Kenn had attended Heavenly Parent and True Parents for many years, as well as serving his community, friends and family.


Let us support Kenn's family in this special time and pray for his victorious transition to a glorious new life in the spiritual world. Following is a short biography and information of the Seonghwa service.

Victorious Life of Kenneth Hendricks December 5, 1948 - July 21, 2014

Ralph Kenneth Hendricks (known by most as Kenn, Uncle Ken, and Appa) was born on December 5, 1948 in Dickinson, ND to Oscar and Clementine Hendricks. From a young age, he had a passion for music and the arts. After graduating from Dickinson High School, Kenn dedicated two years to the U.S. military during the Vietnam War.

In August 1974, Kenn met the Unification Church in Fargo, ND and officially joined in September of that year. In July 1982, he was married to Akemi Ono from Japan in a memorable wedding ceremony of 2,075 couples. Today, he is survived by his wonderful family.

Kenn has served his community, friends and family abundantly. He served Rev. and Mrs. Moon directly in various events, represented Mongolia as its National Messiah, offered his musical talent at gatherings, shot a feature-length film ("Dakota Sunrise") in the North Dakota Badlands, was a strong supporter of the Landmark Forum, and filled every heart he met with laughter and joy. Kenn truly was, in his own words, a "prophet" of God.
