In his sermon on Sunday, Hyung Jin Nim discussed how popular culture trains young people in a narcissistic bubble, which leads to delusional thinking and the destruction of society. The consequences of reacting emotionally are not good. Have strong people who can check you. Our value comes from inheritance, more than money and wealth.

Biblical scriptures do not predict a democracy. Rev 19:15 says that the returning Christ will "rule with a rod of iron." He comes in judgment, but not as a despotic ruler. We must rule with the spirit of God and the ethics of God. We must emulate His righteousness.

He showed an NRATV video by Dom Raso, who calls for local communities to organize local militias, to establish communication trees, to talk about risks, and coordinate with local police. It's not just about personal protection, but about protection on the community level.

Basic virtues are even more important when you have power and authority. The need for a correct motivation and attitude is expressed in 2 Timothy 1:7, "God has not given us the spirit of fear, but of power, and of love and of a sound mind."

Hyung Jin Nim emphasized the right to protect, but also the need for safety. Each us of must move from being a "sheep" to being a "sheepdog." The goal is to build a culture of peace through strength. The Peace Police Peace Militia does not seek fights. In the Sermon on the Mount recorded in Matthew 5, Jesus talks about traits needed for a good, benevolent society. We must be guided by a disciplined mind and by love, so don't get upset when someone insults you. Learn the process of de-escalation.

Even though not a Christian, philosopher and cultural commentator <u>Stefan Molyneux</u> recognizes how Christianity teaches about the inherent potential of humans to be corrupted by power, which is why a separation of powers is needed. It is the foundation of Western civilization.

Hyung Jin Nim urged us to not be overly sensitive to harsh words. Brush them off! He spoke about gender differences. For most of human history men were hunters who spoke to each other side by side.

Let's get the job done! Women have much more face to face communication and tend to be much more sensitive to emotions. Men like to tease each other with playful putdowns and "insults."

Through Peace Police Peace Militia training women learn there are good men who are protectors, not predators. They learn to become attracted to an alpha male, not to someone they can dominate. Good men don't want to dominate their wives either. Unlike feminist teachings that marriage is about a struggle for power, Christian marriages should seek to work together as a couple.

In the Kingdom, your reputation will suffer if you break God's commandments and teach men to do so. The free market rewards fairness and honesty. The Kingdom is guided by Judeo-Christian teachings. During Jesus' time, the Scribes and Pharisees were colluding with the oligarchy. It's not that hard to exceed their righteousness, just being a decent person, you will do fine.

Jesus taught us not to be angry with each other or call each other abusive names. Even if we do not agree with everyone, we can still work together. Don't pick fights without a serious public purpose. Otherwise people will see that it is you who have a problem.

Women should want to build up men as protectors of the nation. How you treat your marriage reflects on your character as a person. Jesus said do not divorce except for cause of adultery. Pray for your enemies to be saved, delivered from evil, and turn from their wicked ways. The Rod of Iron culture is centered on Judeo-Christian values, not just a tribal standard.
