### November 20, 1991 Mother Moon Proclaims the “Feminine Logic of Love”

On November 20th, she spoke before a gathering of 15,000 Women’s Federation Peace in Asia members at Seoul’s Jamsil Stadium. At the event she stated, “In history, the ‘logic of power’ has been on of ruling” but now the present age demanded the “feminine ‘logic of love’ to solve...problems and lead history in a proper way.”

### November 22, 2010 International Delegates Attend Historic World Assembly

The special World Assembly, The Era of Universal Peace: God's Providence and the "Abel UN," was held on November 22, 2010 at the Manhattan Center in the heart of New York City.

The assembly was providentially important since it took place on Nov. 22 (10.17 H.C.), which is the day right after the Three-Day period (10.14, 10.15, 10.16 H.C.) centered on 10.14 H.C. in 2010, which is the 60th anniversary of Father Moon's liberation from *Hungnam*, a North Korean labor camp. Especially through these three assemblies, the proclamation of True Parents must reach perfection,

conclusion and completion. It is proclaimed that Korea, which is where True Parents were born, became God's homeland. These assemblies have the internal meaning that all the leaders of G-20 and other countries should join the assemblies and attend to the victorious True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind.

### November 23-26, 1972 Father Moon Convenes the First ICUS Conference

Father Moon convened the Unification movement's first International Conference on the Unity of the Sciences (ICUS) from November 23-26, 1972, at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel in New York City. The conference brought together twenty scientists from seven nations to discuss the "Moral Orientation of the Sciences." It included an opening banquet and three-working days of lectures, responses, panels and open discussions on a number of topics.

**Third World Culture and Sports Festival Held in Washington, D.C.**

On November 23rd to 30th, 1997, the third World Culture and Sports Festival WCSF was held for the first time in the United State in Washington, D.C. The first two World Culture and Sports Festival (WCSF) were held in Korea.

According to the report from Rev, Chung Hwan Kwak on October 1997, True Parents envisioned gathering thousands of participants from the many fields for the purpose of establishing a foundation for world peace. This gathering would bring together many of the projects which represent Reverend and Mrs. Moon's lifelong efforts around the world. Based on this vision, the church organized the first World Culture and Sports Festival in 1992 and the second in 1995, which both took place at *Jamsil* Olympic Stadium in Seoul, Korea.
