The Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP) in Korea held their 17th National Workshop for WFWP Leaders with the theme "WFWP's role for victory in VISION 2027." The three-day workshop was held from November 22–24 at Yong Pyong Resort.



In her welcoming speech on the first day, WFWP International President Julia H. Moon said, "During my four years as president of WFWP, I have always been grateful to the members of the Women's Federation who have been working actively."

You are truly filial daughters of True Parents and just like extensions of True Mother. Take pride in the amazing achievements that you have shown to True Parents and the Women's Federation over the past 30 years and become victorious women leaders in 2023 as you fully unite with True Parents!"



WFWP Korea President Choi Young-seon in her welcoming address urged: "Now, aligning with WFWP's founding vision as we mark our 30th anniversary and head toward VISION 2027, we must find women leaders who can join us and we must strive to nurture future talent. Let's gather our passion and bring victory in VISION 2027."



In her opening remarks, Korean Co-Chairman Kim Soo-yeon emphasized, "Although there are many difficulties in Japan, the elder sisters in Korea should strive to get along well with their younger sisters in Japan and unite completely as we attend True Parents." She continued, "In order to achieve the will by 2027 through various initiatives, the WFWP members in Korea and overseas must work together with one heart and one mind."

Following this, FFWPU International HQ General Director Yun Young-ho gave a special lecture on the theme "The Role of the Women's Federation in the Era of the Heavenly Unified Korea," explaining the special role of women based on their empathetic ability. Director-General Yun explained, "In a heavenly unified Korea and a heavenly unified world, interdependence, mutual prosperity and universal values are possible only through empathy. And the Women's Federation is at the center of this. This is the age of women. The unification of the Korean Peninsula will not be possible without women's empathy and women leaders. WFWP must play a pivotal role in the journey toward the establishment of a heavenly unified Korea and a heavenly unified world."

The following day, reports on activities in 2022 were offered by the five sub-regions of Korea and the Cheonwon special district, along with a report on global activities during the year, followed by a 2nd special lecture on capacity building education (improvement of speech and communication skills). The schedule for the final day featured a 3rd special lecture by Dr. Moon Byung-chul on "Unification: The Future of Inter-Korean Coexistence as Seen Through the European Peace Economy," which was followed by a report on plans for 2023, a report on WFWP's VISION 2027 strategy, and the closing ceremony.

In closing, WFWP Korea President Choi urged, "Let's become completely one with True Mother, who is leading us at the front line of the providence and let us all create miracles so that VISION 2027 will be not merely a dream, but a reality. This is a difficult time, but let's make it a time when we take hands and start again, moving forward together." The workshop concluded with a reading of closing remarks from WFWP International President Moon.
