arm greetings, respected Cheon II Guk leaders and beloved family members. May the Blue Dragon's energy in 2024 inspire the realization of new dreams and objectives for our respected Cheon II Guk leaders and our beloved blessed families.

On May 7, 2023, True Mother conducted the dedication ceremony for the 'Cheon Won Gung Cheon II Sanctum' during her 80th birthday celebration. Subsequently, on May 9, she launched a new era with significant organizational restructuring and personnel changes, heralding a fresh chapter for the Family Federation. Moreover, True Mother established the International Headquarters along with the First and Second Secretariat

Offices, aiming to unite the dispersed Family Federation organizations worldwide and foster synergy.

During this time, the International Headquarters unveiled seven policies for an innovative leap in 2023. I wish to highlight three key policies:

The first is about the, "world tour for strategic assessment and planning". Following True Mother's guidance, the International Headquarters embarked on a tour of 12 countries across five continents over three months, starting with Heavenly Europe. This journey allowed us to visit providential sites globally, listen to urgent field reports, and engage in open-hearted strategic dialogues. These efforts have deepened our heartistic connections and led to the implementation of 'continuous communication and sharing,' as promised during the world tour. This includes monthly continental conferences and one-on-one meetings with the national leaders from 161 nations.

The second policy is "re-establish and educate on the Heavenly Parent's Holy Community culture of heart centered on True Parents." This policy is in progress through the development of educational materials for the 'Theology of True Parents in the Era of Cheon II Guk.' True Mother asked that we do research for teachings appropriate for the Cheon II Guk era, develop suitable presentations for the establishment of the Cheon II Guk tradition, and promote education that fully engraves and establishes the essence of Heavenly Parent and True Parents, and the value and identity of the blessed families.' We have also been instructed to 'promote culture of heart education that establishes the essence of the Heavenly Parent and True Parents, as well as the value and identity of the blessed families. Following these directives, the International Headquarters launched the True Parents' Theology Research Committee that is made up of professors of theology from Sun Moon University and Sunhak UP Graduate School, and it began an intensive study.

The International Headquarters, in accordance with the recent words of True Mother and in response to the providential times of completed testament age, plans to meticulously enhance the educational materials. This is to ensure we can comprehensively educate about the stature and value of the True Parents, aiming to compile the contents and create a thorough and well-rounded, Cheon II Guk textbook.

Understanding the urgency as expressed by True Mother's words 'time is of the essence,' the International Headquarters, along with the First and Second Secretariat Offices, FFWPU-Korea, and the theological faculty, have united. Together, they are deeply discussing and communicating all aspects, thereby enhancing the completeness and quality of their work."

The third policy focuses of nurturing capable people for the future and setting up a talent database system. In line with True Mother's recent directive, "Second-generation members should spearhead the restoration of nations and the world," the International Headquarters is prepping the 'Heavenly Top Gun' program for second-generation members. This initiative, starting in 2024, will see around 60 Sun Moon UPA cadets, including Shin Chul and Shin Heung, embarking on international missions' post-graduation. We are coordinating with continents worldwide to facilitate these overseas assignments for UPA cadets and second-generation youths worldwide.

Esteemed Cheon II Guk leaders and blessed families, the International Headquarters remains committed to fostering tangible church growth and achieving the vision of national restoration. We follow True Mother's unwavering path, continually progressing and unifying across continents. In this light, your dedication throughout 2023 has been extraordinary.

Looking ahead to 2024, we aspire for all blessed families globally to embrace 'The Value of True Parents from the Viewpoint of Heaven's Providence,' as imparted by True Mother. Together, let's unite in our resolve and dedication, bringing great hope Heavenly Parent and the True Parents. \tilde{p}

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The Role and Mission of the Messiah

Cheon Seong Gyeong, Book 1, Chapter 4 Section 1

od's purpose in calling the Israelites to the land of Canaan was to have them complete a victorious foundation as one people. Upon that foundation, they were to build a kingdom in Canaan under Heaven's sovereignty and prepare the foundation for the coming of the Messiah. The people of Israel were to attend the Messiah as the central person who would rule over their country. Then they were to defeat Satan's world and complete God's providence of restoration together with the Messiah. Although that was their mission, the people of Israel and their religious leaders did not know it.

In those days, there were those among them who thought that when the Savior came, they would automatically become the nation that could rule the world. They did not grasp that they had to complete the history of restoration by first gaining victory on the level of a people and then on the level of the nation before they could achieve a victorious worldwide foundation.

Unless individuals attain perfection, they cannot form families with a new and higher awareness. And without such new families, a new people and a new nation cannot emerge. Therefore, the Unification Church has come forth with a focus on bringing about the perfection of individuals through True Parents. God longs to complete the restoration of the individual. It has taken six thousand years, until today, to substantiate one perfect man. God has been toiling with the goal to bring forth that one perfect man; this has been the whole purpose of His providence of restoration, transcending time. Then, by centering on the one perfect man, God's intention is to recover one woman and form the model for the perfection of the family. This is the messianic teaching. God desires to conclude the providence of restoration by setting

up the bridegroom and the bride according to this messianic teaching. By doing so, God plans to lay the foundation for all of human life. The way of life and the teaching that the Messiah brings are the eternal standards that all human beings need to follow.

Another formula in God's providence of restoration is that before sending the Messiah, He works to set up one central religion and one central nation. God called the Israelites and Judaism. God planned to send Jesus upon that foundation and then expand that realm of goodness by having all humankind unite with him. In this way He would restore the world and realize the ideal of the kingdom of heaven. If the Israelites and Judaism, which God had prepared over four thousand years, had received Jesus, united with him and upheld the one Will in a sacrificial way, then Jesus would have united the Arab world and Asia. connected them to the Western world, and spread the Will quickly to the ends of the earth. In that way, Jesus could have established the kingdom of heaven on earth under God's sovereignty.

Adam possessed the seed of true love and true life. After God lost Adam, He had to recover the Son, a man having the new seed. This Son has to be a man having no condition for Satan to accuse. Just as God made Adam first at the time of creation, in the providence of restoration, which is the providence of re-creation, God has to first set up a Son who has nothing to do with the Fall. This is the root of the messianic teaching. The Messiah is the true man with the new seed of life. He guides people of the fallen lineage to deny their life and then engrafts his new seed onto them. Even though the Messiah is rooted in God, as the second Adam he must clean up what Adam did. This is the reason God cannot send the Messiah as a superman having God's almighty power.

The Savior is God's representative who can dissolve the bitter sorrow in God's heart, the sorrow that was brought by the first human beings' failure to fulfill God's love in accordance with His Will. Because they never realized God's love, all people are in despair and filled with bitter sorrow. The Savior is the one who dissolves this bitter sorrow and brings God's love to fulfillment. He comes to help people attain this original love. The Savior does not come to feed those who are hungry physically. He comes to liberate God. A man is liberated when he has a wife of true love. When a man has a wife

who loves him and remains with him eternally, there is no imprisonment. He is free. Does God, the original central being, enjoy that kind of freedom? He is a sorrowful God, who, while searching for love and investing His love, had to forget how much He invested, only to invest again.

God, by all means, has to restore the ideal of true love and peace that He has held onto since the beginning. God's providence of salvation is the providence to restore that original state; in other words, it is the providence of restoration. For the providence of restoration, God set up religions and expanded the realm of goodness. The Messiah Whom God sends is responsible to complete the providence of restoration. Therefore, the Messiah must come as the True Parents and quickly recover everything, starting from the root. Jesus, who came as the Messiah, had the mission of the True Parents. He came with true love to give rebirth to all humankind and to restore them as true individuals and as true husbands and wives, so that they too could become true parents. Unfortunately, he could not complete this mission due to the disbelief of those on earth, and he departed with the promise to return. He must come again as True Parents in order to restore completely God's ideal of creation. 🌾





The Role of Blessed Families in the Era of Cheon II Guk

Excerpt from True Mother's Address at the Prayer Rally for the Salvation of the Nation and the World Changwon Convention Center, November 26



That is the role of Christianity, the Korean people, and those of us in the Cheon II Guk era, in the context of divine

Our Creator, Heavenly Parent, created all things in His image. He created a man and a woman to be humanity's ancestors. He allotted them a period of growth, hoping they would mature and attain perfection. However, their failure led to the humanity we know today. The course of human history has been marked by continuous wars and conflicts. Today, we remain divided, plagued by religious disputes, ideological wars, and ethnic conflicts. Additionally, our Earth, originally healthy and created by Heavenly Parent, is now suffering due to human neglect.

The Creator, having initiated this creation, is bound to conclude it. The reason Almighty God had to wait until now is because He endowed humans with a unique part of responsibility. Consequently, God had no



choice but to carry out the strenuous task of the providence of salvation and restoration through indemnity. He chose the nation of Israel as His chosen people, and it took 4,000 years to establish a lineage that Heaven could connect with. We know this well through the Old Testament.

But what did they do with Jesus Christ, the only begotten son sent by Heaven as the Messiah? In the end, Jesus had no choice but to take the path of the cross. Therefore, Jesus said, 'I will come again.' The inception of Christianity was founded on the wait for Jesus Christ, who promised to return, and has continued for 2,000 years through the saints inspired by the Holy Spirit. Why did Jesus say, 'I will come again'?

Originally, the Creator made a man and a woman to be the ancestors of humanity. Through these perfected beings, the Creator dreamed of living a heavenly life on Earth. However, Jesus Christ, as a single male figure, could not fulfill such a providence. Since the birth of life comes from a mother, Jesus had to return to conduct the prophesied 'Marriage Supper of the Lamb'.

In preparing for the Second Coming of Jesus Christ, whom Heaven has said 'will come again,' the first task was to establish a foundation for the birth of the Only Begotten Daughter within a Christian context. Only with the birth of the Only Begotten Daughter can the providence of the Second Coming Messiah be fulfilled.

Cheon II Guk is the nation that attends the Heavenly Parent. In this light, today we must understand the truth of the providence, the truth and essence of Jesus Christ, and become one with the Only Begotten Daughter.

This is the only way to resolve the 2,000 years of pain endured by Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son, and to fulfill his wishes.

I hope that today marks the beginning of this process. I pray that everyone gathered here will exert their leadership and ensure victory in this mission. \mathcal{P}

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2023 Heavenly Unified Korea Leaders North-South Unification Prayer Meeting in Changwon

n celebration of the 78th anniversary of Liberation and the 70th anniversary of the Armistice Agreement, the '2023 Heavenly Unified Korea Leaders North-South Unification Prayer Meeting in Changwon' was grandly held on November 26 at the Changwon Convention Center. The event was jointly organized by the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification, the Universal Peace Federation (UPF), the National Alliance for the Unification Movement of North and South Korea, the Korean Religious Council, and the Heavenly Unified Korea National Alliance of Gyeongnam Elders Council. Acknowledging Six Months of Progress: A Tribute to Growth and Effort



On this day, Mother prayed earnestly asking Heavenly Parent to accept the dedication with joy. She said, "Glory be in Heaven. On earth, the exhilarated and joyful voices of the people of Cheon II Guk resound throughout the world. Please hear this stirring and exciting sound of joy and exultation!" We have ushered in the era of the providence when Heavenly Parent dwells on earth.

Explanation of International Headquarters Policy

As part of this new beginning, the International Headquarters has striven to understand True Mother's deepest thoughts and dreams. Based on True Mother's messages, we arrived at four points to be aware of during this time, three key objectives, and seven key policies.

The four points to be aware of now, in this time, are: active and substantial attendance, the pursuit of the original essence, a loyal heart that transcends filial love, and presenting the results of our witnessing





efforts. They are the four core values of Vision 2025. These values are substantiated through the three key objectives, which include accomplishing actual national restoration through strong and genuine witnessing results, realizing a heavenly unified Korea through a step-by-step process and the division of organizational roles, and completing Cheon II Guk with transparent and efficient organization.

Under these three objectives, the International Headquarters embarked on an international tour with the aim of better understanding the current situation of the regions, helping them establish strategies, re-establishing and educating on the culture of heart centered on True Parents, igniting a "new creation" movement around the world through the Spirit and Truth, seeking ways to secure economic independence and transparency, evaluating ways to standardize practical growth and witnessing results, garnering support for a heavenly unified Korea through the solidarity of our peace movement worldwide, and discussing how to build a databank system to cultivate talented people and leaders for the future. Centered on these seven policies, the International Headquarters communicated with each regional headquarters, collaborated with other organizations, and continued to advance.

Reporting Results

Due to time constraints, I would like to briefly review the progress made on two of the seven major policies. First, I will mention our policy to "re-establish and educate on the Heavenly Parent's Holy Community culture of heart centered on True Parents." This policy is in progress through the development of educational materials for the 'Theology of True Parents in the Era of Cheon II Guk.' True Mother asked that we do research for teachings appropriate for the Cheon II Guk era, develop suitable presentations for the establishment of the Cheon II Guk tradition, and promote education that fully engraves and establishes the essence of Heavenly Parent and True Parents, and the value and identity of the blessed families. Following these directives, the International Headquarters launched the True Parents' Theology Research Committee that is made up of professors of theology from Sun Moon University and Sunhak UP Graduate School, and it began an intensive study.

To respond to True Mother's urgent call and deep heart, the committee studied the subject matter day and night. They completed and reported their first study to True Mother. Mother was very happy and





gave the following instructions: "Compile these contents in a textbook and give presentations on this as soon as possible." Based on this directive, in-depth lectures were presented to all of Heavenly Korea's public leaders in November, and to Heavenly Japan's public leaders in mid-December.

Mother entitled the textbook: "The Value of True Parents from the Viewpoint of Heaven's Providence." Going forward, we will continue communicating with you and make any necessary revisions so that we can deliver the content to our members worldwide as soon as possible. In this way, we promise to convey the truth about True Parents and the truth about the providence to all humankind, thereby permitting Heavenly Parent to be understood from the highest perspective.

My second report will be on the policy of nurturing capable people for the future and setting up a talent database system. True Mother expresses her deep interest in our youth missionaries, and in October she said, "The second generation must take the lead in restoring nations and the world." Therefore, Sun Moon UPA cadets will be assigned to missions starting this year—including cadets Moon Shin-chul and Moon Shin-heung, True Parents' grandchildren. Furthermore, the International Headquarters would like to combine the various "youth leader training programs" in the regions into one official young leader training program.

Currently, the International Headquarters is putting everything on the line to train future leaders to lead Cheon II Guk. No effort will be spared in providing support so that the seeds you have sown throughout the world can flourish into a giant forest. Please show great love and interest in our younger generation!

As the International Headquarters looks forward to 2024, we promise to build upon the accomplishments of 2023 and to pursue our goals "without pause," with renewed hope and vision. Yang Chang-shik, Chairman of UPF International, Makes a Diplomatic Visit to Cambodia


Yang Chang-shik, the Chairman of the Universal Peace Federation (UPF) International, undertook a diplomatic visit to Cambodia from November 17th to 21st. His agenda included meetings with several prominent Cambodian leaders, including Samdech Khuon Sudary, President of the National Assembly, and Prime Minister Samdech Hun Manet.

Yang Chang-shik, Chairman of UPF International Meets with Cambodian Prime Minister Samdech Hun Manet



n November 20th, Dr. Yang met with Prime Minister Samdech Hun Manet at the Phnom Penh Peace Palace. He delivered a congratulatory message from Hak Ja Han Moon, the Co- founder of UPF, celebrating the Prime Minister's inauguration. Dr. Yang acknowledged and commended Prime Minister Hun Sen's efforts in advocating for peace and opposing war, noting that Cambodia's journey could serve as a model for conflict-ridden nations globally. He sought the Prime Minister's continued support for UPF's global initiatives, including peacebuilding efforts and the promotion of unity on the Korean Peninsula. Dr. Yang emphasized UPF's commitment to enhancing the wellbeing of Cambodians and stimulating the local economy. In response, Prime Minister Hun Manet expressed appreciation for the congratulatory message and assured ongoing governmental support for UPF's activities.

n the same day, Dr. Yang discussed with President Khuon Sudary strategies for strengthening collaboration and communication between the Cambodian government and UPF.

He expressed hope for ongoing cooperation in various sectors based on the long-standing trust between Cambodia and UPF. President Khuon Sudary highlighted Cambodia's engagement in international forums to foster peace and dialogue and outlined the government's economic goals for the coming decades.

In response, President Khuon Sudary highlighted Cambodia's active participation in international forums such as AIPA, IPU, APPF, APF, and ASEP, aimed at fostering peace and dialogue. She outlined the government's ambitious goals to elevate Cambodia to a middle-income country by 2030

to a high-income country by 2050. She welcomed UPF's support in attracting investors and tourists, as well as in providing educational and training initiatives to enhance public sector capabilities. Dr. Yang reaffirmed UPF's role as a key partner and strategic ally of the Cambodian government, expressing his hope for ongoing mutual support to further strengthen their relationship.

Visit to the Win-Win Memorial

he day before, on November 19th, Chairman Yang visited the Win-Win Memorial. This memorial, completed on December 31, 2018, by Prime Minister Hun Sen, commemorates the 20th anniversary of the end of the Cambodian civil war, symbolizing a significant historical milestone. 76



UPF Asia-Pacific Region Co-Hosts Conference with Sri Lanka Parliament and Parliamentary Leaders

he UPF Asia-Pacific Region, in collaboration with the International Association of Parliamentarians for Peace (IAPP) and the Sri Lankan Parliament, co-hosted a conference titled "Responsible Action: Fostering Transparency and Good Governance." This event, held on December 6, took place at the Sri Lankan Parliament. It was attended by over 200 participants, including current members of parliament, government representatives, and UPF representatives from 12 countries, such as India, Malaysia, Indonesia, Cambodia, among others.

The event was jointly presided over by former Sri Lankan President Maithripala Sirisena, Chairman of the Asia-Pacific Summit for World Peace, and the Speaker of the Parliament. Ranil Wickremesinghe President of Sri Lanka graced the event by participating as a panelist and delivering a welcoming speech. Following a congratulatory message from Dan Burton, Co-Chair of the IAPP, Yang Chang-shik, Chairman of UPF International, delivered a keynote lecture. He emphasized the virtues, public consciousness, transparency, altruistic actions, and responsibilities that politicians should maintain, from a principled perspective.





In particular, Dr. Yang underscored the significance and goals of the Asia-Pacific Union (APU), initiated by True Mother in Nagoya in 2019, to foster regional solidarity beyond national borders, and exchanged views on various issues. At the conclusion of the event, Dr. Yang and the Sri Lankan Parliament discussed joint participation in an upcoming international event organized by UPF in May 2024 at the United Nations.

Sri Lanka holds special significance for the True Parents, as they made official visits to the country in 2005 and 2006, shortly after the establishment of UPF. During these visits, they were warmly received by the Sri Lankan government at the Presidential Palace. \mathcal{P}



Universal Peace Academy's Heavenly Top Gun Missionary Activities

1. Introduction to Universal Peace Academy

he Universal Peace Academy (UPA) was established in March 2013 as an institution dedicated to nurturing future generation leaders who will lead Cheon II Guk in unity with the True Parents. Over the past 10 years, it has continued its legacy. True Mother established the UPA master's program (Senior UPA) as her first project after True Father's ascension, to cultivate leaders who will be central to future generations. In 2020, Sun Moon University was designated as the national university of Cheon II Guk, and its theological department started anew as the undergraduate program of UPA (Junior UPA).

UPA aims to educate and train leaders who embody Hyojeong and are well-versed in ministry, missions, academia, and culture, resembling the True Parents. Cadets live in dormitories, establishing their inner discipline through basic routines like Hoon Dok Hae, physical and spiritual training, deployment ceremonies, roll calls, prayer meetings, and Jeongseong. Beyond this, they enhance their capabilities through various educational and training activities.

After a four-year undergraduate program followed by a two-year internship, cadets are officially commissioned by True Mother in a dispatching ceremony and become 'Cheon II Guk Young Special Envoys,' engaging in public service activities around the world.





2. Heavenly Top Gun Missionary Activities

True Mother has been nurturing UPA cadets, including those of the third generation, with love and grace. Now, Junior UPA 1st generation cadets, including Shin Chul and Shin Heung, are finishing their education and moving on to overseas missionary internships.

True Mother has commanded these cadets to go to Christian nations to proclaim the substance of the Only Begotten Daughter True Mother and the truth of Jesus' essence and providence. She has bestowed upon Junior UPA cadets and accompanying young missionaries the title of 'Heavenly Top Gun.' The Junior UPA 1st generation cadets and future generations who have committed to missions will carry out overseas missionary activities in 2024 under the name of Heavenly Top Gun.

Currently, the International Headquarters is meticulously preparing for the mission country selection and deployment, focusing mainly on Christian and English-speaking countries in North America, Europe, and Africa.

How I Came to Understand God and True Parents on a Deeper Level

Family Background

irst, I would like to introduce myself. I was born in Bremen, Germany, in 1951. During my childhood, I often had to visit physicians and undergo frequent surgeries; this experience helped me develop compassion for people who suffer.

As a child, I enjoyed attending Sunday school at different Protestant Churches, and I had some spiritual experiences. Then, as a teenager, I started searching for answers to many questions regarding the purpose of life, but neither the people in my life nor the books I read were able to help me.

Meeting Our Movement

In 1973 I finally met my spiritual mother, who introduced me to the Unification Movement. At that time, I was a kindergarten teacher. It took me almost a year to become a full-time member since I knew from the beginning that this would require a lot of discipline and sacrifice. I always stayed in contact with my parents, even though they never understood my motivation for joining the Unification Movement. In 1974, I joined a witnessing team in Munich and worked in Karlsruhe for a while before all German members were called to a meeting at our training centre near Camberg. There I volunteered to become a missionary to Thailand.

The Beginning in Bangkok, Capital of Thailand — My Country

On 28th April 1975, I arrived in Bangkok, unprepared for my mission country's

language, climate, and culture. Somehow, in my broken English, I managed to tell a taxi driver that I was looking for an apartment to rent. At first, I could not imagine how I could survive in Thailand, after sweeping and scrubbing my apartment, I only wanted to sleep. The temperature out-side was about

99 degrees Fahrenheit (37°C), and I only had a fan in my room. During my first three days in Bangkok, I mostly consumed just fruit and water. On the third day, my landlord introduced me to a Vietnamese student who could speak German. She took me on a tour to interesting places.

On 2nd May, I encountered the American brother, Jack, in the lobby of my apartment building. I was happy to meet him and learned that he had already joined our movement in 1970 and participated in the Marriage Blessing of 1800 couples in February 1975.

Political Situation

Jack and I were extremely concerned about the political situation in Thailand because Cambodia, Vietnam, Laos, and Burma (now Myanmar) already had communist governments. At that time, leftist students began to organise demonstrations in Bangkok.

We taught English and German at language institutes to increase our income. In this way, we were also able to take classes in the Thai language regularly because the majority of the population in this country was not fluent in English. In June, another missionary, arrived at our home and told us that he could not stay in his mission country, Myanmar, because of the political situation. So, for the time being, he moved into our apartment and later stayed in Thailand for sixteen years. Every few months, he was able to travel to Myanmar as a journalist.

Visits by Other Missionaries and Joint Actions

Until the end of 1975, all missionaries, who were either unable to remain in their mission countries or stayed in Thailand just for a short time to apply for a new visa to re-enter their mission countries, came to Bangkok. That was a very chaotic period because everyone had their own agenda. The missionaries who had visa problems and could not stay in their country travelled to Thailand's Cambodian, Vietnamese, and Laotian refugee camps. Yet, they did not know how to help the refugees who had just escaped death and were not ready to join our movement.

Jack and I started to offer prayer and other conditions. For the most part, it was just the two of us. Yet, at times, other missionaries attended our meetings and activities. Even though, during one of our gatherings, all missionaries decided that Jack should be our central figure, nobody really adhered to this decision. Therefore, in November 1975, he concluded that we should separate for a while.

I rented a small room in a house, which was in a poor neighbourhood in Bangkok. This home belonged to a couple that rented out every room except the one they occupied. Kitchen and the bathroom were shared by about ten people, which meant that everyone was only given up to five minutes to wash. Fortunately, the toilet was in a separate location. We had to brush our teeth and attend to all other personal hygiene in our bedroom or at an outside sink.

How I Came to Understand God and True Parents on a Deeper Level

I remained in this house for a few months, which became one of the most challenging times during my mission in Thailand. Some people in the same building hearing me pray in my room made fun of me and asked: "Where is your God?" Furthermore, they did not believe that I sincerely practised an ascetic and celibate lifestyle. Therefore, they introduced me to different potential boyfriends. I always made an effort to witness, even when I felt that most people were not in the least bit interested in what I had to say. The positive aspect of living with people who did not speak English was that I



continuously had the opportunity to practice my Thai.

When an American couple invited me to their home, I slipped and fractured my right hip. The physician who performed the surgery inserted several screws so that my bones would heal faster. He instructed me not to put any weight on my right leg for at least three months and use crutches. Worried that I might have to return to Germany, I determined to continue praying and witnessing.

Unfortunately, I had to quit my job as a language teacher, so I could not continue with my Thai lessons due to a lack of funds because, for a while, the financial support from Germany did not reach me on time. In addition, it was impossible to use public transportation with my crutches and too expensive to travel by taxi every day.

For the first time in my life, I did not even have enough money for food. I decided to purchase one inexpensive meal per day and trust that God would provide more nourishment through other people. My landlady knew of my financial problems and invited me almost daily for dinner. She also said that I should not worry about my rent for the time being. My witnessing contacts often invited me to a meal. Even the physician who performed my hip surgery told me that I could pay him whenever possible. I experienced severe physical pain because, according to local custom, I slept on the floor. Moreover, I felt very lonely since I was not able to meet my brothers every day.

During this period, I had my first dream



of True Father. He told me that I could entrust all my problems to him. I felt overwhelming love as he listened to me. Looking back, I am infinitely grateful for the suffering I had experienced as it deepened my belief in God and True Parents immensely.

Unity in the Trinity and a New Beginning

In January 1976, Jack and some brothers, who were expelled from their countries due to visa problems, relocated to a house that became our second centre. In the end, we always cleared up our differences because both of us were wholly convinced that Thailand's future depended on our unity. I never sacrificed as much as during these pioneering years! We started organising weekend workshops regularly, and Jack encouraged me to give lectures in the Thai language, admitting that I was more fluent than him. I wrote the words of the diagrams in English and taught them in Thai because the Thai written language is much more complicated than the spoken one. Whenever I introduced the Divine Principle, I felt so much energy from God, and words I did not know before came out of my mouth. Strangely enough, it became more difficult to have simple conversations afterwards.

First Members, Political Tensions and Changes

Our first member joined us in December 1976. Four more members moved into our centre during the same year, but only Dr Lek has remained in our movement until today. He spoke fluent English and translated the Divine Principle into Thai.

One of my spiritual children, Rungporn, was a woman who took three years to become a member; I met her in 1975 she listened to lectures, joined our movement, and later received the Marriage Blessing. Even today, we are in close contact.

On 6th October 1976, amid rising fears of a communist takeover similar to the one that had taken place in Vietnam, anti-communist police and paramilitaries attacked a leftist student demonstration during an incident that became known as the Thammasat University Massacre. According to official estimates, 46 students were killed and 167 wounded.

In 1977 we relocated to a different mission centre and kept this building for seven years. A German sister, Amala, came to Thailand to live with us. She met our movement in Sri Lanka but was unable to remain there due to visa problems. In 1978 we began to sell Ilhwa Ginseng and other products to finance our living expenses and projects without relying on financial support from the United States and Germany. The number of our members grew steadily.

Temptations, Protection and Reflections

During my first years in Thailand, I often felt lonely and occasionally made careless decisions. One night I was walking alone in Bangkok, not thinking about my safety; a young man appeared and said he would stay with me until I was ready to go home. I do not recall how long we were walking, but when we arrived at our centre, he told me

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that he would wait in front of the house until I turned off the lights and went to sleep. I never saw him again and concluded that he was an angel. Sometimes I wonder how often God protected me in mysterious ways.

I experienced diverse temptations because, generally, the male population here felt more attracted to me than German men. Soon I faced the greatest trial of my faith; one day, while I was street witnessing, a handsome young man followed me and inquired about our movement. He declined my invitation to visit our centre and asked me to give him a lecture at a nearby coffee shop. I agreed, but during my presentation, I realised that he was not interested in the Divine Principle. He said he would like to meet me again, and we made an appointment a few days later. I was somehow attracted to him, yet I hoped that the second lecture would turn him around. However, that second meeting changed nothing. He said that he would call me later. At the centre, I entered our prayer room. While crying profusely, I admitted to God that I was seriously thinking of leaving our movement because I had not felt such an infatuation for a long time. Then I found myself knocking at the brothers' bedroom door, and Jack appeared. I told him about my experience, and he did not judge me at all. Instead, he replied that it was okay because now I could sympathise with my brothers on a deeper level since they had faced temptations many more times than I did. Afterwards, I had the strength to tell this young man that he could only see me at our centre, but I remained very sad for a few months.

One afternoon, when I was street witnessing for a short time, I met my third spiritual child, Woravut. I just wanted to distribute one more invitation to our lectures and immediately return to our centre, because we expected many guests. Most people who received our invitations just took them and disappeared, but Woravut was very intrigued and followed me on the spot. When I introduced the Divine Principle to him, he seemed fascinated; however, more with my presence than the actual lecture. Woravut visited us every day to see me, whereupon I said to him that God had already chosen a partner for each of us and waits for us to become mature enough to receive the Marriage Blessing. Woravut continued to listen to lectures every day without much understanding until I talked about Moses' providence. Suddenly a light dawned on him; he understood the contents of my words and asked if he could become a member. I shed many tears for him. Later he was blessed in marriage and now has two children as well as four grandchildren.

I cannot express how much joy I felt to teach the Divine Principle. Some guests wanted to hear the whole content in one sitting. Some of them stayed all night, and we consumed a lot of coffee to stay awake. I used the diagrams in my book for a while, but later, some Thai members created beautiful charts, making lecturing easier.

In May 1978, Jack was officially appointed national leader of the mission in Thailand; my responsibility was to be a foreign correspondent for our German and American newspapers. I was also responsible for building an economic foundation for our movement in Thailand. Those directions came as a big shock for me since I had no experience in politics or economics. Nevertheless, I decided to follow the new directives to the best of my abilities. I told Jack that I would write newspaper articles two days a week and work on a business plan for another two days. During the remaining three days and every evening, I would continue giving Divine Principle lectures because Jack wanted me to, and I could not imagine giving it up.

Sometimes I visited refugee camps together with other missionaries and wrote about my experiences. Once I interviewed prostitutes to understand their motivation and to publish their stories. Soon the political situation changed once more, which provided important material for my journalistic activities.

Vietnam launched an invasion of Cambodia in late December 1978 to disempower the dictator, Pol Pot. Two million Cambodians had died at the hands of the Khmer Rouge regime, and Pol Pot's troops conducted bloody cross-border raids into Vietnam, Cambodia's historical enemy, massacring civilians and torching villages. Pol Pot fled ahead of the onslaught, and Phnom Penh was placed under Vietnamese control in a little over a week. During the rule of the Khmer Rouge regime, we learned about reports from Cambodian refugees through newspapers and personally interviewing them at a camp in Thailand. Jack and I shed many tears for the Cambodian people, and we were relieved when Pol Pot lost his power.

We started to build our Home Church in that area by visiting families and offering classes to the children.

In the fall of 1980, Tanet joined us. He had met our movement in London and just knew the address of our P.O. Box; every day, he visited the post office to meet one of us. He became a dedicated member who received the Marriage Blessing two years later.

In December 1980, Oliver, a young British man visited us. He had met our movement in his homeland but decided to travel the world before listening to the Divine Principle. Whilst still in Thailand, he changed his plan and tried to find our phone number. Through the Ministry of Education, he received the number of a journalist who specialised in religious movements. This reporter knew our number, even though we had not yet registered our organisation. Oliver became a full time member; later, his brother Russell from England paid us a visit to convince the former to come home, but instead joined us as well. 1989 Russell received the Marriage Blessing and was appointed national leader of our movement in Greece in 2010.

Birthday of True Parents, Trinity, Matching and Blessing

When we missionaries were invited to the birthday celebration of the True Parents in February 1980 in New York, I felt that True Parents looked exactly as in my dreams and the photos I had seen. When True Father spoke, I was surprised by how much he understood our struggles and suffering. Many missionaries were shedding tears during his speech.

Amala, the German sister from Sri Lanka, and I took part in a Matching by photo on 30th December 1980.

In 1981, all missionaries and their spouses received visas as representatives of the International Relief Friendship Foundation (IRFF). We were elated because, for the past six years.

In 1982, a Professors for World Peace (PWPA) conference took place in the Philippines, and we were able to send a group of professors from Bangkok. Amala, as well as I, received the Marriage Blessing in July as part of the 2075 couples in New York, and six of our members joined a Blessing ceremony in October among a group of 6000 couples in Korea.

In 1983, my husband Tom and the wives of some Thai brothers arrived in Bangkok to start our families, and together we continued our mission. We were happy to sponsor a conference of the International Cultural Foundation in Thailand, and at the end of the year, some Thai professors attended a PWPA conference in Korea.

Progress in Our Mission

In 1984, the first conference of the World Media Association took place in Bangkok. Reverend Lee became the national leader of the movement in Thailand and later the regional director of twenty Asian countries. By that time, we had more than forty full-time members.

Jack and I had worked together for nine years on the national level; Amala other missionaries also supported us immensely for a long time. When Reverend Lee arrived, we only had a few pioneer centres in Bangkok and some other provinces. The Unification Movement was not yet officially registered because Jack and I were concerned about the political situation in Thailand. Furthermore, we knew that





Christian missionaries had been largely unsuccessful in converting the Thais, as 95 percent of the population is Buddhist, and we wanted to avoid any misunderstanding.

Since Reverend Lee was responsible for the mission in Thailand, Jack, others and I were working in pioneer centres. My husband and I managed three different centres successively, located close to the largest university in Bangkok. During that time, our daughter and son were born.

In 1986, when our youngest child was one-year-old, our family and a group of members were sent to Phuket in the south of Thailand to start a mission there. At first, we felt lonely because we were used to the many members and projects in Bangkok, but then we came to love this beautiful town close to the ocean. Our fundraising and witnessing efforts brought outstanding results. The worst experience in Phuket occurred when my husband Tom almost drowned, whereas the best one was the conception of our third child.

After one year in Phuket, we were assigned to Songkhla, another town in the south, and a year later to Chiang Mai in the north of Thailand.

In August 1988, a World Collegiate Association for the Research of Principles (CARP) Conference was held in Bangkok. For a few months, Tom assisted with the preparations. Most Thai members and representatives from many countries around the world participated in it.

In 1989, Tom and I returned to Bangkok because Reverend Lee wanted me to conduct 21-day Divine Principle workshops and become the principal of a small school for the children of our movement.

In 1990, Reverend Lee encouraged my family to move to the United States, planning to assign leadership positions to native members. The missionaries were to stay in the background as advisors. I wanted to remain in Thailand at all costs, but my husband did not. I cannot express how my heart was torn apart at that time. This country had become my home, and I wanted to be buried here. At first, I could not imagine how I could ever be happy at any other place. With time I got used to America, but Thailand will always have a special place in my heart.

Reflections

When I first arrived in Thailand, I did not have the faintest idea of what was waiting for me. Jack became my closest ally, and I believe that our unity was the foundation for all the success in Thailand. We shed count-less tears and offered many conditions, including prayers, fasting and witnessing. Jack ascended to the spirit world in 2007; I know that he also loved Thailand more than any other country. Some Thai members told me that they often feel the presence of his spirit.

At the time of this writing, it has been 31 years since I left Thailand. However, I have always stayed in touch with some of the members. Especially since the creation of social media, I have shared a lot with my Thai brothers and sisters. In 2018, I stayed in Kalasin in the Northeast of Thailand for three weeks to participate in witnessing and preparing candidates for the Marriage Blessing. In 2019 I revisited Kalasin.

One year after our family moved to the United States, the Unification Movement in Thailand experienced severe persecution because one government official became very hostile towards our organisation due to misinformation. Our members were accused of attempting to abolish the Royal Family and Buddhism in Thailand. Eight of our leaders were arrested and imprisoned for 21 months, where they had to wear hand-cuffs and shackles. This group included Dr Lek and his wife Bai Hang from Taiwan. Some leaders of our movement in the USA were able to assist by hiring a good lawyer, but it took 21 years until we were completely vindicated.

Finally, in 2012, Dr Lek and his wife became the first Blessed family worldwide who fulfilled their mission as tribal messiahs.

Until this day, my family continues to support Thailand and our mission there. 7
