CARP & Young Adults Plan for 2014

GROUPING

1. CARP (University students, pre-students)
2. Blessed couples
3. Professionals

Things can seem very different when you enter a new stage of life so we are planning to create three focused groups to support youth where they need it most

DETAILS

1. CARP

- University Students and pre-students (gap-year/work experience)
- Goals: After HARP, it isn't as easy to stay involved and active in our movement so we will create more activities and workshops which will not only focus on our life of faith but also target areas such as entering university and creating CV's
- We will also be more involved with Youth UPF, WFWP Youth, STF and Service projects.

2. Blessed Couples

- People who are in matching process (matching support) and Blessed couples.
- Goals: Support people who are in the process of matching and blessing by making marriage support and advice more available. We also want to support new couples and new mothers by creating events such as young mothers' workshops and monthly Husband/ Wife meetings.

3. Professionals

- People who are working/ looking for a job.

- Goals: Working can be great but it can also be tough so we will create more events or workshops that will allow young professionals to meet, discuss and give each other career advice as well as learning how to balance our job, family life and life of our faith. We also plan to create events that support people in the interview process of finding jobs

COMMUNITY LEVEL ACTIVITIES

We 2nd Generation may want to get involved, go into the matching process, develop our faith and/or do outreach but feel we they cannot do these things because we lack support, space or facilities. True Mother is also pushing us to start acting within our communities.

SOLUTION:

- CARP committee and YA committee – hold regular events and create a young people’s community to give spiritual guidance.
 - Work closer with pastors to make support more available for us to be more active and creative
 - Create more open and embracing communities.
 - Focus more on blessing program – support families
