The Spring of the Providence, the Golden Age with True Mother

There is a narrow path deep in a forest, barely wide enough for one person to walk along. The one who creates that path sweats profusely, with hands getting scratched while cutting away branches. Thanks to that person, those who come after can walk along the path in comfort. We need to be deeply grateful for the hard work of that first person, and endeavor to make the path wider and more even.

A path through people is harder to create than a path through a forest. Unlike trees that give way to the hatchet, people have their own will. And when something goes against their will, people close their hearts. I shed sweat and tears, trying to open hearts and connect people as one family. I pioneered a path no woman has ever walked, and embraced the world's peoples in the most precipitous places. I quietly practiced true love for human salvation and world peace

in situations from which anyone else would have run away. My forgiveness and embrace have moved enemies to tears.

Now we have ushered in the springtime of the providence. Spring is the busiest time for farmers. They must do their utmost to ensure an abundant harvest in the fall. In this providential spring, we need to construct the original world that God planned to realize from the beginning. We can receive the marriage Blessing and share it with our family and tribe. Then we can work together as veritable messiahs to transform our nation. Such is Heaven's decree.

No matter how difficult our work, we need to complete the providence and reveal the truth. When we fulfill our responsibility, following God as sunflowers follow the sun, we will surely realize Heavenly Parent's dream and humanity's hope. The question is whether we will be able to achieve that while I am on earth.



If we do, we will stand proud and tall in front of our descendants and all generations to come. There has never been such an opportunity. No matter how young or old you are, you are living in the same era as the Only Begotten Daughter. This is your golden age. Be grateful and do not miss this time.

We cannot let the world be ignorant of the coming of True Parents and the blessings and grace of God. We must guide all people to attend Heaven. Those who live in the kingdom of heaven on earth can go to the kingdom of heaven in heaven. We have one goal and one path, the path by which we can become God's proud sons and daughters. We need to lead lives such that God can embrace us and say, "Well done, my daughter! Well done, my son!" We need to realize in our hearts that this is the golden age.

True Parents' guiding life philosophy is "live

for the sake of others." Wherever I may go, I practice living for the sake of others. I always try to love people more than their own parents or siblings do. People tend to keep the best things for themselves and give things of lesser value to others, even in the relationship with their own parents. If you pursue only personal gain, chains of addiction and greed will tie you down. If you constantly put others first and live for their sake, you are on the path to eternal freedom and blessing.

When I see people in need, I give them whatever I have. I even gave somebody my wedding ring. A world where everyone gives their best things to others is a world of joy. This is my life philosophy. People who live only for themselves will soon hit a wall. You need to live your life with love and generosity.

Many people suppose that Father and Mother Moon are wealthy. The truth is, we have never

owned a house, a car, anything. I am sure no one has been as thrifty as my husband and I. How can we possibly eat good food and sleep in comfort while knowing that missionaries are working through the night at home and abroad? We direct that all donations from church members be used for the poor through building schools and other projects.

We endured hunger because we knew there were people who were hungrier. We should not be indebted to Heaven. People who follow the providential path while coveting material things violate heavenly law and bring sorrow to their parents.

I have always placed love at the center of my life. Life is like running a marathon without knowing when it will end. A truly successful life is not powered by money, position or authority; it is powered by true love. True love is a mother breastfeeding when she is going hungry. That is the greatest love of all. Love is why we are here, how we should live, and where we are going. No matter the difficulties we face, the answer is to practice absolute faith, absolute love and absolute obedience.

If you reflect on God's heart, you will recognize that the hardships and suffering that you may be going through are nothing

compared to God's. We have to repent before God. You did not bring yourself into the world. Your life is a gift from God. His will for us is that we make our lives beautiful and worthwhile. When we believe in our hearts that we are here for our children and family, for our spouse, as well as for all humanity and the entire world, we will find happiness.

In all of this, your heart is your closest teacher. In the face of difficulty or confusion, ask your heart. Your Heavenly Parent who loves you resides deep in your heart. You are designed to hear God's true voice. We all need to hone our ability to hear the true voice of Heavenly Father and Heavenly Mother in our hearts. Your heart is your eternal guardian. Heartfelt prayer is the only passageway to God. Through such true prayer, you will receive the grace of God and True Parents in even the most destitute and difficult place. The helping hand of that grace leads us on the free and happy path to the kingdom of heaven. *✠*

Gyeongbae Ceremony in Celebration of the Holy Births of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind

The Gyeongbae Ceremony in celebration of the Holy Births of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind was held on 1.6 by the heavenly calendar in the 14th year of Cheon Il Guk (February 22, 2026) at 8:00 AM at Cheonshim Won.

The ceremony proceeded in the following order: ▲Lighting of the Holy Candles (True Family) ▲Opening Declaration ▲Cheon Il Guk Anthem ▲Family Pledge ▲Prayer of Gratitude ▲Cheon Il Guk Gyeongbae Ceremony ▲Holy Meal ▲Message ▲Cheers of Eok-Mansei ▲Gyeongbae ▲Closing Declaration.

The ceremony began with the lighting of the holy candles by the families of Moon Hyo-jin and Moon Heung-jin, representing the four-position foundation of the True Family. The opening was then declared by Song Yong-cheon, President of the Family Federation for Heavenly Korea, who served as the master of ceremonies.

In the prayer of gratitude, Kim Dong-woo, Continental Director of Heavenly Central and South America, reflected on the past and offered repentance, praying that the occasion would become a new starting point in our lives. He also prayed that the 14th year of Cheon Il Guk would be a year in which we unite with True Parents and fully attend Heavenly Parent, and resolved to practice and realize Heavenly Parent’s Will in daily life.

Cheon Il Guk leaders, together with the True Family,

offered bows with one heart, celebrating the Holy Births of True Parents. During the Holy Meal, all participants joined in proclaiming, “Congratulations on the Holy Births of True Parents,” and shared the rice cakes of the Holy Meal with hearts of gratitude.

The Commemorative Worship Service for the Holy Births of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind and the 13th Anniversary of Cheon Il Guk Foundation Day was held at 10:00 AM 1.6 by the heavenly calendar in the 14th year of Cheon Il Guk (February 22, 2026) in the Main Hall of the HJ Heaven and Earth CheonBo Training Center.

Blessed families from around the world participated both onsite and online. The service proceeded in the

In his prayer of gratitude, Lee Gi-seong, President of Cheonshim Won, reflected on how True Mother inaugurated Foundation Day to fulfill Heavenly Parent’s dream and the promise she had made with True Father, and how she has guided the providence without interruption over the past 13 years. He also expressed deep gratitude for the providential journey through which Heavenly Parent’s dream was realized through the Cheon Won Gung Cheonil Sanctum Entrance Ceremony.

Following this, members of the True Family’s four-position foundation, together with the Inheritors of Heaven’s Love and Blessing, offered bouquets of gratitude and congratulations. Today, we make a solemn resolve and pledge to attend True Mother and walk with her to the very end.” They further affirmed, “We pledge to become true children of Cheon Il Guk—Heaven’s chosen people—who give our utmost in every moment and persevere faithfully to the end.”

World Mission Headquarters Director-General Ken Doo affirmed, “We have now transitioned into an age in which we live together with Heavenly Parent, who is truly and substantially present among us.” He urged that we move beyond a faith that is largely conceptual, and unwrap the bundle of love within our hearts, letting it pour out in ways our neighbors and society can genuinely



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feel and experience. He continued, “We must bring true love and heart into tangible reality, and in doing so, bring to completion a Cheon Il Guk that transcends religion.” Encouraging all participants, he concluded, “In 2026, let us inscribe the opening page of a new history—written in the living record of substantial true love.”

Blessed families around the world solemnly reflected on the sacred significance of the Holy Births of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind and the dawn of the Cheon Il Guk era. One in heart, they reaffirmed their unwavering commitment to live centered on Heavenly Parent and to embody substantive true love in every aspect of their daily lives.

Commissioning Ceremony for the 11th Class of Cheon Il Guk Special Youth Envoys

Also held during the commemorative worship service was the Commissioning Ceremony for the 11th class of Cheon Il Guk Special Youth Envoys. A total of 79 cadets completed their training and were commissioned as Cheon Il Guk Youth Envoys, among them Missionaries Moon Shin-chul and Moon Shin-heung, the Inheritors of Heaven’s Love and Blessing.

The 79 newly commissioned youth envoys comprised 54 members of Junior UPA Class 1 and 25 members of Senior UPA Class 11. The Junior UPA cadets completed six years of training and served as Heavenly Top Gun missionaries, proclaiming True Parents’ message in mission areas around the world. The Senior UPA cadets completed a master’s program at Sunhak Universal Peace Graduate University, followed by a two-year internship at FFWPU Heavenly Korea mission sites and affiliated institutions, further developing and equipping themselves as leaders.

At the commissioning ceremony, Moon Yeon-ah nim and Moon Hoon-sook nim, members of the True Family, presented the youth envoys with their letters of appointment and commissioning rings on behalf of True Parents. Upon receiving their commissions, the youth envoys renewed their sense of mission and the responsibilities entrusted to them as Cheon Il Guk leaders.

Nurtured in the love of True Parents, the special youth envoys pledged to become devoted *hyojeong rang*, fully committed to the fulfillment of the providence and the firm establishment of Cheon Il Guk. They vowed to go forth as youth leaders who will carry and proclaim the Will of Heavenly Parent throughout the world and across every mission front.

2026 Winter Great Works and Holy Ground Pilgrimages

The 2026 Winter Hyojeong CheonBo Special Great Works in Celebration of the Holy Births of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind in the 14th year of Cheon Il Guk was held at the HJ Heaven and Earth CheonBo Training Center from 1.4 to 1.6 by the heavenly calendar in the 14th year of Cheon Il Guk

(February 20–22, 2026). More than 140,000 participants from around the world registered for the event and shared the grace of hyojeong.

Throughout the Great Works, members gathered in sincere devotion by joining the Cheonshim Won Special Prayer Vigil, the Chanyang Sessions, and prayer meetings in the Special Prayer Hall. A variety of programs were also offered, including a special lecture on the Ocean Providence and kingdom of heaven breathing technique, guiding members toward deeper spiritual reflection and the practical living of their faith.

In addition, a variety of cultural events—including caricature booths and food stalls—were organized, heightening the festive atmosphere. This Great Works became a place of grace in which participants inherited heavenly fortune within the embrace of Heavenly Parent and True Parents, and reaffirmed their commitment to a new beginning.

During the same period, a special holy ground pilgrimage was held in commemoration of the Holy Births of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind. Pilgrims toured Cheon Jeong Gung and Cheon Won Gung, reflecting on the life and accomplishments of True Parents and retracing the providential journey they walked to fulfill the dream of Heavenly Parent.

After offering respects at Bonhyang Won, pilgrims toured the True Parents' Life Exhibition Hall and offered

prayers in the Cheon Jeong Gung Special Prayer Room. At Cheon Won Gung, they visited the Great Epic of the Chosen Han People Hall, the Cheon Won Museum of Art, and the Registry of Cheonseung Families [donors who contributed to the construction of Cheon Won Gung]. They then entered the Cheon II Sanctum to offer prayers and viewed the exhibition of the Cheon II Seonghwa artworks.

International Academic Conference of the Institute for the Chosen Han People

On 1.7 by the heavenly calendar in the 14th year of Cheon II Guk (February 23, 2026), an International Academic Conference of the Institute for the Chosen Han People was held in the Multipurpose Hall of Cheon Won Gung, with approximately 300 attendees, including heads of providential organizations and Cheon II Guk leaders.



Held under the theme “The Identity and Culture of the Han People of Korea,” the conference served as a forum to explore how the thought system of the Korean Han people—as a chosen people—can be shared and disseminated globally.

In her welcoming remarks, Kim Min-ji, Director of the Institute for the Chosen Han People, stated, “Beneath the phenomenon of Korean culture permeating the daily lives of people around the world today flows the unique spirituality of the Korean Han people.” She added, “The concept of the chosen people that we study does not refer to exclusive superiority, but rather to universal values committed to fulfilling our responsibility toward humanity, rooted in the heart cultivated through a history of suffering.”

In his opening address, Vice Director Oota Tomohisa of the Institute for the Chosen Han People emphasized, “We are heading toward a world of one family of humanity centered on True Parents, and this present age is the very age in which those True Parents, who are that center, have appeared.” He expressed the hope that the conference would serve as “a significant occasion for conveying to future generations the historic event of the manifestation of the Only Begotten Daughter.”

Delivering the keynote lecture, Lee Gi-sik, President of the Institute for the Chosen Han People, emphasized that “for the Korean people to attend True Parents and participate in the providence of salvation is not a privilege but a matter of fundamental responsibility.” He further explained, “The chosen people of this age should not be confined to lineage or nationality, but should expand into a “chosen people of the heart” — those who reflect the heart of Heavenly Parent and embrace the suffering of humanity.” He added, “Our mission is to lead the way


toward a world in which all humanity becomes one family attending Heavenly Parent.”

In the academic session, Dr. Yang Soon-seok, Deputy Director Katsuhiko Noguchi of the Japan Doctrine Research Institute, and Professor Moon Min-young of the University of North Carolina, and Professor Moon Min-young (University of North Carolina), among others, delivered presentations examining the identity of the Korean Han people from theological and cultural perspectives. Participants also reached a consensus that the culture of filial piety and love of the Korean people could serve as an ethical foundation for modern society.

Cheon Il Guk Leaders' Open Forum

The Cheon Il Guk Leaders' Open Forum Commemorating True Parents' Holy Births was held from 1.4 to 1.10 by the heavenly calendar in the 14th year of Cheon Il Guk (February 20–26, 2026), in the Multipurpose Hall of Cheon Seung Jeon.

Heads of providential organizations and continental directors from around the world attended the forum, where both major developments and challenges in various nations were shared. Drawing on this information, discussions ensued on the future direction of the providence.

The forum consisted of five thematic sessions, along with a roundtable meeting with the Director-General of the World Mission Headquarters and a peace prayer gathering at the Seoul Detention Center. Participants reaffirmed their commitment to fulfilling their responsibilities in their respective positions and resolved to become one with True Parents in establishing the environment for the settlement of Cheon Il Guk.

At that moment, there was nothing we could do. We did not even know how to begin to accept such a reality. All we could do was stand there, our gaze fixed beyond the enclosing walls, thinking, "She must be there . . . Mother must have heard this devastating news as well."

In that way, we passed the dawn with sleepless eyes and greeted the morning. And yet, we knew we had to steady ourselves. We had to rise again - because Mother was there. And because Mother's words lifted us up. It was Mother's words that gathered our scattered hearts and enabled us, once again, to look toward hope.

"Do not worry about me. Do not pray for me.
Rather, pray and offer your devotion for yourselves, your families, our Unification community, and for the fulfillment of our Heavenly Parent's Will.
Blessed families, I love you."

Our Internal Attitude at this Time – True Parents’ Birthday in the Year of the Red Horse

We are honored to join with our beloved True Mother, the Holy Mother Han, to usher in the Year of the Red Horse. It is also with great honour to be able to offer our special greetings to True Mother on the occasion of True Parents’ birthday, 2026. And to all family members worldwide, we wish you all a Happy True Parents’ Birthday Celebration.

We understand that the year of the Red Horse is associated with intense energy and passion, a time of significant transformation. It also represents a time for bold moves and rapid progress. Amazingly, the description of the year of the Red Horse closely matches what we are experiencing at this time. For us in Heavenly Parent’s Holy Community, the turbulence of the time, which started in the last third of 2025 and has persisted into 2026, promises and paves the way for transformation, bold moves and rapid progress.

Looking back, we recall that in April 2025, True Mother victoriously inaugurated the Cheon Won Gung Cheonil Sanctum, bringing glory to our Heavenly Parent. Just a few months later, in September 2025, we were

all shocked to learn that True Mother had been placed in the detention center. That was our situation as we entered the year of the Red Horse.

As members of Heavenly Parent’s Holy Community, how did we process and digest this twist of fate? We were shocked, outraged, and anguished. We cried, prayed, repented for our shortcomings, offered devotions, protested, reached out to our friends and supporters, held daily prayer sessions in front of the detention center, and offered nightly vigils in our churches and Cheonshim Won prayer halls around the world.

Several weeks after our True Mother had been in detention, I ran into one person who was a one-time associate of ours. This person said to me, “Oh, I heard that your founder, Mother Moon is in detention. How are you all keeping faith in the church now?” I instantly understood the import of his comment and my reaction was sharp. “What do you mean by ‘keeping faith’? Are you implying that we should have run away because our Mother is unjustly put in detention?” Isn’t it fundamental that you stand by the one you love under any circumstance?”

History has taught us that people of true faith do not seek to escape at times of trial and persecution. We are good students of history. If anything, this is the time that our faith and commitment to Heavenly Parent and True Parents must be stronger than ever before. Perhaps those who persecute us are hoping that we will be broken under the weight of persecution, threats and intimidation. Once the truth is revealed, they will be ashamed. They are perhaps unaware of the history of religious faith. You can destroy that which is physical but you cannot destroy that which is spiritual. That's why the Bible says, "Fear not those who can only kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in hell." (Matt. 10:28)

The year of the Red Horse suggests that as we celebrate our True Parents Birthday, we do so with an internal attitude that is centered on filial piety, unity of heart, and active responsibility to complete the providential mission as owners of Cheon Il Guk. We must be focused on fostering a deep, sacrificial, parental heart that mirrors our Heavenly Parent's unconditional love, in unity with True Mother as she strives to complete the Will of Heaven. Q Congratulations on your appointment as special youth envoys. What motivated you to apply to UPA?

[Yoshiyuki Shikanai] When I was in high school, I went through a time of deep reflection about my future—questioning whether I should pursue my own personal dreams or dedicate myself to the path of public service in support of True Parents. Around that time, True Mother delivered a message at a rally in Japan commemorating the 60th anniversary of the Japanese mission. Hearing her speak about how second-generation members from Korea and Japan were actively going out into the world and making an impact, I felt a strong conviction that I, too, should step forward into the wider world and contribute to the providence. From that moment, I set my heart firmly on the path of public service.

Later, while studying at a language institute, I

learned that Sun Moon UPA had been established. I immediately recognized this as the unmistakable guidance of Heavenly Parent and True Parents. With my heart overflowing with gratitude and joy, I made a resolute commitment to join UPA.

[Patima Atithanakul] Before joining UPA, whenever I faced difficulties and turned to prayer, I always felt Heavenly Parent right there beside me. Each time, I sensed Heavenly Parent watching over me with love—never once departing from my side, not even when I made mistakes. Through those countless experiences, Heavenly Parent became the greatest presence in my life. So when the moment came to make a major decision, I reflected: since Heavenly Parent has always remained by my side, this time I wanted to remain by Heavenly Parent’s side as well. That is why, instead of choosing the easy path or the one I personally desired, I chose the path dedicated to Heavenly Parent.



Interview with UPA Youth Envoy Yoshiyuki Shikanai

[Huang Ling-Yi] On July 21, 2019, after a rally in Cheonan, I attended the victory celebration, and True Mother spoke to us, “In 2020, Sun Moon University will be transformed. I will build up the department of theology to become like a military academy. It will become the university that second-generation members from around the world most want to attend.” At that time, my Korean was not strong, yet these particular words reached my ears with striking clarity, and I was able to understand them fully. I felt with great conviction that this message was a personal calling directed to me. I also sensed True Mother’s earnest hope—as she looked toward the younger generation—to help us grow through UPA. Quite naturally, I found myself moved to join in fulfilling that hope.

Q. How did your family or those around you respond when you applied?

[Yoshiyuki Shikanai] Everyone around me gave their wholehearted support. At first, there was concern,

since this was not an easy path to walk. But when I shared candidly about why I had chosen it and the conviction behind my decision, they came to understand my heart and stood with me.

[Patima Atithanakul] They responded very positively. My parents and family were all very supportive, and a friend I had studied with also applied to UPA with me, which made me feel even more at ease.

[Huang Ling-Yi] My parents had always supported my studies and the decisions I made, but when I said I wanted to enter the Department of Theology, my mother opposed it. Both of my parents had served in public missions, so they knew firsthand how demanding that path could be, and it was out of concern for me as their child that my mother was concerned. Even so, I felt that if I did not go to UPA, I would regret it for the rest of my life. So I made up my mind and expressed my determination to them. My husband, too, waited patiently for me. Now, both my husband and my parents are proud of me as I devote myself wholeheartedly to the provide



Interview with UPA Youth Envoy Patima Atithanakul

Q After you entered UPA, what has been the most difficult moment for you, and how did you overcome it?

[Yoshiyuki Shikanai] The hardest moment came when I felt the wide gap between the person True Parents envisioned me to be and who I actually was. My sense of calling was clear, yet whenever I felt how my abilities and capacities were falling short, I sank into deep discouragement. There were times I even found myself questioning, “Am I truly worthy to walk this path?” Yet each time, rather than letting shame take hold, I resolved to acknowledge my shortcomings and make them the starting point for growth. Through prayer and True Parents’ words, I re-established my center and steadily worked to build up my skills, starting from even the smallest areas. While it is also important to strive for perfection, I steadied myself with the mindset of simply moving one step beyond who I was yesterday. Through that process, I came to understand not only what it means to grow as an individual, but also how to grow within a community.

Looking back now, I see every one of those moments as precious training that has made me more resilient.

[Patima Atithanakul] In my third year, I went on a mission to the Philippines. Once there, I encountered many challenges—difficult living conditions, economic limitations, and even conflicts within the team. As the situation grew more difficult, we found ourselves having to manage meals and daily necessities on a very limited budget. In the midst of it all, I began to ask myself, “How can I change in this situation?” Around that time, while reading True Mother’s autobiography during hoondokhae, I came across these words, “Happiness does not come to us when we have everything. It comes mysteriously, when we have seemingly lost everything yet still feel gratitude.” Reading those words led me to reflect on the life True Mother had walked. I realized that she had taken a path far more difficult than mine, yet she always moved forward with a heart of gratitude toward Heavenly Parent. True Mother’s life and those words became a great comfort to me—they were like

a compass that gave me direction and helped me overcome those hardships.

[Huang Ling-Yi] In my second year, a great trial came to my family. At the time, I was a second-year student at UPA and beginning to feel the weight of many responsibilities, so when this happened to my family, I went through a very difficult time emotionally. I felt deep guilt, thinking that while I spoke about happiness and love in the family, I could not even protect my own. I kept wondering whether things might have been different if I had been at home. Lying alone in my room, I wept and found myself asking, “What am I living for? Why am I walking this path?” Then I thought about how hard it must have been for my mother, so I reached out to her. But instead of sharing her own pain, she comforted me, saying, “Don’t worry.” In that moment, I realized why the word “mother” carries such significance. At that moment, I felt Heavenly Parent’s love—especially True Mother’s love—surging toward me like a storm. I realized how profound and powerful True Mother’s love truly is. From then on, I began to think that I wanted to become a public leader who could share that love with many more people. I also felt a deep desire to become a light for those who cannot find hope in life, and to bring them hope.

Q When was the most memorable moment for you?

[Yoshiyuki Shikanai] The most memorable moment for me was when I had the opportunity to meet True Parents in person. In particular, the moment when True Mother called the UPA cadets and shared her words with us remains deeply engraved in my heart. It was not simply that I was present there—I truly felt that I myself was being called. In True Mother’s voice and gaze, I could sense her profound love and high expectations for UPA. At that moment, a strong sense of responsibility took root in my heart to live up to those expectations. It remains my most precious memory, one that strengthened my faith and deepened my resolve.

[Patima Atithanakul] During our mission work in Los Angeles, we met an elderly man who was not very welcoming toward us. Nevertheless, we continued visiting his home and bringing him food and snacks. On the last day before leaving the United States, we went to his house to say goodbye. For the first time, he opened his heart and honestly shared about the painful experiences from his past. In that moment,

I felt my perspective change. I began to see him through Heavenly Parent’s eyes—not as a man over ninety years old, but as a wounded young person. Through that experience, I realized that Heavenly Parent always sees us as beloved children—waiting for us and loving us with a parent’s heart.

[Huang Ling-Yi] The moment that left the deepest impression on me was in September 2025, when True Mother entered the detention center. Until then, I had received so much of True Mother’s love. Her presence and love felt completely natural to me—like the bond between a mother and child connected by the umbilical cord. But in that moment, I realized that if something I had always taken for granted were even briefly cut off, it would be so painful that I could hardly bear it. That was the moment when I most deeply realized that I cannot live without True Parents—especially True Mother.

Q What do you consider the mission of UPA?

[Yoshiyuki Shikanai] I believe it begins with developing a deep understanding of the heart and circumstances of True Parents. UPA is not simply an institution for acquiring knowledge; rather, it is a place where we first come to know the heart of Heavenly Parent and True Parents, and where individuals are nurtured to put that Will into practice in their lives. To achieve this, I believe it is important to grow in a balanced way—not only in faith, but also in character, competence, leadership, and a sense of community. Of course, there are many practical challenges. However, I believe that the very process of overcoming those limitations one by one is itself a form of training and growth.

[Patima Atithanakul] I believe it is about growing into representatives of Heavenly Parent and True Parents. At UPA, people from diverse backgrounds and with unique personalities come together, yet we all share the same heart toward Heavenly Parent. The journey at UPA is about becoming individuals who, through our distinct personalities and abilities, can reveal and share Heavenly Parent’s love with the world. I also believe our mission is to go where Heavenly Parent and True Parents wish to go, and to meet and love the people they wish to embrace—on their behalf.

[Huang Ling-Yi] UPA is a program that prepares Cheon Il Guk leaders who will guide the next generation, grounded in absolute unity with True

Parents. True Parents' dream has remained the same from the beginning—to realize world peace and establish the kingdom of heaven on earth and in heaven. As UPA envoys, we must become people who can play a central role in bringing that vision of peace to reality.

Q After being commissioned, what kind of work would you like to do as a special youth envoy?

[Yoshiyuki Shikanai] I aspire to become a person of exceptional ability and competitiveness—one who earns recognition not only within our faith community, but in society at large. I want to grow into someone who embodies not merely a passion for faith, but also professionalism, strong execution, and the ability to solve problems, so that I may responsibly fulfill the mission entrusted to me. I am committed to disciplining myself and maintaining a humble attitude of learning at all times, so that my personal growth may serve as a source of hope for our community. As a representative of True Parents, I aspire to live a life worthy of that calling, and to serve as a special youth envoy who faithfully carries out every responsibility entrusted to me, through to the very end.

[Patima Atithanakul] I hope to dedicate myself to educating and caring for young people. Because youth are the hope of the future, I believe they need great attention, love, and proper guidance. 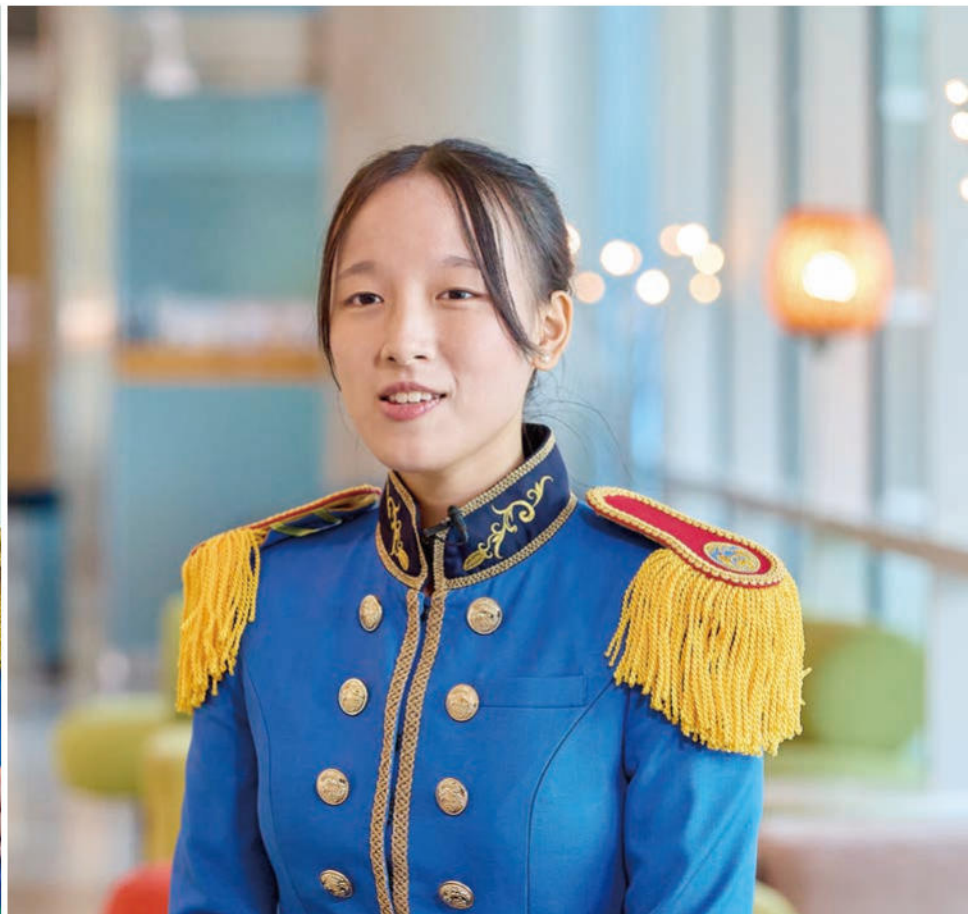

The Hyojeong Youth Church: A Church Young People Dream Of

On December 21, 2025, Hyojeong Youth Church officially opened its doors as the young persons' hub church of Northern Gyeonggi District, with a dedication service. The church represents a new model of faith community—one that goes beyond the conventional role of a young person or student ministry within an established congregation. Here, young people are not simply participants; they take primary responsibility for the church's ministry and operations, leading the community together. They are involved not only in Youth programs but also in key areas such as finances and administration.

In early February, True Peace Magazine met with Heo Eun-seon, Senior Manager of the Personnel Development Department, and Kim Young-ae, pastor of Hyojeong Youth Church, to hear the story behind its founding and explore the vision shaping this youth-led community.



A Church Led by Young People

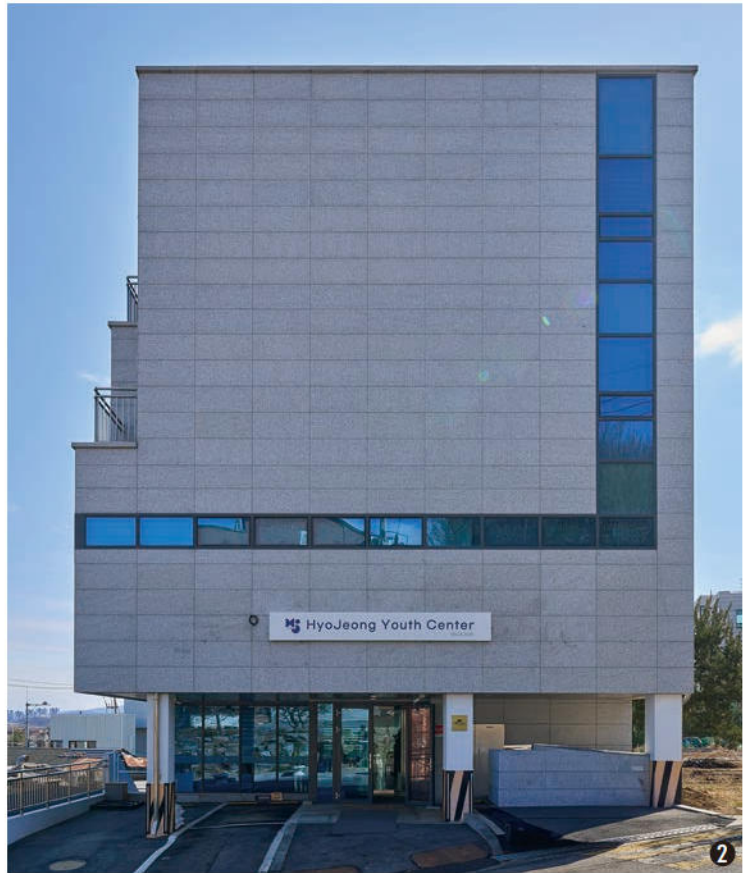
The founding of Hyojeong Youth Church stemmed from a deep concern for the young generation. As True Parents repeatedly emphasized the importance of raising and nurturing young people, the need for a new type of community centered on Youths became increasingly clear. The church found itself facing a pivotal question: “What must we prepare today for the sake of the next generation?”

Through this process of reflection, the dream and vision of a “Youth Church” gradually took root. At the same time, the vibrant community of members in their 20s and 30s at Guri Grand Church offered precisely the strong youth foundation that such a vision required. As these elements converged, a bold new challenge was set in motion: the establishment of a young generation hub church.

The defining characteristic of Hyojeong Youth Church is that it is, in the fullest sense, a church owned and led by young people. Whereas a typical youth ministry functions under the care and oversight of the parent generation, Hyojeong Youth Church places young people at the helm—entrusting them with responsibility for every aspect of the community’s life and affairs. Its governance also follows a different model: rather than being directed solely by a pastor, the church is guided by a formal set of bylaws, with all major decisions made collectively by the community itself.

One of the key reasons many young people leave the church is that they struggle to find a meaningful role within it. When church activities feel disconnected from the realities of daily life, a natural sense of distance from the community begins to grow. To confront this challenge, Hyojeong Youth Church made a deliberate choice: to entrust young people with both genuine authority and real responsibility.

The preparation of the church itself was likewise carried out entirely by young people. Over six to seven months, they renovated and breathed new life into a building that had once served as the headquarters of Heavenly Korea Sub-Region 2. From laying floor tiles and applying sealant to assembling furniture and designing the interior, they invested both their hands and hearts into every detail. Branding elements such as posters and the church logo were also created by the young members themselves. Much like launching

a youth-led start-up, every stage of the process unfolded through voluntary effort and shared initiative.

Beyond Worship: A Space Where Young People’s Daily Lives Take Root

As they prepared to establish Hyojeong Youth Church, Heo Eun-seon, Director of the Personnel Development Department, and Church Leader Kim Young-ae found themselves rethinking what “church” truly means as a space. It became a time of deep reflection—not merely on the church as a place of worship, but on the broader meaning of church and community itself. In that process, they recalled the stories of elder members who had pioneered the first congregations. Remembering the sacrifices of those who spared neither money nor time in building the community, they came to appreciate, even if only in part, the heart of those who had gone before them through their own experience of preparing Hyojeong Youth Church.

When the church officially opened last December, meaningful changes began to appear among the Youths themselves. As they joined in shaping the church’s operations and direction, a natural sense of



responsibility and ownership took root. By debating budgets and designing programs firsthand, their perspective on the church shifted dramatically. Where once they had been mere participants, they had now become co-creators—owners actively building the community together. This transformation is regarded as the most significant change of all.

Another hallmark of Hyojeong Youth Church is the transformation of its physical space. The entire building has been designed with young people in mind, creating an environment where they can linger freely long after worship concludes. While many churches remain centered primarily around worship halls, Hyojeong Youth Church aspires to be an open, welcoming place that the younger generation can visit at any time. In practice, when the lights are on during weekday evenings, university students and young professionals often stop by naturally to share stories from their day. A “church you can drop into, even without a reason”—that is the vision Hyojeong Youth Church seeks to embody.

To bring this vision to life, the building has been thoughtfully equipped with diverse spaces where young people can feel at home. The lobby features a cozy café open to anyone in need of rest, while seminar rooms provide students with places to study or collaborate on group projects. A dedicated childcare room for infants and toddlers ensures that young couples with small children can attend worship without concern.

The church also includes gathering rooms where youth can freely meet for conversation and activities, as well as a rehearsal studio for the youth band to practice. Together, these spaces reflect a deliberate

vision: to make the church not merely a place of worship, but a living environment that naturally integrates with the rhythm of young people’s everyday lives.

Creating a Reason for Young People to Come to Church

True Parents bestowed the new young people’s church with the name *Hyojeong Cheongnyeon Gyoheo* (孝情青年教會, hyojeong young generation church), a name carrying two profound meanings. *Hyo* (孝) signifies a heart of devotion aligned with Heaven’s Will, while *jeong*(情) represents the outward spread of true love.

Hyojeong Youth Church aspires to be a space where young people can not only experience this “culture of heart” in their daily lives but also actively share and expand it. To that end, the church is preparing a wide range of activities designed to help young people deepen their understanding of Heavenly Parent’s heart and encounter a living culture of true love in tangible, personal ways.

There is much that the church hopes to pursue going forward. In the near term, it is preparing a range of community activities, including university retreats, one-day workshops, and regular band performances. Above all, its primary goal is to develop a sustainable system so that the culture of community experienced by young people can continue to grow and be passed on.

Hyojeong Youth Church also keeps its doors open to all young people, regardless of where they come from. Many young people become disconnected from their church communities as they move away

from home for university or work. Hyojeong Youth Church hopes to serve as a hub where such young people can reconnect with the community of faith. The Guri area, where the church is located, holds particular significance as well, as it was established by True Parents as a cradle of education. The church aspires to become a place where young people can learn, grow, and deepen their faith within a supportive community.

Park Jin-ho, a member of Hyojeong Youth Church, put it plainly, "The reality today is that young people have far more reasons not to go to church than to go. Rather than simply asking them to come, we need to become a community that gives them a genuine reason to want to be here." In a world of increasingly busy lives and rapidly shifting values, young people's ways of engaging with the world are constantly evolving. In this light, Hyojeong Youth Church is committed to being a community that offers young people meaningful encounters and experiences that truly matter.

Hyojeong Youth Church is determined to create those very "reasons." Not a place where young people simply pass through, but a community of purpose—where hearts are opened and shared. A space where faith and friendship, laughter and hope flow freely together, and where the season of youth shines all the more brilliantly.

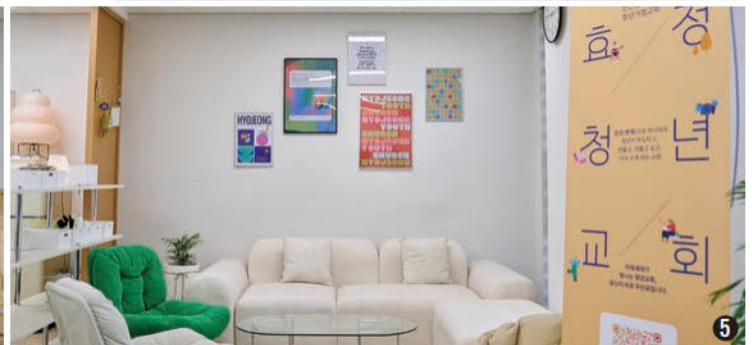
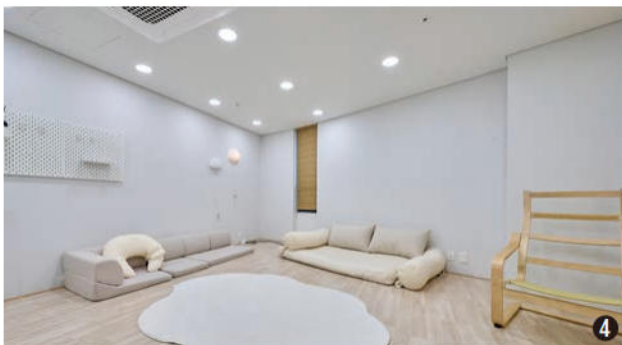

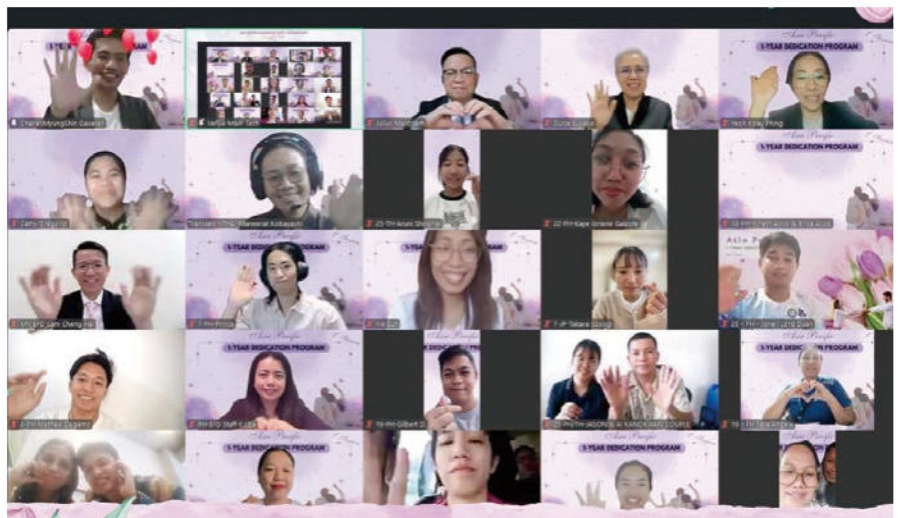

That evening, a special national worship service was held for West African members participating both in person and online. Rev. Doo’s message was centered on forgiveness, unity, and love, and participants felt called to repair family and community relationships. The delegation also visited the city of Ouidah, a center of the slave trade from the 17th to the 19th centuries, where they offered prayers of repentance, comfort and healing.
