Children's Summit, 18.74 "The family has the primary responsibility for the nurturing and protection of children from infancy to adolescence. Introduction of children to the culture,

For the full and harmonious development of their personality, children should grow up in a family environment, in an atmosphere of happiness, love, and understanding. Accordingly, all institutions of society should respect and support the efforts of parents and other caregivers to nurture and care for children in a family environment.”
