We sincerely hope that members and providential organizations in each nation can join in this historic effort that is possible through the unity of our hearts and will and that all can partake with a heart longing for True Parents.

### **1) Global launching**

a) Date : May 30 (4.13 on the heavenly calendar in the third year of Cheon Il Guk)

b) Venue : PEACE PALACE(Las Vegas, U.S.A.)

**2) Regional launching:** The very first launching in a region by a participating nation will be considered as the regional launching.

※ The regional launching of Africa and South America will be held at the same time with the global launching on May 30, 2015. (Cape of Good Hope, South Africa/ Santiago, Chile)

### **3) National launching**

a) Date: Please refer to attachment *#1 Peace Road 2015 Participating Nations and Schedule* for the launching schedule of each nation

- b) Venue: Select a meaningful venue for the launching in consultation with the regional headquarters
- c) Main Contents
- Passing on the PEACE ROAD regional course flag: The regional president is to pass on the Peace Road course flag to the national leader of the first nation that holds a launching ceremony (We recommend to continue passing on this flag from one nation to the other at the regional level)
  - Congratulatory address (An address by a high level leader in the nation such as a parliament member or peace ambassador)
  - Conduct a Peace Road Banner signature ceremony and a photo shoot with key people
  - Take a group photo with everyone included
- d) Main banner: Should be independently made by each nation and used at the launching

**4) Details on the Peace Road course**

- a) After the launching, participants are to set off on the Peace Road course by bike, car, train, a march (walking) and other diverse means with the small Peace Road flags hanging from them.
- b) In the case of bicycles, participants are to set off on their course after attaching the Peace Road small flags on the bicycles and participants are geared with safety equipment.
- c) After completing the Peace Road course in each nation or region, the nation or region concerned are to hold a victory celebration.
- d) After completing the regional course, the regional president must bring the regional Peace Road flag to the third anniversary of True Father's seonghwa (7.17 on the heavenly calendar, Cheongshim Peace World Center)

**3. Administrative matters**

- 1) Report of plans:** Please refer to attachment #1 *Peace Road 2015 Participating Nations and Schedule* and report your nation's final **Peace Road plan** (attachment #2) and the **regional schedule table** (attachment #3) by May 5.
- 2) Report on results:** We ask each national headquarters to take photos and film the launching ceremony and views of participants following the Peace Road course. Please upload the

photos and videos of the event on our homepage ([www.peaceroad.net](http://www.peaceroad.net)).

**The original photos (twenty photos – ten on the launching and ten on the actual course), video and result report (attachment #4) must be submitted within three days of the completion of the course concerned.**

※ We plan to make an exhibition or video for the third anniversary of True Father's Universal Seonghwa (7.17 on the heavenly calendar, Cheongshim Peace World Center) out of all the photos and videos you send us.



#### **4. Reference details: Korean, Japanese and Taiwanese plan of execution**

- 1) Korea :** Form a team made up of Korean participants and international members that can partake in the course and then ride bikes from the mouth of Nakdong River in Busan to Imjingak (Aug 22 – 28, 653 kms)
- 2) Japan :** To express our hope that the Japanese-Korean tunnel be made, the Japanese team will ride bikes across the nation (3,500 kms) and then pass through the underwater tunnel site (Karatsu) – Iki Island – Daemado and arrive in Busan.
- 3) Taiwan :** Ride bikes across the country from Pingtung to Taipei (450 km)
