Summer greetings!

I would like to invite you to support an issue that is very close to our hearts, with regard to a longstanding injustice toward our co-founder the Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon, which we would like to take a small step toward rectifying and healing;

As you might know, our WFWP co-founders, Rev. Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, came to the United States in the early 1970s, obeying a calling from God to remind Americans of their founding principles and morals, and to reawaken them to the need to practice them. They could already foresee the danger of America losing her moral fiber altogether, as drug and alcohol abuse, licentious behavior, and family breakdown were already rapidly rising back then.

Father and Mother Moon therefore invested all their efforts, prayers, tears, and resources into awakening America, even in the face of massive persecution, misunderstanding, and rejection. This opposition culminated in an unjust imprisonment of Father Moon in federal prison in Danbury, Connecticut on preposterous and bigotry-based charges of tax evasion.
