Mary Magdalene came from Magdala, a coastal city with a pagan tradition alongside its Jewish one. In the Greco-Roman world there was the common practice of teachers having sex with their male students, since they saw women as dirty because of monthly menstrual bleeding. Such homosexual sex with boys was used as a method of control to break down the independence of young men.
