True Father taught that the sexual organs are the borderline between heaven and hell. “Now, let us discover the dividing line between heaven and hell. Is it up in the air? Where is it? It is your sexual organ. ...If you use your sexual organ like a blind person aimlessly wandering without direction, it will undoubtedly lead you as its owner to hell. By the same token, if you use your sexual organ according to the standard of God’s absolute love, you will be led high up into heaven.”

Let’s unpack this. We abide in a spiritual state. While in the physical body, because of the distractions of the physical world, we are minimally aware of our spiritual state. Once we shed the physical body, our spiritual state, heaven or hell, is our world.

With no love, you are in the shadows, in a fog. In spirit world, love is air. With love, you breathe freely. With no love, you are gasping, suffocating. Breathing in light, or gasping in darkness.
