In this <u>sermon</u> on "Freedom and Responsibility" Hyung Jin Nim explores how the original fight for women's equality and right to vote has been co-opted by a Radical Feminism which portrays women as helpless victims oppressed by a "patriarchy," posing ever increasing government as the solution to problems it has enabled.

<u>Are women in America "oppressed" by a patriarchy?</u> Hyung Jin Nim examines the evidence:

* Children have an 8 times greater risk to be beaten or abused in

single mother families;

- * Since women live 5 years longer than men, they receive 5 years more social security benefits, even though men pay 60% of social security taxes;
- * Men pay 63% of Medicare taxes, but receive 44% of Medicare health care benefits;



- * 75% of chronic homeless are men;
- * 77% of homicide victims are men;
- * 97% of American combat deaths are men;
- * 79% of suicides are by men;
- * Criminal sentencing for men is 63% greater for the same crimes and history;
- * Women are twice as likely to avoid incarceration for the same crimes;
- * 6 in 10 college students are women;
- * Research on STEM (Science/Technology/Engineering/Math) field employment found that <u>female applicants were twice as likely to be hired</u>.

These are hardly evidence that women are being oppressed by men. Most men, especially those who are married husbands, are working hard to support, protect and take care of their families and communities.

Hyung Jin Nim also discussed how <u>feminist bias in family courts</u> in the U.S., the UK and other western democracies has led to a presumption that fathers are always guilty of abuse. Far from being patriarchies, these countries have become government-enforced matriarchies which justify their bias by anti-male social conditioning, which unfortunately aligns with the new theology coming from the current FFWPU.



Yeonah Nim shared that the Divine Principle teaching that Eve was the first to fall is an expression of *God's love for women*. Since criminals, as cowards, will always choose the weaker target, Lucifer naturally manipulated and targeted Eve first. Instead of blaming men for their problems, "true women" are empowered through their Savior, Christ, who comes as the True Adam, and who transforms men from abusive, self-seeking archangels into sons of God.
