- There will be a crèche for pre-school children, two Sunday school classes for primary school children and activities for HARP children up to year 10 (about 15 years old).
- We expect a parent to stay with babies under 2 in the crèche. Children can be registered in the appropriate rooms from 10.45am and should be collected no later than 1pm.
- Older children in year 11 or above (aged about 16 and over) should join the main service.
