The Coronation Ceremony of True Parents as the King of World Peace Washington DC, December 13, 2004

The fourth World Summit was held at the Marriott Wardman Hotel on December 13, 2004. Here, leaders from around the world offered the Crown of Peace to True Parents. True Father delivered his speech, "Our Mission in the Last Days of Providential History" to more than 3,400 leaders from around the world. In this speech, he emphasized, "We have the heavenly fortune that enables us to establish God's home nation."

On December 15, 1990, 500 people attended the Kodiak Training Center Opening Ceremony. Flags of all nations were set up inside and outside of the church and snow was falling thickly. True Father called the building the World Training Center and also gave the name Angel Garden so the space could be used as a preschool. True Father would fish halibut and salmon almost every fall here.

Il Hwa Pharmaceutical Company Launching Ceremony December 16, 1971, Seoul, Korea

The launching ceremony for Il Hwa Pharmaceutical Company was held in Songjeong-dong Seongdong-gu Seoul on December 16, 1971 with a goal of taking responsibility for the health of all humankind through ginseng products. True Parents gave the nickname “the prince of all plants” to ginseng, and told the participants that it is a Korean treasure. Following the construction of a high-tech facility in August 1973, it achieved the grand goal of \$10 million only four years after its creation. Its name was changed in 1976 to Il Hwa Co. Ltd, and its main products include ginseng tea, ginseng extract, Sam Jung Ton, Ginseng Up, McCol, and Cheonyeon Cider. (Materials provided by the FFWPU History Compilation Committee)
