The Responsibility of the Chosen People: Witnessing and Action



Am I Holy Mother Han? What does this mean? The Creator created all things of heaven and earth according to the original image, and finally created a man and woman who could become the ancestors of humanity, and to them God gave a responsibility. God waited for them to advance to the position of perfection during their time of maturation, their period of growth. However, they could not achieve this, and thus today's fallen humanity came to be.

The Creator must absolutely see perfection achieved. The unfallen world of all things of creation operates automatically through the

cycles of God's creation principles, but due to the actions of fallen humanity, the natural world is also being damaged. The Creator could not simply abandon fallen humanity. God therefore had no choice but to undertake the difficult course of the providence of salvation.

Heavenly Parent's Providential Work of Salvation

Among the many nations, God carried out the history of the providence of salvation through the chosen people of Israel. In the course of God's providence conducted through central figures who were established beginning from the

individual level, when the people failed to unite with the central figures and distanced themselves from Heaven, the people of Israel were taken away as slaves. You know this through the history recorded in the Bible.

It took not just 100 years, but, with the passing of century after century, 4,000 years for Jesus Christ, who was "conceived by the Holy Spirit," to be born. However, neither Mary, nor Zachariah's family, nor the traditionally faithful, nor the people of Israel understood Jesus' essence. Moreover, they did not know the essence of the Creator. Jesus said, "I have much to say to you, but you

cannot bear it now.” Eventually, this lack of understanding drove Jesus to the cross. Because of this, the chosen people of Israel became a people who had to pay indemnity. We know this through history.

Facing death on the cross, Jesus said, “I will come again.” Christianity began through the Apostles as they waited for Jesus, who had promised to return. However, because they did not understand the reality of the spirit world, they made many mistakes. Salvation could no longer come solely through the Catholic Church. Therefore, the Reformation occurred, and in 1543 Calvin wrote a more comprehensive formulation of Christian thought.

Jesus definitely said he would come again. He planned that upon his return he would hold the Marriage Supper of the Lamb. This means the Christian sphere should be awakened. Before waiting for the Messiah who would come again, they should first know where Heaven’s chosen Only Begotten Daughter would appear. However, none of these things happened as intended.

The beginnings of Protestantism was a movement to freely attend Heaven starting from within each family. It began through the Puritans who traveled from Europe to America. There were already indigenous people living in North America, but God wanted to quickly save the world through the providence.

Therefore, God blessed America, a Protestant nation and democratic country that could fulfill that responsibility. Though America grew well amid Heaven’s blessings, after a while it became complacent. Family breakdown, drug problems, youth problems and selfishness arose. Moreover, America was in a situation where it could be taken over by communism.

Therefore, less than ten years after the Holy Wedding in 1960, True Parents began the providence in the United States. Forty years was invested in America, because if this key nation representing democracy and leading the world would attend Heaven and become one with True Parents, a peaceful world of one family of humankind could be realized and all nations could unite in peace.

In 1975, the global witnessing effort began through young members from the US, Europe and Japan. Even now, though they have grown older, there are members who are still investing in their mission after more than 50 years. Therefore, during the recent Cheon Won Gung Entrance Ceremony, their achievements were commended in the name of Holy Mother Han. That was good, wasn’t it?

True Parents’ mission is to create the environment on earth where Heavenly Parent’s dream, life in the earthly kingdom of heaven, can be realized. Particularly, this is the life that true children who have come through blessed families should live. I expressed it this way: It is like single drops of water gathering with others to form a stream, then becoming a river, which flows toward the broader ocean, creating the environment for the nurturing of many forms of life.

The Completion of the Providence Comes Through Holy Mother Han

The Family Federation began through this Korean people, but because it advanced without having a Christian

environment, its growth was inevitably slow. Moreover, the one who has the mission of the Messiah at the Second Advent becomes the Returning Messiah only by meeting the Only Begotten Daughter. Just as Heaven brought forth the Only Begotten Son, Jesus Christ, 2,000 years ago, so too must Heaven bring forth the Only Begotten Daughter from within a Christian environment.

The completion of the providence comes through the Only Begotten Daughter, through Holy Mother Han. I have shown you everything. If there are people who, due to a lack of proper understanding of the providence, remain stuck in the Old Testament era even while witnessing the present-day environment, we must teach them.


You are living in the Cheon Il Guk era. What is Cheon Il Guk? It is a nation where blessed families, sons and daughters, who attend the Creator Heavenly Parent on earth are living. Then with whom must you become one? You must become one with Holy Mother Han. Do you understand? Now you must boldly state that this people has a future only by becoming one with Holy Mother Han.

Ask those in the Christian realm: “Why did Jesus say he would come again?” Ask: “What did he say he would do when he comes again?” Ask: “How long will you just keep waiting for Jesus’ promised return?”

You cannot enter heaven just by believing in Jesus. Heaven is the place where blessed families that exist due to True Parents can enter. This is something that everyone desires. Today’s reality, from which we can look toward the future, is one of ongoing wars, conflicts and religious strife. Until now, religions have emerged centered on men. This is not in alignment with the principles of creation.

It is the mother who gives birth to life. Do you understand? We should attend the Mother. We must attend not only Heavenly Father but also Heavenly Mother. You leaders of today must practice this and show it through your actions. You will do this, won’t you? Shall I trust you on this?

Have you made your determination for 2027? After 6,000 years, through Holy Mother Han, the Cheonil Sanctum was finally offered—a dwelling place on earth where Heavenly Parent has entered and can be fully attended. Yet even now, the environment remains far from adequate. That is why I have long since emphasized the urgent need for witnessing. It cannot be just one person per month—it must be at least one person every day. The nation must be restored.

Only in this way can our people fulfill their responsibility as the chosen people. Only then can this nation become the homeland of the chosen people that is respected and revered by the world! Will you do this? Where will you begin? Will you start from Gapyeong? Will you start from South Gyeongsang Province? Will South Jeolla Province just observe? Let us all achieve victory together!

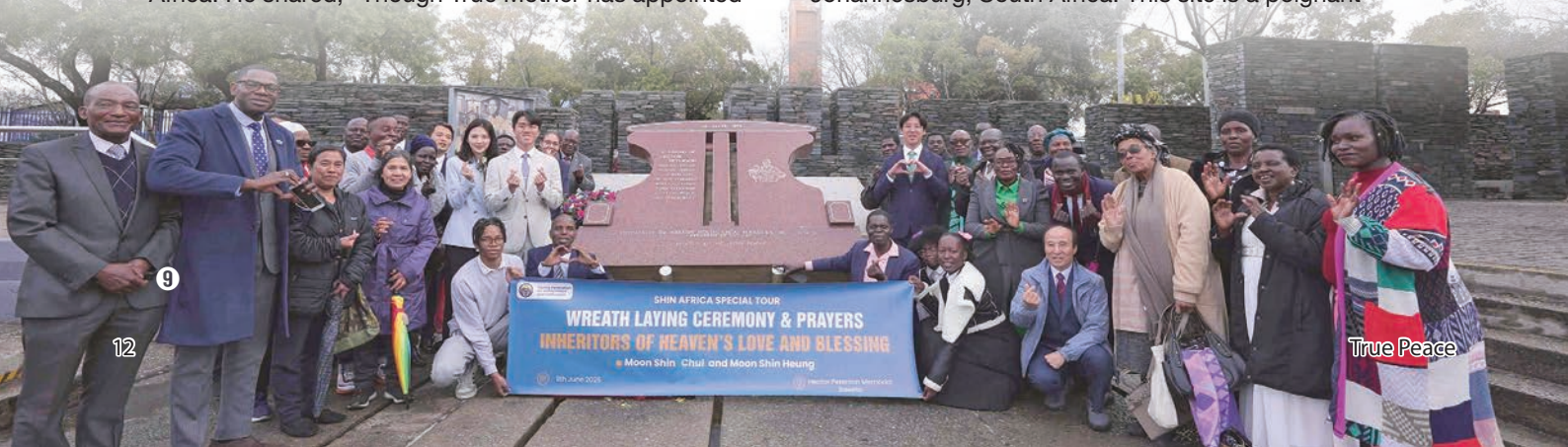

His words deeply resonated with everyone present. The evening concluded with a collective song, a moving moment in which all committed to advancing with love and hope, united under True Parents.

On June 9, the fifth day of their Africa tour, the delegation visited the Hector Pieterse Memorial in Johannesburg, South Africa. This site is a poignant

landmark in history, commemorating Hector Peterson, the young boy who was tragically killed during the Soweto Uprising (a large-scale student protest against apartheid that took place in Soweto, South Africa, on June 16, 1976). It is also the sacred site where True Mother offered a tearful prayer of liberation in 2019.

At this sacred site, the touring party quietly reflected on South Africa's painful history, offering sincere prayers for the full realization of Heavenly Parent's ideal of Cheon Il Guk on this land. It was a profoundly meaningful moment—a time to heal past wounds and foster hope for the future.

In the afternoon, the delegation revisited Prophet Samuel Radebe's Holy Spirit community, the Revelation Spiritual Home. There, they presented copies of *The Value of True Parents in Heaven's Providence* (Chambumo Ron) and *The Epic History of the Chosen Han People*, offering a detailed explanation of True Mother's esteemed status and value centered around the Cheon Won Gung Cheon Il Sanctum Entrance Ceremony.

Outside the airport, the delegation was warmly welcomed by members, Hyojeongrang youth, Heavenly Top Gun missionaries, and leaders from neighboring countries, all united in spirit and heart. After moving to the Peace Embassy, the delegation greeted and met with key leaders.

Kadima Mundadi, Heavenly Africa Continental Director, gave a detailed report on the current state of the providence in Africa. The members also offered their sincere and heartfelt prayers, hoping that the African tour of the Inheritors of Heaven's Love and Blessings will serve as a significant turning point in solidifying the Cheon Il Guk environment on the continent.

On the following day, June 11, the delegation toured the providential foundation of Zambia. The group began the day with a prayer at Cheonshimwon, then visited the Barlaston area, a providential site established through the dedication and hard work of early missionaries and members, which includes schools and a martial arts

training center.

In Twikatani, the delegation was warmly greeted by the cadets and missionaries at the Hyojeongrang Training Center. They reflected on their deep relationship with the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification and reaffirmed their continuing commitment to fruitful cooperation. During the meeting, the Inheritors of Heaven’s Love and Blessing, on behalf of True Mother, expressed their gratitude and called for collective efforts to build a peaceful world where all people live in harmony with and attend Heavenly Parent.

On June 13, the ninth and final day of the Africa tour, a “Heavenly Africa Pure Water Worship” was held in a grand ceremony in Lusaka, Zambia. Around 240 young members gathered from countries such as Benin, Kenya, and Eswatini, and together with the Inheritors of Heaven’s Love and Blessing, they reaffirmed their filial love for Heavenly Parent and True Parents.

Kadima Mundadi, Heavenly Africa Continental Director, urged the younger generation of Heavenly Africa to make a renewed commitment. He emphasized True Mother’s unending and profound love for Africa and highlighted that she had sent the Inheritors of Heaven’s Love and Blessing to this place.

Rev. Kadima revealed that Zambia was the final country of the Africa tour and called on everyone to show their love, devotion, commitment, and determination to stand with the Inheritors of Heaven’s

We sincerely thank True Mother for sending the Inheritors of Heaven’s Love and Blessing to encourage us and provide the great strength to begin anew.”

The Africa tour was a deeply inspiring journey filled with unforgettable realizations for the Inheritors of Heaven’s Love and Blessing. During this time, they experienced a profound sense of gratitude and hope. The Inheritors reaffirmed their commitment to inherit the great love of Heavenly Parent and True Parents and to fulfill their noble calling as true children. Yet even now, the environment remains far from adequate. That is why I have long since emphasized the urgency of witnessing. It cannot be just one person per month—it must be at least one person every day. The nation must be restored."

Good day. At this time, I would like to extend my heartfelt gratitude and a warm welcome to all the Continental Directors and Vice Continental Directors joining us from around the world, as well as to the Regional and Vice Regional Directors, National Leaders, and Church Leaders from each country. 2025 Holy Mother Han Special Jeongseong Workshop Hosted by Cheon Mu Won Central Administration

The Path to Becoming Absolutely One with True Mother

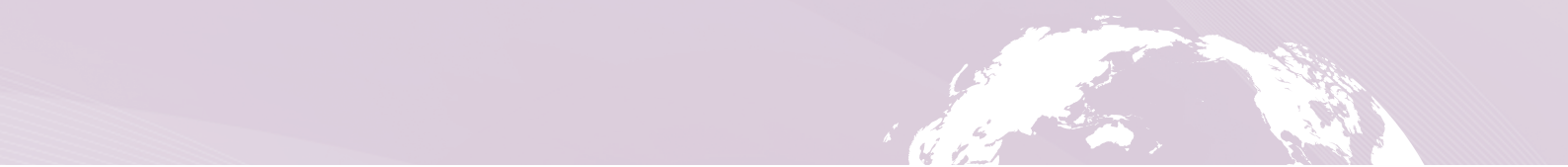
On June 27, 2025, the 2025 Holy Mother Han Special Jeongseong Workshop Opening Ceremony was held at the main hall of the HJ Heaven and Earth Cheonbo Training Center. The event was attended by approximately 800 people, including Special Jeongseong Workshop trainees, Spirituality Academy trainees, and staff from the Cheon Mu Won Central Administration.

At the opening ceremony, Lee Cheong-woo, Chief Director of the Cheon Mu Won Central Administration, emphasized the importance of future generation Pure Water members joining together to offer devotion for Holy Mother Han, True Mother, with passionate zeal and filial hearts. He stated, "The destination we are aiming for during this 40-day journey is the beginning and the end of our faith and prayer: our True Parents, especially Holy Mother Han." He further remarked, "As Pure Water united with Holy Mother Han, we must inherit the spirit aligned with her heart and purpose." He stressed, "We must wholeheartedly participate in the realization of Cheon Il Guk and the providential path led by True Mother." Chief Director Lee made it clear that the goal of this Special Jeongseong Workshop is to become absolutely united with Holy Mother Han, to elevate her status and value and protect her well-being so that True Mother can fully carry out the providence of Cheon Il Guk on earth.

The Cheon Mu Won Central Administration redesigned the 40-day program, moving away from traditional workshop formats, to enable Pure Water participants to offer comfort to True Mother and deeply unite with her heart. The renewed schedule places True Mother at its center, incorporating special jeongseong conditions, spiritually focused education, and pilgrimage experiences.

The main programs include devotion and training centered around Cheon Won Gung, daily pilgrimages, and heartfelt acts of attendance. Participants also engage in in-depth discussions with the compilers of *Chambumo Ron* and *The Epic History of the Chosen Han People*, as well as lecturers on True Parents' Life Courses, Unification Thought, and Blessing education. Additionally, the program features established activities such as prayer vigils and spiritual training, including the Cheonshim Resonance Prayer, Cheonshim Ansu, Hyojeong Chanyang, and more. In particular, the Cheon Mu Won Central Administration offers daily evening sessions focusing on the recent providence, explaining the will and heart of Holy Mother Han, our True Mother, as well as the mission of the younger generation in this era.

Trainees attending the Special Jeongseong Workshop begin each day with devotion at Cheon Won Gung and maintain a heart solely focused on attending Holy Mother Han, True Mother, until they go to sleep. With this spirit, they chant "For True Mother's long life" and "For True Mother's absolute protection," offering jeongseong completely dedicated to True Mother. In addition, this Special Jeongseong Workshop is attended not only by Pure Water members in their 20s and 30s, but also by staff from the Cheon Mu Won Central Administration, further intensifying the devotion.

Heavenly Korea FFWPU Pastors' Assembly Convenes

The Heavenly Korea Family Federation Pastors' Assembly for Victory in VISION 2027 was held from July 1–3, 2025 at the Hyejeong Cheon Won Cheongshim International Youth Training Center, with approximately 700 participants. Attendees included pastors, pastors' wives and providential organization leaders from across Heavenly Korea FFWPU.

Responsibility of the Chosen People

On July 2, all attending pastors and leaders from FFWPU-Heavenly Korea and the providential organizations at the Pastors' Assembly gathered at Cheon Won Gung for a Special Audience with the True Parents of Heaven, Earth and Humankind.

True Mother began her message with the probing question, "Am I Holy Mother Han? What does that mean?"—reminding us that she is the embodiment of Heavenly Mother as the Substantial Holy Spirit and the Only Begotten Daughter.

She then explained how Heavenly Parent has guided the providence of salvation for fallen humanity, working through the people of Israel and Christianity. True Mother elaborated, "Jesus died on the cross, and promised to come again. Christianity began through the Apostles as they awaited Jesus' return, when he would hold the Marriage Supper of the Lamb."

True Mother expressed how regrettable it was that Christianity had not adequately prepared the environment for True Parents, and spoke about their 40 years of work in the US following their Holy Wedding. Beginning with the Pilgrims who sought religious freedom, she described how Heaven

nurtured and raised the United States as a central nation for God's providence.

True Mother emphasized the restoration of the Christian environment, stating, "Who must you become one with? With Holy Mother Han. This is what today's leaders must practice and demonstrate through action. We should witness not to one person a month, but at least one person a day, so this nation fulfills its responsibility. Only then can this nation become the homeland of the chosen people that is respected and revered by the world!" Finally, she encouraged everyone by saying, "Let us achieve victory together."

Aligning with True Mother's Central Providence

The 700 assembly participants included FFWPU pastoral couples and administrators, evangelists, youth leaders, local BFD heads, UPF executives and chapter leaders, WFWP leaders, and representative senior pastors.

The general assembly, held in collaboration with Cheon Mu Won, focused on three key objectives: strengthening internal capabilities, establishing strategic footholds, and achieving tangible results in preparation for offering the 60th Heavenly Parent's

Day; fostering spiritual awakening based on spirit and truth, moving toward victory in VISION 2027; and refining mission field strategies in line with recent restructuring. The event was held in accordance with True Mother's guidance and providential direction.

During the opening ceremony, Lee Cheong-woo, Chief Director of the Cheon Mu Won Central Administration, introduced core policies focused on building internal strength, establishing strategic footholds, and producing substantial results. He called on Heavenly Korea's pastors to align more deeply with True Mother's central providence and policy direction, emphasizing:

"The more chaotic the times, the more we need clear standards and steadfast hearts as children who attend True Parents."

In addition, Chief Director Lee emphasized the focus on witnessing, building internal strength, establishing strategic footholds, and producing substantial results. He emphasized Cheon Mu Won's role in serving as a bridge to help those in the field to align with True Mother's will.

Then, Hwangbo Guk, President of FFWPU-Heavenly Korea, addressed the assembly with heartfelt urgency, calling on the Korean church to unite with True Mother's heart and to realize the kingdom of heaven on earth within their lives during this pivotal period in providential history. Presentations by FFWPU HQ and affiliated organizations followed, outlining their approaches to

achieving VISION 2027. These were followed by regional strategy reports and open discussions—connecting with the principles and direction set forth by Cheon Mu Won.

During the Special Audience with the True Parents the FFWPU Pastoral Couples, with Hwangbo Guk, President of FFWPU-Heavenly Korea, serving as the MC, a song of praise was offered before the solemn entrance of True Parents and bows of reverence. After presentations of flowers and gifts, UPF-Korea President Park Young-bae delivered a heartfelt prayer of gratitude. The program continued with True Parents' message, followed by a Hyojeong cultural performance featuring young pastors, district and vice-district leader and their wives, as well as the senior pastors and concluded with three resounding cheers of *Eok Mansei*, led by Chungbuk District Leader Byeon Jung-ho.

Resolution for Victory in VISION 2027

In the afternoon, a special lecture was delivered by Professor Seong Hae-young of Seoul National University on the topic, "The Direction Religion Should Take in a Post-Religious Era." Professor Seong noted that Korean society has entered an "era of self-realization," while emphasizing that the intrinsic human longing for spirituality and transcendence still remains alive. He stressed, "Religion gains new life when it achieves a balanced and harmonious integration of intellect, ethics, and spirituality," adding "Korea must become the model for this kind of transformation."

On the third day, Professor Oh Taek-yong delivered a special lecture titled *"The Providential Meaning of Holy Mother Han."* He explained that the title "Holy Mother Han," proclaimed by True Mother, is not simply a name but a providential designation that encapsulates the entirety of her life journey. He highlighted its significance in inaugurating a new era of creation, with True Mother standing as the embodied manifestation of the Heavenly Parent.

At the closing ceremony, Rev. Hwangbo presented commemorative photo albums of the Cheonil Sanctum Entrance Ceremony, bestowed by True Mother, to the leaders of each church district and affiliated organization. The heartfelt applause of the participants expressed their deep reverence and gratitude to True Mother.

In his closing remarks, Rev. Hwangbo underscored the significance of cultivating a faith rooted in gratitude. He called upon everyone to follow True Mother's example of a life lived in gratitude, and to embody the path of true children capable of moving Heaven—even in times of crisis.

The event concluded with a unison prayer for Victory in VISION 2027, through which the pastors and other public leaders of FFWPU-Heavenly Korea reaffirmed their solemn resolution to fulfill their missions in their respective fields. As true children called to lead the Cheon Il Guk era in alignment with True Mother's words, they strengthened their commitment to achieve victory for VISION 2027—and with that determination, they departed for their assigned mission areas. 

Cheon Won Gung Cheonwon Grand Church Holds Senior Pastor Installation and Farewell Service

On June 8 (Heavenly Calendar 5.13), the Cheon Won Gung Cheonwon Grand Church held a Senior Pastor Installation and Farewell Service, attended by approximately 400 Cheon Il Guk leaders and blessed families.

The service opened with a moving performance by the Cheonshim Choir, followed by a message of encouragement from Kim In-chang, Director of the Mission Policy Department at Cheon Mu Won. Outgoing Senior Pastor Lee Gi-seong delivered his farewell address, and incoming Senior Pastor Hwangbo Guk, President of FFWPU-Heavenly Korea, gave his inaugural remarks. The program concluded with three resounding cheers of *Eok Mansei* led by Jo Man-woong, President of the Senior Pastors Association.

In a message of encouragement, Policy Director Kim conveyed True Mother's guidance, explaining that the current organizational restructuring is aimed at expanding the Cheon Il Guk environment. This mission calls upon all providential organizations—including the Family Federation—to make witnessing the top priority and actively broaden the substantial realm of Cheon Il Guk, the kingdom of heaven on earth, beginning with the town of Seorak in Gapyeong County, which is home to Hyojeong Cheonwon. He further emphasized the importance of aligning with Cheon Mu Won, centered on

the 2025 motto bestowed by True Mother, and urged all leaders to fulfill their responsibility as devoted children in restoring Gapyeong.


Outgoing Senior Pastor Lee Gi-seong, in his farewell address, reported four key accomplishments offered to Heaven during his 10-month tenure at Cheonwon Grand Church. These included: laying a foundation for witnessing through the dispatch of heavenly tribal messiahs to all 131 villages in Gapyeong County; the creation of new centers for outreach through the dedication of new churches in Sang-myeon, Jojong-myeon, and Buk-myeon—three townships which previously did not have FFWPU churches; the activities of the Gapyeong Hyojeong Service Corps to strengthen and expand the witnessing environment; and offering the Gapyeong Hyojeong Culture Festival as the first official event to Heaven during the events marking the Cheonwon Gung Cheonil Sanctum Entrance.

Senior Pastor Lee Gi-seong pledged, "Moving forward, I will continue to attend True Mother with devotion centered on Cheonshim Won, striving to unite all blessed families as one. I will do my utmost to

mobilize the spirit world toward the substantial settlement of the Cheon Il Guk capital, and to strengthen the spirituality of members—creating a spiritual environment where Heavenly Parent can freely work."

In his inauguration address, newly appointed Senior Pastor Hwangbo Guk stated, "The current providence, unfolding within the grace of True Mother, is entering an era in which the realm of the kingdom of heaven on earth is fully open and accessible within our daily lives. This marks the golden age of the providence—a time when we are called to seek the nation and the righteousness that Heaven longs to see substantiated."

Korean Christian Leadership Conference (KCLC) June Prayer Meeting

The Korean Christian Leadership Conference (KCLC) held its June prayer meeting on June 18 at the Haenuri Retreat Center in Goesan County, North Chungcheong Province. Approximately 20 pastors attended the meeting, where they engaged in in-depth discussions aimed at future revitalization.

Hong Yun-jong, President of the Korea Religions Association, has met individually with KCLC pastors since his inauguration to assess the current situation and establish future plans. During this prayer meeting, he requested that the pastors in attendance become a strong pillar for KCLC. He also emphasized that this pillar should not just serve as the foundation of an organization, but as a spiritual pillar for building God's kingdom.


Kim Soo-man, co-chair of KCLC, emphasized, "Every gathering must have a clear purpose, and it is important for KCLC to clearly recognize its founding purpose and identity, and properly understand the will of True Parents."

Senior Pastor Kim Shin-woong referenced Isaiah 43:1, where God declares, "You are mine," to profoundly affirm our identity as God's children. He then reminded the congregation of God's providence in protecting him people throughout history, citing examples such as the flood in Noah's time, the parting of the Red Sea during the Exodus, and the judgment of Sodom and Gomorrah. He reassured everyone that

God's protection and guidance remain unchanging, even in the present day.

Pastor Shin Ho-chul addressed five critical challenges confronting modern Korean Christianity: shamanism, secularization, materialism, ignorance, and elitism. He shared profound insights with those present, emphasizing the need to serve God properly and return to the essence of faithful Christianity.

After the prayer meeting, participants shared a meal and fellowship, followed by a focused discussion where KCLC's core vision, goals, and key activities were thoroughly reviewed and discussed.

Among the topics addressed were plans to operate an interdenominational church, with a decision made to hold regular gatherings on the first and third Tuesdays of each month. While biblical teaching remains foundational, members agreed to integrate ideological education about the founder to further strengthen KCLC's identity and direction. They also resolved to continue holding peace and unification prayer meetings and to launch leadership training programs for key leaders to promote qualitative growth in ministry. 



Women's Federation for World Peace "Wellness Peace Journey"

From June 11 to 12, the Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP - Korea chapter, led by President Kim Go-eun) hosted a "Wellness Peace Journey" at Camp Greaves and sites near the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) in Paju, Gyeonggi Province.

The event was designed as an integrated experiential program, combining education that fosters empathy for Korean unification, site visits symbolizing Korea's division, and wellness-based meditation experiences in nature.

This "Wellness Peace Journey" marked the final phase of the "Peaceful Unification Wellness Program," a project conducted as part of the Ministry of the Interior and Safety's 2025 Public Interest Support Program for Nonprofit Civil Organizations. The curriculum—centered on "Understanding Unification Issues from the Perspective of Conflict Resolution"—was thoughtfully structured to include both foundational instruction through the "Wellness Unification School" and immersive field-based learning.

On the first day, Dr. Ra Hun-il from Dongguk University's Department of North Korean Studies led a discussion session that encouraged participants to move beyond passive learning. Themed "Pro-Unification vs.


Anti-Unification," the class focused on empathetic listening and persuasive dialogue, inviting participants to explore the complexity of unification from diverse perspectives.

The division site tour was carefully designed to allow participants to reflect on the pain of the Korean War, examine current security realities, and consider the possibilities of future unification. The tour unfolded across three meaningful sites:

- The National Memorial for Korean War Abductees, honoring the sorrowful legacy of those taken during the conflict;
- Camp Greaves, formerly a U.S. military base, now repurposed as the DMZ's only youth hostel and cultural exhibit hall, showcasing the historical and contemporary realities of division;
- And the DMZ Forest, home to the DMZ's only glass greenhouse—transformed into a vibrant symbol of life and healing within a once-divided space.

Together, these locations guided participants through the temporal flow and emotional landscape of Korea's divided history.

Wellness experience activities were led by Oxygen Footprint Co., Ltd., a wellness education institute specializing in holistic programs. Participants took part in sound bath meditation using therapeutic instruments in the DMZ Forest, engaged in walking meditation in sync with the forest's tranquil rhythm, and practiced forest yoga under the early summer sunlight—all aimed at enhancing mental and physical well-being and deepening inner peace.

A representative from WFWP shared, "Wellness is not simply about healing—it's the starting point for expanding inner peace into social empathy." She added, "This journey has reaffirmed that unification is not a goal imposed from above, but a process built together through empathy and trust in our daily lives." WFWP has expressed a commitment to continuing wellness-based education programs that support peace and unification in the future. 

Unification Preparation Academy with Foreign Residents in Korea

The Unification Preparation Academy with Foreign Residents in Korea, aimed at building international consensus on peace and unification of the Korean Peninsula, was held on June 30 at the Seoul Archives Conference Room in Eunpyeong-gu, Seoul.

Hosted by the Unification Korea Federation (hereafter referred to as the Korea Federation), the informative session was designed as an opportunity for foreign residents in Korea, North Korean defectors, youth, and Seoul citizens to come together and explore the future of unification. Following up on programs held in Jeonbuk, Gyeongju, Gwangju, Gangwon, and Gyeonggi, this session was the first to be held in Seoul, and attracted much interest, attended by about 60 people, including Korean and international citizens.

The event, emceed by Lee Sang-ho, Secretary General of the Korea Federation Seoul Metropolitan Chapter, opened with the pledge of allegiance, followed by opening remarks by Korea Federation President Park Young-bae, who expressed his concern over the widespread perception that unification is disconnected from everyday life. He emphasized, "Unification is not the responsibility of a privileged few—it is a vital issue directly tied to our future and the very foundation of life for the next generation." He added, "I hope today's gathering will serve as a meaningful step toward making unification a present and personal reality for all of us."

In his welcome remarks, Ok Yun-Ho, Standing Advisor of the Unification Korea Federation Seoul branch, stated, "Unification is no longer solely an issue between North and South Korea—it is a challenge that must be addressed by all of humanity. In particular, it is essential to build a shared understanding with foreign nationals."

Kim Ju-seop, President of the Seoul Metropolitan Ambassadors for Peace Council, encouraged attendees by stating: "Unification becomes possible when those from younger generations and diverse cultures come together in mutual understanding."

In his congratulatory remarks, Song Kwang-seok, Director of the Inter-Korean Unification Policy Research Institute, emphasized, "The core of today's event lies in clearly understanding the realities of North Korea and thoughtfully exploring solutions for unification based on liberal democracy," presenting a clear direction for

preparing for reunification.


In the keynote presentation, Dr. Kim Hak-young, a North Korea studies scholar, delivered an analysis under the theme "Characteristics of the North Korean Regime and the Hereditary Succession Process." The attendees show great interest in his in-depth examination of North Korea's political structure, the nature of its power succession, and the structural issues affecting inter-Korean relations.

During the panel discussion, author Lim Il, a North Korean defector, vividly described the oppressive nature of the North Korean regime and its mechanisms of control, emphasizing, "The key to unification lies in inner transformation through access to information and truth."

Youth representative Jang Ji-hye proposed, "The unification movement among young people must be a process of understanding differences and seeking common ground through dialogue." She added, "We need unification stories that resonate with generational culture and amplify women's voices. Above all, restoring relationships must come first."

Noda Koji, representative of foreign residents in Korea, stated: "Foreign nationals residing in Korea—who now comprise over 5% of the population—can serve as intermediaries between North and South Korea, especially in this time of change in the North." He added, "When foreigners come to understand Korea's culture and spirit, they can make meaningful contributions to the unification movement."

The event concluded with a spirited Q&A session centered on the timely question: "What should we be doing right now?" Throughout the discussion, participants demonstrated a strong sense of commitment and practical interest in the issue of unification.

A representative from the Korea Federation stated, "This Seoul event has served as a meaningful opportunity for participants—both Koreans and foreign residents—to recognize the issue of unification as a personal concern," adding, "We will continue to expand unification preparation programs that embrace diverse communities and regions."

Heavenly North America successfully hosted its annual leadership summit under the theme “Leaders’ Summit: Ready, Set, Go!” from May 27–29 at The Assembly by Kiln, a co-working and event space in Las Vegas. The gathering brought together more than 160 participants, including Heavenly USA leaders, pastors, Heavenly Top Gun (HTG) missionaries, and young adults from across the continent. Their mission: to chart a bold course for local church growth and national objectives through 2027.

One of the summit’s most significant developments was the expansion of Strategic Communities. Eight new groups joined the existing ten, strengthening collaborative efforts to increase membership, enhance tithing culture, modernize church facilities, and expand community outreach and programming.

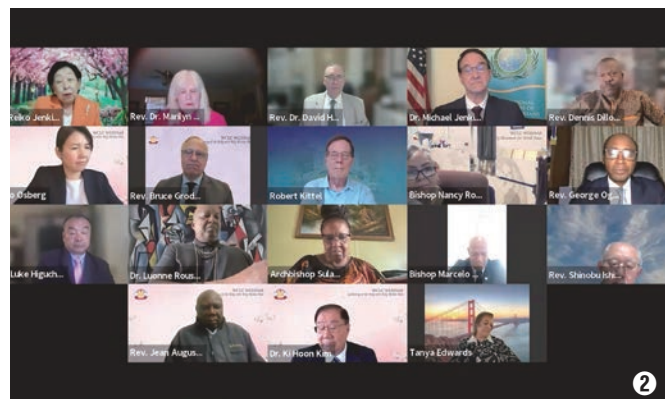
WCLC Hosts June Monthly Webinar
