

2017 December 31 ~ Kingdom of the Rod of Iron I ~ Rev. Hyung Jin Moon ~ Newfoundland, PA

Now, we're going through a lot of different words, today. with not only God's Word, but a lot of different Scriptures, okay; so, let's frame this a little bit. I'm now working on a new series that you will see, that you will combine the study of the Gospel, which is delineated by Jesus Christ, the Gospel of the Kingdom, with how he'll rule that Kingdom with the Rod of Iron; so, we're going to be going through, again, the New Testament Scriptures that we did in studying the Kingdom; but, we're going to be looking at it through the framework of the Rod of Iron, or the means by which Christ will rule it in the Last Days, or when the millennial Kingdom comes, okay.

So, we're going to be focusing a lot on the Rod of Iron, folks. A lot of the Rod of Iron. You're going to see a lot of ARs, and that kind of stuff, okay. So, while we are moving through this, I know I'm going to be hearing from people, "Oh, this is not new. I want to hear more spiritual stuff." I know I'm going to hear that. I'm telling you before hand. I know you're going to do that; so, don't do it, okay. If you do it, just pray for me. Alright, we're going to work through this, because look, the Kingdom is not only for us, folks, there's also other inheritors that God has prepared, and that is the Abel type Christian realm. The Abel type Christian, folks, who are one with Christ, but at the same time, they deeply, deeply, deeply, deeply hold on to sovereignty. They deeply understand what it means to be sovereign. They deeply love the founding fathers, okay. They deeply love their right to bear arms and have weapons, okay. These are the Abel type Christians that are not only unchurched, but they're not allowed to be in church. Well, they are; but, the churches have become so state run, and so feminized, that these kinds of alpha males don't feel that is a Kingdom that they could be in.

So, I'm telling you this in advance, okay; and, if you want the Power Points presentation we'll be going over, I'll give them to you; so, if you are talking to other gun owners and stuff like that, then you can give them a biblically based understanding about why it's so critical, the Rod of Iron rules in the reign of the Rod of Iron. Why it's so critical, why it's absolutely centrally biblical to the understanding of Christ and his Kingdom, as you will see, of course; but, I can give you these slides. The tech team already has them; so, if you want these slides, and you are talking to people who are obviously concerned; but, the more prepared people, who are in the conservative framework is of course Christians who love Jesus. They may not know that he comes with a new name in Revelation 3:12. They're not even aware of that Scripture that Jesus, when he returns, he'll come with a new name, okay; but, they love Jesus, they love Christ, and they understand that they have sovereign rights that they will not be treaded on, that these kind of folks, they're like the warriors of the civilization, okay. They're like the warriors of our society, okay; and, yes many people will go to the vets, something like that, and say thank you, etc, etc; but, it's important that these kind of folks get connected to the Kingdom Gospel, of course, the Rod of Iron reign. These are really the Abel type Christian folks that are going to inherit the Kingdom; and, of course, you see God moving so powerfully with Mr. Larry Pratt, who will be joining us. He already joined us on The King's Report, twice; and, he will be joining us in January in Switzerland, and joining us again here in PA. He bought his tickets to fly here in February as well. Mr. Larry Pratt, he's the Gun Godfather, okay; so, he's not a joke. If you don't

know Mr. Larry Pratt, you don't know the gun community. Mr. Larry Pratt is the Gun Godfather, okay. He is the heavenly godfather. He's a good, tremendous patriot, okay.

So, his organization, that group of patriots out there is keeping the NRA honest, and they empower citizens to understand their responsibility, and their power, and their rights, okay; so, I know while we're moving through this, I'm not going to be talking much about conventionally Christian spiritual things, okay; so, make sure you have your Bible, make sure you have Prayer Room, and you're praying, also, in your normal lives, so God can fill you with that. Ladies, if you need that, because when you come to service, you are going to see a lot of Rod of Iron stuff, okay; so, make sure you're supplementing that with your Prayer Rooms, and your Scripture study, okay. I'm pointing that out, because I know it's gonna come in a couple of weeks, okay.

Let's get into it. Kingdom of the Rod of Iron Number 1. I'm just gonna number these, cause this is gonna turn into a book, okay. This is probably going to turn into a book. It's probably going to become the beginnings of a book, which we can release this into the biblical evangelical community; so, this is where God is leading in 2018, and of course, is setting it up beforehand. We're just trying to catch up; and, we didn't know it moved this fast, honestly speaking. We didn't know it would move this fast. I kind of wanted to move slower maybe, with the NRA folks in this area, and then go a little more bigger; but, God just, boom! brings it way on top, and Mr. Larry Pratt and others are already connecting us that deeply; so, we're just trying to catch up. We're just trying to shoot, and boom! God creates, shall we say, the split in the Red Sea. Let's go! Time to go. Gotta run across it, okay; so, you got to understand where we were at as well. God opened up a whole new avenue in these End of Days, okay.

So, let's get into the Kingdom of the Rod of Iron, Number 1, or Section 1, or Episode 1, whatever you want to call it. Chapter 1. First of all, we have to get back to what the Gospel is. The Gospel, what is the Gospel? What is the Gospel as Jesus Christ defined himself? This is for Christians. This is a great thing to discuss with Christians. What is the Gospel? Of course, the euangélion has traditionally explained, or has been churches, is the Crucifixion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. That is the Gospel. Through that, you will be saved. They commonly quote John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son; anyone who believes will have everlasting life." They will commonly quote that Scripture; but, what does the Scripture say, and what does Jesus say? He's kind of an important person in this whole dialogue, isn't he? What does Jesus say is the Gospel. okay?

So, that is what we got to look at; and, that's what we have to help our Christians, especially on the Abel side gun owners, etc to understand what we're talking about. We have to help them understand. Hey, hey! Look at what Jesus said the Gospel is, okay. So, what what does he say? First of all, before we get into that, he says we should be praying about the Kingdom God everyday, right. So, in Matthew 6 it says, pray this everyday. he says to his disciples, and that is the Lord's Prayer. That is the one where we see, right, which the Pope by the way is trying to change. The Pop, the fake Pope... I'm the Camo Pope, I'm the real Pope. He's the fake Pope. He's trying to change the Lord's Prayer. I am the Heir and Successor to the Lord of Second Advent. He is not; and, the fake Pope is trying to change the Lord's Prayer. I do not change the

Lord's Prayer. We say it everyday at the peace police/peace militia training, right. We end it all the time with the Lord's Prayer, okay.

Matthew 6:9 "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, 10 your Kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. 11 Give us today our daily bread. 12 And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. 13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

So, the Lord's Prayer says, "Our Father which art in Heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven." Did you hear that? Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done on Earth, as it is in Heaven. That's what Jesus says to believers, and to Christians, who call themselves Christians, that they have to pray every day.

So, if Christians turn to you and say, "Hey, what are you believers believe," and you get into that discussion, and it's lively and friendly, you say, "Hey..." Of course, you can show them the Constitution, all that kind of thing; but, if you're going deeper with them, and you're discussing things, do you know that your supposed to pray for the kingdom to come everyday? Did you know that? Did you know, that's what Jesus said; and, if you do, then what is it? In John 14:15 it says, "He who loves me will follow my commands, will obey my commands." right? So, if you are a Christian, and you say you love Jesus, well, are you praying that prayer? Is that part of spiritual life, daily? Are you desiring his desire, for the Kingdom to come, and for his will to be done?" Isn't that interesting, right?

Next, in **Matthew 6:33 we see, Jesus say, "But seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.**

In Matthew 6:33, Jesus says, "**seek ye first the Kingdom.**" He says, before we do anything else, or worry about this or that thing, or what's going to come up tomorrow, etc, he says, "**Seek ye first the Kingdom.**" "**Seek ye first the Kingdom.**" He didn't say, "Seek ye first democracy." He didn't say, "Seek ye first Communism." He didn't say, "Seek ye first some, some useless diploma." He said, **Seek ye first the Kingdom.**" Alright. **Seek ye first the Kingdom, and his righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you.** Okay. So, there again, we see again in the Matthew 6, in the Gospel of Matthew, in the Bible, yes, he says, "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God." Okay.

In Matthew 7:21, now this is just a reminder to Christians, okay. This is a remind; so, let's look at **Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the Kingdom of Heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.**

Now Christian say I'm a cult leader, and they say you are cult members, or that we are all Cultists. Well, they said that about Jesus Christ, too, didn't they? They said about Jesus, didn't they? They said that about the early Christian Movement. We are looking at the Scriptures. We are listening to some glitterbug state run Catholic Priest, or some state run Pastor. We are looking at the Scripture, and what it says. Federally funded Pastors, okay; and, I ranted about

that a million, billion, quadrillion, quintillion times, okay. You know why that's bad; and, you know how the state buys off the churches, by making the programs, the charity programs that they have to do, be registered under the federal government, etc. Okay, so the state run church have tremendous leverage on the Pastors; and, they don't remind their flock about what the Bible says.

So for Christians, it is important to remember, especially when they say you're a Cultist, where a Cultist, Hey, hey, you got to remember, cause many of the Christians will say, Lord, Lord. We can be humble in that; but, many of us will say, Lord, Lord, not everybody that saith Lord, Lord shall enter. Do you see that? So, when you discuss with Christians, of course you should have some working knowledge of Scripture. You should have some Bible study. You should have some Scriptures that are in your mind, so that you can discuss things with them, right; and, just like we did when we discussed things on Pastor Dave Zacker's Show, a month or two ago, we got into Rev. Moon's the Messiah. We got into this kind of thing. Then, I started bringing up Scriptures. He said, "Oh, your father's not the Messiah." I said, "Well, Rev. 3:12, it said this, that when the Lord returns, you won't know his name. He'll actually have a new name. It says, he'll have it written on his forehead the name of his father, which no one will know; but, you still think he'll come back as Yeshua, Jesus, which he will not. The Bible says, he will not return as Jesus. Now, isn't that interesting? Most Christians will never hear that. Again, because, they're not looking at their Scripture.

Okay, so it's important to remind them, look. Alright, **Matthew 7:21**, don't be so confident Christian. I'm Christian, too; but, don't be so confident Christian. **Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter the Kingdom of heaven; but, he doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.** That's what Jesus said. You got to read your Bible. You got to understand, he comes with a new name. You got to understand, even you have all the experts in Hebrew and Greek, but still the Bible says they will not understand the name that is written on his forehead. Isn't that interesting?

So, this is what commonly happens when you have a dialogue with evangelicals, and it gets theological, because they throw out a couple of Bible quotes. You throw out a couple of Bible quotes. They throw out a couple of Bible quotes. You throw out a couple of Bible quotes; and, they say, "Okay, we agree to disagree; and, will see on Judgment Day, who is right," That's basically, what it boils down to, okay. How many people had that experience? Almost all of you, okay. If you've been talking to Christians, that's basically where it ends up, right? Okay.

So, that is a real reality. Of course, that's like a stalemate. It's like a stalemate, okay. It's a stalemate. So, with those kind of people, the most you can do is, "Okay, I love you. We agree to disagree," you know, things like that, okay; and, that's why God is bringing us to the Rod of Iron, because that is something that's not only a belief, it is a not only a lifestyle. We're talking about the fundamental, fundamental ability to defend all human rights, all human rights. Okay.

So, if you have control of some of these Scriptures, and I'll make these slides available for all you guys who want it, just ask Rio, and he'll give it to you, okay. So, you'll have these at your

hand, at your desk, at your phone. Take a picture of it. Just keep a picture of it on your phone, and say, "Hey, let me show you these Scriptures." That's interesting to look at. Just put them on your phone, whatever. If you have a discussion with an Abel type prepared Christian, because they're the inheritors of the Kingdom of God. Whether you like them or not, they are. They're supposed to be, right, even though they don't know what it is.

Matthew 10:7 And as ye go, preach, the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.

Luke 4:43 And he said unto them, I must preach the Kingdom of God to other cities also: for therefore am I sent.

You ask a normal Christian, "Did you ever hear that?" They'll say, "No." I never hear that. Have you heard in Luke 4:43 that Jesus said that he **must preach the Kingdom of God to other cities also: for that is the reason why he was sent?** Notice, he didn't say, "The reason why he was sent was to die on the Cross." Remember that, because that is fundamental to Christian theology, that Jesus came to die on the Cross. That is the core of Christianity, two thousand years of Christian spiritual salvation theology, okay. That Jesus Christ came to die on the Cross, and that God the Father new and sent him to die on that Cross; but, it's interesting, cause Jesus, himself, says that he didn't come to die on that Cross. See, that he said, I must preach the Kingdom of God to other cities also, for that is the reason why I am sent. For therefore is the reason why I am sent. That is old King James Version. That to me, that's the reason why I've been sent. To preach the Gospel of the Kingdom of God. You don't see in the Gospel yet. You're going to see in the next line, but to preach the Kingdom of God. Interesting, right?

Alright, let's keep going. **Matthew 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.**

The Gospel of the what? The Gospel of the Kingdom. What did he say? The Gospel of the Kingdom, not the Gospel of the Crucifixion. Not the Gospel of the Death and Resurrection. Not the Gospel of democracy. Not the Gospel of whatever it is. It is the Gospel of the Kingdom of God. Now, this is biblical. Biblical. The Bible says it. Jesus went about teaching in the synagogues preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, okay.

Let's go to **Mark 1:14 Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom of God,**

Again, not the Gospel of the Crucifixion, not the Gospel of the Death, not the Gospel of the Burial Tomb, not the Gospel of the Resurrection on the third day. That is not the Gospel. You know, that is so shocking. If you say that to a Christian, most of them will say, "You're a freakin' heretic. Get out of my face. You're a freakin' heretic. How dare you say that?" But, that's why the Word of God is so important. You got to show them, "I'm not saying that. The Word of God is saying this." Do you see how important it is? "It's not me who is saying it; but, the Bible says it.

So, it doesn't matter what your glitterbug Preacher said, It Doesn't matter what your prosperity Gospel Preacher said. It doesn't matter what your fake theology Preacher and Priest told you. They are teaching a false Gospel. Jesus Christ, himself, referred to it as the Gospel of the Kingdom of God, not the Crucifixion, not the Death, not the Burial Tomb, not the Resurrection. That's shocking. Folks, you hear it all the time; so, it's like, "I know;" and, it will be like next week, "You know, I heard this." Of course, you heard it; but, I'll tell you, when a Christian hears it, it's crazy. It sounds nuts. It sounds crazy, because it goes against every single Sunday School they ever had. It goes against every single Christmas they had. It goes against every single time they've been in a church. It goes against every single thing that they heard; but, but, but, we're not making it up. It's right there, in the Bible. That's the problem.

So, we now established that most Christians don't read their Bible. They're not engaging with the Bible; they're just listening to little or big mega church Preachers. The Bible itself defines euangélion, which means the Gospel, the Good News. It defines it as the Kingdom of God, not, not the Crucifixion, Death and Resurrection, Empty Tomb, you name it. Okay.

So, this is easily establishable by Scripture. Jesus Christ taught the Gospel of the Kingdom of God, of the Kingdom of God, and if you're a Christian, you cannot deny it; otherwise, you deny the Bible, even though you pretend to believe in raising your hands and praise the Bible. You are denying the Bible, the Word of God. You cannot be a Christian and think the Gospel is something else, because the Scripture says it's this. Sorry, sorry, sorry. Okay.

In Mark 1:15 And saying, the time is fulfilled, and the Kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the Gospel.

What Gospel? The Kingdom of God. Basileia comes from Basileus. Basileus means King. King, King, King. That's what it means. Basileia means Kingdom, which means a nation that's centered on a King. How do you negotiate that as Christian? You love democracy as a modern day Western Christian; but, if you're Christian, you have to believe in a Kingdom, which will physically take hold of this Earth. Ooh, now you're in some trouble. Now, you're in trouble, cause you love democracy so much, which of course never lasts, and always implodes in about three hundred years. It turns to mob rule; but, you have a conflict as a Christian. You love the democracies, because we're on the tail end. Trumps trying to keep it going; but, traditionally, democracies don't last over three hundred years. That's the longest they can last. It always degrades to mob rule. It always degrades to, you know, the masses voting for the forceful aggression. The politicians will let them vote them into power, and then of course use forceful aggression to do what? Take and redistribute resources, which is what they want; and, that civilization always will collapse, Always. Always, always.

So, you have a Gospel of the Kingdom. Now, it's interesting, when you bring this up to Christians, they kind of like blank it out. They say, "I know it's a Gospel; but, it's a Spiritual Kingdom." "What the hell are you talking about? Have you been praying the Lord's Prayer? It's a Spiritual Kingdom? Have you been praying the Lord's Prayer, huh?" It says, "Our Father, who

art in Heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done, on Earth as it is in Heaven.” That Christian has clearly not been praying the Lord’s Prayer. They’re the ones who say, “It’s a Spiritual Kingdom.” Have you been praying your Lord’s Prayer, which Jesus said you should be praying everyday? Obviously not, because it’s a Physical Kingdom. Ahh! You see this?

Mark 1:15 The Kingdom of God is at hand, Repent ye, and believe the Gospel.

What is the Gospel? Now, traditional Christianity, folks, you got to remember, it’s the Crucifixion, it’s the Death, the Empty Tomb, and the Resurrection. Almost all of Christian Apologetics, for the Christian aspect of Apologetics, okay, past the notion whether there’s a God, or atheism vs. theism, past that, for the Christian Apologetics world that tries to say that Christianity is the type of God that is most reasonable. This is critical to their argument. Critical. Critical, critical, critical. The Crucifixion, Death, and Resurrection, because these are things that can be proved, or at least parts of them, by Science and historical means and methods. We all know that Jesus is the most validated historical figure, person, that actually lived. Some scholars say he never lived. That’s total balony. Now New Testament scholar, even atheist ones that believe that crap, Jesus was absolutely a historical figure. You have people that were totally killing the Christians who write about him; so, he is absolutely a historical figure, etc; and, so the Apologetics view is based on those things. Death, Burial, and they talk about a potential Resurrection, where they have first eyewitness accounts, and all these things, proclaiming something that could get them killed. If you study Apologetics, you’ll know. Okay. Watch Lee Strobel’s movie, if you want to go through it more quickly. Just watch his movie. What’s that title again? “The Case for Christ.” So watch this movie, if you want a Cliff Notes movie version, okay.

But, is the Gospel of the Kingdom of God? This is shocking. Shocking, shocking, shocking, because this goes against every single Preacher in the modern day, basically. This goes against 99.99999% of mainstream Christianity; so, who is actually looking at his Scripture, and who is actually believing the Scriptures? Jesus himself said, his Gospel is not about the Crucifixion, Death and Resurrection, it’s about the Kingdom of God. An actual Kingdom that will overtake this world. An actual Kingdom. Ah, see, Christians are not told, see? In mainstream Christianity, it’s like the mainstream media. Christianity does not teach the core of the Gospel. They don’t. They’re not teaching the core of the Gospel, which is, the Gospel is defined by Jesus Christ; and, if you believe the Bible is the Word of God, which Evangelicals have to believe, the Word of God says it. The Gospel is about the Kingdom of God. So, these are things you can bring up to your Christians friends, if you are at that level, or you’re going deeper, do you know what I mean?

Matthew 9:35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, (Euangélion of what Baseia) and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew 24:14 And this Gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

And is this Gospel of the Crucifixion, Death and Resurrection? No! It's the Gospel of the Kingdom of God. How many Preachers are telling their congregation that the Gospel is the Kingdom of God that will come on this Earth? How many? I mean, it's really hard to find any of them. They're teaching the same old thing; but, the Scripture says, the same old thing. The Scripture says, same old thing, literally. Really. They're just not reading it. In a good way, the Scripture says the same old thing in a good way. It's the living Word, right? It's a refreshing Word. It's like you've been drinking from the same old well of water every day; but, when you're thirsty, boy, that's good water, even though you're drinking from the same old well. Now, that same old is bad, ya young bums. When you're thirsty, that old fountain everyday tastes really good, right? That's how the Word of God is. Okay.

It says, you draw from the well of salvation. Alright, so, the Gospel of the Kingdom, not of the other thing. Back in **Matthew 9:35 The Kingdom, and healing sickness and every disease among the people. Matthew 24:14 And this Gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.** The Body of Christ has to do something before the end comes. The Gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. The end is coming, folks. The end is coming.

Matthew 25:34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

We went over this the last time, remember? We went over this whole dichotomy, that if you're a Christian, if you're an evangelical Christian, you have to believe in a Kingdom, a Physical Kingdom is coming; but, they have this dichotomy inside, because they love freedom, and they love Western civilization so much, and most Christians appreciate the founding fathers. Some of them, the Abel types, they really love them. I'm talking like they worship George Washington, and that's not bad. That's preparing them for the Cheon Il Guk Constitution, the Constitution of the Kingdom of God; because, if you love George Washington, you'll just love Rev. Sun Myung Moon, baby. You're gonna love him, if you look at that Constitution. Boy, oh Lord, if you love George Washington, oh my goodness, okay.

So, there's this problem in the modern Christian mind. They have to love a Kingdom. They have to believe Jesus will come. They have to believe that this democracy is not the top. It's not. It's not the Kingdom, right; but, inside they love George Washington and Thomas Jefferson so much, that they just don't want to give that up. They think they have to give it up.

What we're saying is, the Abel type mind, you are the inheritor of the Kingdom. That kind of person, who is a Conservative Christian, etc, these ones who love the founding fathers more, those people are the more Abel type; and, they are ready to receive the Gospel of the Kingdom. They are ready to receive the Constitution of the Kingdom of God. "Oh, there's a King there. Oh, in the Constitution of the Kingdom of God, we don't like that." Americans patriots will say that; but, the King is a Supreme Court Judge. He's not an Executive. He doesn't rule the military. He

doesn't have centralized power. He has a lifetime appointment to the Supreme Court. "Oh, you think that's weird? Well, the US has 9 lifetime appointments to the Supreme Court. That's nine times more than Cheon Il Guk. The problem is, you're ignorant. That's why you think it's so weird." "Ahh! The King's actually not that weird. Having 9 Supreme Court Judges for a lifetime is weird, in terms of the Kingdom." Okay, So, you got to know the US Constitution, and you got to know Cheon Il Guk Constitution.

Matthew 25:34 Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

So look, they have a big problem. They know Jesus is going to come back. They know when he comes back, he's going to rule with the Rod of Iron. In their mind, he's going to be like a despot; he's going to be like a tyrant. That means a tyrant, okay. The Bible says, "smite the nation. Smite the nations as a potter's vessel is smashed. You're talking about some violence, baby. You're talking about some violence. You're talking about some force, force, force coming; so, the Christians know that. They know the Scriptures saying, "Okay Jesus is going to come back. Yes, he's going to come back on the clouds. He's going to smite the nations with a Rod of Iron, yes; so, yes, okay;" but, they have a big problem now, because they love democracy. They love Western civilization. They love their freedom. They actually don't want to live under a tyrant, Jesus; but, they can't say that, or they'll be called unfaithful. You see this problem in the psyche of the modern Christian? They don't know how Jesus will look at this?

From the foundation of the world. What does the Bible say? The Kingdom will be like a New Jerusalem. Like a new Eden; so, we know how God ruled in Eden. He was not a tyrant; so, when he comes back, and when he rules with a Rod of Iron, will it be a tyrannical rule? Well, most Christians don't want to admit it, but they believe it. They believe that it will be, even though they don't want to admit it; and, they also admit that they don't want to live there, if they had a choice, okay. Only the Cheon Il Guk Constitution shows how the rule of Christ, and the believers as co-heirs with Christ, will be appointed as Judges in the Kingdom, will rule with the Rod of Iron; but, it will be ruled with sovereignty. There will be freedom, there will be responsibility, there will be free markets, there will be free association. Only the Cheon Il Guk Constitution explains that. There's not one Preacher on this planet that understands and teaches it. Not one. There are Preachers that teach about the Second Amendment, the US Constitution, why as Americans we should have arms. That's only one argument. I'm talking about in the Kingdom of God, I'm not talking about as an American citizen, I'm not talking about this or that country. I'm talking about in the Kingdom of God. See that? There's not one. Not one Preacher that's preaching about this. Not one in this whole world.

So, in Christianity, you'll hear every... Just watch Christian TV. You got to get use to the culture, okay. Some of you don't watch Christian TV, or you're not with Christian to deal with them all the time, it sounds weird to you when somebody says, 'God told me. God gave me this revelation to do this. God told me to do this.' You're thinking, especially if you come from a Catholic background or something like that, "God told you something? Isn't that supposed to go through the Pope, Cardinal, down to the Priest?" Right. So, it's kind of weird. So, you have to

get use to the Christian culture. So, if I say, "God gave me a revelation on the Rod of Iron," that's not weird. That's not strange. That's not weird. It's just that we're not in the Christian culture, so it seems weird, because you got no cognizant of the Christian culture. I mean, some of you do; but, most of you, or a lot of you don't, so you think that's weird. It's not. It's not that weird. God revealed to us the truth of the Rod of Iron, okay; and, of course, through the Cheon Il Guk Constitution, it is there for all to see.

So, let's go back to the Rod of Iron, and through our Scripture here. This is going to be on The King Mobile; and, I think we're getting The King Camo gun, this week; so, you're going to see some cool Rod of Iron camo on the jeep that Kook Jin Nim so generously donated to the peace police/ peace militia. Let's give it up for Kook Jin Nim. Oh, and he may, I'm not sure he released this to the public; but, he may release the Rod of Iron AR series rifle, okay, with the Bible quotes on it. Oh, Lord; but, I don't know. I don't know.

Rod of Iron: **Psalm 2:8 Ask of Me, and I will give you the nations for your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for your possessions. 9 You shall break them with a Rod of Iron; you shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel.**

There is a small remnant on this Earth. Ask God, that His nations will be covered with the Kingdom of God, and it's Constitution. God's promised, it's true. **I will give you the nations for your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for your possession.** In the Kingdom of God, in Cheon Il Guk, look at the Constitution. In the Kingdom of God, do you think Rev. Moon's crazy? Look at the Cheon Il Guk Constitution. Christian, if you think Rev. Moon is crazy, look at his fruit? **"You will know his tree by his fruit."** (Matthew 7;16) Look at its Constitution. You tell me, if you are a patriot, if you are a gun owner, if you are somebody who appreciates human rights, and sovereignty, free markets, free association, I'll be willing to bet you, if you appreciate those things as a Christian; and, you want to hound on Rev. Moon of being some heretic. You look at the Constitution, and you tell me if that's a bad fruit? You tell me, cause that fruit is more free, more sovereignty, more liberty, than even that which George Washington gave to you, or Thomas Jefferson, the founding fathers, you name it?

"You shall know a tree by its fruit." And look at the Cheon Il Guk Constitution; and, if they want to complain about the King thing, it's easy. All you'll have to understand is, the King is like a Supreme Court Judge that has a lifetime appointment; when, all the other Supreme Court Judges don't have lifelong terms, which is actually even better. The US has nine, okay. I said it a million times; but, when I say it again, it makes us remember; and, you can tell them. It's not really a big thing.

Earth for your possession. Look at that. Earth for your possession. That's not so you can be greedy, and say, "Yeah..." No. It's understanding sovereignty and private property. When you have private property, and somebody else is on their property, you respect their land. If you don't, you get shot. That's how you learn very quickly as a society, to respect other people's land, and respect them as a King or a Queen. Okay.

Verse 9, You shall break them with a Rod of Iron. Look at that. You shall break them. That doesn't sound so nice. That doesn't sound nice. **You shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel.** That doesn't sound too nice. This is why I'm telling you. This is why Christians just kind of pass over them, because when Jesus comes back, he's going to be like Fidel Castro or something. He's going to be like a freakin' tyrant. He is going to be scary to live under. They actually feel fear. If they are patriotic Christians, and they read these things, at some point, I'm sure they're saying, "Yeah, he's going to smite all the wickedness; but, after that, we have to live under a despot. Okay!" Alright. There's a big problem.

Revelation 2:27 AND HE SHALL RULE THEM WITH A ROD OF IRON, AS THE VESSELS OF THE POTTER ARE BROKEN TO PIECES, as I also received authority from My Father;

You can't get around it, if you're a Christian. You cannot get around the Rod of Iron. Stop trying to run away from it, Christian. You are running away from it. You can't run around. You can't run away. It's in the Scripture; and, it defines the way the Kingdom of God will be ruled. It will be ruled with a Rod of Iron. Ha, ha. Oow!

He shall rule them with a Rod of Iron, as the vessels of the potter are broken to pieces, as I also received authority from My Father; Whoa! Okay, so look: When Christians look at these Rod of Iron Scriptures, it terrifies them. It brings joy to them, because it seems to imply it's going to get rid of all the Hillary Clinton's and George Soros', and all that; so, they are like, "Yeah;" but, then, they're going to see that he's going to rule with a Rod of Iron, and like, "Oh, crap," you know. Inside. Conflict, conflict, conflict.

Revelation 12:5 And she gave birth to a son, a male child, who is to rule all the nations with a Rod of Iron; and her child was caught up to God and to His throne.

There you go again. Christ's Kingship, when it rules, it will rule with the Rod of Iron. Isn't that interesting? So, just think about it. Just think about: You never heard about, you never heard me preach, or something like that, and you just hear these Scriptures, how can you not believe that's it going to be some despotic, tyrannical Christ Kingdom? It seems like that what it's going to be like. It doesn't specify, but it seems like it, right?

Rule with a Rod of Iron: Revelation 19:15 From his mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a Rod of Iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.

Okay. There you go. **He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God.** So, there's this scary Rod of Iron rule, in the Kingdom that all Christians are supposed to be looking forward to. Do you see why these fake churches, and these fake glitterbug state run Pastors, and Catholic run, Vatican run Priests, don't teach this? Because it goes against Hollywood Jesus, and blond-haired, blue-eyed Jesus floating in robes, with classical music, choir music playing, as he's floating down. He will come down and smash you. Okay.

So, in the Kingdom Scripture, we're going to look at a couple of Scriptures. We don't have to do that one per service. Let us look at a couple, okay; so, these are the first time, in the New Testament that the Kingdom of Heaven, or the Kingdom of God, or Kingdoms in general come out.

So here you see in **Matthew 3:2 And saying Repent ye, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand**. That's not Jesus, that's John the Baptist. That's the John the Baptist; and, in that Chapter, John the Baptist, he's talking about remember? "After me, I'm not one worthy to kiss his sandals." Remember this? And he will baptise you with the Holy Ghost and with fire. He said, he will baptise you with the Holy Ghost and with fire. Okay, let me ask you a question, Did Jesus baptise people in water, or did he put them into a burning furnace? So, Jesus would actually baptise you with the Holy Ghost and with fire. Just keep that in the back of your mind as we go on, okay?

Matthew 4:8 Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand.

The next Chapter in Chapter 4, where Satan tempts Jesus, and he's tempting him with the Kingdoms of the world, that's where it comes in, right here. The Kingdoms of the world. He tempts Jesus with the glory of all those things. Jesus, of course, defeats those things, and chases away the Devil; and, then he goes forth and says, "**Repent: for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand.**" He starts preaching the Kingdom.

So, you have within the normal minded Western Christian, a conflict. How will Jesus return? When he does, he going to come with the rule of Iron. He's going to use force. There's going to be a lot of force involved with his rule. A lot of force. Lots of force, okay. The Rod of Iron is tremendous force, okay; but, at the same time, how do we deal with that, with our understanding of Jesus as the God of love? How do you deal with that, when their experience in the Garden of Eden in Scripture as a God of love, and of giving freedom and responsibility? Do you see that?

Alright, let's go to this video. This is from NRA TV, and they are talking about the reciprocity of love. I saw this a couple of weeks ago. This video is about asking the Senate to vote for the right to conceal and carry a gun.

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year! Now, if you are not part of the gun culture, I'm telling you, you're going to feel like you're out of it; but, for people who are in the gun culture, you will know exactly what I'm talking about. So, what does that mean? That means, everybody has to start stepping up with their game. You have to enter into this community of protectors. You have to start becoming more familiar with firearms. You can't. There are so many Sanctuary people, who are still so far away from the Rod of Iron. You have to become more familiar with it. As you become familiar with it, with people that these kinds of folks will seem more normal to you. Right

now, because you're not part of the gun culture, a lot of you, these people don't feel normal to you; but, they are the real protectors of this country, you understand?

So, it's really essential, especially as God is leading us to work closer and closer with the Abel type evangelical community, which are the true strong patriots, the real Alpha men and women of the nation; and, that is the gun owning gun community conservative Christian; and, they are the ones more than anybody, who are more worried about losing their freedoms than any neocon Paul Ryan, fake brown-haired, blue-eyed politician. They do not want to lose their rights. Of course, they're the kind of people who say, "from my cold dead hands," right. Those are the kinds of people; but, if you don't understand that culture, that's a warrior culture, if you don't understand that kind of culture, it's because you're not a warrior. You're not in the warrior culture. You have to step into it. Come to peace police/ peace militia training, where you learn not only empty hand combat, knife combat, do firearms training, not only that, you learn a culture. That's what's important. Don't worry, you won't get hurt, or something like that. It's just part of it. You're learning a culture of being a protector.

Remember, Father's not always in a suit and business tie. Most of the time, he's on dirty fishing boats, hanging out with total, you know, commercial fishing men. These kind of people, we would consider as blue-collar workers, the furthest thing we consider from Father; but, that's because you don't attend him. You may have seen him at an event, and then he goes away behind the curtains, and then you don't see him for a couple of months. Where's he going? He's gone straight to the fishing place, with the chum chums, and the guys. They open and carry, these guys who are driving the boats around. These are the kind of people that he's around.

You know, when we go to Alaska, they all got their pistols. Their .44 magnums on their side, you know what I'm saying; but, you guys were not part of that. I'm telling you, you have to understand this about Father's culture. These were the folks that he was around all the time. These are the people that he spent time with, and in nature, practicing and training with, okay.

So, it's a very important part of his life, and his real historical life, that we were separated from, because we had to do is show up at some kind of convention, or something. So, for example, if Shot Show is coming up, you want to learn about the gun community, come to Shot Show. You know, do a little traveling, go to Las Vegas, whatever. Go to Shot Show. See that whole community. You'll be shocked. The first time I went to Shot Show, I was thinking, "Holy shemitah. Whoa! It's shocking." We'll be flying from Geneva, and we'll be flying right back to Shot Show, okay; and, the King Mobile, the Rod of Iron Camo Mobile will be there; so, I will be driving it around town, talking with those guys with guns, and talking about the Rod of Iron ministry, and all that stuff, okay; and, then will be driving back, okay. So, if you guys want a little break from the cold, get out there. Listen, will meet out there. Get some CB radios in your jeep, and will do some forty days in the wilderness, in the desert. Oh, Gregg and Tim, they're pulling their hair out, okay. Don't tell them that. We won't do forty days. We'll do four days. "Oh, thank God."

So, we have to understand this culture, okay; so, look, every week I'm going to be talking about this kind of culture, folks. You got to mentally prepare, especially you ladies. I know, cause a lot of you are not in this culture. You got to mentally prepare. I'm saying, the King's going to be talking a lot about this kind of stuff. I'll be showing things that seem kind of foreign; but, actually these are the kind of people that Father hung around, okay. They're the real, honest kind of alpha male types that will stand up to evil, okay. They're not these little glitterbug Preachers. These little, "Oh, you have to love me." These are the kind of guys that Father spent his life with, okay.

So, Father is not like he is in the conventions, when you see him with a suit on. He dresses up for these events. Normally, he's out getting dirty on the fishing boat, and in the mountains when he was younger. When he was young, in the mountains, you see all these pictures of him hunting with the pigs, and with the ducks, and all that. He's out there. He's out there. Do you understand? This is why you have to understand Father's culture. His has nature around him. You have to inherit that, because as inheritors of the Kingdom, we have to have that; and, our families have to have that. It builds not only character, it builds honesty, patience. It builds learning how to deal with tribulations, and things you don't want. Anybody, who's spent anytime outdoors, you know you can't control the weather. You got to be prepared for it. Right?

Okay, so, now let's go to this. Now, what I'm about to tell you is going to sound totally wacky to some of you; and, it's going to sound wacky, because you're not in the gun community, okay. That's what I'm saying. It's very important for us to make that step, especially because these are the real Abel-bodied Christians; and, when they come to meet us, and know us, we can't just talk about like we like guns. We have to be part of the community. You got to be real about it. I'm real with them. I'm not. I've not been totally involved in the gun community. I'm a more recent member of the gun community; so, I'm still learning, and I'm still trying to absorb as much as I can, and still training with high level Masters, as much as I can; but, I've been in combat arts for twenty years; so, I understand what it means to do combat, okay. Gun fighting, and gun martial arts, that's more recent for me; but, it's still combat arts.

Now, if you didn't have this kind of history, you're not going to understand that. It's going to feel very foreign to you, okay; and, that's why peace police/ peace militia training is so important; and, anybody who comes, come on. You know even in their fifties or sixties, you don't get hurt. Come on, we keep it very safe for you. We keep everybody safe. Nobodies running on ego, okay; and, everybody stays safe, right? It that true? Okay, great.

So, I know some of you are still scared, are still chickening out. I'm telling you, what's good for you, is good for your family, is good for the whole nation of Cheon Il Guk. Okay, you come, you still going to get beat up a little bit. That's okay; but, you're going to get stronger. You're going to break out a lot of the delusions you have about yourself. That's a very important right of passage you need to go through. To be a responsible person, okay. Alright.

So, again, I'm going to warn you again, some of this stuff may sound crazy, but I'm telling you, when you become more a part of the gun community, especially if you start appreciating the

Rod of Iron, once you start appreciating the AR, if you really love your wife, your daughter, your children. You should appreciate that AR. Boy, I am really starting to appreciate that AR. If you love Grandma and Grandpa, and want them to defend themselves against a hoard of people, boy, it's very interesting, because I never had this experience. I had the experience maybe with swords, and stuff like that, cause people kind of generally, I guess, expect, especially if you trained with the real live swords, and stuff.

Some of the Samurai, you folks from Japan, you'll have no conscience of this, even though you didn't train with it, that there is like a spirituality connected to the sword, right? Am I right? Those from Japan? There's like a spirituality. There's a respect. You bow to your sword, actually, before you practice in some schools, and things like that. Obviously, we don't want to do that. We don't want to worship the item. I mean, you don't want to worship the item. They're coming from an animistic religion; so, they believe there's an actual spirit inside the metal. There's a spirit. Obviously, as a Christian, we don't believe that; so, we are not going to be bowing at our weapon and stuff like that; but, there is the idea that this weapon, which can give and take life, has tremendous power, and must be revered. There's all types of ceremony built in and around it, right, to take it what? through the generations to teach the new generations that you have to be serious when you're dealing with this kind of power. You can't play around, right. Is that right? You can't muck around, when you're dealing with something dangerous. You cannot muck around. You have to have some level of maturity; so, you deal with it with maturity, right?

That's why they have in the military, when they do the color presentations, the presentation of firearms. You know, when they come up, and they'll do a ceremony, and they'll shoot into the air, or shoot into the ground, whatever it is. Different nations will have different ceremonies, but similar. The idea is that their establishing the presentation of the colors for that nation. We will fight and die for this flag, right? Who's seen this? Everybody's seen this, right? You go to the Philippines, I've seen it in the Philippines. I saw the presentation of the colors, obviously in Korea, many times. Okay, so it's not only Americans who does this. Every nation does it, okay. Will also have the presentation of the colors in some of the upcoming ceremonies in February as well. There's going to be a color guard. There's going to be also a presentation of the colors with the Rod of Iron. Let's give some encouragement for our color guard, everybody. Hey, you guys got to practice up. You guys know who you are, okay.

So, it is important for us to understand that the Rod of Iron is the best way for somebody who is weaker, less physical stature, maybe older, even handicapped, that has some major disadvantage towards somebody else. It's like, in the world of empty hands martial arts or combat, Brazilian Jiu Jitsu did that for the smaller person. The smaller person, who is less athletic. The smaller, lighter, weaker, through technique, could create leverage, which would allow them to defeat a larger untrained opponent, right? Now, this normally could not happen, if you just do wrestling, if you just do boxing striking arts. The bigger man would almost always win. Almost always win, right?

So, it's only when the Brazilian Jiu Jitsu thing came up on the stage in the late 90s, early 2000s, with the UFC, and the Helio Gracie family, etc. They beat everybody. 250-60 pound giants. The

140 pound Gracie brothers, you know, they couldn't punch for anything. Boy, you should have saw them when they fight. They had the worst striking in the world. Like in the world; but, they are destroying all these people; so, it was shocking to see such a small person in real life fighting destroy these larger opponents. Very shocking. Professional Olympic wrestlers they were beating, right. They were beating Olympian Judo players. They were beating Muay Thai World Champions, who could kick your head off, right; so, this was shocking to the whole martial arts world that a smaller man; but, if you think about it, everybody wants that in their heart, because our kids are small. They're vulnerable. Smaller people are more vulnerable, generally, right. So, who is generally smaller than big men? Obviously, smaller men. Women are generally smaller than men, right? And also, children are smaller. Instinctually, we want the smaller person to be able to defend themselves, if you are are good person. If you're an evil psychopath, then you want to prey on the small people, right? But, if you are generally a good hearted person, you want the small person to be able to defend themselves. Is that true? At some point, your kids will be small. They're just not going to come out big like the Brunhofer boys over there. That's got to be painful, if they come out that size. Does that make sense? So, instinctively, we want the small person to be able to defend themselves.

It was amazing. The first time you got to see people of lesser stature, weaker, less athletic, non-professional Muay Thai Champions, who are jacked-up, and they are just like striking beasts, professional shoot boxers, and huge Olympic wrestlers; and, you saw the smaller man, through technique, and the guy came out with a Japanese kimono, and was beating these guys up. He was a Brazilian guy. What the heck. Who are these guys? They're choking out all these guys. They're like, what the heck is this? Okay.

So, that revolution, but think about it. You have that instinct that you want people who are smaller to defend themselves; and, you're happy when that happens. You kind of root for that person, who's the underdog. You root for that person, who is that small person. You want them to be safe. You see your daughter, or you see your wife, and they are smaller than you; and, you want to save them. It's a natural instinctual desire, right. You have to that. You should have absolutely. You should be the biggest gun fan, because what gives that small person way more power than than the most dangerous Gracie brother, than the most dangerous John Jones MMA fighter, the most dangerous knife fighter, you name it, that small person, who is less skilled, less trained, less athletic, less stature, less weight, has no chance against somebody who is trained and big, right? Does that make sense. So, if you really have the instinct to want to protect people in general, you know, small people, you want them to be safe, then you should be the biggest gun fan, because, it is the only item that allows you to relatively and quickly completely equalize all the disadvantages.

So, see, this is what, if you're not part of the gun community you don't understand. In the gun community, the fundamental principle of wanting to spread the gun culture is love for other people. That's the reason why they want to spread gun culture. The reason why I'm pushing you, and all on the internet, is to unlock this epigenetic. Step into this culture. We want you to be able to defend yourself, because as a sovereign person in Cheon Il Guk, as a King and Queen,

that is essential that we are in that culture, that we know that culture, that we pass that culture down. Does that make sense?

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand. 18 And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishers. 19 And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. 20 And they straightway left their nets, and followed him. 21 And going on from thence, he saw other brethren, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets, and he called them. 22 and they immediately left the ship and their father, and followed him.

Okay, so, Jesus, he's now preaching the Kingdom, and he goes out. Does he go to the Roman aristocrats? Did he go to the Rulers of his area? Did he try and go visit, "Hey, I want to talk to Herod; or, I want to talk to the Ruler here. I want to talk to the Prelate." Where'd he go? He went down to the humble man. The fisherman. A marine hunter. That's what a fisherman is: a marine hunter, a water hunter. That's what a fisherman is. Did you know that?

Did you know that fishermen are water hunters? Did you know that? I don't know why they divide up hunting and fishing. They're both hunting. Why do they divide them? They're actually the same thing, isn't it? You're catching these animals. Whether it's waterborne, or on the land, it's the same thing. It's just that they look different to humans. I guess that's why. Different techniques; but, these are people, who are involved in life and death, folks. Remember, we talked about this? When you come into the warrior community, whether that's combat empty hand arts with Jiu Jitsu or MMA, that's like knife fighting arts. Whether it's gun fighting arts, you enter in, and you start commiserating with a whole bunch of alpha warriors.

Now, they may be nice. They're very kind, they're loving, they're patient, they're nice to their wife, they take their kids out, all that sort of thing; but, they are deadly, right? If people who don't know that before you come in, you don't know, you're judging people based on how they look. You don't realize there could be some really nasty guys. They just look like normal dudes, right. If you're not in those communities, you're not one of them. Trust me, you're not one of them. So, come into that community. You see what I'm saying? Come into it, and become one of those. Does that make sense?

Jesus goes to the fishers, the people who are actually dealing with life and death. They are water hunters. Now, when you're hunting, you have to deal with life and death. You have to deal with life and death. You have to kill things to provide that food, or that supply, whatever. You have to take life to survive; and, having dominion. That's why Father was in those arts, the arts that he practiced. He doesn't play soccer, even though he likes soccer; but, he didn't he himself didn't play it, right? He doesn't go around. That's not his thing. You don't see him on the basketball court playing with them. We have one picture of him shooting a hoop; but, that's about it. It was literally one time, do you understand? There was a picnic on the old house tennis place; there was a basketball hoop, and everybody was having a picnic, and the kids

were playing basketball; so, Father said, "Give me that;" and, he shot one hoop. But, don't be diluted, he's some kind of basketball freak. He's not. The sport that Father's involved in involves life and death.

Now, it's interesting, the people who involved with the sports who are involved with life and death, do they tend to be more liberal, or do they tend to be more conservative? Isn't that interesting? Your lifestyle, what you give your life to, certain sports, create more conservative people. Isn't that interesting? Right? Why? Because, you have to do the dirty work yourself. You can't, like a liberal, tell somebody else to do it. Get a big government to do it, and feel like your a virtuous signaling good person. Pretend to tend a virtue. You have to get down, and you have to kill it. You have to skin it. You have to gut it. You have to get down and dirty. If you practice combat arts, you have to choke the other person. You can't have somebody else do it for you. Okay, does that make sense?

So, it makes you have to do things you usually would consider dirty; but, by doing those things, you actually become stronger. That's the irony of it, by doing these things. Of course, it's better to think about why we're doing this. It's even better, because it helps you grow faster. If you just do it unthinkingly, you may not get all that benefit; but, if you it cognizant of what you're doing, of what epigenetics you're trying to do, the purpose of why you're doing such a thing, it will help you grow through those processes, through those episodes of challenges, so to speak.

But, Jesus goes. He's attracted to, when he starts preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, he is attracted to the fishermen, or the hunters. They're marine hunters. He's attracted to those who are practicing life and death. Somehow, he feels they will connect with him in a different way. Now, of course, I know there's a tax collector who comes up; but, look who he reached out to first, okay? He reached out to the people who are in these kind of dirty business, right? Butchering. Hey, you got to butcher when you fish. You got to gut, you got to clean them out. It's a type of butchering, is it not? It's just a different animal. It's a type of butchering, okay.

So, somehow the Lord felt that these people would resonate with him a little more. Now, if you look at how the Family Fraud even became, it became so elitist. It became so far away from these kind of people. It became so, "I'm in the UN building. Oh!" This kind of crap. It's ridiculous. "Oh, we had even had pie in there," It's ridiculous. Think about how far. "Oh, that's Father's thing. Oh, yes. You get on the boat. Okay." They try to stay as far away from the boat or blood as possible. Is that not true? Come on.

Most of the Family Frauders. Even when Father was here , we tried to stay as far away from that boat with an eight mile, ten mile pole. "Oh, that's Father's thing. Okay, yeah! He's praying." It was their inability to understand, or even reflect on why he's doing that. What kind of culture that builds; and, I'm sorry, if you're not in those cultures, you won't be able to appreciate what kind of people they build. Your just going to think, blue collar workers. They're kind of stinky, and smelly, and they do dirty work. There kind of deplorables, right; and, this is how to become. A lot of the ladies in the Church became like that, is that not true? Woo, yeah, you girls. Ladies,

I'm not gonna let you get off the hook. This is Father's culture. It's not only that. It's the same within Father's family, too. The same with the Han Mother.

Think of how different it would be if she embraced, and was passionate about the arts he was teaching. She was alongside teaching women how to hunt; maybe, she was taking out teams to go and get that proper training, boy, that would be totally different, instead of going out for a little photo op and coming back in. Think about it. She was leading teams to go hunting, when he was hunting, or fishing, then she's with other people fishing, she's learning from hunters, think of how different that kind of woman would be? Whoa. Think of how different of an impact that would have on the entire Church. Hmmm.

You see, folks, it's again, this is why Cheon Il Guk comes down to freedom and responsibility. We have to live the lifestyle, too. I'm talking about these kinds of things that Father did. They have to be part of our lives. You can't just come to service, and hear on the internet, hear me talking about it. This has got to be a part of your life. This is the King of Kings culture. We can't lose it, because they're such precious things you pass down through these arts to your children that are much more valuable than this stupid brainwashing they get in Marxist run Professor schools, with useless degrees. Two hundred thousand dollars in debt. Okay. We cannot lose these traditions.

There was something is these kind of men that attracted Jesus to them. I'm not saying you can't be a jeweler. I'm not saying you can't be an artist. I'm not saying you can't have a business. I'm not saying you be, whatever the heck it is. You can do all that; but, also, embrace the culture. Challenge yourself at least to be a part of the culture. These communities of the Lord of the Second Advent, his Kingship. Join us for the training of BJJ, MMA, and knife fighting, and firearms. Join us, and then you become a part of those communities, do you see what I'm saying? Join us for our bushcraft survival training things, and sleep out in -27° weather. Just do it safely, okay. Alright. Join us for that. We had couple of these big guys join us for that last year. Remember, we had -27, Lowell. Gregg, I think, was there, too. -27. Wowwee, that'll get you going. Okay.

And this is hard, now for the guys, I know; but, girls this is even tougher. It's totally against your nature. That's why I'm totally proud of the Queen, because she's stepping up. Everybody knows it's not her favorite thing to do, especially bushcraft, and outdoors, sleeping on leaf piles, and bugs all over, and crap. She hates that like any girl does, okay; but, she did it. She slept on a super shelter on just leaves, in an emergency shelter. How many girls can say that they did that? Some of the Ninjas did that. Christina did that. Some of the Korean girls back there did it. Right. There's something about these kind of folks, this type of culture, that Jesus identified. That's the first people he reached out to.

Straitway they left their nets following him, etc. Now, let's look at this next Scripture down here. This is **Verse 23, Qne Jesus went about all Galilee teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.**

How do you satisfy the nature of the rule of the Rod of Iron, because the Christians have to believe that Jesus, when he returns, it's still Jesus, even though he has a different name . It's still the same God, okay. It's not some different thing. It's the same God, who's returned. Does that make sense? He just has a different name. Revelation 3:12, okay.

So, this was his nature. Jesus went, and wherever he went, he also healed. He also healed; but, how do you negotiate that as a Christian, who has to believe that Jesus will come back, and rule with a Rod of Iron; but, yet Jesus was a healer. He was also a God of love, even though he was strong, and chased out the moneychangers and kicked over their tables, etc? How do you negotiate all this in your mind? You don't as a Christian. You don't. You just pass it over. Jesus will come one day. Praise God, okay. You don't negotiate in your mind. You don't try to make sense of it, because you can't; but, when you understand the Lord of the Second Advent, when you understand the Cheon Il Guk Constitution, which is the fruit of the Lord of the Second Advent, then you can understand how the rule of the Rod of Iron will heal the land. Yes, the rule of the Rod of Iron will heal the land. Isn't that interesting.

If you look at a society, and you see violent crime, rape, pillaging, theft, breaking and entering, murder, double homicides, all those things we see as sicknesses in society. Yes or no? So, in society, when you have super elites that believe that they have to go through these universities, to then be able to rule everybody, and to make these laws for everybody, and then they'll solve all issues, they always make what? Hell on Earth. Hell on Earth. Hell on Earth. Case in point, Chicago, and what is it, Detroit has the highest homicide rate. Baltimore. You go to those cities, it's literally a lake of fire, and demons, they're running around with pointed tails and horns. Don't be stupid. But it means, relatively, to the other places who are allowed to defend themselves, it is way more dangerous, and way more evil is allowed act with impunity. That means, for people who don't understand that word, they could act freely. Bad guys can do whatever the hell they want, and there's no punishment. That's what freedom acting with impunity means, okay; but, when people, good people, have the rule with the Rod of Iron.

Now remember, Christ says, he comes back, and Christ says, Christians, you have to be coheirs with Christ. You can't just be slaves and dulows, just like John Macarthur teaches you in his church. He teaches you, you have to be a slave to Christ. On some levels, yes, that's true; but, on another level, you first of all have to be a coheir with Christ in the Kingdom. He kinda forgot that part. You have responsibilities that an heir to the Kingdom would have. He will appoint you as Judges. That's what the Bible says. You will not be on welfare in the Kingdom. You will not get free things from Jesus. You will get responsibility from Jesus. Now, I know I'm talking to you; but, I'm also talking to Christians that are watching, okay, or that are joining us here.

Jesus ruled with a Rod of Iron. When you understand that, and what that means, and that he will appoint the citizens to also be Kings and Queens to have coheirship and responsibility over the nation, and if Christians understand that, ahh, that what the Rod of Iron is. That's how a loving God, a loving God, who is a father, who wants to protect his children, with the bestowing

of the responsibility with the Rod of Iron, heals the social ills of that land. Stops predators from doing evil, and feeding on those who are vulnerable. That's called some he-a-l-ing! That's called some healing. That's something to get your Holy Ghost fire, shooting and ahallaring, and jumping up and down, Holy Ghost swaying, that is something to get excited about. How about the Holy Ghost with on? Okay.

The rule with the Rod of Iron is not a scary rule, it's not a despotic rule. It's goes against the nature of Jesus. It goes against the nature of God in Eden, etc; but, when the Body of Christ can understand, that it means that you and me, good people, have the authority of the Kingdom of the Rod of Iron, have the power of the Rod of Iron over life and death, dominion - I like that - dominion, subdue, and have the Earth as your possession, the wicked ones of the world will have to fear. They have to fear.

Look at this? In **Verse 24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.**

Isn't that interesting? Violently eradicating demons from people. You take that to the national level. Violently, if you have to in self-defense, not offensive, eradicating predators, if they are seeking to kill and destroy. That's literally like an exorcism on the national level; and, that happens enough in the neighborhood. People learn about that. Criminals learn about that. That if they go into that Grandma's house, they gonna go to Spirit World. Isn't it interesting how they don't go to Grandma's house anymore? Isn't that an interesting phenomena? Absolutely ridiculous.

It should be common sense. In the Kingdom, it will be common sense, cause everybody from a young age will be in peace police/ peace militia training. You'll have already trained in combat arts. You'll have already broke through delusions. You'll already know your not Wonder Woman or Superman. (microphone and lights start flashing) You alright, tech team. Yeah, we're good. They trying to stop this at all cost. I'm chastising the Body of Christ; and, I'm chastising the Christians. Stop being a glitterbug preaching Christian. Read your dang Bible. Get ready for the rule with the Rod of Iron, and His Kingdom to come. The rule with the Rod of Iron is not a scary place. It's only scary place for bad people, okay. It's a bad, bad day for the wolves. It's a great day for good people. Absolutely great.

Let me show you these real case scenarios. Real case scenarios, okay. This is from a cancer survivor. Five home invaders. Five dudes in the middle of the night, who tried to come in on this woman. Look at this. She's a 34 years old cancer survivor. 34 years old. Who's 34 here? Who's near 34? Oh, they don't want to show their age. You see that. Golly! Dietta's a 34 years old cab driver from Detroit, okay. She was asleep. She wasn't doing anything violent. She was sleeping. She was sleeping in her own home, trying to get some rest for the next day, okay. Just an innocent person, just trying to get rest for the next day. When she heard a cat on her bedroom window just before 3:00 AM, she pulled back the curtain, saw a man with a gun standing there.

As he was coming through the window, Gueye managed to grab a Glock and fired four shots. The suspect fled, but not before shooting Gueye once in the thigh. Had she not had her concealed carry gun, things could have ended much worse; and, they don't tell you that four other guys were coming in, too.

What would you have done, girls? What would you have done? You got four or five guys coming into your apartment, and you're there alone. What would you do? This is a normal person; but, she had the power of the Rod of Iron; so, five criminal males with bad intent, with criminal intent, breaking and entering into this woman's house, fled at a power. Not her power, cause she's a weak 34 years old girl. Physically, probably weak; but, she had something, which gave her more power. She had an equalizer; and, what happened when a good person had that, who's trying to get a better business, a good person had it, look what happened? Five criminals with criminal intent had to run. They had to run. They could not stay. Do you see? Okay, she had scary episode, yes. She had to have a fighting spirit, yes. She had to have the wherewithal to grab the gun, and try to shoot at them, yes; but, everybody has some stress in their life, and it's better than dying or being raped by five men, wouldn't you say? Ahh, you see.

Check out this other story. [Armed Citizen Saved Rookie Cop Being Beaten With Police Baton.](#) This incident began when Officer Adam Eller and Sgt. Michael Lambert of the Oklahoma City Police Department responded to a burglary call. The two suspects involved are brothers Tremaine and Jermaine Williams. Tremaine had already taken off by the time the officers arrived, but Jermaine was still there and fled the scene when he spotted the officers. Eller and Lambert gave chase and became separated. Eller caught up to Jermaine in a driveway in a nearby home, but when he tried to arrest him, Jermaine managed to grab Eller's baton and started hitting him over the head with it between six and twelve times. (Now, that's like being hit with a small baseball bat. Do you know how hard a baseball bat is? Remember that. What are you going to do? Bong! Bong, bong, bong! Right. Think about it.) 6 to 12 times. That's when a nearby armed citizen witnessing the fracas approached with his gun drawn, and told Jermaine he would open fire if he did not stop hitting Eller. Both suspects were arrested and the officer recovered from his injuries; and, of course, he went on to thank those guys, tell them they were heroes, and he was saying he would have probably died if he kept being pummeled in the head with a baton. It's a wooden baton, folks,

How come the Body of Christ does not understand the Rod of Iron? They can't. To them, the Lord of the Second Advent didn't return. Only those who know the Lord. In the Prayer today, John Raucci prayed about that. It's only those who know the Lord of the Second Advent, and know his tradition, his Kingship, his Constitution. We are the ones who understand how God will rule with a Rod of Iron, with love, with ethics, with jurisprudence, but where good people will have power over the wicked.

So, get ready folks. We're going to be talking a lot about this subject, okay; so, it's going to help you, if you take gun classes, you join the community, you bring people who are your friends, who are gun shooters, or whatever. They'll understand exactly what we're talking about out

here. They may educate you. They may tell you, "Hey, I know that Rod of Iron stuff," Right. These are the Abel type people that God in 2018 are bringing to his Providence towards.

You are separating from **the original ideal of creation**. When you say, somebody else should do it, what if there's a ladies group meeting, and you went to an Indian restaurant buffet or something, and some dude comes in and shouts in Jihadi, "I'm going to shoot you all up;" and, now there is nothing you can do about it? What if you're the only person that God put there who'd be ready?

Now, if there was someone in that whole group of women who were armed, and they know how to use the Rod of Iron, hey, that's even better. The Jihadi's going to go down faster. That episode will bring wickedness down. But, who knows, you may be the only person, the only woman, the only young man or girl who's there, that God put you there, to stop some bad thing just like that in the restaurant, that got shot, the Mexican Restaurant that got shot up.
