H.E. Jaime Paz Zamora

President of Bolivia (1989-93); Vice President of Bolivia (1982-84); oversaw Bolivia's cooperation with the inter-American War on Drugs; worked to roll back the neoliberal policies of his predecessor and presided over improvements in Bolivia's education, medical and general services; successfully negotiated the cession of a sovereign port for landlocked Bolivia on the Peruvian coast.



Hon. Newt Gingrich

Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives (1995-1999); House Majority Whip (1989-1995). These are two notable positions he held during his twenty-years as a United States Congressman from Georgia (1979-99); A co-author and architect of the "Contract with

America," Gingrich was a major leader in the Republican victory in the 1994 congressional election. In 1995, Time Magazine named him "Man of the Year" for "his role in ending the four-decades-long Democratic majority in the House."



Dr. Michael Jenkins

President, Universal Peace Federation International, Chairman, Washington Times Holdings LLC, owners of The Washington Times; and has has organized a number of Fact Finding trips to Northeast Asia and has led a number of briefings on Capitol Hill with U.S. Senators and Congressmen.
