The Beijing Platform for Action of 1995 set the first formal global goals for advancing women's rights. This platform covers 12 critical areas of concern: poverty, education and training, health, violence against women, armed conflict, economy, power and decision making, institutional mechanisms, human rights, media, environment, and the girl child. The United Nations Commission on the Status of Women, a functional commission of the Economic and Social Council established in 1946, brings together government, civil society, and the public to discuss how to transform the promises of the Platform for Action into concrete changes in individual countries.

The theme of discussion this year was to ensure that social protection, public services, and sustainable infrastructure meet the needs of young people and advance gender equality.
