

## 2017.12.24 ~ Kingdom Right of Defense ~ Rev. Hyung Jin Moon ~ Newfoundland, PA

Now, it's interesting, I was listening to Lt. Colonel Grossman. He was saying, even in the churches are becoming soft targets for various radical groups. Pennsylvania just got hit with another Islamic terrorist attack in Harrisburg. A gunman tried to kill a whole bunch of cops, and that was on Friday; so, Lt. Colonel Grossman said, "Even though we're praying, you keep your eyes lifted to God; but, you keep them open." That's important. There's nothing in the Bible, where you must close your eyes, when you pray, or you go to hell; so, some sheepdog must be awake when you pray. Even in the prayers, you got to have your eyes open and keeping vigil. That's important.

Alright Folks, the world is celebrating Santa Claus and pine trees, and we know it's not the birthday of Jesus; but, we do know, historically, where this is the time when many Christians were killed. If you would worship Christ, it was illegal in the first second or third centuries, and so, Christians had to worship as the Mithras cults, worshipping the Sun god, and all this kind of thing, and that was the Winter Solstice and the shortest days, whatever; so, they had to worship along with that. Then, of course, they need to pretend that they were worshipping Mithras; but, in their heart, they were worshipping Jesus. We have to keep that in mind this Christmas season, even though it is a time to remember early Christianity and the birth of Christ, which is closer to February and early Spring. As the Bible says, the shepherds were outside tending to the flock overnight; so, that only happens when the sheep are having babies, and that only happens in the Spring. So, that lines up with the Jewish holy days. That lines up with Father's birthday in late February, early March, okay; but, at the same time, we can still remember, this time is a time where early Christians are very persecuted, very persecuted in the early centuries, okay.

Now, all those other pine trees, whatever, the wreaths and mistletoes, that's all pagan. Santa Claus, stars on trees, and all that kind of stuff, this was all all from the Roman festivities. Saturnalia festivities that surrounded around Mithras. Their Roman cult was the Saturn god. There was actually one week celebration in the Roman Empire; and, you would exchange gifts, and you would do all this kind of stuff that we now associate with Christmas; so, we all have to be able to parse these things well in the modern world.

How many enjoyed that video by Bill Whittle last week? The US has 90 guns per 100 residents, okay. You work through the liberal lunatic logic. If that's true that if guns are a problem, this would be the murder capital of the world, because we have by far the most guns, by far the most. Double than the second or third countries that come right after it. 90 guns per 100 residents. Isn't that amazing? That's a lot of guns, okay; so, we should be murder capital number one; but, what was murder capital number one? It was Honduras. It's the Communist nation of Honduras, folks, followed by the Communist nation of Venezuela, etc; so, the US, of course, with the 90 guns per 100 residents, we should be, according to liberal logic, we should be the murder capital of the world. We're not even in the top ten.

We're not even in the top 20. We're not even in the top 30, folks. We're not even in the top 40, not even in the top 50, alright; so, we're not in the top 60, we're not in the top 70, not in the top 80, not even in the top 90 as well. Not even in the top 100. Not even in the top 100 murder capitals of the world. Not even in the 110. Isn't that amazing? If the lunatic logic was right, we would have to be uno numero, because we by far have the most guns in the hands of citizens; but, of course, we are the 111th; and, if you take out the liberal controlled operated cities, which have way higher murder rates, because they don't allow citizens to defend themselves, the US in such places as Plano, TX, we would be right at the end, the bottom of the list of the two hundred plus nations.

When you have armed citizenry, you don't have criminals running a mock thinking they can push people around and do stupid stupid stuff; and, that's why in the Kingdom of Cheon Il Guk, you have the Crown and the Rod of Iron. Then, we have shot shows, then we're in the desert, all this kind of crazy stuff So, it's going to be a crazy couple of months; but, we have some wonderful Speakers that will be preparing for the Conference. As I mention, Mr. Larry Pratt will be coming. His contact, a gentleman from Slovakia will be coming. Also, we have some other Speakers. We'll give you the whole schedule.

This is why our founding fathers left Europe to come here. It's like you can't even be part of a hunting club and talk about the right of self-defense. I mean, how is an older person, a senior citizen, a grandma or grandpa who lives alone, how are they going to defend themselves against some intruders? I mean, what are they going to do? What are they going to do? This is, of course, if you talk about violence and violent attackers, unless you're trained in combat arts, you don't know what it means to be violently controlled. You just don't know; and, all the girls that are trained here. They realize the aspect of violence, okay, and how you're lied to in the

media with "Charlie's Angels" and all these 90 lbs beating up enemy fighters. Girls, that ain't happenin'. Trust me, it ain't happenin'. You try fighting them, you're going to be in big trouble. Big trouble. So, when you learn the real combat arts, you get realistic, you know, you really confront reality. That's why it's a great device to break people out of the delusion, and to understand, people are much more underprepared than we thought. Much more underprepared, okay. I mean, some of the toughest girls, they can beat up normal boys that are untrained. They can probably beat up normal men at this stage who are untrained. It's not going to be easy. Trust me, it's not going to be easy; but, still the girls, even the tougher girls, and I make them go with the weaker boys. They are completely dominated, and they see very quickly how even a small boy, you walk by and think he's a little wimp, he totally dominates you, let alone a big guy like 250 and trained. Holy shemita. That's a whole different animal. So, this is of course is the lie.

I'm going to show you a clip from John Lovell, who's an amazing tactician instructor. He trains in Brazilian Jiu Jitsu as well. He taught it in college. He's also an Army Ranger, special forces guy. Awesome. Amazing Christian. A man of God. I'd love to get him up here; or, we go there, and train with him in Georgia. He does seminars all over the country. I'd love to train with that guy. Boy, he is such a man of God. He's like philosophically smart. He's a philosopher as well; so, he knows all apologetics. I mean, the guy is a real philosopher as well. I love it. Absolutely fantastic patriot, and just an incredible person. He may be in his early thirties. I'm not sure. A handsome young fellow with a beard, you know. He's a nice fellow.

He says, if you walk around with a false sense of security, you're putting yourself at risk; and, people who get suck up by the propaganda of feminism, which is a complete lie. they walk around with a false sense of security, even though they're not indoctrinated with it. Most girls are, in the West; but, even though you're not, just by watching the movies - I don't know. I don't watch these stupid movies - anyways, she pinning up this grown man with these six inch stiletto heels up against the wall, with one foot on his wrist. The guys standing there in the movie completely immobilized by this little stiletto heel on his wrist. Now, if you understand anything about body mechanics, and anything about reality, first of all the whole weight distribution is on that one point heels. All you have to do is tap that angle, and it will snap, because you are standing up like that, let alone if you want to keep somebody against the wall, even a grown man. You have to lean up into that person at least 45 degrees, even you have to lean up into him. You're not going to be standing up on one foot, keeping his body like that. You're not going to be able to do that. You see how unbalanced you are on that one foot? Give me a break. Ridiculous. Let alone, the girl she's ninety pounds. You see me lifting up the Queen with one arm, right, when we do the pickups. She's a hundred pounds.

They just have no idea, no idea how much that's a danger to indoctrinate women to believe that, because they have no sense of reality; and, of course, that's puts them into danger of being attacked or assaulted. This is also the danger of martial arts that don't deal in combat arts. They're teaching their students things that are not going to happen in real combat. This was the problem with Karate and Taekwondo, and all those kinds of things. Recently, Jiu Jitsu just came on the scene. It really challenged all of them. That's right, anybody challenged us, you fight bare

knuckle, and they defeated everybody, because the traditional martial arts like Kung Fu, all the fancy smancy Tai Chi, all this kind of stuff, it doesn't work in real combat. The big video I showed a couple of times with that Tai Chi Chuan guy in China. He's got Tai Chi Chuan, and you got an MMA fighter, remember, and he's on the floor beating him up. He just used simple boxing on him.

So, the movie's a complete lie, and it's complete fakery. It's totally fake; and, of course, that's a danger to actual people, who are actually learning that, and actually believe they can actually defend themselves. I'll get somebody big like John Clark. What is he, two something, and he may be 59 years old. Do you see how strong he is? Somebody who has done construction his whole life. See, even guys don't realize that. Even boys, who don't do the arts of fighting, don't realize how strong elder men can be, who, for example have done construction. They don't have to have like these big water muscles. They don't have these big bulbist muscles that are filled with water and steroids that burn out after about five minutes, okay. They have muscles that they are using all day long lifting cords, lifting up big blocks of cinder. These guys are very strong.

That's why a lot of MMA fighters are actually doing construction work on the side. That's how they get strong, because that core gets built up moving rocks, and moving stuff like that, just to supplement their training. They may not look huge, they may not look like Sylvester Stallone, or these guys in Hollywood that look all big. It has nothing to do with your ability to fight. We have so much misconception, we have so much misinformation; and, this is a dangerous to people, because people can learn things, which are stupid. Completely stupid; and, they do not work in real application, okay. That's why the advent of Brazilian Jiu Jitsu, MMA, and stuff like that, is a great, great, great, great, great fantastic reality checker on the whole commercialized community of anybody taking combat art, because it shows the reality. It shows the reality. It's not just how you look. It's not just how formidable your muscles are. You know what I mean? And, of course, the girls who fight MMA, stuff like that, they're tough. They can beat up normal untrained boys, easy; but, can they beat a trained MMA men? No. No. No, no, no!

So, this is the reality of combat. What, you have this crazy transgender guy, who is a man, who says he's a woman. He can actually fight against women, and he's slaughtering them; but, he says he's a guy. So, it's a man, who says he's a woman, and now he's stealing the championship away from the women, even though he's a dude, with eleven times the testosterone, which is a natural steroid, by the way; and, he's slaughtering the girls, plummeling their faces in. That's unfair.

There's a reason why, at the highest levels, you don't let them even compete with the women, because on average, women are less physically strong; and, so if you don't have the reality, you still live in LaLa Land reality. You need to go to a fight dojo and test your ego. You need to do it. It's probably the healthiest experience you'll ever have to be dominated by another human being. Completely dominated, and feel utterly hopeless. Utterly hopeless, right. I mean, these guys are big guys. We have some very large guys; but, even trained people who are smaller, you can see how they can get away from your bigness, right, and they can get on top of you.

Somehow, they can get on top of you and strangle you, somehow. You guys can experience that. We do this in a safe place, and I make sure nobody gets hurt, stuff like that; but, it's important to have this reality check. It's very important. Without that, there's a real danger of being misinformed, believing something in terms of our ability to defend ourselves that may be completely false, okay.

So, that's why in the community the BJJ becomes a wonderful tool. The girls, you girls got a lot stronger. You girls got a lot tougher, now. A lot more dangerous. You are learning a lethal force; but, of course, that's why we train weapons as well, cause weapons are important force multipliers, they're force multiplication; and, they give you power you otherwise, physically, you may not have, okay.

So, this is what's so important to understand about training. We're going to get into a little bit of the philosophy of the mindset, okay, In Matthew 6, and this is a famous one right here. This is the one where we did the Kingdom Scriptures; and, we went through all the Scriptures, and we saw very clearly, when he described the Gospel, he did not describe it as his crucifixion. Not once, in the Bible, did Jesus describe the Gospel as his crucifixion, death and resurrection. Not once. In fact, Jesus described his Gospel as the Gospel of the Kingdom of God. He's talking about a Kingdom. The Gospel of the "Good News" is about a Kingdom, okay. It's about a Kingdom.

So, let's read this real quick. Let's actually jump down here to 31.

**Matthew 6:31. Therefore, take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? Or, What shall we drink? Or, wherewithal shall we be clothed 32 (For after all these things the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that you have need of all these things. 33 But seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and, all these things shall be added unto you.**

Now, this is very important, when we talk about Christmas. We're talking about a life. Well, we're supposed to be talking about the life and birth of Jesus, even though it isn't. We just mentioned it about a million times, okay. This is a Mithras cult, Winter Solstice. They would be killed, if they worshipped Jesus, okay; so, they had to worship in secret, with the Romans, at the Mithras cult, in case you didn't hear that. That's why Christmas had become celebrated on December 25th, etc. It has nothing to do with Jesus' birthday. He's born closer to the Spring, according to the Bible, early Spring is when the shepherds are out with the lambs all night long. There's only one time of the year they do that. It's when the lambs are having babies; and, that is in early Spring and late Winter, and lambs only have babies once a year, and they have it at that time; and, the shepherd has to go out, because the wolves are out at that time, because they're easy prey. The babies come out, and the wolves come eat them; so, shepherds have to guard them at that time; so, according to the Bible, Jesus was born later, okay; but, since it's commonplace in the Western world, and at least now in the rest of the world that Christmas is supposed to be the time about celebrating the birth of Christ, even though it's more about Santa

Claus, and Christmas trees, and all that kind of stuff, which is pagan stuff. Pagan accoutrements that have been added in through the years, okay.

But, while we are celebrating the birth of Christ, he gives his life for the sake of the world and salvation. He talks about the greatest love is he who will lay his life down for his friends, just as Jesus did. (John 15:13) It wasn't the course, it wasn't the best course, but it was a course that God did use, and of course to bring spiritual salvation; but, could it bring physical salvation or the physical Kingdom? No. That's why he said he would come back. He said, that's why I'll come back. Pray everyday, thy Kingdom come, thy will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, etc, etc, etc.

So, we talked about this a billion times. God's Kingdom has to come. If you are Christian, you must believe that God's Kingdom will come to the Earth. You must. You can't get around it. As we look looked at the Scripture last time. We looked at Psalm 2, and Revelation 2, 12 and 19. Those are ways in Jesus will rule when he returns, which is with the Crown and the Rod of Iron. The Rod of Iron. So, if you are a Christian, again, you can't get around that. Can't get around it. Jesus will return. He will establish the eternal Kingdom; and, Christ will rule with the Rod of Iron, as the Bible says in Psalm 2, etc, and in Revelation 2 as well. He will smite the nations of the Earth, and smash them as a potter's vessel.

There's going to be some power and violence, when Christ returns, okay. Violence is not always bad, as we are taught and brainwashed in school as ridiculous. Learning about violence, and learning to control violence is very important. That's who you learn how to defend yourself. You learn the power of violence against somebody who's trying to use violence, who is violently attack you, and somebody who is vulnerable; so, the knowledge of violence, and the control of violence, and the dominion over another word for that, force, is a very important responsibility; and, good people should definitely have control over that responsibility, because good people are not the pathological predators that want to rule and dominate people. They don't want to do that. They instinctually just want to protect people. They don't actively want to go out and prey on people, or prey on weakness. When they see somebody weaker, they feel sorry for them, and they want to build them up and make them stronger. A normal person would do that. That's a normal person.

We know, about ten percent of the population is psychopathic. That sees weakness and says, "Ooh, I'm going to capitalize on that weakness and prey." That would be the criminal class, etc. Then, you have the sociopathic class that Sociologist say some forty percent could become sociopathic. That is, they will go along with the psychopaths, and the predatory class, if they can get benefits; so, this is what you would call the good Nazis; or, people would go along with something, which they know is wrong, but they get a pension, they get benefits, they get all of that. All those things are promised to them, but then they get taken away; but, they're the ones to be first lined up and killed, if you look at the historical records.

And then you have the rest of the population, which is about fifty percent, which don't have those tendencies, and don't want to either follow somebody, who they know is psychopathic for

benefits; or, they themselves who are not psychopathic. They're just normal people, who want to work hard. They want to get on with their life, okay.

So, these are sort of the sociological breakdown of civilization, the populations; and, in the Kingdom, it's very important that good people have power. Very, very important. When there is a disparity of power, a vacuum arises, and predators flood in; so, when you have centralized power, and you have any state, any representation of government that will centralize power, then you'll have the predators of the civilization go to that power, because they are attracted to that power, because they want the power. They'll be magnetized towards that centralized power, eventually be taking it over, and using that to virtually signal and morally posture, but really to genocide their opponents.

Okay, you look at Stalin, Hitler, Mao Zedong. Now, we're getting Kim Jong Un, all this stuff; it's the same deal, it's the same thing, okay. The Democrat Party in America, which is basically a Communist Party, is really no different. They want centralized military, centralized law enforcement. They want centralized banking, they want centralized education, they want centralized health care, they want centralized welfare. It's the exactly Communism, okay. All the planks of Marxism are sitting right there, all in it; and, of course, you have the neocons, which are the fake Republicans on the right side, which are in cooperation with the Communist left, colluding, doing this little show, you know, right vs. left, so everybody thinks we have a choice, when it's not the fact.

Trump represents something different in that power structure, even though he's not perfect. He's bombastic, he's insulting to people, etc. He's just like that Jehu the Warrior, we talked about a couple of weeks ago. He fights with everybody. He's bombastic, he crass, he's rough around the edges; but, God uses him. God uses him. You can have the slickest demon, and you know Satan is using him; but, God will sometimes use a crass, bombastic person to get through, to start breaking and shattering the status quo, and political correctness, you name it.

But, what is the reason why populist side of Trump, or the Trump revolution spreading to places like Europe as well, where now Eastern Europe is actually saying, "Hey, we want gun rights." We are gonna go to the conference in Switzerland, and we're going to be talking about gun rights in Europe. European people, what makes them less than Americans. They, too, should have rights to have the right of self-defense; so, that their rulers and their lords and overlords cannot rule over them. That's literally illegal to talk about in Europe. Not in Poland. Poland is changing; so, Eastern Europe has always been the historical buffer zone between Islamic invasion, you name it; so, they're a little more realistic; but, the Western Europe, oh boy, they are in LaLa Land. Always protected. The oceans on one side. They're protected by Eastern Europe on the other side.

So, they are just literally Communist, a Commie haven over other. So, we're going over there with Mr. Larry Pratt, the Director Emeritus of Gun Owners of America, telling them about the history of guns in America. Telling them the real statistics. When good people are armed, crime goes down. Criminals are scared. If you are a criminal, and you try to walk into somebody's

house, and you know everybody in this little neighborhood, we have one of the lowest homicide rates in the world here, cause everybody, and their mama has a shotgun and an AR15 here; so, you walk into a nursing home, Grandma's going to pull out a shotgun and get you. Okay, you better watch out. The criminals know, you can't be stupid over here. If they want to live another day to enjoy the fruits of their stealing, they better not steal here, okay. So, that is so common sense. It's ridiculous. It's so sad how people are so indoctrinated and brainwashed by their professors and public school teachers, etc, even though all public teacher are not bad or anything; but, they are officials, they are official teachers of the state. They have to teach Common Core, they have to teach things you may disagree with; but, they have to teach it.

So, we see here in **Matthew 6:33 Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness.** Jesus was talking about the Gospel, he talked about the Kingdom of God. I've shown you billions of times all the Scripture, where it says the Gospel is the Kingdom of God. The Gospel is go preach to the nations. The Gospel is the Kingdom of God. Just over and over and over, okay; so, Christ is talking about his Kingdom. **Seek ye first the Kingdom, seek ye first the Kingdom and his righteousness. Now,** righteousness is very important in the Kingdom. It's absolutely critical. God says, seek ye first His Kingdom and righteousness, because it's very interesting. Isn't it interesting?

Force must also have an ethic of love, did you know that? The dominion of violence must also paradoxically have an ethic of love and/or compassion, whatever you want to call it. Traditionally, compassion would mean with suffering. Suffering with the actual breakdown of the etymological breakdown of the word; but, it has to have an ethic of love. If you are only trying to use force, or to study force, or to learn about force, or to have dominion over force for no other purpose other than power, or acquisition of resources, or increasing ones stature, whatever, you are pursuing then something that could become evil, very wicked; and, that's why the dominion of defense, of self-defense too, has to be connected with an ethic of love. It has to be. Absolutely critical. In fact, it's not only critical, let's take a look at this video.

This is John Lovell, ex Green Beret. I guess you're never an ex-Green Beret. You're capable of fighting tomorrow, if he wants to, do you know what I mean? He's Green Beret, Army Ranger, and Special Forces. Multiple deployments around the world, but awesome. He has the "Warrior Poet Society" as his organization. He trains people all over the country. We gotta get him, folks. We gotta get John Lovell up here. He's fantastic. I want to train with him so bad. He'll be at a gun show. Maybe, we'll have a chance to have an interview with him. Will see. We'll try to scout him down and talk to him. But a fantastic fella. Let's check out. Listen to what he says about this? Go ahead:

(John Lovell spoke deeply and philosophically whether a person has nothing to lose in battle. A person who has nothing lose may have nothing to fight for.)

And, that is Master John Lovell. Awesome, awesome young man. But again, he's talking about that ethic. The whole desire and motivation to want to train and get better, and to want to become stronger, and harder to dominate, and harder to kill, etc. This is common in the gun



community. The desire for that is not just to be badass, right. It's not just to intimidate people. That's not the right motivation. I'm telling peace Ninjas all the time, "Look, I'm training you guys not in the dangerous arts, these lethal arts, not so you can go some accolades, and just fulfilling your dreams, and desires, and your fulfillment of your ego." I want to win a U of C Belt, this or that. You know what, who gives a crap about that stuff? I trained with people in the U of C. I trained with people, who are top Jiu Jitsu world champions; but, guess what? When they're 30, 40, 50 years old, nobody remembers what they did, did you know that? When you're sixty-seven years old, nobody remembers. Maybe, the people in that community may remember; but, generally, people don't even know who they are. So, it's hyped up to be a lot; but, I mean, in the end, really, a lot of them, you know, unfortunately, if they get too addicted to that, that dopamine high of only feeling value when they have their belt around, or they won the belt, this or that. They'll quickly collapse and degrade over time very fast. Drugs, alcohol. They'll start coping with these dangerous things. You've seen many stars or athletes fall down in that way, haven't you?

So, this is a very important thing. What is the motivation by which we're trained, and what is the motivation by which we live a lifestyle, which part of that is obviously trying to be healthy, and fit, and strong, and hard to dominate, etc. Things like that; but, what is the purpose of this? Not just to be tough. It's not just to be cool, or know how to use a cool weapon, or something like that. It's not for that purpose. I always ask the kids, I always tell them, "Look, you guys didn't know I knew how to do this stuff. Did I ever show this stuff off? No." Most people don't know. I had to bring it out, cause Father made me bring it out; and, I had to be in a position, where I had to teach kids, or stuff like that; but, most people don't know that I know these arts, okay, and that's a good thing; so, I tell them, "Look, if you want to train in these things, remember, you don't want to give all your secrets to the enemy." That's not part of being a responsible person that's hard to be controlled, that's hard to be dominated. You don't just give up all your secrets. I mean, you don't just go off and flash off in front of people. This is not the part of this culture. It's okay if you want to do that, and you want to get this medal, if you want get something. Okay, so what; but, in the end, trust me, that's not going to be anything that gives you value. It's really not. What's going to give you the value, and the desire and the joy of being a powerful person is why we train. Love God/Love your neighbor.

Actualized the Commandments that Jesus condensed, when the Pharisees asked him, what are the Commandments of Moses, etc. He just said, 'Love God with all your strength, mind and soul (Deut. 6:5) and love your neighbor as you love yourself. (Leviticus 19:18) Be willing to protect your neighbor. Very Simple. So, the hardcore central impetus of peace police/ peace militia training is to the actualization of Christian ethic, which is love God / love your neighbor. So, it's not only about that. I was talking to the Queen the other day, and she said, you should tell the kids to love God and love your neighbor. Oh no, I don't want that, because they may think their neighbor is God. They, themselves, also have to think, love God / love your neighbor. Don't forget the first part. It's critical. It's the reason why you love your neighbor, you understand?

But, this ethic of love, that is the thing that actually keeps you excited. Passionate. Passionate. It keeps you passionate about being a somebody, who has better means than the normal person, more means than the normal person, more skill than the normal person to be able to

protect people, who are innocent, if you have to. Remember, nothing is guaranteed. You know, you could do all that training, and get shot in the head, your dead. Right? Everybody knows that in the reality of basic martial arts. Everybody knows, you get one cut, and that's why they bring the DLA, and you just slash it one time, boom! You guys saw how deep those cuts are. You get cut once like that, you're dead. Sorry, you're dead. It's a game of percentages; and, we want to put the percentages in favor of the good people; and, the percentages against the bad people, for the bad people will always try and use force to dominate and gain power, because that's what they crave.

They worship that. They worship power. They worship control. They worship whatever they can get to give them the pleasure they want, right. Sex, drugs, rock and roll, whatever it is. The worship of those kinds of things; whereas, the good people, they hold and build and protect civilization, they love God and love their neighbor. There's an ethic there that is radically different; and, this is a very important thing: There has to be love in the training of force. Isn't that a very paradoxical thing? You have to base your training on the ethic of loving God and loving others. It has to be based on love. We love God; so, we love and respect the gifts he has given to humankind, and to humanity and the rights He has given. That's why will protect people and their rights. Right? That's why, even though they disagree, we'll still protect them. That's why in Cheon Il Guk, they can still express their views. Obviously, they can't get funding, and make a Communist state. They can't do that; but, there is freedom of speech there.

So, when we love God, we love His creation, we love the apex of creation, which are human beings, even though they're not perfect, even though they've fallen away from it, etc. but, we have the ethic of respecting that which God has created, especially the apex of that. That's why we have, for example, Judeo-Christian based jurisprudence. You're innocent until proven guilty, because if something sovereign inside, even an alleged criminal. That he has the right to stand and explain himself, and show evidence that he said or she said or everything said about you, whatever, is either wrong, or it's true. Innocent until proven guilty, right?

Not like the left, where you are guilty before you're innocent; or, the Communist, right. They can just call you, and say, "Oh, he's just a hate-speech monger. Arrest him now, officer." What the heck does that mean? That's every Christian then. That's every Christian, that they're trying to make society. You're plagued like that, too. You can be put in prison for, "hate-speech" saying, "transgender is not scientific, right? Or, homosexuality, according to the Scripture, is an abomination. In Canada, you could be arrested for hate-speech, or you can be sued for quoting Scripture that says that; so, you talk about taking away the censorship of speech. This happened in the US with the Johnson Act, where Pastors are not allowed to talk about political issues, or endorse political people, politicians that agree with Christian values, otherwise they would get their 5013C tax exempt status removed; or, at least threatened, okay.

So, we see that centralized government, control freaks, and power hoarders, they're always in the business of trying to control people more. Engineer them tighter, engineer them less powerful, make them weaker, make them more pathetic. Then it's very easy to rule over those people. It's very hard to rule people, who, number one: Have an ethic, who have lots of love in

their heat, who love their families and have strong powerful families that they're willing to die for. If you have a lot to lose, it's not that you fear the enemy, but that you fear what will happen if the enemy wins; and, when the Commies win, or when the Centralist win George Soros wins, even though he's pathetic, demonic, Nazi collaborating Satanist win, it's over. It's over for freedom of speech. It's over for freedom of religion. If you're not part of it's relativist religion, you are for traditional values, and you are a racist, xenophobic, homophobic, blah, blah, blah, blah blah. Whatever label they want to put upon you, okay.

So, it is the love, it is the attachments, it is the things that God has given us that we adore so much that gives us the fuel and energy to be able to fight against evil, if we have to; and, this is many times forgotten in the martial arts community, or in the different combat arts communities, this whole discussion of the ethic of love has to ground anybody's training. It has to be based on, even though we go target-shooting, where we're trying to be better marksman, what's the purpose of that? Is it for our ego, is it really just for hunting so you can put food on the table? Right? It's got to be something greater, it's got to be something transcendental, that we're tapping into when we're exercising, and giving or receiving with, that fills our soul, and our life with purpose; and, it's not like we're doing this in a wishful thinking way. It's just the nature of the Universe, especially if the Universe was created by an Intelligent Mind that has the beauty of mathematics embedded within the Cosmos, the beauty of the Cosmic conditions that if you tweak just a little bit, it destroys the whole Universe. Right? The mass of electrons, the mass of a proton, atomic force, gravity. if you adjust any of those, the whole dang Universe collapses. We know this is a mathematical architectural Universe that has been designed by an Intelligent Mind; and, if that is the case, and that mind has beauty, it's has transcendence, it's has structure, it has all the aspects that we value in personhood. Feelings, desire, will, love; and, so in the true Cheon Il Guk, in a truly free world of freedom and responsibility, it is incumbent upon the owners of that society, who are the Kings and Queens of that society, to have the dominion over things that the world poo-poops, chuns, looks down upon. They say, only they can control, or the super special elites and the politicians can control. It is a normal man and woman that usually lives their life generally on the ethic of love, that when they have the power over dominion of force, create a better, safer society.

You need to have a safer society. Why is that? You need to have some semblance of stability within society to have the fruits of prosperity. You have a constantly destabilizing society, it's very hard to set up businesses, it's very hard to do free association, to do free trade. It's very, very hard, which is why these political engineers are always trying to destabilize nations before they take them down. What makes the stableness of Cheon Il Guk? It is the Kings and Queens of Cheon Il Guk. The people have their Kingly rights and duties. We have the right, we have the connection, the legitimate right, given to us by God, connecting us to God through the Crowns. We have the legitimate right of self-defense in what our Father has given us in the peace police/ peace militia, where armed citizens create the true safety that's necessary for a flourishing society.

If course, with that armed citizenry, then comes each individual who then has to be responsible; so, that responsibility comes in with the love ethic. This is why it's so important. You take your

children to go shooting, and you take the Benghazi hero, who was on show the other day. We're talking about, he takes his kids out hunting for squirrels, chipmunks, whatever, with just a .22; and, he shoots the animal, and he shows the children what it does to that animal. So, he'll show them, look, this is what happens to animals; so, you have to be very careful with your rifles. You have to make sure you're always responsible with it. If you see Daddy's rifles out, if you see Daddy's guns out, you always come to Daddy, and tell Daddy. See, he trains them to understand there's consequences, if you misuse this power, right. That's why the younger kids, who are training, what is the first thing you did? I showed you guys. We brought that ham hock, that big deer leg; and, what's stuck up on the picture in the Dojo, on the wall of the Dojo? You all saw that picture, right? A small little one inch knife, and see how deep that cuts.

A little baby knife, a little tiger or bear. You got to respect the weapon; but, people who don't understand this, think it's like a Hollywood movie. You can get your hands slashed up with somebody that knows how to use a knife. I was just thinking, you're going to get your legs cut off with someone who knows how to use a knife. Absolutely ludicrous. But, what happens when the young people/ You saw that, the adults, you saw the cut with a one inch blade. What happens with the eyes of those young kids? They literally were shocked. Did you see that; and, remember, we called the small girls? The eleven years old Hanna made one cut, and saw how deep that cuts. It literally opens your eye. They say, "Oh, my goodness. What is happening there?" You had no idea, cause you think you could do some Karate block, and throw him over, when a guy is never going to attack you like that, right.

So, this kind of dangerous training, of course, is absolutely responsible to make you people more empowered, stronger, harder to destroy; but, also get trained in the ethic of loving God/loving your neighbor. Now, you may never have to use it. That's what we wish for; but, if you have to use it, at least you're more prepared than the normal person, who is hilariously unprepared. I mean, just ridiculously unprepared. I mean, it's just unbelievable; and, those percentage is now put on your side, on the good side. You're on the side that's trying to protect people, not destroy people.

So, your fight, your training, your purpose is a good one. It is a righteous one, right. **Seek ye first the Kingdom and his righteousness.** We have big community of girls training, and of course, they're getting tougher and tougher; so, we have a lot of girls that get dominated by the small girls the first few days. They're just beating them up. They have to reevaluate themselves. Maybe, they get a little hurt pride, they get a little hurt egos; but, that kind of reality then brings in a life-changing experience, which then forces them to reassess themselves, and their ability.

So, really the root of self-defense, of course, human beings from a primitive level, you see the cavemen with spears and everything. If you're a human, you have tools that would bring you above animals. They would give you the power over animals, the dominion over things that could kill you; and, a human being would never be found without those tools. A human person, today, has been so engineered, so we don't don't associate that with a human being; but, the human being with tools and force multipliers are absolutely the safety in this chaotic world. The question is, whether or not, you trust human beings; or, do you trust archangels? Do you trust

centralized mafias; or, do you trust human beings. Who you going to trust? You can either trust college professors, who want to collude with governments or big corporations. Not that big corporations are all bad; but, that collude with centralized power. They believe that the state, this unknown, unnamed ethereal thing, almost like a religion, can do better than the normal person to protect the normal person; or, you must believe that the human being is capable of defending himself. That they have a right to do so. That if somebody's trying to rape them, harm them, kill them, they are able to at least fight back, have a fighting chance.

The question is, whether or not, do you love human beings or not? Do you see human beings as dangerous; or, do you see human beings, fundamentally, made in the image of God, right? This goes back to the Garden. Does God see human beings, who are made in His image, as fundamentally evil; or, does He see them as, in His image. The Bible says, God is love; so, that would very clearly show that humans should be about love, right? Their nature is love, to protect others, who are in threat, danger. We could identify with that very easily; but, of course, that's why the state woo us, romance us, in believing that, "Oh, if we just give them power, they'll allow that protective structure to protect us, essentially giving up our responsibility to the state; but, that of course is the defeat of humanity, it is the defeat of humankind, wooing and romancing you out of your own ability to have power and defend yourself; and, that is what is represented by the Kings and Queens.

Kings of Cheon Il Guk have power. They don't have power like we're talking in this spiritual way, which just Crowns on our head that could be stolen anytime in a state that oppress your speech, your religion, your beliefs, your ability to protect yourself, and everything else that follows after that. This is not Kings and Queens rights and duties cerebrally, theoretically, in the mind. These are rights and powers that exists on the Earth; and, signs show it, the statistics show it, that when good people are able to have power, not centralized power, but have power to defend themselves, collectively, they produce a safer society, with less homicide, less crime. Why? Because criminals are scared.

So, seek ye God and His righteousness, whether you are trained with firearms, whether you are training with blades. It's pretty much a different type of weapon, etc. It doesn't matter. There has to be an underlying purpose. An underlying purpose, an underlying ethic, the underlying reason. The motto, okay; and, that is to love God and love your neighbor.

So, when we look through the Scripture, we can also see that God talks about protection of peoples. Look at this?

**Psalm 82:1 God standeth in the congregation of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods. 2 How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah. 3 Defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy. 4 Deliver the poor and needy: rid the of the hand of the wicked;** and, this is what Donald Trump is facing with in North Korea right now. The poor and the needy of the North Korean people, who are under the fist of totalitarian Communism, okay, which is exactly what the Family Fraud is pursuing, if you look at their Constitution. On the micro and macro, you can see it. The same Satanists

movements are being stand up against; and, Trump is standing up to North Korea. We have all these 26 million poor and needy folks, who many, unfortunately, are completely brainwashed by social engineering, who experts almost all agree will be fought for, or will be delivered. There's major decisions on the desk of the White House, if you understand what I'm saying, is about how to change the situation in the North, and to bring down that Communist regime.

The Bible says, to **defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy.** God gives us a reason by which His people become strong. He gives us the ethic, why good people must be strong. He gives us the will, the purpose of why you must be strong. You can't do that, you can't delegate to somebody else. You may be the first line of defense for somebody else's life at a certain given time that is unbeknownst to you. You may be the one who is called to take action against somebody else who is harming an innocent person. You may be that person in school, and some wacko Jihadis come and kill all these kids, which they've done in Pakistan, all around the UK, Europe, you name it; mass as many killings as the can. You may be the one in the room, where this crazed fool walks in, and starts shooting up the kids, right. That's why Israel learned about it; and, Thailand, the Buddhist country of Thailand, learned about it.

Did you know the teachers carry guns in the public schools. Did you know that? You thought this was just a White Supremacist thing, huh. You poor, dark skinned Asians, you racist. Are you racist? The poor, dark skinned Asian are not people, hmm? But, the government's learned about it; and, of course, they - You knew about that, Chief, you knew about that.

(Chief Did you know Psalm 82:4 is the motto of the Special Forces?) Let give it up for him. What a man of God. Of course, if you know Chief, when he fought in the jungles of Vietnam, he killed a lot of folks. He's killed a lot of bad guys. He's had to expire people's lives from the planet. He had to; and, I asked him about his first gun fight, you've seen that. He said, "He was going in there, 15-18 guys. They just captured a village, and they were raping the women. They were taking the babies, and tossing them around like footballs; and, as they were tossing them, they catch them on the bayonet. They stabbed them with a bayonet as a game. Chief had a whole reconnaissance team for intel, and he just said, he couldn't hold it in; and, he was a Sergeant, he broke command, and went in and killed them all. He took them all out; and, that's why even in warfare, there's a whole philosophy of a just war, when is it right to take another human's life.

In the King James Version, the Bible says, "Thou shall not Kill," and that's the thing they spread around a lot; but, the Hebrew; it says, ratsach, which mean, "Thou shall not murder." Kill is a different word, because you could kill a mosquito; but, you won't say, "I murdered a mosquito," because when you murder something, there's unjust, there's unrighteousness there. There's nothing that that thing, that entity, has done to warrant expiring their life, and so that would unjust, and it would be murder. The Bible talks about, "Do not murder" is the Commandment, okay; but, of course, do not kill is a different thing; and, the liberal's are always trying to twist the Bible saying, "Thou shalt not kill." You idiots. Are you kidding me. God Commands to kill animals in sacrificial rights. There's even Scripture that I was going to show today, where one commits, even under Moses, kill blasphemers. That's Old Testament, okay. In the Completed

Testament of Cheon Il Guk, you're not going to do that; but, thou shall not murder is a separate category. When you kill somebody in self-defense, that person was trying to kill you, or rape your children, you had to expire that person's life, you have not murdered somebody. You have defended your life in self-defense, okay.

So, **Proverbs 24**, the Bible, the Scripture calls us to deliver the poor, the needy. Of course, that's what the Chief did; that's what all his Green Beret folks did for the different villages they fought for. Also, **Proverb 24:10 If thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength is small. 11 If thou forbear to deliver them that are drawn unto death, and those that are ready to be slain; 12 If thou sayest, Behold, we knew it not; doth not he that pondereth the heart consider it? And he that keepeth thy soul, doth not he know it? And shall not he render to every man according to his works?** So, if you say, "Well, God knows about it, shouldn't God defend them? You committed sin. Hey, God knows everything. Hey, why don't He defend them? Why do I got to do it?" That's deferring responsibility. What if God put you there, so you can do it, and through that, you may live or die; but, either way, you will grow through it, and that person will be saved by it.

**Verse 11 If you forbear to deliver them that are drawn unto death, and those that are ready to be slain;** and you say, "God should do it," you commit a sin against Him. So, again, what is the ethic, what is the reason why good people have to learn dominion over force? What is the reason? For God's Kingdom, for love, because we love God, and we love our neighbor, even though we disagree with them, and don't like their dog, and don't like their politics, but still we can defend them.

**Ezekiel 33:3 If when he seeth the sword come upon the land, he blow the trumpet, and warn the people; 4 Then whosoever heareth the sound of the trumpet, and taketh not warning; if the sword come, and take him away, his blood shall be upon his own head. 5 He heard the sound of the trumpet, and took not warning; his blood shall be upon him. But he that taketh warning shall deliver his soul. 6 But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand. 7 So, thou, O son of man, I have set thee a watchman unto the house of Israel; therefore thou shall hear the word at my mouth, and warn them from me.**

This is about the watchman. In **Verse 6**, it's the watchman right here. That means, the watchman's iniquity. Does that make sense? The King James Version is a little Old English, okay. It's a little not common English. But the guy who is killed is taking away in his iniquity. Who is here? It is the watchman, okay, in the watchman's iniquity; but, his blood I will require at

the watchman's hand. That means the watchman, who was responsible to alert the people that the sword was coming, if he didn't do that, then he will be responsible for when the people die. That's why every Pastor, every religious leader, etc. should be teaching about why good people need to be armed, and that's why Father made me the Pope. Camo Pope. Not the Catholic Pope. I'm the Camo Pope. Did I wear camo today? Okay, I got a camo hat on, okay.

Religious leaders should be telling their people and their flock to be aware, and have the ability to defend their loved ones and neighbors. We live in an upside down, backwards world, where religious people cannot talk about this stuff; and, it's wacky, if you talk about this in Church. You're only supposed to talk about pine trees and mistletoes and gingerbread cookies on Christmas Eve. I want to talk about self-defense, because God came and was born on this... I know it's not Jesus' birthday; but, that's what people think. He was born, and gave his life in love to others. He shows the warrior poet ethic. He shows the warrior ethic. He shows what it means to be human, to be real, to be God-like. I'm not saying, we should have ego trips and worship ourselves as being God-like, etc; but, all the glory to God, and the purpose, the purpose. Jesus laid down his life for the salvation of those who believe. He gave it for love.

Most of us will not be called to do that in a lifetime; but, that does not mean we cannot practice an ethic. Most of us will not be committing adultery; but, that does not mean you cannot speak against adultery, just because you haven't committed adultery. Does that make sense? You don't have to commit adultery to say adultery is bad. You don't have to jump off a cliff and die or say, "Hey, don't jump off a cliff." Does that make sense? You may not be called to give your life for your friends, etc; but, that doesn't mean you can't practice at it. It doesn't mean you can't be motivated to live a powerful and vibrant training life. Right? There's only a very specific small group of people like Chief, who are Green Berets, and go out there and have done that; but, as a civilian, don't ever believe the lie that your job is any less important. Chief is the first one to tell you that, right, because civilians, you are the first line of defense against evil in your hometown, in your neighborhood, on your street. You're the firstline.

The cops come ten minutes later, ten minutes later, forty minutes later on average. We love our law enforcement, etc; but, it's just the nature in them. If something happens, boom! They're not omnipresent. They're not going to be there all at once. You are the firstline. It's not law enforcement that's the firstline. That's one thing I don't like about Lt. Colonel Grossman. He says, "Law enforcement is the firstline." It's civilians that are the firstline; and, that's why we need training with folks like that. Again, not so we could feel badass and yeah, yeah, yeah baby. Come on. Not for that.

So, we can be realistic. We can have ability . We can understand reality through folks like that; and, if the moment is called, where we have to do something, even though we freeze, and even though we screw up, we can push through the craziness better than if we didn't have the training. It doesn't mean we'll be perfect. We may not be perfect like Chief. He can run into gunfire not flinching. I doubt a lot of us in the room can do that. We're probably going to be flinching a little bit, and that's okay, that's alright, because you're not at his level.



It doesn't mean we cannot learn from somebody like that. It doesn't mean that we cannot be a line of defense. Don't ever believe the lie; and, you get some guys, who are only promoting government or law enforcement or military, who will try and make you feel ashamed of being a civilian sheepdog, like, "Oh, you guys never saw warfare. You guys never saw this." You guys don't know what you're talking about; but, the guys who train the civilians, who really love the civilians, who love people, and they don't want to centralize the government, centralize power, they train civilians, because they know the civilians are the frontline. It's the single mom, who has two children going to do whatever. She's the firstline for those children, even though, obviously, that's not the best lifestyle for the children; but, if that's the scenario that she's in, she's the firstline for those kids. Mom and Dad, you're the firstline for your kids. Brothers and sisters, you are the firstline for your younger siblings. It's not military. It's not law enforcement. It's you. So, the civilian has an absolutely critical role to play in the protection of society, and in society is where they do that. The civilians have that power, and not guilt/shame them into believing they can't do it. Is crime rate higher? No. It is ridiculously lower.

So that's why watchman in the Scriptures tell us, we have to alert people, we have to sound the trumpet, not to freak people out, but to get people. I'm not going to say to get them prepared, but just at a level, where they could be a human being, and freely go about their lives, without external predatory violent interruption. Can you see what I'm saying? There's only one way to thwart that, and keep that at bay, is to have for yourself as a citizen, to have the violent dominion power, because that's the only language the bad guys speak. This is a very important episode in the Scripture, and this is in Luke 22. This is an absolutely critical Scripture. Let's look at this one. This is Jesus speaking, okay.

**Luke 22:35 And he said unto them, When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye anything? And they said, Nothing. 36 Then said he unto them, But now, he that hath a purse, let him take it, and likewise his scrip: and he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one.** A purse is like a money bag, and a scrip is like a knapsack; so, if you have a knapsack, if you have a money bag, get rid of it. Get rid of your garment, too, if you have to. You know, garments are very important, especially in the Middle Eastern world. It gets very cold in the desert. Anybody who's been in the desert, you know. it gets very cold in the desert. You need a thermoregulating layer. Sell that thing off your back; you have to get a sword. Isn't that interesting? People are never told this Scripture. Jesus said that. Get a sword. Get a sword.

**37 For I say unto you, that this that is written ust yet be accomplished in me, And he was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning me have an end. 38 And they said, Lord, behold, here are two swords. And he said unto them, it is enough. 39 And he came out, and went, as he was wont, to the mount of Olives; and his disciples also followed him.** This is a very interesting episode. In the modern day, the modern day sword is a firearm, okay, it's a firearm; so, can you imagine, if this episode is happening. Now, remember, this is a religious leader, who all Christians in the world believe is God on Earth, the

perfect man; and, he tells his disciples, okay, sell all your things, your scrip, your purse etc. If you have no gun, let him sell his garment, and buy a gun. This is quite a shocking teaching, right, if you think about it, in the time; but, if you think about it from the perspective of the value of human life, it's not a shocking thing, because, people who are going into dangerous ways. They need to protect themselves. This is an episode of Christ that is hardly ever taught in the Church. How many knew this Scripture was in there? Okay, you folks kind of cheated, you know. You're kind of cheating. You ain't no normal church, okay. But, this is an episode in the Gospels.

And, of course, there going to say, "Well, Jesus, when he was assaulted with the armies of Rome, he said, put the sword back. He, who will live by the sword, will die by the sword;" and, of course, they'll always quote those Scriptures; but, isn't it interesting, the same man who told them, I'm letting them take me, we have the power of violence, we can do a violent revolution; but, I'm willing to let them take me, cause there's a purpose here. The same Christ who did that, tells his disciples, make sure you have the ability to defend yourselves. Make sure you have that ability. "Oh, but Father said, we're going to smash those swords into plow shares and hoes." Remember this one? They tell you this one alot, too. "Oh, that's the argument for disarmament. We have to disarm, because the Bible says, and True Father also quoted, "Smashing your sword into plowshares." Actually, somebody brought it up to Kook Jin Nim the other week; and, he just answered it so brilliantly. He said, "That is talking about economic development. That God gives them a portion of their weapons to be transferred and formed into agricultural tools, which then help their economy build up; but, then, of course, at the end, God tells them that they must destroy, or smite, the evil nations." Isn't that interesting? They kinda forget to tell you about the last part of that, don't you, or what the Bible says about the good side vs. the evil side.

The point is, in the Kingdom, the why every man and woman is part of the peace police/ peace militia training, even though we won't use it. It is because better people through it, you actually become more loving people through it. You'll become more protector type people going through that type of training. You will learn to value and put into your psyche, "I need to protect the people." You'll probably be the only one in a restaurant that is sitting there thinking about the entrance way, and what if people come in here, and I have to be the one to defend it. You may be the only person in that completely sheepproof, completely wide-eyed, zombie-eyed people, who have no consciousness of their own protection. You may be the only one in that room, who actually has a mindset to positioning yourself facing the door, positioning yourself in a place doing something, less something happens. Is that a bad mindset to have? Is that a power to let the left people say, "Oh you live in so much fear. You're so paranoid." Is it so paranoid to want to love people, and to want to protect them? Is it paranoid, if you live in a flood-zone to have to have emergency preparedness food? Is it paranoid to wear a seatbelt everytime you drive a car, because your way more likely to die than someone flying a plane? Would you consider someone paranoid, if they wore a seatbelt?

So, this is a problem. Good people allow bad people and selfish people to guilt/shame them into their type of mentality, which is a weak-minded, heard type mentality, which would befall anything for power. Good people cannot be guilt/shamed that way. We cannot think that our mindset is weird, the fact that we want to protect people, and we're thinking ahead of the game.

Anybody who does evil fighting, even I'm wrestling around with somebody, I'm already thinking, because I have it built into me. I'm already thinking two, three steps ahead of them. They don't know what they're doing, because I'm already two, three steps ahead. I'm training with a higher level Blackbelt, I'm thinking three, four steps ahead. They're thinking three, four steps ahead. It's just built into you.

So, you should not feel guilty, and feel bad, that you have a mindset that is special. That you have a mindset, which is powerful. That you have a mindset that is facing reality, and not just wooing seductive, romantic lie, like politicians. It's basically reality; and, everytime they guilt/shame you, you say, "Do you wear a seatbelt? Do you know the statistics in car accidents? You must live in fear and trepidation and paranoia all the time, especially when you're driving. You must be weak, because you wear a seatbelt." Ridiculous. Ridiculous.

The reason why every time, even if I'm in my home, in the gun community, in the home, they're armed; or, if they step out, they have layers of armament upon them, it's not because we're trying to feel some infantile desire to prove and satisfy, gain approval from our celestial father figure, which is really this internal angst of sexual oppression that we've projected into the Universe. Shut up. Shut up. None of that's going to matter, when some bozo is breaking into your house, just like it did with one our friends hear in Scranton.

His son was the only one in the house. A guy came in through the back, and the son was trained in firearms; but, he didn't have firearms. He had a crossbow, which he used to go hunting with his Dad. The dude was coming in the back; the son was like, "Oh, crash!" He ran and got the crossbow, and the dude was coming in through the backdoor in the porch; and, he jacked it open with a screwdriver, and started through the porch, because he thought, no one is there.
