X This is a chart with the standard dates for observing important Church events according to the heavenly calendar. The dates are based on True Parents' words.

- 1. True Parents' Birthday (6th day of the 1st month of the heavenly calendar) shall be celebrated on the 1st day of the 1st month of the heavenly calendar.
- 2. Coronation Ceremony for the Kingship of God will be celebrated either on the 1st day or the 3rd day of the 1st month of the heavenly calendar depending on True Parents' decision.
- 3. Settlement of Eight Stages (Paljeongshik) (31st day of the 8th month does not exist on the lunar calendar) will be celebrated on the 29th day of the 8th month of the heavenly calendar.
- 4. Hansik will be celebrated on April 6, 2011 on the Gregorian calendar according to the social norm in Korea.
