
Topic: "Challenges and Prospects for Peace in the Holy Land: A Conversation during the Time of Covid 19"

Backgrounder: During this time of the coronavirus governments have their hands full addressing the immediate challenges that derive from Covid 19. And whereas these challenges are most forcefully felt by citizens and health care providers, the political and economic impact is equally enormous and widely felt. Recent "Peace Talks" have had focus on Africa, Europe, the USA and China.
