Well, this entire site is dedicated to keeping you up-to-date about Tribal Messiahship standards and best practices. Here is a quick checklist to help you review the size of your tribe today!

HEAVENLY TRIBAL MESSIAH CHECKLIST:

Obviously there is a lot more to it, but the central metric used to measure your tribe-building success is the number of active Blessed couples in your tribe. This raises two questions:

1. What defines “active”?
2. Who can we count?

HERE ARE THE ANSWERS:

1. Global standards define an active Blessed couple as those who:

- a. Completed all five steps of the Holy Marriage Blessing
- b. Remain connected to FFWPU. The metric used to define a minimum level of active participation is participation in a church service and tithe at least twice a year.

2. Who can we count?

a. Couples who have now received the Marriage Blessing as a result of you witnessing to them, including your:

Relatives

Non-relatives

People you have witnessed to since joining FFWPU

b. Couples who have now received the Marriage Blessing through your physical and spiritual children, including their:

Relatives

Non-relatives

People they witnessed to since joining FFWPU
