Before the appointments, we showed an introductory video on UPF's leadership areas and "Think Tank 2022," which focuses on the reunification of Korea (2).



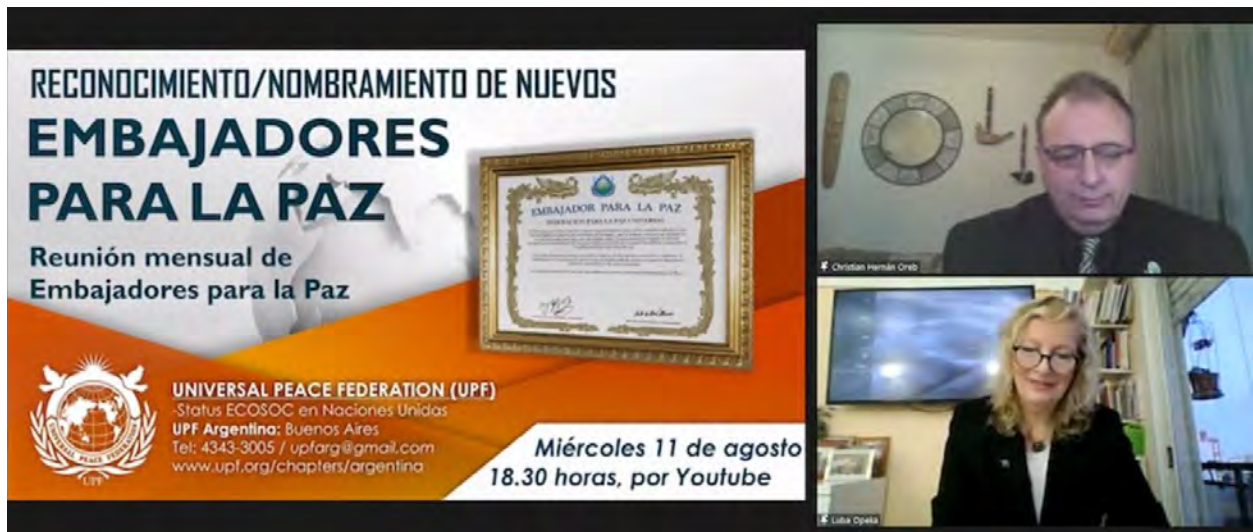
