## Kozue Leone, Tottori, Japan, 1966 \* \* \*

I joined the Unification Church in Tottori, Japan, in March 1966. My spiritual mother was one of my classmates in medical school. I was able to attend a 21-day workshop taught by Mr. Ken Sudo.

Whenever President Osami Kuboki saw me over the next several years, he encouraged me to stay in medical school and graduate. I participated in various Collegiate Association for the Research of Principles (CARP) activities, fighting against leftist-student groups on campus.

True Mother was close to her due date with Kwon Jin Nim, and I was practicing OB/GYN in Tokyo at that time. I was asked to help to take care of Kwon Jin Nim for a year after his birth. True Father also asked me to get my United States medical license. I was fortunate to participate in the 74-Couple Blessing while I was in East Garden preparing to take the American medical-licensing exam during the day and helping True Children during the night.
