CSW Background

CSW stands for the UN Commission on the Status of Women, which was established in 1946, and is the principal global intergovernmental body dedicated to the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of women.

In 2016, CSW will hold its 60th Session, from Monday, March 14 - Thursday, March 24, with the theme, "Women's Empowerment and its Link to Sustainable Development." CSW is attended by representatives of UN member states, civil society organizations and UN entities. Thousands of women and men travel to New York from around the world, to attend hundreds of events that are held in the UN, as well as in venues throughout New York City. WFWPI has been actively engaged in CSW since 2003.
