The following parables were shared:

Christian Science: The Wheat and the Tares (Matthew 13:26 - 30)

Bahá'í Faith: The Parable of the Sower (Matthew 13:1 - 23)

WFWP/UPF: The Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11 - 31)

Latter-day Saints: The Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25:14 - 30)

Bahá'í Faith: The Parable of the Tenants (Matthew 21:33 - 46)

Each faith leader took time to prepare and deliver a thoughtful and meaningful presentation. Participants gained new insights from each perspective, deepening mutual understanding and respect.

The gathering concluded with a shared prayer, followed by expressions of goodwill as participants wished one another a Merry Christmas and Happy Holidays.
