

This webinar continues a conversation on ways for Faith Leaders to assist the world to shift to a culture of prevention that will save thousands of lives, protect millions of women and save hundreds of millions of children from violence. World leaders have committed at the UNGA to significant reductions in violence for Agenda 2030. Solutions that tackle the roots of violence have been proven to reduce violence by 50%. A few cities have achieved and sustained remarkable reductions in violent crime by pioneering offices for violent prevention that plan the use of science, consistent with resolutions promoted by governments at UNODC and UN Habitat. But even with public demonstrations over many years, the cultural shift is not easy from existing systems of criminal justice and punishment to investing in people and effective prevention. How can Faith Leaders use their influence to spread the word? How can Faith Leaders partner with UN agencies? How can Faith leaders partner with city leaders determined to achieve a world safer from violent crime?
