In accordance with True Parents' special instructions, the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation is now receiving applications for the **Wonmo Pyeongae Global Leaders Scholarship Program** for the second semester of a Korean language course for competent leaders in the public mission who have potential to serve as a national leader. We would like to ask all regional headquarters to base their selection of scholarship recipients on the guidelines within the attached program guidebook.

1. Education Program: the second semester of 2015 Korean language course at Sun Moon University (a one-year program)

2. Number of scholarship students to be accepted: 10 maximum

3. Benefits for the scholarship students:

- a) Full tuition for the Korean language course
- b) Support for food expenses including the food expenses on weekends
- c) Support for the dormitory fee
- d) Refer to the attached guidebook for more details

4. Applicant Requirements (must satisfy all qualifications below):

- a) The applicant is a citizen, or resident of the mission nation (Korean citizens are ineligible)
- b) University graduates or those with an equivalent education or higher
- c) A person who commits to completing the entire Korean language course (one year)
- d) A person who is recommended by the regional president or national leader in the mission nation
- e) A person who commits to returning to the mission nation and serving in a public mission as a national leader candidate under the direction of the regional president after completing the scholarship program



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- f) A person who has served at least 1 year of public mission in the mission nation (as a minister or working full time in any of the various organizations of FFWPU)
- g) A person who has served at least 3 years in a life of devotion (The devotion standard is based on their region.)
- h) A person with no physical or mental disabilities (Pregnant women are also ineligible.)
- i) After finish one-year program, Universal Peace Academy(UPA) applicant will not be able to receive financial support for the 1-year language course of the “1+2” course system at UPA

5. Selection Procedure:

Each regional headquarters must collect documents submitted by the applicants and send them to the international headquarters. The Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation will conduct the final selection. Refer to the guidebook for more details.

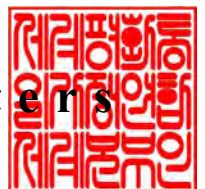

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1. 목적 / Program Objective

“원모평애 글로벌장학생 프로그램 공직자부문”은 어머니의 사랑으로 전 인류를 살리기 위한 미래의 지도자 양성에 그 목적을 두고 있다. 특히 공직자 장학제도는 한 국가를 책임질 현직 공직자를 대상으로 선발하여 선문대에서 한국어 교육과 지도자코스의 교육을 제공함으로써 통일가의 미래를 책임지게 함에 있다.

The objective of the Wonmo Pyeongae Global Leaders Scholarship Program, by the grace of True Mother's love, is to nurture future leaders for the salvation of all humankind. The scholarship program consists of selecting scholarship recipients among current missionaries, who have the potential to take responsibility for a nation, and having them take responsibility for the future of Unification Family by providing a Korean language leadership course at Sun Moon University.

 - A person who recommended by the regional president or the national leader of the mission nation
 - A person who pledges to return to their mission nation and serve in a public mission as a public missionary under the direction of the regional president after completing their scholarship program
 - A person who has served at least 3 years in a public mission in the mission nation
 - A person with no physical or mental disabilities (Pregnant women are also ineligible.)

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- Students have to attend the Korean Language course for a full year
- The attendance rate for class should exceed 90% (including summer and winter sessions). Students must provide advance notice if they will be absent for a valid reason.
- Students have to attend the Sunday services at Sun Moon University.
- Students have to attend the education programs organized by the FFWPU International headquarters and the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation.

- Students must arrive Korea before the opening day of the 2nd semester in 2015.
 * Detailed schedule for the day of entry will be notified later.
- Students are required to get a D-4 visa. Visit the Korean Embassy or Korean Consulate in your country of residence with the invitation letter from Sun Moon University.
- Students are advised to prepare sufficient funds to cover personal expenses during their stay in Korea. Part-time jobs are not allowed for students with a D-4 visa.
- Prior to arrival, students should be informed about the Korean climate, customs, and culture.

C. Korean Language Course

- Duration: 1-Year Course : August 31, 2015 – August, 2016
- Institution: Korean Language Institute at Sun Moon University

D. Cancellation of Scholarship Selection

- When any document for scholarship application has been found to contain false information.
- When a scholarship student does not enter Korea by the opening day of the 1st semester in 2015.
- When the admission of Sun Moon University Korean language course is canceled.
- When a scholarship student is not allowed to move into the dorm due to health issues.

E. Suspension of Scholarship Issuance

- When a scholarship student has violated the written pledge.
- When a scholarship student is punished by Sun Moon University or involved in certain forms of political activities.
- When a scholarship student has detracted the reputation of FFWPU International Headquarters, Sun Moon University, and Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation by hurting the dignity of the scholarship.
- When the student has violated the guidelines and regulations set by FFWPU International Headquarters, Sun Moon University, and Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation.

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- During the Korean Language course, scholarship students must attend all classes (attendance must exceed 90% of total class time) including summer and winter sessions. If a student has any special reason to be absent from a class, he or she must receive permission from his or her teacher in advance.

11. 질의응답 / Frequently Asked Questions

What is an insurance fee?

Every international student at Sun Moon University joins the insurance service provided by Sun Moon University, unless a student has already joined another international insurance service.

If I go eat outside of school, will I be reimbursed?

No, if you eat anywhere other than the school cafeteria, you will not be reimbursed. You will be responsible for your personal expenses.

What happens to the international students during winter/summer session?

Students in the Wonmo Pyeongae Global Leaders Scholarship Program are expected to stay at the dormitory during the winter/summer session, since there will be education programs. The information about the educational programs during the winter/summer will be announced later. The school cafeteria is open during the winter/summer session.

What is the situation regarding medical coverage and medical insurance?

There is a health center on the first floor of the Student Building on campus. Please refer to the table below for descriptions of medical coverage. Please contact Sun Moon University for the process of getting the medical coverage.

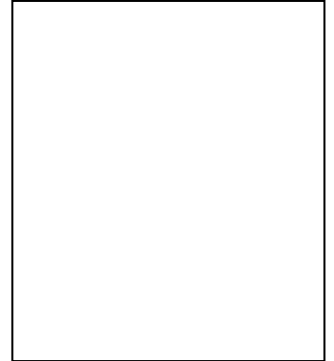
