Dear esteemed member of WFWP USA,

We are pleased to offer a number of exciting opportunities to you during this year's Commission on the Status of Women UN events which is taking place in New York City from March 14th to March 24th.

In addition to the events listed below, we would like to announce that as of today we have established a **scholarship for 3 young women (ages 18-28) to receive UN Grounds passes** during the 2 week CSW sessions. These women would be able to stay at a nearby dorm. This scholarship is for any young women who would be able to stay for at least 3 days, preferably at the beginning of the CSW events, and be able to attend the WFWP International Parallel event and dinner on Tuesday March 15th.
