home invaded by government agents who forced his family to take PCR tests. His wife was traumatized. She became paralyzed and passed away a few weeks later. Their 5 children lost their mother. When people learned what had happened, there was an outpouring of support.

The man came to the Yeosu rally with his five children. His autistic oldest son came forward and was "slain in the spirit," lying on the floor for hours. Finally, after nearly everyone had departed, his son rose and explained that he had been talking to his mom in the spirit world. For the first time he was pouring out his heart to his father.

A woman who had been suffering from immense migraine headaches came. She felt a fire pouring into her body. The migraine pain was washed away.

These were not things Hyung Jin Nim could do by his own power. He just had to place his trust in God's hands.

Brothers and sisters are waking up and coming back.
