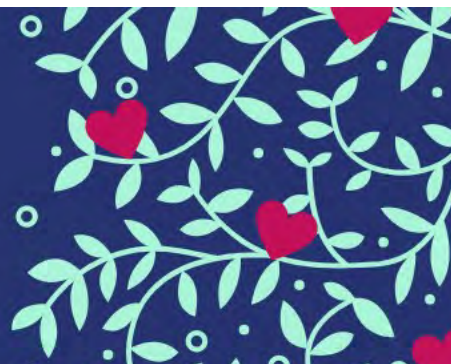

The WFWP USA "Schools of Africa" project supports 9 schools in 8 African countries.

Each year, WFWP chapters across the country hold dynamic and creative fundraisers for the Schools of Africa. Fundraising events may take the form of tag sales, silent auction galas, or luncheons that celebrate African food and culture.

**Since 2001, thanks to generous donors, WFWP USA has sent over \$430,000 to the schools.**

This invaluable support has helped the schools purchase critical materials for lessons and provide scholarships to impoverished students.
