September 8, 1998

Father and Mother Moon Proclaim 4.4 Jeol

By combining together the numbers for the date 1,9,9,8,9 and 8, it adds up to 44. According to Unificationist theology, the number 4 has become a significant number in the dispensation to break Satan's dominion of the four-position foundation and return it back to the heavenly side. For that reason, True Parents have declared 4.4 Jeol, which has restored and established the perfection number of the four-position foundation of heaven, the perfection number of the four-position foundation of earth, plus the first generation- and second-generation four-position foundations. The installation of 4.4 Jeol means that God will be able to perform substantially His works of omnipresence, omniscience, and omnipotence. Heaven's side will be able to directly attack and judge Satan's side.

Soccer Legend Pele sent his condolence for Rev Sun Myung Moon Passing.



Pele, the soccer hero of Brazil, sent the following condolence for the passing of Rev. Sun Myung Moon, attracting the attention of many: "I am deeply sorry to hear about the passing of Rev. Moon. After meeting three former popes and former presidents of various nations including President Nelson Mandela, I had an opportunity to meet with Rev. Sun Myung Moon and the peace movement in Korea. He said to me that, since football is the largest organization in the world and a very important means of propagating the message of peace, I hold a great responsibility. I hope that, just as Rev. Moon had endeavored to bring about peace, his cooperators and his followers will continue to work for peace."

September 9, 1998

Rev. Moon's Family Responds by Letter to Nan Sook Hong's Book.

The Unification movement as a whole responded to the situation of Rev. Moon's ex-daughter-in-law's tell-all publication in several specific ways. Rev. Moon's third son, Hyun Jin Moon, who had been recently inaugurated as Vice-President of the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) International, sent a letter addressed to all members on September 9th that was intended to share "the heart and spirit of my family." He stated that they considered "Nan Sook to be part of the family...[and for others] to not criticize her, even though we do not agree with what she sets forth in the book...[and] are ready to take care of unresolved problems and... would like Nan Sook to be part of the healing process." The following day, HSA Headquarters sent a letter to members intended to help them respond to issues raised by the book. The letter outlined the movement's position on personal and marital abuse, financial accountability, issues of political power, religious freedom, the teaching and practice of family values, and lifestyle issues. Finally, though declining to speak with media representatives, Rev. and Mrs. Moon submitted a brief statement to "Sixty Minutes" stating in part: "We commiserate with Nan Sook over the suffering arising from the tragic personal problems our son has faced. We, as parents, feel a deep sense of responsibility."

September 9, 1999

Father and Mother Moon hold 9.9 Jeol Liberation Ceremony of the Cosmic Unification

The 9.9 Jeol, which True Parents declared as a new holy day, has the meaning of creating a connecting point between the Declaration Day of the Realm of Cosmic Sabbath for Parents of Heaven and Earth (7.8 Jeol) and the Proclamation of the Celebration of Cosmic Victory. Moreover, by passing beyond the number 9, which Satan possessed and by establishing a border which Satan cannot go beyond, Hell on earth and in the spirit world can be removed and the entrance into the era of liberation of the ideal age of the Kingdom of God on earth and in heaven will begin. On this day, True Parents emphasized that the realm of living together, sharing joy and our inheritance will be realized when we love with absolute, unique, unchanging and eternal love, with absolute True Love.

In recognizing this day, True Parents made a proclamation establishing Heung Jin Moon (Rev. Moon's second son, deceased) in the position of son of God of Family Salvation, established Choong Mo Nim (Mother Moon's physical mother) in the position of a mother who has accomplished all ideals of indemnity of Adam's family in the original world, and established Dae Mo Nim (Hyo Nam Kim, physical embodiment of Choong Mo Nim) in a position to determine the standard of the Spiritual Parent (Holy Spirit) at the time of Jesus

Three Generations Embark on Peace Tour To Visit Europe

Father and Mother Moon, The Reverend Dr. and Mrs. Sun Myung Moon and their family, children and grandchildren embarked on a 40-nation speaking tour. Rev Moon announced this very shortly after Mrs. Moon had completed her world speaking tour and they had blessed four of their grandchildren in marriage.

September 10, 1999

Father Moon Proclaims 3.10 Jeol

Father Moon proclaimed 3.10 Jeol in the name of Jehovah at 10 minutes and 10 seconds past 10:00 a.m. on September 10, 1999 in Kodiak, Alaska. The meaning of 3.10 Jeol is that, on the foundation of Father's declaration on the "Declaration Day of the Realm of the Cosmic Sabbath for Parents of Heaven and Earth" and 9.9 Jeol, all numbers from 1-10 have been restored as heaven's numbers. Father Moon said that since all numbers from 1-10 have been restored to God's side, God is now able to freely, and from a spontaneous position, superintend the original world of creation by numbers.

September 11 – 30, 1993

Mother Moon Conducts 25 Rallies in Japan

From September 11-30, 1993 Mrs. Moon conducted 25 rallies in Japan, the highlight being her speech before 50,000 at the Tokyo Dome. At that particular rally, Princess Eva Marie of the former Kingdom of Yugoslavia and Marilyn Quayle, wife of the former Vice-President of the United States., offered remarks.

September 12, 2005

Founding of the Universal Peace Federation and start of 100 City World Tour

Shortly before the United Nations' 60th anniversary, The Universal Peace Federation was founded by Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon, and his wife, Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon. They proposed a revitalized, renewed United Nations with more than 50,000 diplomats, clergy, civic leaders, current and former heads of state appointed as Ambassadors for Peace. Rev. Moon inaugurated the UPF with a 100-city world speaking tour in which he delivered his speech titled "God's Ideal Family – The Model for World Peace."

September 12, 2011

Dedication Ceremony for the Ocean Cheonjeong Palace Hotel Held in Geomun Island

The dedication ceremony of the Ocean Cheonjeong Palace Hotel on Geomun Island began at 10:30 AM at the newly built hotel located in Deokchon Hamlet, Samsan Village in Yeosu City, South Jeolla Province in Korea. More than three thousand people attended, including members of the American Clergy Leadership Conference (ACLC), church members, core members of the Tongil Group, chief executives of our providential organizations and corporations, ambassadors for peace, Japanese leaders, leading celebrities of the local Yeosu region, and local residents of Geomun Island.

Press conference for Day of Hope rallies

Ministers and religious leaders from a wide spectrum of faiths and denominations joined together in a press conference at the Waldorf-Astoria publicizing their support of Rev. Sun Myung Moon, and the Unification Church. Participating were: Rev. Paul Shin Nakamura of the Union Church of Japan, Rev. Royal Davis of the Congregational Church of America, Father Shawn Byrne, a Catholic priest from Ireland, Mr. Melvin Orchard, former Mission President of the Mormon Church, Pastor William H. Luke of the Church of God, Therese Klein, a former Franciscan Sister, and Rev. Jack Counterman of the Assemblies of God. The press conference was conducted by Mr. Joe Tully, chairman of the New York Day of Hope committee.
