Welcome to 'The Victorious Gospel of True Parents' Session 2 'The True Daughter'

I'm your host Tyler Hendricks

She was told (as captioned)

"They say that you are going to get married tomorrow,' ...

She responded by saying, 'Is that so?'

She was like that. She did not oppose anything."
(Sun Myung Moon's Words)

Her parents, Seung-woon Han and Soon-ae Hong, married around 1934.

True Mother (Hak Ja Han) was born on Feb 10, 1943 (1.6 lunar) (nine years later) at her maternal grandparents' house, Shineui Village -- which is 18 miles from Father's hometown, on opposite sides of the same river.

Mother's Birth came after nine years of marriage. Her parents separated shortly afterwards. It is said that Her mother refused to have sex after her conception.

Mr. Han was a member of (a spirit-led but marginal Christian group, one that was expecting to receive the Messiah) Rev. Yong-do Lee's New Jesus Church.

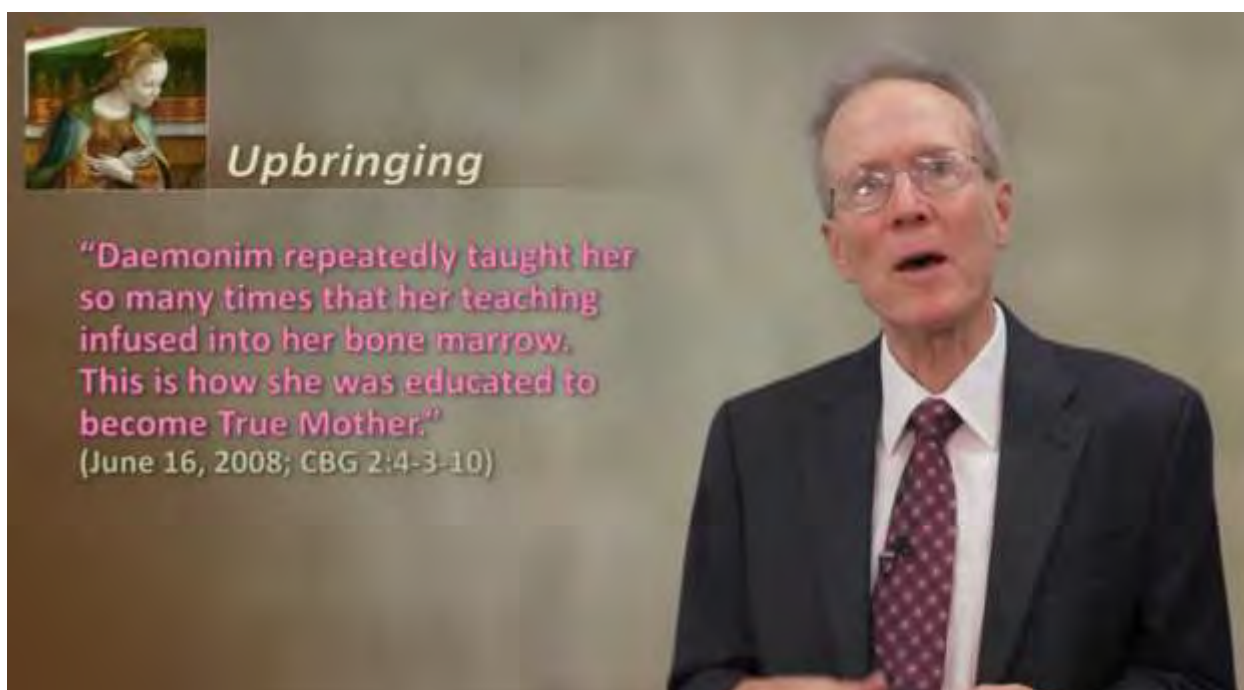
Mrs. Hong's course:

Mrs. Hong was raised a Presbyterian and she joined the New Jesus Church.

(It may have been because her husband belonged, or perhaps she had joined and met him there. In either case, she moved on to two more preparation churches: Seog-do Kim's Holy Lord Church and then Heo Ho-bin's Inside the Womb Church. She was, as I understand, the only surviving member of the Inside the Womb Church when she joined the Unification Church together with her daughter in Seoul.

Upbringing:

There were signs and prophecies of True Mother's calling from an early age, which I will not detail, but to mention, as a representative, that Ho-bin Heo's mother blessed True Mother, age 4, as "the one who will become the bride of Heaven."



The essence of the experience of True Mother in these spirit-led churches is what matters; and I will summarize True Father's Words on the subject:

Over and over again, she heard from her mother that the Lord will come in the future, and that when she meets him, she must attend him in this way and that.
(June 16, 2008, CBG 2:4-3-10)

Dae Mo Nim repeatedly taught her so many times that her teaching infused into her bone marrow. This is how She was educated to become True Mother.
(June 16, 2008; CBG 2:4-3-10)

So, if True Mother mentioned on some occasion that True Father did not educate her, She was just repeating his Words. Not to belabor the point, Father also said:

"Because of that old woman's faith and dedication, I chose her Daughter, who was in her second year at high school."
(Unless otherwise noted, citations from Today's World series on True Parents' course)

Here, 'that old woman' of course refers to Mrs. Hong, whom Father later named 'Dae Mo Nim' 'Great Mother'.

Further, Father knew the hardships Hak Ja Han faced growing up with a single mother in war-torn Korea, not just a single mother but one who was a devout follower of persecuted religious sects.

Father said:

"With care-givers devoted to church, she was not well clothed or fed, and was thereby trained to support those who devote 100% to the providence."

She knew persecution as a sect member.

It does not describe a happy childhood, but somehow this girl thrived in this setting, was very obedient to her mother and grandmother and inherited their devotion to God.

Mother graduated high school in 1959 and entered St. Joseph's Nursing School. Didn't True Father go back and visit schools that True Mother attended as a child?

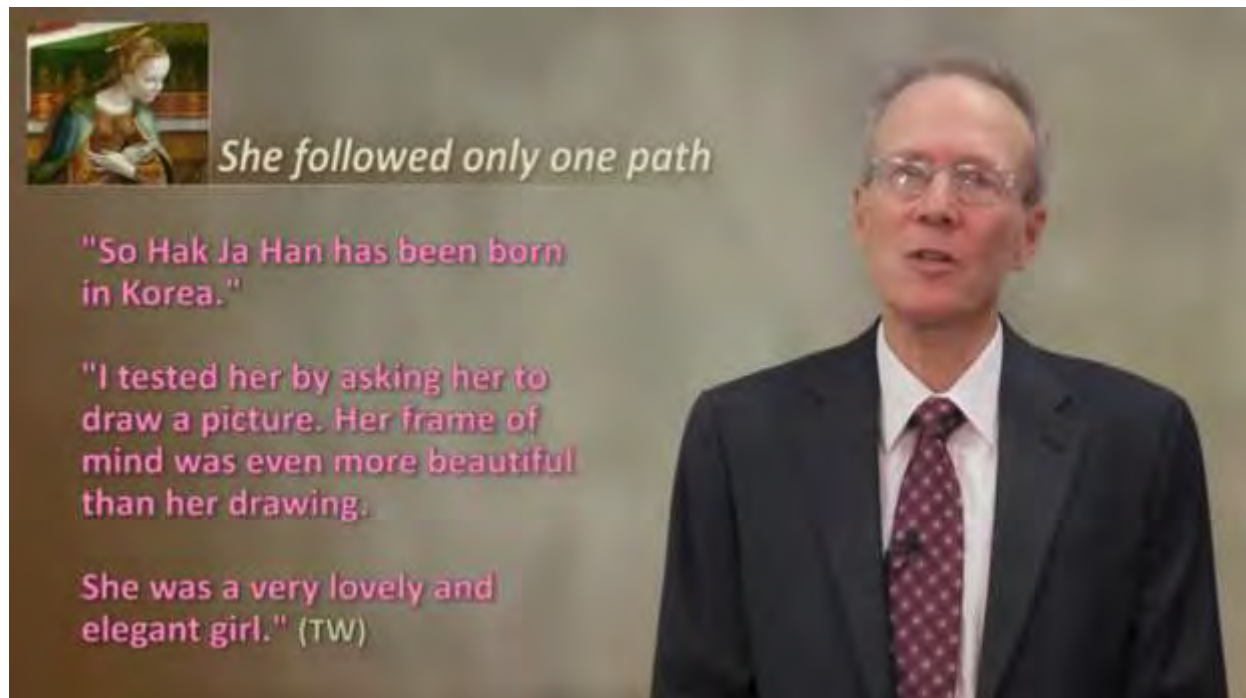
Didn't he provide generous grants to them? Is it just a coincidence that the property Father chose for UTS was built as St. Joseph's Normal Institute? I see a pattern here. Father always created meaning and he treasured True Mother.

At this time in her life, as she prepared to be a nurse, Heaven arranged for her to lead a life of divine isolation. She wanted never to marry but to enter a convent, plant an orchard and live there alone.

'She followed only one path'

Around this time her mother joined the Unification Church. One interesting thing made True Father notice Mrs. Hong's fourteen-year-old daughter. Father said,

"When she went to and from Chungpa-dong, she followed only one path. I watched her carefully...Seeing that she always followed the right path, I thought to Myself, Aha!"



This led to his meeting with the small family, at which time we know well that, without premeditation, closed his eyes and uttered the words,

"So, Hak Ja Han has been born in Korea."

He carried out, whether then or on other occasions, the wonderful meetings to learn about his young member of his small church.

"I tested her by asking her to draw a picture. Her frame of mind was even more beautiful than her drawing. She was a very lovely and elegant girl."

Would that we had that picture.

On another occasion, Father presented another reason for his choosing Hak Ja Han as his Bride: her hands.

"Though she looks docile, she has grit. You can see that right away when you see her hands. ... her hands are thick and bold."

He also harkened back to his observation of her approach to the Chungpa-dong Church each Sunday. He said,

"She doesn't waver... This is why I have chosen her as Mother."

In 1996, Father reflected more on the qualifications that Hak Ja Han met as the basis for his decision to call her to be his bride. Father said, "When Jesus returns to the earth in the flesh, the woman whom He takes as the Bride must meet the qualifications, as stipulated by the Principle to be the Bride.

"This requires that she knows all the contents of the heavenly way."

"It requires that she look forward to his coming and prepare to welcome him."

Father knew the enormity of his decision. For the woman he called would have a mission comparable only to his own, and in some ways, more difficult.

Father said:

"These are conditions she needs in order to prepare herself to establish the one God-centered family, nation and world. This is her responsibility as the Bride."
(CBG 1:1-2-4, 1966.03.22)

Why would I say 'in some ways more difficult'? Well, in this world, how difficult is it for a man to become the president of the United States? How about for a woman? In some ways, even more difficult.

As Father himself was prepared, God was preparing True Mother. Here's how she described it in Belvedere in 1977:

A month before the Holy Wedding, Father appeared to Me in a dream, and gave Me a special revelation from God: 'Be prepared, for that day is at hand.' More than a marriage proposal, it was a decree from Heaven. When I received that decree, I went completely beyond myself. I had to empty myself, because at that time, I did not have the ability to deal with such a monumental matter. All I could do was pray. I responded while ever keeping that revelation in mind, thinking, 'Oh God, I have been living in accordance with Your Will. I will follow and do whatever Your Will may be.

I was 17 years old, and it was sometime in February. I did not want to analyze the situation at that time because I was making internal preparations by emptying myself. I only wanted to follow God's Will.



The artwork here is that of Jesus' mother, Mary, prior to her call to do something really difficult, to offer her life to God, substantially to give birth to the Messiah. This illustrates both Mary's and Hak Ha Han's perfect submission to the Will of God and her role to give birth to the Messiah, for without a Bride, there is no True Parents.

What happened next is best related by True Father:

"When she was told 'Rev. Moon is calling you,' she said, 'Why? He does not know Me; why is he calling Me?'

She was told 'They say that you are going to get married tomorrow,'

She responded by saying, 'Is that so'

She was like that. She did not oppose anything."

What was True Father going through at this time? He had suffered imprisonment. He had two failures in finding the true Bride. He was serious and he offered even more sacrifice. True Father gave his bones and flesh to call the new Eve. He restored the course of Jesus by the sacrifice of his family. his prison course, his (crucifixion) prison course, building a movement of 120 churches, sending missions to Japan and the United States, he had gone through in Pyeong Yang the restoration of 8 stages, the 43-days battle in the spirit world, he raised up three core disciples who would give their lives for him, in 1957 he did a 40-day fast, and more.

Of course, Father had experienced one setback after another, but he never complained to God or to people. He saw in everything the hand of God.

In his Words:

"I underwent twenty-three years of ordeals to connect with what Heaven had prepared. I passed through all kinds of experiences, while living only on raw food."

This is figurative, of course, because most of the time Father was living on no food.

"Up to the end, however, I did not give up my core principles ... and thus laid the foundation whereon I could meet Mother."

What man can say that for forty years he did not give up his core principles? This was a condition to meet his Bride, who was born to be God's Bride (for whom Father lived with his core principles intact, and thus, Father said, 'I could meet True Mother.'

Concerning their Marriage:

The nation opposed it, the police opposed it, Christianity opposed it, his own church leaders opposed it, but True Mother did not waver. She had absolute faith in True Father. It means that she had absolute faith in God and in Herself, as she surely had absolute faith in her own mother.

In February 1960, the betrothal was announced; on March 27 (3.1 lunar) the engagement ceremony took place, and some two weeks later at 3 a.m. on April 11, 1960, the Wedding started.

Father had been released from a police station four hours earlier.

How would you feel if, the day before your daughter's wedding, you were told that her husband-to-be was dealing with problems with the police? Sure he's a wonderful man. he truly believes in God, but why are the police holding him late all night. Oh, did you hear? Twelve church leaders just resigned in opposition to this wedding. You know they were all professors. Did you hear? The government is investigating this church. Maybe he is stealing money ... Did you hear that all the Christian ministers are warning everyone that it is a sex cult. Your daughter is marrying the leader of a sex cult. And what are you facing? This man is the one who tells you that you are the be the Queen of Heaven and Earth, to govern the world, to lead Korea to glory, to build the kingdom on earth with this man who happens to be held in a police station on the night of his wedding.

Father said:

"The Wedding seemed very simple but it was a core event embracing everyone."

I see the mission of the husband to protect, liberate and glorify the wife, to create an unstained and beautiful Bride, who is the Queen of the world, based on her creative responsibility.

Father said:

"It is remarkable that this Adam, for whom God had waited six thousand years, came to earth and indemnified everything, and thus held the Holy Wedding in 1960."

This is what True Mother believed, and to this she dedicated her Life.

Mother's predestination:

(It is just like ours. This is straight out of the Divine Principle:)

Born into the chosen people;

Accomplishments of her ancestral line;

Being endowed with the requisite character;

Developing the necessary qualities during her early life;

Her time and place in God's Providence.

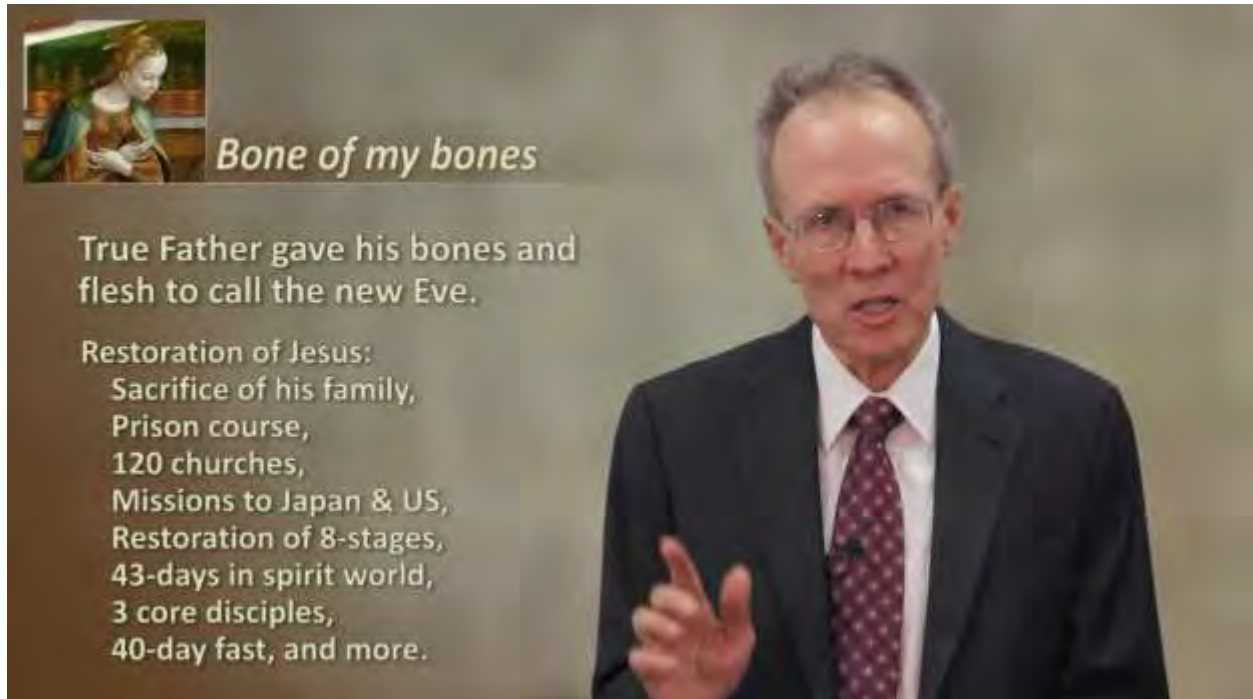
In Father's Words:

She was already "educated to become True Mother."

How to attend the Lord was "infused into her bone marrow."

She "looked forward to his Coming and prepared to welcome him" and when she met him, she had absolute faith in him.

I'm sorry to bring this up, but Father's first wife lacked faith in Father. His second wife lacked faith in herself.



How could God find the True Mother?

She had to be the 'bone of Father's bones, flesh of Father's flesh of Father's flesh, Hak Ja Han won the victory for God, for Father, for True Parents, for all humanity.

At age 17, Mother vowed, with True Father, to become True Parents of Heaven, Earth and all Humankind. This is impractical, implausible, and inconceivable.

I have a cousin-in-law who met the Church in 1957. The Principle answered all his questions; but, he could not conceive of joining. Why? Because Father's vision was too unrealistic. He couldn't believe all the grandiose visions that Father assured people would happen. Somehow, True Mother could believe it all, and accept co-responsibility with Father to achieve it.

At 17, Hak Ja Han gave her spirit and flesh, representing the world, so that Father could give life to the world through her.

In his last public speech, True Father revealed more of what Jesus told him at the very beginning. Jesus said,

"I came here today to go with you to join the marriage. I know it will be difficult for you but what do you think if you join me in being married? ...Elder Brother Yong Myung." He said to me, "Let's go to The Blessing Ceremony July 16, 2012 – Abel Women's UN Inauguration

At age 40, through the faith, love and obedience of this daughter of God, our Father could fulfill Jesus' request ... and begin to comfort the heart of Jesus, and of God, who never had a Bride. True Mother received the crown, and never took it off.
