Mark 14:18 And as they sat and did eat, Jesus said, Verily I say unto you, One of you which eateth with me shall betray me. 19 And they began to be sorrowful, and say unto him one by one, Is it I? And another said, Is it I? 20 And he answered and said unto them, It is one of the twelve, that dippeth with me in the dish. 21 The Son of man indeed goeth, as it is written of him: but woe man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! Good were it for that man if he had never been born. 22 And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake it, and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body. 23 And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them: and they all drank of it. 24 And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many. (bring that down just a little bit, guys. The next verse is off here. Hold on, hold on. Bring that down. Can you scroll that down a little bit? Yeah, it jumped off here. I can't read that next verse. Okay, there it is a little bit on this side. Let's check on this side.) 25 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day (What is that?) in the Kingdom of God.

Okay, tech team, you having a little trouble there? That's all that's in there. Oh, goodness. Okay. Well it's right there in the next verse; and, the Kingdom of God reference is right there.

Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.
