
John explained about his matching to Madeline. He had asked Father to be matched to a Japanese sister and was disappointed when Father matched him to Madeline. But when she explained about a dream she'd had four months earlier about him

unbuckling her blouse and her angry response to stop him until he said, "But I'm your husband!" And her response, "Then, I must be your wife." Of the 4,000 people Father was matching, he picked the one sister who had dreamed 4 months earlier that he would be her husband."


After John's testimony Hyung Jin Nim explained, "Father said the last providential organization to be established would be the headquarters for the unity of the physical world and spirit world, so we are living in that time! Madeline is now more powerful, so watch out!"



He went on to discuss the scriptures from Matthew 19, saying, we've been looking at the parables of Jesus in the context of the Kingdom that God wishes to establish. In the Cheon Il Guk Constitution, Principle I is to Maintain the Pure Lineage of God.

Consequently, they could never take the subject position in terms of perpetuating their lineage. In Cheon Il Guk, government officials are prevented by the Constitution from taking excessive power. There are limits on taxation, spending, etc.

In Cheon Il Guk, citizens have the rights of Kings to own land and exercise sovereignty. Lucifer was a servant who was not supposed

to take the subject position. A politician in Cheon Il Guk must understand that he will never be the subject over his people, that he must serve them. In this context, eunuch = servant, politician who remains in his proper position.



In the Roman empire, you become wealthy by being part of the oligarchy. Oligarchs do not give up their power easily, do not want to see middle class flourishing in an economy has truly free competition. Hyung Jin Nim continued to examine Matthew 19:16-22, where Jesus spoke to the rich young man who was virtuous in many ways, but who could not bear to give up his wealth. This young man must have part of the elite oligarchy. Sadly, many FFWPU leaders fell into the same

trap. They could not give up their positions to unite with the successor that Father anointed. The 36 couples valued money more than obeying the will of the Messiah. As it says in the Bible, the first shall be last, and the last shall be first.
