Independence Day & the Cheon Il Guk Constitution

July 4th, 2021

Let's go to Galatians Chapter 5: 1-6 and let's read together:

1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. 2 Behold, I Paul say unto you, that if ye be circumcised, Christ shall profit you nothing. 3 For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.

4 Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace. 5 For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. 6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

I like the translation that says, "yoke of slavery."

Now remember the controversy in the Early Church with the Petrine and Pauline factions was the whole issue of, "hey, because I'm circumcised and I was a Jew, I am holier than thou." So if you were a Jew and circumcised well somehow you were holier, and if you were uncircumcised then you were what's known as a gentile or somebody of the non-Jewish heritage.

The priestly role

We see the providential expansion from the Old to the New Testament. We talked about it when we were studying Leviticus, Deuteronomy and Numbers a couple of weeks ago, and you can see how God is moving the priesthood. He's not just keeping it into a specific tribe of Jews which would be the Levites, as He did in the Old Testament because they're still in the wilderness period, and still in the preparation for the messiah period.

After the Messiah had come, Jesus Christ came, the church now took on the priestly role and in the church you could be either Jew or gentile. See, that's the difference, because in the past if you're a gentile you cannot be a priest of God; you couldn't be a priest, plus you had to be of a specific tribe of Jews. But in the New Testament Age, you don't have to be from that specific tribe, nor do you have to be Jewish. You can be a gentile, somebody from a pagan background who's given their life to Christ, and received a calling to become a priest, to become a pastor, to become a minister, a prophet,

evangelist etc. Paul talks about the five- fold ministry and people focus on that, but in Romans he talks about the eight- fold ministry. So it's not like he just delineated the five-fold ministry.

But the point is: You didn't have to be from that particular Jewish tribe and neither did you have to even be Jewish; now you could enter into the priesthood, you could enter into becoming a teacher of the Gospel even though you had no connection to that.

Now in the Complete Testament Age -we talked about it recently- the establishment of God's Kingdom and Kingship has to occur on earth, then that priesthood is further decentralized because we know God is not centralizing power.

“Churchianity”

But in the modern age a lot of churches have been taken over by the state; they're translating and interpreting Romans 13 to mean complete subservience to the state, which is terrible; we deal with it all the time here in Sanctuary. Romans 13 says that everybody has to be obedient to the higher powers, but of course in America the higher powers are not government officials; the higher powers are what? It's the Constitution. (*Applause*) So all government officials have to be obedient to the higher power which is what? The Constitution!

We talked about this millions of times, but of course the statist and the government infiltrators of churches like Margaret Sanger, by the way who was a Democrat racist white supremacist, wanted to eradicate Blacks; so she started Planned Parenthood in the Black community to kill Black people and her stated aim as she said was, “*Go take over the churches; we have to take over the church.*” So, taking over the church is not a new idea; taking over the churches to eradicate the people and their connection with God is not a new thing.

The family as stable social unit

Anyway the point is: In the Completed Testament there is further decentralization: not only in the church where there's a specific category of priests or holy people, but now into the family. Because think about it: every civilization has a fundamental social unit. That social unit has to be as stable as possible for society to have freedom, economically, politically etc. You have to have a stable social unit and that unit of course is what? It's interesting because it's not the individual, because individual alone, if you don't reproduce for example will die off in one generation. The fabric of society is a family, a family of man and woman. How is that controversial in this hour folks? Man and woman! Hello, the fact that we have to actually say that, is crazy.

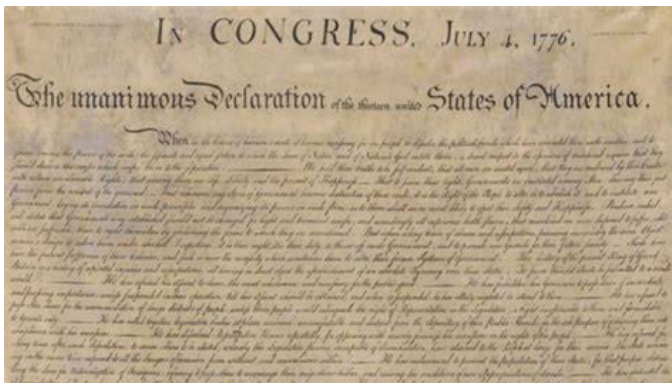
So you need to have a stable social unit. But look at what happened to the churches? One of our brothers called the church *churchianity*; I love that, because that's what it's become. It's just become *churchianity*; the church organization has taken over, and where it should be empowering the families to become priests and kings, many times it's taken that away. In the Kingdom it's further decentralized even away from organization and it goes to the fundamental unit of the society which is

the family; you have to have stability in the family. We've gone through all the studies; we've shown the statistics etc.

If you have dysfunctional families if you have a single mother for example and she's living with another man that's not the children's biological father, there's eleven times more child abuse; way higher rates for sexual abuse. So it's a big deal that society maintains its structure that comes like building blocks. When you build a Lego, if you build a big castle, a car or whatever, you build it up with the blocks; each of those blocks is supporting and holding up that thing. Society is the same. Individual families are very important because if they're dysfunctional, if they're broken, if they have eleven times more probability of child abuse, if they have a multiple times factor of sexual abuse; if they're ravaged with divorce which is one of the biggest traumatic thing for children, you see how this then starts affecting every portion of society?

The Declaration of Independence

Right now of course young people are being trained to think that the Founding Fathers are these white supremacists, you know hateful slave owners. Nobody denies that slavery is a sin; it is a sin. That's why in the end the Christian American community was the catalyst to end slavery worldwide, because we understood that it was a sin; it was a sin. And it's hinted at, in the Declaration of Independence which many times on July 4th, we don't read. So let's read it; I want to read it.



In Congress, July 4, 1776

The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America,

When in the Course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

*We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their **Creator** with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.--That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the*

governed, --That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and accordingly all experience hath shewn, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed.

But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security.--Such has been the patient sufferance of these Colonies; and such is now the necessity which constrains them to alter their former Systems of Government. The history of the present King of Great Britain is a history of repeated injuries and usurpations, all having in direct object the establishment of an absolute Tyranny over these States. To prove this, let Facts be submitted to a candid world.

He has refused his Assent to Laws, the most wholesome and necessary for the public good.

He has forbidden his Governors to pass Laws of immediate and pressing importance, unless suspended in their operation till his Assent should be obtained; and when so suspended, he has utterly neglected to attend to them.

He has refused to pass other Laws for the accommodation of large districts of people, unless those people would relinquish the right of Representation in the Legislature, a right inestimable to them and formidable to tyrants only.

He has called together legislative bodies at places unusual, uncomfortable, and distant from the depository of their public Records, for the sole purpose of fatiguing them into compliance with his measures.

He has dissolved Representative Houses repeatedly, for opposing with manly firmness his invasions on the rights of the people.

He has refused for a long time, after such dissolutions, to cause others to be elected; whereby the Legislative powers, incapable of Annihilation, have returned to the People at large for their exercise; the State remaining in the mean time exposed to all the dangers of invasion from without, and convulsions within.

He has endeavoured to prevent the population of these States; for that purpose obstructing the Laws for Naturalization of Foreigners; refusing to pass others to encourage their migrations hither, and raising the conditions of new Appropriations of Lands.

He has obstructed the Administration of Justice, by refusing his Assent to Laws for establishing Judiciary powers.

He has made Judges dependent on his Will alone, for the tenure of their offices, and the amount and payment of their salaries.

He has erected a multitude of New Offices, and sent hither swarms of Officers to harrass our people, and eat out their substance.

He has kept among us, in times of peace, Standing Armies without the Consent of our legislatures.

He has affected to render the Military independent of and superior to the Civil power.

He has combined with others to subject us to a jurisdiction foreign to our constitution, and unacknowledged by our laws; giving his Assent to their Acts of pretended Legislation:

For Quartering large bodies of armed troops among us:

For protecting them, by a mock Trial, from punishment for any Murders which they should commit on the Inhabitants of these States:

For cutting off our Trade with all parts of the world:

For imposing Taxes on us without our Consent:

For depriving us in many cases, of the benefits of Trial by Jury:

For transporting us beyond Seas to be tried for pretended offences

For abolishing the free System of English Laws in a neighbouring Province, establishing therein an Arbitrary government, and enlarging its Boundaries so as to render it at once an example and fit instrument for introducing the same absolute rule into these Colonies:

For taking away our Charters, abolishing our most valuable Laws, and altering fundamentally the Forms of our Governments:

For suspending our own Legislatures, and declaring themselves invested with power to legislate for us in all cases whatsoever.

He has abdicated Government here, by declaring us out of his Protection and waging War against us.

He has plundered our seas, ravaged our Coasts, burnt our towns, and destroyed the lives of our people.

He is at this time transporting large Armies of foreign Mercenaries to compleat the works of death, desolation and tyranny, already begun with circumstances of Cruelty & perfidy scarcely paralleled in the most barbarous ages, and totally unworthy the Head of a civilized nation.

He has constrained our fellow Citizens taken Captive on the high Seas to bear Arms against their Country, to become the executioners of their friends and Brethren, or to fall themselves by their Hands.

He has excited domestic insurrections amongst us, and has endeavoured to bring on the inhabitants of our frontiers, the merciless Indian Savages, whose known rule of warfare, is an undistinguished destruction of all ages, sexes and conditions.

In every stage of these Oppressions We have Petitioned for Redress in the most humble terms: Our repeated Petitions have been answered only by repeated injury. A Prince whose character is thus marked by every act which may define a Tyrant, is unfit to be the ruler of a free people.

Nor have We been wanting in attentions to our British brethren. We have warned them from time to time of attempts by their legislature to extend an unwarrantable jurisdiction over us. We have reminded them of the circumstances of our emigration and settlement here. We have appealed to their native justice and magnanimity, and we have conjured them by the ties of our common kindred to disavow these usurpations, which, would inevitably interrupt our connections and correspondence. They too have been deaf to the voice of justice and of consanguinity. We must, therefore, acquiesce in the necessity, which denounces our Separation, and hold them, as we hold the rest of mankind, Enemies in War, in Peace Friends.

We, therefore, the Representatives of the united States of America, in General Congress, Assembled, appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world for the rectitude of our intentions, do, in the Name, and by Authority of the good People of these Colonies, solemnly publish and declare, That these United Colonies are, and of Right ought to be Free and Independent States; that they are Absolved from all Allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection between them and the State of Great Britain, is and ought to be totally dissolved; and that as Free and Independent States, they have full Power to levy War, conclude Peace, contract Alliances, establish Commerce, and to do all other Acts and Things which Independent States may of right do. And for the support of this Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes and our sacred Honor.

(Applause) How hard was that to read on July 4th? It's tremendous.

Our modern day has made us obsessed with race. So the generation that's growing up, all they see is white men, all these white men gathered together, and they were slave owners; this is all they see. They were fighting the British who were white people too, and they were saying, "We're going to dissolve our relations with these people here who, by the way, owned hundreds of thousands of slaves around the world. The British Empire was a large slave trading organization, maybe not as big as the jihadi slave trade which was a sex slave trade, and has continued on since the 7th century, after Muhammad.

Two groups of human beings

But the point is: We are trained to see all this through race now, so we can't see the human person. Let's just take away the race, pretend the Founding Fathers they're not white, they're not Black; just let's forget it. It doesn't matter; they're just human beings. Take away the race, take away the whole equation of race in this discussion; you're going to see a totally different picture. You're going to see human beings resisting other human beings for a reason. They're resisting them, and there are long statements on why, as you can see, which sounds very similar to today; doesn't it? With the Left and Biden ruling over the states.

Take away all the race issue; we have human beings resisting other human beings.

*One group of human beings wants to have centralized government, one group of human beings wants to have Socialism, Communism, political Satanism type of centralized government; one group of human beings wants to centralize power.

*And then there's another group of human beings, our Founding Fathers - just take the racist stuff out of here, okay- another group of human beings are saying, "No!" They're holding on to something fundamental; they're holding on to a very foundational philosophical starting point. In apologetics, in the defense of Christian faith and Christianity and theism in general against atheists, we have fundamental philosophical starting points that we are trying to defend.

In the Declaration of Independence as you saw, many times they talked about the Supreme Judge of the universe, or they talked about our Creator from which our unalienable rights come from. These

are very fundamental starting points. These people, this group of human beings are not atheists; they're not post-modernists, they're not relativists, they're not saying, *"Well, there may be a God and there may not be a God; it may be polytheism, theism, deism, nihilism or none of those, and thus we hold these truths to be self-evident."* They're holding to a very strong perspective on God.

Abortion & Babylonian culture

In Scripture we see this all the time; God warns on the gods, the other anti-gods of the bible like Zeus, Moloch, Asherah, Baal; why? Because these gods are many times anthropomorphizations of wicked human desires, wicked human concepts, and they usually lead to child sacrifice. Baal worship was known, and it was emblematic of Baal worship to kill your children.

So, from a sociological perspective what is it doing? Just like abortion does today! Now put your sociology hat on; what does abortion do to a society? What does it allow? It allows what? If one is engaging in sexual intercourse -it should be done in marriage, amen - there is the risk of what? Pregnancy! As soon as sexual interaction happens between male and female -I have to qualify all the time - the risk of baby happens; pregnancy. Let's just put our sociology hat on, abortion does what? It takes away the responsibility of what? Sex! There are certain consequences to it, and that's why that power, that relationship is preserved for marriage where it can be done safely, and create a protected environment for the next generation of people. Everybody follows me on that?

It's the same thing: Baal leads his civilization to that type of thing. They don't have the abortion stuff where as soon as a baby's born then they're doing post-birth abortions which Governor Northam of Virginia supports. Oh yeah, Governor Northam of Virginia, who's a doctor by the way, was on a radio show, and he said, *"Well, we just keep them comfortable until the doctor and the mother decide."* That is a baby that is born and he's saying, *"Well, we'll keep it comfortable, and if they decide to terminate then we will terminate depending on the issuance of the doctor or the mother."*

You understand? So it's not like Governor Northam is very different from the Baal worship, is it? Because Baal worship normalized the practice of allowing a religious ritual, with many times a big cow or a bull or something like that with a big furnace and the kids were thrown into the furnace to kill them. So what is this doing? In this culture of licentiousness where there is not the institution of holy matrimony, consecration of a king and a queen or consecration of a priest and an evangelist in marriage, when there's none of that, it's just rampant animalistic behavior.

The Babylonian culture was famous for the fact that, as a young girl is hitting puberty, now she has to be given over to the temple prostitution. So you have Babylonian "families," not really families at all, are they? Giving over their children to the temple prostitution, so that in the great holy day of Babylon, strangers would come and defile and deflower that young girl! Are you with me, folks? That's traumatic; you're being raped, you understand? That is obviously a total destruction of family and the protection which godly family provides.

Any of these deities will lead the culture towards particular things which have different layers of impact. They have obvious spiritual impact: you're murdering your children; you're murdering

people who have not committed a crime. So obviously they have spiritual impact; they have spiritual repercussions, consequences. But also they have sociological consequences, don't they? Because if the society begins to practice these things and normalizes these types of behaviors, it's destroying the fundamental fabric or the building block of society, which should be committed man, woman, and children. Amen!

Asherah, Moloch; same thing! Moloch as well: these crazy people in Bohemian Grove have this ridiculous satanic liturgy with the big owl, and they do that ceremony that was captured on film by Alex Jones breaking in there twenty years ago. They're burning images of children like an image of a skeleton of a child, and they're burning that before the altar of Moloch; because these are ancient practices.

From the 1950s to our day

But what is Satan trying to do? Satan is trying to take away the consequences, the responsibility of the sexual relation, which should be only for the proper place of marriage. Anywhere outside of that, it becomes destructive; anywhere. As soon as society starts slipping to another direction, it starts destroying the fabric of that civilization.

Not all in one day, obviously it takes time, but within a few decades; you don't know what culture you're living in any more. I mean, think about it, folks: in the 1950s - which is not that far back, it's not actually that far back- folks that grew up in that age, when you dated a girl it was a totally different situation. You were not dating for sexual activity; you were dating for courtship or dating for marriage, and her dad was probably threatening you with shotguns and guns and you know healthy stuff like that. *"You'd better come back on time or you're going to have two bullets in your head, boy!"* Just to make that clear. *(Laughing)*

The point is: you had a civilization like that. Now, look at this: it's like animals; people behave like animals. They can't even decide what gender they are; that's how confused and deranged people have become! So in a couple of generations, you've seen a very different picture: let's say in the 1950s mommy, daddy in the home, children; father's trying to protect his daughter etc. So any boys, you'd better be aware; dad is not just giving her to all these predators. Like in the modern day if you're liberal you want to encourage your daughters to be sexually free because it shows your virtue. You understand? Do you understand this, people? You understand? We've come so far as a culture. And now you don't even have a unifying culture.

This is what they're trying to do: they're trying to destroy any allegiance to the flag; the Pledge of Allegiance is a racist statement. Now the flag itself is a racist thing. President Big Dawg over there, he's running the red, white and blue on his hat; that makes him a white supremacist bigot in support of colonialism and the hegemonic empire of colonialism! Are you with me folks?

I mean you literally went in your lifetime from a time when it was deeply shameful if you defiled that flag, deeply shameful; to now, when it's almost normal. You see the young people, they don't care. They think, *"It doesn't mean anything to me,"* because they've been separated from that identity. Do you understand: culture is very important!

That's why there is this infatuation about race, and they want to bring people back to this tribalism, as in prison. In prison the white gangs hang with the white gangs; white people are pushed into the white gangs, Blacks are pushed into the Black gangs, Asians pushed into the Asian gangs, and you can't intermingle. You can't, you'll get shafted; you get killed. That's just how it is in prison. So they want to bring us way back to that tribalism where you have that racial tribalism; which by the way Christianity destroys.

Their slaves became their brothers in Christ

Many of the earliest Christians who were for example owners of indentured servants; they would free them as soon as they found Christ. They would witness to their servants, free them and then they'd become brothers in Christ. This happened for example Korea; Korea was a Confucianist country. Father talks about this: in North Korea we had a burning of the whole country with the Gospel in the 1900s. I mean Father talked about it all the time; the Gospel was flooding through the whole country, because Koreans are very passionate. They've been slaves for five thousand years under the Chinese, in the modern day under the Japanese, but mostly under the Chinese and the Manchus, and the Mongols; invaded a thousand times, that's about an average of every five years they were invaded raped, pillaged and plundered and made into slaves. So Korean people kind of know what it's like to be a slave, okay, because of that history.

So when they heard the Gospel of Christ it was so liberating. It was like, *"oh my gosh, my status doesn't determine my value before this deity; whether or not I'm a bond servant or a slave, or if I'm an owner of slaves, or if I'm a landowner or I'm not a landowner, or if I have this job in government or if I don't have this job in government; that doesn't matter? You tell me that it doesn't matter? None of that matters? God loves me?"* You see what I'm saying? The Koreans were Confucianists but they were hearing this, and they could just start feeling the love of God like, *"Wow! I didn't know this could exist!"*

So in the early period when Christianity is starting to spread in Korea, it's the same kind of thing that's happening. Because Confucianism allows for having servants- the *yangbang* class was slave holders- but now they're freeing their slaves who are other Koreans. So it doesn't have anything to do with race; I mean they're Koreans enslaving other Koreans, and they're freeing them. The *yangbang* class was a slave- owner class, and there was a servant class under them; so they started freeing them. There are many famous stories about that. They're freeing their slaves and then their slaves are becoming their brothers in Christ. The landowner or the *yangbang*, the slave owner, he uses his place to minister to the Gospel and he witnesses to his slaves, frees them; they become his brothers and then a small Korean church is born. That's just one example.

But the point is: they want us to get into the whole racism nonsense, because they know Christianity liberates people from these tribalistic group identities; it pulls us out of those tribalistic group identities and ties us to the noble cause, the noble aim, the great story of God. Whether we're white, Black, Asian, it doesn't matter; you see?

Why the Declaration of Independence?

Let's think about the Founding Fathers: we've read the Declaration of Independence which is tremendous. There's no race involved there. There's nothing like, *"oh, the group of white people that are slave owners."* Just shut up for a moment, just think about them as human being; turn off that brainwashing for just a second, and just think about human beings resisting other human beings. Now they had vestiges of the tyrant human beings and their culture of slavery; they had vestige of that. That's why in the Constitution they provided all the elements to get rid of that.

But the point is: Let's just see them as human beings; human beings resisting that tyranny, making a declaration to another set of human beings, saying, *"Wait a minute, we've been constantly abused by you, using the force of government, sending troops to our door, threatening us, harassing us."* This is not just some school-bullying; there are guys with guns that are coming to those towns. You understand, folks? It's not just some kind of school playground bullying here; you understand? The redcoats were coming in with the equivalent of ARs at the time, and they're walking into town with their little wigs and their stockings and their freaking red coats. I wouldn't say the most intimidating style!

They're coming in with the guns and they're quartering themselves; people's houses are taken over, raided. *"What?"* They just bust into the house and you wake up one day and guys are in your house with the ARs or the muskets.

"What are you doing in my house?"

"Shut up, shut up, or I'll put you down!"

And you have all these lists of abuses. Then you have this one group of people saying, *"Wait a minute! This is too much. We have a different ideological starting point; you see, we believe we're made in the image of God."*

Why in 2,000 years, didn't Christians ever create America?

Because think about it: you had Christians 2,000 years before them; why didn't they ever create America? How come they didn't create liberty? It's called the Catholic Church; I know. But why did they not create liberty? They should have created liberty. That's God's gifts; we saw it in Galatians Chapter 5. Why did it take 2,000 years? You had Christians; you had people who believed in the Lord for 2,000 years. Well, how come America took 2,000 years? Why didn't it start early? It would have been nice to start early. Are you with me, folks?

But you have what is known as the centralization of Christianity, and the merging of Christianity with the state, which some of our brothers call *churchianity*, the merging of Christianity with the state.

What the Founding Fathers did, even giving people the freedom of religion and not establishing a religion that will dominate by law or by the government; that was a deeply Christian thing to do. The acknowledgement of human free will; it's a deeply Christian fundamental pillar of belief.

We're not like these determinists who believe that everything is determined, or these evolutionary determinists who believe that everything you do is already programmed by evolution; so every decision you make, everything that occurs you've already been programmed to do by evolution. See, you don't even have to be a theist to believe that; there are atheist determinists that believe that.

But Christianity has a very fundamental belief that one of the pillars of belief is free will, free will: the ability to choose to love God or to hate God. Unfortunately many people choose to hate God; so obviously they go to hell, not because God sends them there, but because they want to go. They want to be separate from God, so God acknowledges their choice, *"I won't force you to be with me if you don't want to be."* That's what God says, right?

But you have the pillars of Christianity, and of course it gets merged in with Rome etc, and becomes a centralized government, an actual state which was not decentralized; it was a state power which was totally centralized to the degree that we can't even imagine in the modern world. Probably when we look at North Korea, we look at other states like Iran, etc, that's probably the degree we're getting close to with the centralization of Rome. Constantine may have been a believer, and of course God could use that to spread the general notion of the Christian Gospel to provide at least spiritual salvation, so the people can receive spiritual alleviation from the oppression of Satan's tyranny.

But again that's why Jesus said he would have to come again because, *"Thy Kingdom come, Thy Will be done on earth as it is in heaven."* That's how God taught us to pray every day.

So, if you take race out of the Declaration of Independence, and stop seeing them as white men, just see them as human beings trying to fight for something like liberty, trying to fight for the idea of unalienable rights that are endowed to us by our Creator; that are not given to us by bureaucracies or men or institutions. They're given to us by the Creator; which is mentioned in the Declaration. If you see it in those terms: these are groups of human beings trying to do something that was totally antinomian, totally different from all the trends of history, something totally different, and obviously we can see they were inspired by God. God was using this group of human beings to set the foundation for His Kingdom.

Top of the growth stage vs. perfection stage

What is the difference between the top of the growth stage and the perfection stage? Well, at the top of the growth stage you're still growing, so you haven't reached that level of relationship with God where you cannot fall. In the growth period you can still fall, you can still collapse; you can still be taken over by Satan. When we look at that in terms of America, America is like the growth stage. If you could see somebody at the growth stage and you could see somebody at a perfection stage,

especially if they're near the top of the growth stage, you would see people that look identical. They would look the same except one is capable of falling away from God, and one who is in the perfection realm is not. That is to say that even though you have free will you become so united with God's heart and God's will, God's subconscious mind, his heartistic mind, that you do not- and it becomes against your free will- to act in a way that would defile God.

Just like it would be against your free will as a grown person, to put your hand on a burning stove; even though you have the free will to do so. How many people want to do it? No, obviously, right; because you tried it when you were young and you learned it, "*Ouch!*" You learned that; so even though you have the free will to do so at an older age, your free will is still used not to do it.

That's how we rebel against sin when we come into closeness with God; we start conforming. The Bible talks about conforming to Him, becoming more like Him, understanding Him more; casting down all imaginations that put us against the knowledge of God. So, sinning against God feels terrible, feels like putting your hand on a hot stove; even though you have the choice to do so, you never would in your right mind do so, especially at a more advanced age. Are you with me, folks?

The Cheon Il Guk Constitution, Father's fruit

In our tradition we can see the Founding Fathers as people that are preparing the foundation for the messiah to come, and also preparing the way for him to spread; Father talked about a big Rome that would be the platform from which the Gospel could be spread to the world. Father talked about this: imagine if American Christianity had united with him! This type of very strong, decentralized type of Christianity, if they united with him and his strong stance on marriage, and his strong stance on what? Anti-communism! This is critical; this is why *churchianity* is killing America today. They're not teaching anti-communism because they don't want to get political. It's Satan's culture coming in! You have to teach against it, you understand!

It's a big deal: Look at this: 144 years after 1776, Father is born; $144 = 12 \times 12$. 144 years later Father is born, and he launches what scholars consider a sect of Christianity. We are a "sect" of Christianity, but we're the only sect of Christianity that sees and identifies Communism as Satanism. Because in our belief True Father as the Returning Jesus spoke clearly about this form of government as satanic. That means for the next generations of this sect of Christianity, we will always be against it; it's fundamental to our belief that we are against this form of government that is antithesis to God's Kingdom.

It's not like our belief system is trying to replace tyranny with another monarchy or something like that, because we have already the Cheon Il Guk Constitution which Father created the grounds for, and then he of course said, "*My heir and successor will put out God's Kingdom Constitution.*" And if you read the Cheon Il Guk Constitution - which is available in the lobby by the way- you will see; you will see, it's a totally different document. Is it a document that is protecting liberty and destroying the tyranny of the systemic structures of Socialism and Communism? Oh yes it is!

So take away the fact that Father is Asian, take away his race; let's take away his race. Let's take away all the stuff about the race and all this; just forget about what color he is. It doesn't matter. What is his fruit? His fruit is the Cheon Il Guk Constitution that has come from his Kingship line and this Kingship line is not interested in creating a kingdom with a centralized monarchy. Instead that Kingship line is tasked with the duty of making more kings and priests, and ordaining tribes and family lines to be restored, connected to the Messiah's lineage and to be made kings and priests.
(Applause)

Then we have a document that Father delineated. Let me show you here: in the Preamble. Because take away all the race stuff take away all the New York Times articles on True Father, all that kind of stuff, "*oh, the white kids are now worshipping an Asian messiah.*" Take away all the race stuff. You see how they're trying to use tribalism? They've been doing that forever. We don't care that Jesus was a dark-skinned Middle Eastern Jew! Who cares? Satan is the one who cares; we don't care.

What are the fruit? The Bible says, "*You will know the tree by its fruit.*" What is the centralized nature of Christianity producing? It's producing churches that are teaching positively against the very principles and the foundations of our fundamental civilization. They're teaching:
-homosexuality is fine; the gay clergy can come in. They're teaching
-abortion is okay. They're teaching
-transgenderism it's fine; that your gay marriage is ordained by God.
This is what's entering the church.

Meanwhile the Moonies were the cult because we stood against those things, and we got lambasted for them. Father got imprisoned in every country because of that belief and because he taught clearly that Socialism was Satanism.

So you look at the fruit. Take away all that race issue; take away all the tribalism. We are a group of Christians that believe Jesus Christ is Lord; that believe in salvation. They believe Jesus comes back, but he establishes an earthly Kingdom which we are the inheritors of, and that Kingdom is delineated very clearly on black and white paper for everyone to see. Just like that Declaration of Independence; it was just a piece of paper for everyone to see what civilization you will stand for.

So if we're really a cult then why is the fruit protecting and defending the gifts of God? If we're a cult then why aren't we trying to centralize everything and trying to make a monarchy for ourselves? Why

would you have the Constitution of Cheon Il Guk, the Kingdom of God Constitution, as Father said, based on the American Constitution. Why? Because that's founded on the pillars that God is the origin of these rights, unlike any other constitution. I'm not talking about Baal, I'm not talking about Asherah; I'm not talking about Moloch. Those are anti-gods; their constitutions don't matter. Amen! America's Constitution is founded on the principle of the Judeo-Christian God, on the love and grace of Jesus Christ -all of which we believe.

So take out the race for one second; take out the race. Father is a North Korean. Who cares if he's Asian; so what? It doesn't matter. It's a group of Christians that have as their fundamental aim the protection of liberty, and the delineation of the Kingdom of God.

(Reading from the Booklet: *The Constitution of the United States of Cheon Il Guk.*)

And look at this! As I said on the Preamble when we announced this in 2015:

"In the coronation Ceremony of God's Kingship January 13, 2001, True Father, the Messiah, Lord of the Second Advent and King of Kings declare that, "

**Article I of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Heaven is that you will not stain the blood lineage...*

**The second point is not to violate human rights, and*

**The third point is not to steal public money, using public property for yourself." (p 7)*

As you can, see very clear orders for governance.

The Constitution of the United States of Cheon Il Guk

"We the People of the United States of Cheon Il Guk (CIG), in order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general welfare, and secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity, do ordain and establish in Heavenly Father's name this Constitution for the United States of CIG."

You see it works off the foundation of the American Judeo-Christian Constitution because that's the growth stage.

Principle I: Maintain the Pure Lineage of God

"The division of the sexes being ordained by God where man is the subject partner and woman is the object partner, congress shall pass no law that contradicts this divine edict."

(Applause) You can't even say "man and woman," in this lunatic age we're living in! But you understand? Take away the race, take away the race; take all this away. How we look doesn't matter.

We're a group of Christians who

*believe in Jesus Christ,

*believe in the Holy Spirit;

*believe in the Divine Providence of God.

They

*hate the anti-gods because they defile and destroy civilization and God's plan for His Kingdom.

*stand against abortion,

*stand for family,

*stand for strong marriages;

*stand for man and woman.

“Faithful marriage between a man and a woman being the ideal of God’s creation, the government of CIG will pass no law which interferes with or contradicts this Divine Law.”

Did you hear that? Now it would have been great if the Founding Fathers wrote in this language; it would have been great if they had established these principles clearly. The first principles are key.

“The fruit of faithful marriage being the conception of children, congress shall pass no law which permits the injury to all persons born or unborn!”

(Applause) Do you understand? You can't make a law that will harm an unborn person. You cannot make it; you can't.

So this group of Christians, as we grow and continue on and found nations, and nations become states, these are the founding principles. You can't create laws which will harm or injure people, born or unborn. That's a big deal, folks; that's a very big deal.

“Sexual abstinence before marriage being the ideal condition for newlyweds, congress shall pass no law supporting or giving aid to alternative life styles.”

So you see here clearly: there's no man -and man marriage; it's very clear. God has a very clear, clear, clear, picture for the sociological structure of the basic unit of the Kingdom, very clear sociological structure: man, woman and the production of children- and the unborn children as well. That's why this alternative lifestyle is dangerous, and then aiding and funding that kind of thing is wretched. It's horrible; it destroys the fabric of marriage.

Principle II: Do not Harm Human Rights.

In this section you will see very clearly, this is the Bill of Rights that we have in America. Again, Father said the Kingdom Constitution will be on the foundation of the American Constitution, but will have even more checks and balances. So you can see right there:

“All genetically unmodified biological living persons, being the apex of God’s creation, are endowed by the Creator with inalienable Human Rights: (Applause)

Do you hear that? Why? Because Bill Gates that lunatic and these crazy transhumanists are trying to become half android. Because they think they're going to evolve away and create a breakaway civilization, away from the normal grass eaters; they call normal people wasteful eaters.

These are not amendments to the Constitution of the Kingdom! These are human rights determined by the Constitution of the Kingdom from the Judeo-Christian tradition.

So take away the fact that Father's a Korean. These are groups of people! It's the same argument they're trying to use on the white folks saying, "Your Founding Fathers were white, so they are bad." You understand what I'm saying? The same ridiculousness that they try to do with the Moonies, "Oh, he's Asian! You're worshipping an Asian." When you're a normal Christian you're worshipping a brown Middle- Eastern Jew! Who cares, if he's God's person? Amen!

Right I

"Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people to peaceably assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances."

Does it sound familiar? That's what we call the Bill of Rights in the American Constitution or history; this is what we call "human rights" in the Kingdom Constitution. These are not amendments; these are rights of a human person in God's Kingdom. Genetically unmodified biological living person by the way! Not for Bill Gates who's trying to be a transhumanist and be half an android, okay!

Right II

"A well-regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a Free State, the right of the people (individuals) to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed."

So why would the Moonies have a constitution if we're such a bad cult where we are giving people power to bear arms? Wouldn't that be counterproductive if we want to make a cult tyranny? That would be kind of counterproductive. We're arming people, training them to be kings and priests. That's kind of counterproductive, isn't it?

But again it's on the Judeo-Christian framework of the American Constitution which Father said was at the highest level before the Lord can return; it's the highest level. But it's capable of falling as we've seen through the amendment process. The sin of slavery is what did America in; the sin of slavery. That created a loophole for the amendments, and the amendment process has slowly degraded and allowed these ridiculous demonic politicians to erode the rights by new amendments and new amendments, new amendments etc.

There's a little problem with the Kingdom Constitution: the Kingdom Constitution can't be amended; it can't be amended!

So, *"the right of the people (individuals) to keep and bear Arms shall not be infringed."* That can never be amended in the Kingdom, never. It cannot be amended; you cannot infringe on it.

Again I'm going to tell you because everybody's really brainwashed, and our visual cues are about 90% of our brain function! So, take away the fact that Father is a Korean man; just take away the fact and

just look at the fruit. Look at the fruit: what is this giving? Is this towards tyranny or is this towards liberty? This is towards liberty.

And then of course what we call the Bill of Rights they're all right there.

Right X

"The powers not delegated to the United States of CIG by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the states respectively, or to the people."

Principle III: Do not Abuse Public Funds

Article I

Authority of the King: **Judicial branch**

Now the Kingship line of True Father again is not legislative. He can't make laws, he's doesn't have any military power; he does not hold any militaristic power. He's not the commander of chief; that would be the president - who's not elected by the people by the way. So, in terms of keeping the culture of Cheon Il Guk and preserving the Constitution, the Kingship line of Father is in the judicial branch. So it's more akin to America; we have Supreme Court Justices which have lifelong terms. We already have that, right; we have lifelong terms for Supreme Court justices.

So Father's Kingship line is in the judicial branch. It's not in the legislative branch, it's not a group of senators, and it doesn't have any military power. But it is upholding the Constitution and the context from which the Constitution arises and the Judeo-Christian belief system of the foundation of the American Constitution, and of the people yearning for liberty and protecting God's natural rights. These are all delineated in here.

There's also the office of the **General Inspector**, which is what? The General Inspector's office is an investigative body on what? Government officials! Why? Because in the Kingdom Constitution the FBI, the CIA, the NSA are all illegal! You cannot have an organization that investigates and that is spying on the people; those are all illegal in the Constitution. You can't have those types of bodies; they would be unconstitutional, they would be illegal. And of course you get a direct cut after 10% GDP, so the government cannot grow beyond 10% GDP.

But if we were secret North Korean spies, then why would we not be pursuing Communism where the centralization of power would just grow endlessly? Why are we putting all these limitations on government if the Moonies are such a bad cult? Because we're teaching what True Father taught: that Communism is Satanism and it destroys and ravaged and created the political economic foundations to ravage God's Kingdom! That's because the fruit of the Lord's in there; the fruit of Christ.

Article III

Section 1: Legislative branch.

“All legislative powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States of CIG, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.”

Sounds familiar? But look, there are central key differences.

Section 2

1:“ The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen every second year by the people of the several states in each state shall have the qualifications requisite for electors of the most numerous branch of the state legislature. Each member will be limited to 6 terms of service.

Limited! Did you hear that word? Limited! All to 6 years of service; total 12 years! You can't have Pelosi there for 40 years; it's illegal. You can't have Biden there for 45- 50 years. It's illegal; it goes against the principles of God. Are you with me, folks?

Section 3

1:“The Senate of the United States of CIG shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for six years; and each Senator shall have one vote. Each Senator will be limited to two terms of service.”

You hear that word again: limited! By the way did you notice that the people don't select the senators; people do not select senators. Remember, in America the people did not use to select senators. Who would select the senators? The state legislatures. Why? Because they would be representatives of the state concerns; whereas when you have everyone voting for these people, senators and congressmen just become the same thing. There's nobody representing the state; now everybody's just pandering for power.

And by the way, for a congressman you have only a voting pool of 2, 100 people. You can't have these congressmen that have tens of thousands of people voting for them. Your voting pool is 2,100 people. That means, if you don't represent those 2,100 people, you're fired, and they all know where you live and they all know you by name, and you have term limits.

Yeah, but we're a dangerous cult, you see; dangerous!

Now, let's look at the commander-in-chief here. Let's go to the president:

Article IV

Section 1

1: “The executive power shall be vested in a President of the United States of CIG. He shall hold his office during the term of four years, and, together with the Vice President, chosen for the same term, be elected, as follows.”

So you have a president, but he will not have the incredible centralized power that the current president of the United States enjoys, with the presidential edicts that Obama was doing; remember these executive orders, as they are called? But really they are presidential edicts.

2: Each elected member of the House of Representatives will have one vote in the election of the president.

Why? Because those people are representing the 2,100 people that voted for him- do you understand? - Not the 50,000 people whom they don't know. Do you know any congressman with over 50,000 people that knows every single one of those families? Is it possible? It's impossible. But you can know 2,100 people, and 2,100 people can know you really well. So if you're going to represent them, you really have to represent them. You can't be bought off by big business; you can't be. It's way harder. Why? Because you have so many representatives; you have a much larger House of Representatives. Are you with me, folks?

Why is that important? Why is that important for independence and freedom? What does the Left do? What did Bill Gates spend more money on than developing tech software as the head of Microsoft? Lobbying! Buying up the politicians; because they represent vast voting pools of hundreds of thousands of people. Now when you have to buy up voting pools of 2,100 people, you got a lot of people to bribe and a lot of problems in your mechanism; you have a great potential for cracks, because you have to now try to buy off thousands of politicians. Are you with me, folks?

And by the way, if you don't represent your 2,100 people well you get kicked out, because they all know where you live, and they all know who you are and who your wife is and who your children are; they all see how you behave, they've all grown up with you. And there are term limits on top of that. That's a problem; that's a problem for communists, socialists, political Satanists.

Do you see why it's important to have the Returning Jesus teaching these things, teaching the nature of politics and Communism? It's absolutely essential for how people will live in the future; it's absolutely critical, critical, because then it's reflected in the law of the Kingdom.

3: Any person with 10 votes among the elected members of the House of Representatives will be considered as a presidential candidate.

And remember there are a lot of House of Representatives; voting pools of 2,100; that's it, no bigger. So there's a lot of local control on who represents you. You can live in a big city but you have many congressmen from that city, because one only can represent 2,100 people, and they all know him in his district. Are you with me, folks? And you can fire him way easier because the voting pool is smaller, and your complaints are a lot more powerful. Why? Because you're not drowned out by 50,000, 60,000, and he says, "I have the support of 80,000 New Yorkers, so your criticism is null and void"; no, you only have a voting poll of 2,100.

So now each one's voice is way louder, way more powerful. The local person now has way more power over the elected official, who by the way - people keep forgetting - has a term limit. You know how everybody's praying for term limits? Well, it's already here; the Kingdom Constitution already commands it. Not having term limits is unconstitutional.

I'm just going to keep reading on my cultish activity here!

4: Once the candidates are selected the entire House of Representatives will vote for the President. If no candidate receives more than 50% or more of the votes of the House of Representatives then a second round of voting will take place. In the second round seven candidates with the most votes will be allowed to run for president. If no candidate receives 50% or more of the votes of the House of Representatives then a third round of voting will take place. In the third round of votes, the candidate with the least votes in the second round will be eliminated as a presidential candidate and the remaining six will be the candidates in the third round. If no candidate receives 50% or more of the votes then additional rounds of voting will occur with the candidate with the least votes being dropped for the subsequent rounds of voting. The candidate who receives 50% or more of the vote will be the president of the United States of CIG.

So, do you see why it is important? What are the Democrats trying to do with flooding the border? What is their technique? Why would you allow all these people flooding in? What is the purpose of that, politically? What would that give them? That will give them more voting power, and of course they reduce our republic to a debacle, which they've done in America, and democracy always leads to what? Mob rule! So now they can have a majority of Americans who have been matriculated in; they've let them in illegally, they give them free reins and just make them a quick pass to American citizenship- they don't care who you are- and they have the amendment process! Remember they have the amendment process; they have the ability to change the Constitution with majorities.

Democracy

How will you stop Socialism and Communism? How will you stop it? There are way more of them than there are of groups of people trying to search for liberty; way more. They love the idea of centralizing power and resources, love the idea; I mean love! Do you understand? And with that power they can bribe millions of people to go along with it. You see the problem?

So, big media and big business, they're very interested in the presidential election, aren't they? Because CNN, this Communist News Network, and MSNBC, what are they doing? They're using the power of mass media, to do what; to sway whose opinion? Public opinion, the masses; to vote for a particular candidate. This is when you have monopolistic corporations, powers, media etc, having tremendous power. And of course you can't sue them, you can't sue CNN, you can't sue MSNBC; they hide behind all the courts.

That's why in the CIG Constitution media corporations are privately owned; they all have to be privately owned. Which means what? You can personally sue them for liable and damages. They can't hide behind boards; they can't hide behind different organizational structures with their army of lawyers and accountants, which prevent them the negative financial consequences for reporting fake news, lying, making stuff up etc. I mean, look at President Trump: he could not sue CNN. Literally, his biggest weapon against them was saying, "Fake news! Fake news! Fake news!" That was his biggest weapon against them, to destroy their credibility.

See, that's why Democrats and Neocons they always want to slide it to democracy, because in democracy all you need is a majority, and you will secure tyranny. All you need is a majority of

people that say, "George Washington is a racist white supremacist, the foundations of America are evil, and we will vote to change them; we will amend everything and we will control all branches." Okay, it's done. Are you with me, folks? It's done, it's done!

In the Kingdom

Why does the Kingdom Constitution not allow for the popular vote of presidency? It's much harder, much harder for mega corporations, large international corporations etc, to use media and influential power through television, media- whatever social media systems they will have in the future - to sway the vote to move away from the representatives which stands for 2,100 people.

What does this Constitution fundamentally say? It says: "*we fundamentally believe the design of God.*" So even though people are imperfect and some people may vote towards Socialism, Communism, political Satanism, in the Kingdom they're also free because God gave free will. It's not going to be a tyranny. Unfortunately I really grieve and cry for many Christians who actually want Jesus to come back and to rule a tyranny; it's a horrible heart and it's not the heart of God. Amen!

In the Kingdom, liberty has to be protected, but other things that you saw in Article I, are protected as well:

*the unborn is protected

*marriage is protected. Congress shall not pass any laws that interfere with those things.

*the designation of man and woman is protected.

Now this is interesting because this was in 2015, when under Father's direction we released the Cheon Il Guk Constitution; this is before all the transgender issues were on the front page of the news every freaking day. (*Applause*)

So the elected representatives in the Congress who are representing 2,100 people, these are the people that will vote for the president. Now the power of mass media is way weakened, tremendously weakened. It doesn't matter how much they try to sway the general population to support a communist candidate; it doesn't matter. Your elected officials who represent only 2,100 people will have to vote in the way that you want them to vote, otherwise they will get fired, and even if they don't get fired, they still got term limits; they're going to be fired at some point very soon. It does not allow for politicians to claw in and create little fiefdoms inside the Kingdom.

So again I'm going to say: take the race out; take all that stuff out. Who cares? I don't care if the Founding Fathers were white guys. I don't care; it doesn't matter to me. I see human beings filled with the heart of love for God. Maybe different theological positions on God; some of them were deists; some of them had different views on the Trinity. But I see a group of human beings that are resisting other groups of human beings who want what Father called political Satanism.

It's a group of people that are inspired by God - and that's why other generations could not produce it - that stood and resisted tyranny, and then created the most prosperous politically free and economic

super power in the world. It's because of their allegiance to the foundational principles of relationship with God, natural law, fundamental human rights. Are you with me, folks?

The civilization we pursue

Now because of the sin of slavery - that was a sin, it was a sin; it was a sin, we cannot deny it- because of the sin of slavery the amendment process has eroded America, and we see the process of its decline, even though we have to fight.

The point is: we can see that a system that we thought was impermeable can be taken over by the communists over time, and primarily through the amendment process, the ability to transfigure this document and pull it away from its founding philosophical theistic position. Because if we take out that fundamental theological context, the killing of children is not a problem; it's a woman's right. The destruction of marriage and tradition, other lifestyle is not a problem; we're just adding alternative lifestyles and the state should protect that. Do you understand? If we move away from those fundamental foundational philosophical principles, then you have problems.

So in the Kingdom Constitution for example, could somebody choose by free will - they have free will- could they choose to try to get a gay marriage? Could they try to get a gay marriage? The answer is yes. But it's not controlled by the state; marriage is not controlled by the state; it's controlled by the church. So they could make a loose church of Satan or a church of whatever that allows for gay marriage. Okay yes, but what they could not do is: they could not punish Christian churches from saying, *"That is wrong,"* and showing biblical Scripture and quoting Leviticus 18 saying, *"That is an abomination; don't go there, don't do that!"* Do you see folks?

They can't use their power to make it a hate crime to preach the Word or to have a different opinion or to censor free speech. So, although it feels messy, it's the acknowledgement of freedom; it's the protection of freedom.

In the end it's the belief, just like God had, because He made us in His own image and He gave us a conscience, that even though we have sin, we still yearn to do good. Why? Because the ultimate good is what? God! We try to do good because it's a reflection of God's nature, so our conscience is always leaning towards trying to be good. God believes in the fundamental nature of the human person's conscience to strive for good. It doesn't mean that they're sinless; we still have to deal with sin. But our conscience that God gives us leads us to good. Amen!

What do centralized power, Communism, Socialism, political Satanism see the human person as? They say, *"If you leave it up to these people, if you leave people alone, if you don't engineer people, they will create endless wars, they will create this and that; they will not do any welfare. We have to do all this by the state."* Are you with me, folks? That is to say what? The state is saying, *"We cannot trust the fundamental conscience of human beings."* Why? Because they don't believe that we are made in the image of whom? God! They don't believe that. Instead we're just animals that need to be herded, animals that need to be used, exploited, farmed; animals that can be used to secure power, etc. Why?

Because they don't have the starting point that we're made by the Creator and we're made in His image; and thus our conscience is yearning for good and for the things that are good. Which is what? We don't want to oppress other persons. That would be bad; that would be against God's nature. That's why freedom of speech would be there. These are extensions of our conscience made in the image of God leaning towards the good.

So if we're such a bad cult, why do we produce as our final aim the acknowledgement of America, the Judeo-Christian founding of the constitution, the acknowledgement of the Judeo-Christian nature of this civilization? Why do we acknowledge that, and then why do we put even more strong checks and balances to block political Satanism from that Kingdom? Because you will know a tree by its fruit; you will know it. Take away the race, take away all this stuff. Take them away the nation; it doesn't matter. You will know the tree by its fruit.

What is the civilization that we pursue? It's the civilization of freedom. In this civilization of freedom will churches be important? Of course, of course they'll be important, in the sense that we're going to want to fellowship with one another; we will have to pray for people. People have free will so they will choose bad decisions sometimes.

But they cannot centralize law enforcement; they cannot centralize the military. The Cheon Il Guk system is based on the militia model, decentralized armed citizens, and what? Peace Police model; Fathers talked about the Peace Police, Peace Militia model, where the people elect the sheriff who can also be fired by them. Why? Because the people are standing with the Three Generation Kingships!

Imagine George Washington as...

I know it's crazy, Okay, but let's just imagine. Let's say George Washington was the Returning Jesus - I'm not saying he is; let's just say he was- and let's say George Washington produced the Constitution. Think about the culture of our America, how different it would be. Every person, let's say they're Buddhist or let's say they're Muslim, in that country every year they would hear about George Washington and how he established God's Kingdom and how he protects liberty and how he's protecting the growth of the state and why the state is the Beast. They would be hearing these principles culturally in their churches, in their halls of politics. You see it would be a totally different picture, wouldn't it?

You would have people that become American, who let's say, they're not in the church of George Washington; let's say they don't believe in the messiah. Let's say they just believe standard Evangelical Christianity; they disagree with the fact that George Washington is the returning Jesus. But it doesn't matter. Those Evangelical Christians are still grateful to George Washington that he's given them so much freedom to preach the Gospel, to never be censored, to have representative government, to not let those international conglomerates come in and take over their system by media and multinational corporations. They would be thankful for that, and they would see that as a fruit of the Kingdom, even though they may not agree with that theological position.

So in the Kingdom it's the same. There is no one religion that can be dominating over the people; nobody can be forced to convert coercively to believe in anything. But culturally you would be talking about how amazing God is; how amazing God used George Washington to give us this incredible Constitution. You see what I'm saying? Culturally you would be talking about that. You would be saying, *"How great is it to live in the Kingdom with this incredible freedom; look at those other countries that have Communism."* You see what I'm saying?

Culturally you would appreciate George Washington, his lineage that is carrying the Constitution, etc. You would appreciate people who are part of his church because in their theological belief system they have to defend the country and the Constitution; as part of their theological belief system. It's not just something that they're just grateful for; it's something they have to defend. Are you with me folks?

In the Cheon Il Guk Constitution

On the Day of Independence I'm talking about this stuff because the Constitution is there. There are tons of copies of the CIG Constitution out there; share them. You can see what the Moonies are searching for; what we're pursuing. This group of Christian people is pursuing a Kingdom with massive checks and balances on the political monster of government.

Now you can probably see why the Body of Christ, and not only that, but the media, all see us as a dangerous cult. Because if American Christianity was like this, we would be so much more aligned with our Founding Fathers, and it would be part of our theological duty, our religious duty, to not only own a gun and be an armed citizen, but it would be part of our theological duty to defend liberty. It would not be something opened in the air; it would not be something that's nebulous and certain pastors can say, *"As a Christian I think Communism is fine,"* and some can say, *"No."*

No! It's very clearly defined in the CIG Constitution, very clearly defined: The kingdom of Satan is Socialism, Communism, political Satanism, centralized government. That is the kingdom of Satan; very clearly defined. And God does not desire that for humanity.

In fact God through Christ, has given us the Kingdom Constitution which is our theological duty to not only be an armed protector of such ideals and values and civilization, but part of our system of core beliefs is that we must allow for human flourishing to spread, by people understanding these particular truths.

Nations would be freed, not only spiritually: *"Thy Kingdom come; thy will be done on earth, on earth, on earth, as it is in heaven."* Nations would be freed if they understood these theological and philosophical pillars of our belief system and of the civilization we pursue.

It has much to do with independence, doesn't it? It has much to do with independence, because just like that group of people -forget the race because the conversation's always turning to race; forget the race- that group of people rebelled against groups of people who wanted to be tyrants; this group of people said, *"No, we declare independence politically, economically, spiritually."*

That is what the CIG Constitution does again. It's a group of Christians that say, " *We declare political economic, spiritual, sovereignty endowed to us by our Creator and through Christ who's given us this tremendous inheritance and these are the things that we pursue.*" And we separate and we segregate from those systems of the world that pursue the opposite, whether it be Britain, whether it be some factions in America; it doesn't matter. If those groups of people pursue that system, then we oppose it, and it is fundamental to our theological core values. Are you with me, folks?

That's a big deal! That's why Father said that if Christianity would unite with him, within seven years the world would be restored. Because imagine if the entire Christendom was not tied to an organization, but was tied to the Kingdom Constitution which would give them real freedom from the real Beast, government corporations, banking systems etc. Centralized banking is illegal in the Constitution; centralized education department also illegal. If Christendom could uphold these worldwide in unison, imagine the type of world we would have! It would be radically different, and the commies would not only be on the run, they would be hiding; it would be a bad day for them.

So again let's take it away from the race stuff; let's just put up groups of people.

We're praying for groups of people to be inspired by the Holy Ghost to seek independence; seek independence from the systems of Satan, from the political systems of Satan. We are praying for those groups to continue to rise and to unite and to stand together, and we make it our theological duty to defend these things, to protect these things for posterity, and to give the glory to God. Amen! Amen!

Pastor Sean's Prayer:

Father God, we thank You for this day on this Day of Independence, dear God, where we can celebrate the freest country on earth before Your Kingdom. So we want to praise You today on Independence Day because “*it is for freedom that Christ has set us free,*” as we saw in Galatians Chapter 5. We pray that we stand firm to not be put under the yoke of slavery and bondage that is not only spiritual nature, but that is shackling the world from its true potential, because only in liberty where you can choose life or death, where you can choose to love You or hates You, dear God, that is where people can truly choose to love You of their free volition.

We value that freedom, we value that liberty, because it's the only place where true relationship to You the Creator can happen, and cannot be coerced by the state. We pray that all the people that are standing up for this Abel-type world, this type of God-centered world, whether they believe in what we believe or not, but they are standing in that general direction. We pray for them and we bless them. We ask for Your hedge of protection around them as well, because together we are standing to preserve:

- *Your principles,

Let us be part in saving her, and to create more safeguards so that she reflects Your Kingdom culture and Your tenants more clearly, more strongly, more assertively, and that this world will follow in those footsteps, and never allow the political Satanists and the domination of Satan's kingdom to rule ever again.
