The young pupils had been consistently wetting the beds, which caused the mattresses, bed sheets, and blankets to become old and worn out. Unfortunately, some of these beddings had even developed bed bugs, making them completely unusable. With 45 pupils staying with Teacher Jesca, her home urgently needed new bedding. Due to the lack of clean and suitable bedding, the pupils were forced to share the bedding.
