### **HDH- Lost in translation**

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#### **Excerpts:**

Everybody, we have to read in Korean. Westerners, you have to learn Korean, Father's love language. He asked you to study and you didn't do it. That's just reality; you have to do it. We need to read this in Korean. I don't want to just harp on you every morning. Hurry up and study Korean! That's his love language; you have to learn it. You need to read Father's words in Korean, not in English. You can study it in another language but not for HDH. We have to do in Korean; that's the traditional way. We are the orthodoxy, so we have to keep on the tradition of orthodoxy; we must do it in Korean. Listening to it in English, it's not the same.

Okay, so again, if you don't know Korean, that's homework Father gave you forty years ago, and you have to do it. You cannot be lazy about it and just keep on pushing it down the road. It's disrespectful and against Father. We need to learn Korean even if it's slow and it's like baby Korean when you're reading it; just read it in baby Korean then. Everybody will understand and everybody's fine with that.

But it's not okay for me in upholding the orthodox tradition of True Father to be hearing it in English. It's not appropriate; you have to do in Korean. So, we're going to have to find a way how to do that and have everybody who does not know Korean to have good pressure, because good pressure makes good rice. The Westerners or the Japanese or whoever it is, need good pressure to actually do it and stop being lazy and making excuses. They have to do it. In the orthodox tradition, HDH is in Korean. Again I don't want to repeat this every morning when there's one new person, or there are two new people: this is absolutely critical.

And of course as we were talking before, that whole culture of just laughing it off, it's a very disrespectful culture to our True Father, whom everybody says they love and put in the center of their life. But obviously it's not true because if you did, you would have spoken in his love language. I did it; I only had basic Korean, very very weak Korean but I wanted to communicate with Father, and he said "*Korean is my love language,*" so I learned it. Tim Elder did it. So there's really no excuse. I don't want to have this talk every morning when one new person, or two new people show up, or we're on a Zoom with this or that group.

So we have to find some system where there are consequences or where there's some type of reward; it's as basic as that. I'm going to keep praying about that, and think about that, so it's a just consequence. But again, as the protectors of the orthodox tradition that Father gave us, we must do it in Korean. Doing it in English, or Japanese or other languages is not appropriate when you're doing HDH with Father; that's just the bottom line cut. So we'll go and as we continue on and Father spirit leads us into making a good system, we will have that put in place and we will do that in a better way.

I learned it anyway, because it's the only way to communicate with him in his love language, not some other foreign language. It's his love language, he decided it's his love language and he said, "*I want you to learn it, and if you love me you will do so.*" But basic bottom line is that if you love him you'll do it; it's that simple.

Don't have this internal hypocrisy where you say you love Father, but then Father has told you for decades to learn his love language and you have not done it; that is complete hypocrisy. That's just reality; it's calling it out

for what it is, and that's what is real. Real! When I only spoke English and I expected Father to speak English, it didn't work; I could not have a relationship with him. That's why he said millions and billions of times to learn the Korean language because it's literally that simple: you must communicate in his language and you have to learn it. Just like, if you became a Jew in the ancient world, you had to learn Hebrew. You know what I'm saying?

By the way your English translation, don't worship it. Andrew Wilson, the traitor, did it. Every time you listen to it, there are all these tinges of all these traitors who have worked on it; you're not getting the actual word. So I don't want to be doing this kind of bitching at people every day; it's not appropriate and it's not loving. You have been told by your Father whom you say you love and is the center of your life and the Messiah and you've worked with the Messiah. It's more important than your breakfast; skip breakfast and just do an alphabet study.

People who translated your text have crapped and shit on True Father. You have to remember that when you're reading that text. You are reading it from people who completely traitorously threw Father under the bus to get power and money. That text that you're reading is done by total traitors, and it's skewed. A lot of it is not translated well. Tim Elder has delivered that point a billion times. That's why Father had a love language, so we could hear it in an unadulterated form without Andrew Wilson or without the others who eventually just kind of sold out for money; they're fake.

It's like if I'm in a Jewish community and I don't know Hebrew and they're reading in Hebrew, it's my fault if I can't learn Hebrew, because the internet gives me technology to learn every language I want.
