# Chicago Family Learns How to Teach the Word





Approximately 300 Unificationists gathered for Sunday Service at the Marcus Addison Theater to hear Dr. Balcomb's speech "Staying Saved."

Dr. Balcomb shared a powerful message for Sunday Service about the significant missions of the three wise men and of John the Baptist during Jesus' time.

Sunday afternoon consisted of a Divine Principle lecture training session led by Dr. Balcomb, who presented a PowerPoint sildeshow developed at Headquarters to help members out in the field spread the Word.

Dr. Michael Balcomb, vice president of the Unification Church USA, shared his heart to some 300 Unification Church members at the Marcus Addison Theater in Addison, IL on Sunday, December 30, 2013. As we had attended the True Family Values Banquet with Rev. Hyung Jin Moon the evening before, members and pastors from across District 7 came together to hear Dr. Balcomb preach.

The Sunday Service began with great music from the worship band that prepared the hearts of the congregation. Dr. Balcomb's message of "Staying Saved" was the finale to the Chicago community's Christmas Sermon Series, and he encouraged us all to keep practicing the lessons we have learned from True Parents. He shared a powerful message about the significant missions of the three wise men and of John the Baptist during Jesus' time and reminded us that Foundation Day is just the beginning, not the end. As it was the last Sunday of 2012, his message was a great reminder of the life and lessons we have received from True Father.



After service, Dr. Balcomb, along with Chicago city pastors Jario and Leena Vincenz-Gavin, greeted congregants as they exited the theater. Members gathered in the lobby and shared for more than an hour and a half over coffee and pastries. Following service, about 40 members went over to the Community Center for Divine Principle lecture training. During lunch, members had time to share with each other, and following the meal, District Pastor Rev. Kazuo Takami offered introductory remarks and welcomed Dr. Balcomb to begin the training. To start off, Dr. Balcomb introduced himself and shared about what he has been up to in the years previous to his new assignment and how he received this new mission from True Mother. It was nice to learn a little more about our vice president.

Dr. Balcomb walked us through a newly created PowerPoint presentation of the Divine Principle. In the first 20 minutes, he shared the "Introduction" as well as part of the "Principle of Creation," and then invited four volunteers to give the next lectures, two first-generation Unificationists and two second-generation Unificationists. Everyone was amazed at the professional quality with which each of these first-time presenters could share; they simply read the notes provided by the PowerPoint as they clicked through the slide show. This presentation is written in such a way that even when read, it sounds very personal. Several of the participants expressed gratitude to the Headquarters Ministry Support team for creating such a presentation on the Divine Principle.

The "Fall of Man" and "Purpose of the Messiah" lectures were completed by four more volunteers. According to participants of the training, the PowerPoint was lauded for its visual, modern, clear and easy-to-use aspects. The point of this training session was clear – anyone could teach the Divine Principle. It was so exciting to see the energy with which everyone left.

Chicago will continue teaching Divine Principle to members and guests alike, and we will do our best to make God and True Parents proud in the coming year of 2013.





# Farewell Message: Dr. Chang Shik Yang - January 4, 2013

My beloved Brothers and Sisters in America,

# New Teaching Method to be Launched by Foundation Day

Church members from Boston to the San Francisco Bay are applauding a new teaching tool which allows novices to sound as credible as Ivy League academics. Dubbed "Discovering the Divine Principle, the scripted slide show gets unpacked at nearly every stop of Dr. Michael Balcomb's preaching tour of the United States, and gets rave reviews every time.

"The tools Dr. Balcomb presented were impressive, and several inexperienced members took turns learning to teach to the rest of the audience. It proved to be a good experience for all who attended, and a lively discussion followed, according to Rev. Michael Hentrich, Colorado State Pastor, after one of these visits. The project began more than a year ago as a brainchild of Rev. Andrew Compton, then the pastor of the West Rock Church in Tarrytown, NY.

"My original motivation was that we provide Unificationists with a newer, briefer and fresher Divine Principle lecture series," wrote Rev. Compton to Unificationnews.





"Not everyone has the ability to teach the Divine Principle, and the only lecture series that was available until now was the one produced long ago by [Rev,] Kevin McCarthy, which is more than an hour long for each lecture."

With the aim of making lectures that were clearer and shorter, Rev. Compton started to design a new series. "I wanted to create something that a new guest, someone who wanted to know what Unificationists believe, could easily digest," he explained.

Having discovered that the local, public-access cable station provided free cameras, crew and editing work, Rev. Compton made an arrangement to create with the station a series of 12 Divine Principle presentations, each 27 minutes in length. "I faced a problem where the cable station would not do re-takes," he said. "I had one shot at producing a good presentation for each of the 12 series. Therefore, I wrote out notes of the entire lecture content in order to practice before producing the actual video."

After a few sessions had been produced, Rev. Compton invited Heather Thalheimer, former director of Education at Unification Church USA, to provide advice for improvements. In response, Thalheimer decided to expand the series and assigned Dr. Tyler Hendricks, developer of ministry curriculum, to create a Divine Principle lecture series based on Rev. Compton's notes. A new project, titled "Discovering the Divine Principle," began.

"This project was very near and dear to my heart," Thalheimer wrote in an email to Unificationnews. "The Education Department had the goal of developing a Divine Principle series that has a contemporary look and feel while staying true to the original substance of the Divine Principle. The Divine Principle is competing with a lot of other media messages for attention. Whatever we produce has to look attractive and hip to get noticed."


According to Dr. Hendricks, "The 'Discovering the Divine Principle' lecture series was designed to meet a need – to present a style of teaching the Divine Principle in terms that are relatively simple to grasp for the average person – without much religious background, commitment or training." Thalheimer said the idea to script the content of each of the 12 lectures came about so that even a first-timer could learn and teach "the powerful truth" of the Divine Principle.



"I am happy to say that Dr. Hendricks and Christine Froelich, advisor to Generation Peace Academy (GPA), have improved my notes tremendously," said Rev. Compton. "In addition, designers Jonathan Gullery and GPA graduate LeeHee Wolf have created an entire new set of PowerPoint slides that are modern, bright and very attractive."

Before the lecture series was finished, trial runs were held in Denver, Chicago, and San Leandro, CA to test the presentations. "Dr. Michael Balcomb, vice president of Unification Church USA, has been out in the field every week since December presenting the slides and encouraging participants to try out the new lecture," Dr. Hendricks told Unificationnews. "We have had young teenagers get up to present, as well as Japanese people who don't speak English well. The participants find that this format of reading from the script works and makes it easy to present. We've heard that participants got very inspired, and we've received a lot of encouragement from the field."

The script for the 12 lectures is complete, and the first seven of the 12 slide shows are finished. According to Dr. Hendricks, the goal is to have all the Divine Principle presentations finished by Foundation Day, February 22, 2013 and made available to members of the local churches. In addition to the lecture series, Dr. Hendricks is working on a "metric companion" to guide teachers who help students through the 12 sessions and "digest, reflect upon and wrestle with the material and see how it relates to their own life."

On the occasion of Foundation Day to be held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month of the 4<sup>th</sup> year of Cheon-gi (February 22, 2013), True Parents wish to acknowledge and encourage those who have served as exemplary blessed families while participating in True Parents' victorious providential course with absolute faith, absolute love, and absolute obedience according to True Parents' tradition and offered exceptional results. This is to announce the guidelines for selecting candidates for the "True Parents' Award on the Occasion of Foundation Day." Each region and nation should render their cooperation so that deserving blessed families can prepare and submit the necessary forms.

- 1. Name of award: "True Parents' Award on the Occasion of Foundation Day"
- 2. The award ceremony will be held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month of the 4<sup>th</sup> year of Cheongi (February 22, 2013).
- 3. Number of awardees: 1,200 blessed families worldwide
  - \* 10% or 120 slots will be reserved as a "Special Award" to be awarded to selected candidates. (See below "7. Selecting Candidates for Special Award")
- 4. Basic qualification for the award candidates
  - 1) Members who are carrying out basic duties (worship, donation, absolute faith) as blessed families and who are recommended by their respective church leader
  - 2) Candidates shall be selected from among all blessed families worldwide.
  - 3) Candidates should be selected from the top-scorers with a perfect score of 100 points. When there is a tie, the person with a higher grade in the order of the assessment criteria categories (numbers 1 to 7) shall be given priority.
  - 4) If there are candidates with the same score for all assessment criteria (refer to above), the family with a higher score in the number of children who are blessed should be selected.
  - 5) Missionaries and Boon-bong-wangs (National Messiahs) who are long-term residents of a nation other than their native country should submit their applications to the local church in their residential countries.
