True Father has emphasized the importance for blessed children of their participation in the Cheongpyeong 40-day workshop, at least three times prior to their blessing.

The workshop schedule for this summer has been arranged so as to enable international blessed children (all blessed children living outside of Korea and Japan) to attend the Cheongpyeong 40- and 21-day workshops during the summer holidays. The schedule is as listed below.

Please make this schedule widely known so that as many 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> generation members as possible can participate together this summer.

Please note that this official memo is intended for members living outside of Korea and Japan.

## 1. Schedule for the Cheongpyeong Workshops for International Blessed Children:

40-day	July 6(Wed) – August 14(Sun), 2011	Blessed children(and *Sung Hwa Students) in high school, <b>16~18 years of age or in grades 10-12</b> who understand English*
21-day	July 6(Wed) – July 26(Tue), 2011	Blessed children(and Sung Hwa Students) in junior high school, <b>12~15 years of age or in grades 6-9</b> , Those high school children that cannot attend full 40-day workshop, who understand English **
	July 25(Mon) – August 14(Sun), 2011	

\* **Sung Hwa Students** (Blessed Children and Jacob's Children) refers to the students of our church who are attending high school or junior high school.

\*\* It is strongly recommended that those Sung Hwa Students in junior high school participate in the 21-day workshop, but if the child strongly wishes to attend the 40-day workshop, please contact

international office or the USA Headquarters' Education Department Office (If you are from USA) beforehand.

\*\*\* If a Sung Hwa Student (in junior high school or high school) completes two 21-day workshops (one this time and one before, or one this time and one at a later time), they can receive a 40-day workshop certificate at the end of their second 21-day workshop.

### **3. Materials to Prepare**

- 1) Holy Song book
- 2) Toiletries, underwear, and socks
- 3) White t-shirts (at least 7), thin pants that will not generate dust during Chanyang Yeoksa sessions (holy song sessions)
- 4) Comfortable shoes and a shoe bag
- 5) A set of dress clothes for special occasions (for example, Ahn Shi Il)
- 6) FM radio
- 7) Umbrella or raingear
- 8) One photo (3x4 cm) (for those who did not attach a photo to their registration form)
- 9) Holy robes and blessing ring for those who will participate in the ancestor blessing ceremony
- 10) Personal medication/s, **traveler's insurance**, etc.

※ Trainees will wear white t-shirts throughout the entire workshop.

※ For more information, please refer to the Honor Code.

### **4. Workshop Registration Form Arrival: By April 30, 2011**

**1) The registration form should be sent to the International Office no later than April 30, 2011, after reading the Honor Code.**

**2) For those participants from USA, your registration form should be submitted to the USA Headquarters (Education Department Office) no later than April 30, 2011.**

**5. Workshop Fee:** 40-day: 800,000 won (exchange rate will differ daily)  
21-day: 420,000 won (exchange rate will differ daily)



- 1) The workshop fee should be brought by your child, and turned in at the time of registration in Cheongpyeong. If you think it will be a problem for your child to bring the workshop fee, please contact us at +82-31-589-7079, 7179.
- 2) We accept checks, cash, and travelers checks.  
Checks should be made out to **HSA-UWC CSC** and \$8 needs to be added for a processing fee. If the check is over \$1000 (workshop fee for 2 people), a \$10 fee needs to be added. Travelers checks are the same as cash.

## **6. Important points to keep in mind:**

- 1) Members must start the 40-day (21-day) Workshop within 7 days from the official workshop starting date. If they arrive late they must extend their participation in the workshop by the number of days they are late.
- 2) You may arrive 1 or 2 days early, but must stay until July 26 to complete the 1<sup>st</sup> 21-day workshop and until August 14 to complete the 40-day workshop or 2<sup>nd</sup> 21-day workshop.
- 3) It is recommended that 40-day workshop participants leave the following day (Aug 15) at the earliest.
- 4) Members who are psychologically or spiritually or behaviorally challenged must first consult with Rev. Kim Dong Bae(82-31-589-7188). If permission is granted, he or she may register only if accompanied by a caregiver. (Please keep in mind that if permission is not granted, or if a caregiver does not come, such an individual may be asked to return home.)
- 5) **Even though you complete the workshop, if your attitude during participation does not meet the workshop standards, you may not be able to receive the graduation certificate. In this case, you can receive the certificate after participating satisfactorily in any other 40-day or 21-day workshop.**
- 6) If you do not follow the workshop standards habitually and consistently, you may be asked to return home.
- 7) International blessed children, living outside of Korea and Japan, age 16 and above can participate in the liberation ceremony and blessing ceremony for their parents' ancestors.
- 8) As of the 71st workshop, 40-day workshop participants who register for the ancestor liberation ceremony are also required to pay the 2-day workshop registration fee of 25,000 won per group of seven generations. (However, the registration fee for the ancestor blessing ceremony is 25,000 won regardless of the number of generations.)
- 9) Members coming to Korea from abroad must usually obtain a 90-day visa, **before coming to the workshop**. (Members in the USA and most of Europe do not need VISA). The Training Center cannot acquire or extend visas for you. If your visa expires while you are in Korea, the immigration office will charge you a penalty of \$100 US per month and your name can be placed on a "black" list.
- 10) **Members coming to Korea from abroad must be sure to purchase traveler's insurance. Before you obtain any insurance, please consult with the Insurance Company to ensure that it can be used in South Korea.**

# **Honor Code for International Blessed Children**

## **Attending the Cheongpyeong 40- and 21-day Workshop**

Hello!! Many warm greetings from the Cheongpyeong staff to 2<sup>nd</sup> generation members all over the world! We are doing our best to prepare and make this upcoming 2<sup>nd</sup> generation summer 40-day (21-day) workshop fruitful, exciting and fun, and for this to happen we need your help.

For the success of a Cheongpyeong 40-day (21-day) workshop, the heartfelt participation of every participant is essential. **It is very important that Cheongpyeong 40-day (21-day) workshop trainees are not forced by their parents to come.** In order to make the workshop a great experience for all of the participants who will be attending, each and every trainee should act in a mature and dignified manner, and take responsibility for his/her actions.

**As a trainee, and (as) parents of the trainee respectively, please read the following and sign your names on the registration form to signify that you agree to comply with the contents.**

1. Cheongpyeong is primarily a place for me (the trainee) to improve my relationship with God, and to find my true self.  
Therefore **I, as a trainee**, will refrain from forming any kind of intense horizontal relationship, or spending exclusive time with another trainee, either of the same or of the opposite sex, but will instead concentrate on nurturing my personal relationship with God.
2. I will try to see everybody from God's viewpoint even though we are different and may have a hard time understanding each other, in various ways.
3. If it is necessary to go to CheongShim International Medical Center, the Youth Training Center, etc., I will leave the Training Center only after receiving permission from the Cheongpyeong staff.
4. I will always be on time and make utmost effort to fully participate in the entire schedule.
5. I will comply with the Cheongpyeong dress code (page 2).

6. I will follow and respect the Cheongpyeong staff and all the team/group leaders.
7. I will not eat in the lecture halls or at the holy grounds.
8. I will make my utmost effort to keep the Cheongpyeong grounds clean and neat.
9. I will not bring any of the prohibited items, which are listed below.
10. I will refrain from doing any of the prohibited activities, which are listed below.
11. I will not use the internet without permission from the Cheongpyeong staff.
12. I will consult immediately with the Cheongpyeong staff if any problems arise.
13. I will follow any and all other rules set forth by the staff during the workshop, since they are designed to help me have a good experience.

※Members who are psychologically or spiritually or behaviorally challenged must first consult with Rev. Kim Dong Bae. If permission is granted, he or she may register only if accompanied by a caregiver.

※Even though you completed the workshop, if your attitude during participation does not meet the workshop standards, you may not be able to receive the graduation certificate. In this case, you can receive the certificate after participating satisfactorily in any other 40-day or 21-day (only summer season) workshop.

※If you do not follow the workshop standards habitually and consistently, you may be asked to return home.

#### **A. Prohibited Items**

1. Personal music players
2. Electronic games, computers, DVD players, cell phones
3. Jewelry, make-up
4. Novels or other non-Cheongpyeong related books or magazines
5. Weapons, including knives with long blades
6. Drugs (except when accompanied by a prescription)

7. Alcohol, tobacco products
8. Revealing or immodest clothing (\*\*see Dress code below)
9. Musical instruments and CDs are allowed for use during talent shows or festivals, but must not distract from workshop activities.

Possession of a prohibited item will result in having it confiscated for the duration of the workshop. Additional consequences may be required for any improper use of the item, on a case by case basis.

Dangerous, illegal, or illicit items such as drugs, alcohol, pornography or the like will be destroyed. These are antithetical to the purpose of the workshop.

#### **B. Prohibited activities**

1. Drinking, smoking, drugs, possession or viewing of pornography
2. Stealing, shoplifting, use of foul or abusive language

#### **C. Dress code**

1. No shorts (Capris halfway down the calf are permitted).
2. No sleeveless tops.
3. No tops that let the stomach show when hands are raised.  
(Cheongpyeong is a training center and trainees should refrain from excessive exposure of the skin)
4. No jewelry. No make-up.  
(Jewelry and make up become a distraction, especially during holy song sessions. Jewelry may injure you or other people, and make-up prevents one from separating evil spirits from the face)
5. Socks should be worn at all times in lecture rooms and prayer halls.
6. No sandals (flip flops) except for showers and rainy days.

※ If any of the above standards are personally / culturally intrusive, please kindly observe them with a heart of offering and respect for the duration of your stay at the Cheongpyeong Heaven and Earth Training Center. Be forewarned that unpleasant consequences await the repeating breaker.

4. Plastic flip-flops or sandals for wear on rainy days (called "slippers" in Korea; these can be purchased at the store at Cheongpyeong)
5. If you are not familiar with Korean food (hot spicy food), granola bars, tuna cans, cereals, etc. can be helpful.
6. Holy robes and blessing ring if participating in ancestor blessing

### **C. All items should be marked with the name of the owner.**

Please do not forget to write names on clothes. Please follow this rule to prevent laundry from getting mixed up or lost.

## D. Money
